» Auburn and Ole Miss renew their annual home-and-home series Wednesday night in Oxford. The Rebels lead 42-25 at home, but the Tigers have won two of the last three, which includes last season's thrilling 19-point comeback win. Down 39-20 early in the second half, Auburn had just a 3.1 percent chance win probability according to ESPN before completing the comeback.

» While Auburn has taken care of business at home with a 50-5 record over the last three-plus campaigns, the Tigers have also shown their grit on the road. Auburn owns a 37-23 (.617) mark away from home since the 2017-18 season, which is tops in the league, ahead of Tennessee (33-21, .611), Kentucky (33-23, .589) and Florida (31-27, .534).

» Auburn has the most games of 15 or more 3s since head coach Bruce Pearl took over prior to the 2014-15 season. The Tigers have 16 games of 15 or more 3s since 2014-15, while the rest of the league has 41 combined.

» Jamal Johnson is tied for fifth in the SEC in scoring at 20.5 points per game in league action. After scoring 21 vs. Arkansas and 20 at Texas A&M, he is one of just seven players in the nation to tout multiple games of at least 20 points off the bench so far this season.

» Auburn is the only team in country to have three players averaging at least 10 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game. Allen Flanigan is averaging a team-high 14.5 points, to go along with 4.8 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game. Justin Powell is averaging 11.7 points, 6.1 rebounds and 4.7 assists per contest, while Jaylin Williams is averaging 10.2 points, 4.8 rebounds and 2.9 assists per game.

• Auburn sold out of season tickets for the sixth straight time in 2019-20, all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came was 1999-2000

• In 25 full years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have finished either first or second in conference play 17 times

• At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 20 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg

AUBURN VS. OLE MISS SERIES

» The Tigers and Rebels meet for the first time this season and 139th time in series history Wednesday night. Auburn leads the overall series at 77-62.

» Auburn is 25-42 at Ole Miss all-time, but has won two of the last three. The Tigers' win at Oxford in 2018 snapped an 8-game losing streak to the Rebels away from home. In total, Ole Miss has won nine of the last 11 at home in the series. The Tigers are 5-15 in Oxford since the turn of the millennium.

» After falling 10 straight times to the Rebels from 2012-2017, the Tigers have won four of the last six duels in the annual home-and-home matchup.

» In last season's matchup in Oxford on Jan. 28, Auburn made history. The Tigers were down 39-20 early in the second half and hope had all but gone away. ESPN had Auburn's win probability at 3.1 percent and SEC teams entered that game 0-102 when trailing by 17 or more at halftime on the road over the last decade.

» The Tigers then stormed back behind strong second halves by Anfernee McLemore and Isaac Okoro. McLemore scored 14 of his career-high 19 points after halftime. Okoro made the play that secured the comeback in the second overtime when he drove, drew the foul and converted an and-1 to give Auburn a 1-point lead it would not relinquish. The 19-point comeback is tied for the third-largest comeback in program history.

» Bruce Pearl is 9-9 against Ole Miss all-time with four of those wins coming as Auburn's head coach. Pearl is 9-3 against Ole Miss head coach Kermit Davis, including 7-1 when Davis was leading Middle Tennessee.

LET IT FLY

» Auburn set a program record with 22 3-pointers vs. South Alabama in the first home game of the season on Dec. 4. The Tigers lead the SEC and are 19th in the nation at 10.3 makes from downtown per game.

PLAYER TO WATCH: JAMAL JOHNSON

In a team full of underclassmen, recent Auburn graduate Jamal Johnson has stepped up in a big way in his second season with the Tigers. The junior is tied for fifth in the SEC with an average of 20.5 points per game in league play. In fact, Johnson is one of just seven players in the country to tout two 20-point outings off the bench, doing so against Arkansas (21) and Texas A&M (20).



» As Coach Pearl has said, "As long as the 3 is worth more than the 2, we'll continue to take them." Below are all the games Auburn has hit at least 15 3-pointers as a team.

» As one of just two upperclassmen on the roster, junior Jamal Johnson has stepped up and provided a spark off the bench for the Tigers this season.

» Johnson is tied for fifth in the SEC in scoring at 20.5 points per game in league action. He has produced back-to-back 20-point outings with a career-best 21 vs. Arkansas and 20 at Texas A&M.

» Johnson is one of just seven players in the nation to tout multiple games of at least 20 points off the bench so far this season. He is joined by JD Notae (Arkansas), Trey Diggs (Bowling Green), Landers Nolley (Memphis), Quincy Olivari (Rice), Myron Gordon (Samford) and Emanuel Miller (Texas A&M).

» Following an internship in the fall with 107.5 The Ticket, an ESPN affiliated radio station in Montgomery, Johnson earned bachelor's degree from the School of Communication and proudly wears an SEC Graduate patch. Johnson is now working towards a master's degree from the School of Communication.

LOTS OF BALANCE

» After losing a majority of its production from a season ago, Auburn has had to count on players to assume new roles for the 2020-21 season. In doing so, the Tigers have found balance across their lineup.

» Auburn is the only team in country to have three players averaging at least 10 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game.

» With the departure of the five seniors and Isaac Okoro, who went No. 5 in the 2020 NBA Draft, there was plenty of opportunity for those that returned. Enter: Allen Flanigan. The Little Rock, Ark. native is Auburn's leading scorer at 14.5 points per game after averaging just 3.2 points per contest a season ago. JP IS A UNICORN

» On Dec. 4, Auburn freshman Justin Powell made history with his performance against South Alabama. Powell had 26 points on 7-of-9 from the floor, with all of his shots behind the arc, and nine assists.

» Powell's 26 points vs. South Alabama tied Eddie Johnson for the Auburn record for most points in a home debut by a freshman. Johnson had 26 points vs. Western Carolina 47 years to the day of Powell (Dec. 4, 1973).

» His nine assists and seven 3s vs. South Alabama were the most by a freshman in his home debut in program history.

» Powell is one of six freshman in the country since 2010 to have nine assists and seven 3s in a game, joining Trae Young (Oklahoma), Ky Bowman (Boston College), Shamorie Ponds (St. John's), Jordan Bohannon (Iowa) and Braden Norris (Oakland).

CLASS OF THE SEC: MOST GRADUATES SINCE 2014

When it comes to graduating players, nobody in the SEC has done it better than head coach Bruce Pearl and Auburn. Two-thirds of the seats are less than 27 feet in elevation from courtside offering a home environment that is unrivaled.

» Auburn and Kentucky are the only two SEC programs to not return a player that averaged five or more points per game from a season ago.

» The Tigers have to replace the winningest class in program history as the 2020 seniors amassed 99 wins, besting the previous mark of 88 set by the 2001 seniors.

» The 2020 class also hold the most wins in a 3-year span with 81, most in a 2-year span with 56 and most in a single year with 30 in 2019.

WHOLE LOTTA HEIGHT

» Auburn boasts the ninth-tallest team in the country, averaging 78.7 inches per player - nearly 6-foot-7.

» Auburn's average height of 78.7 inches on the 2020-21 roster is the tallest the Tigers have had over the last 15 seasons.

» Since 2007, Auburn has boasted an average height of 77 inches or more just four times: 77.1 in 2010-11, 77.9 in 2015-16, 77.3 in 2019-20 and 78.7 in 2020-21.

» Auburn's average height over the last 15 seasons is ranked in the middle of the pack nationally (160.5). The Tigers have had a roster in the top 100 in the country in terms of height just three times since 2007: 93rd in 2010-11, 48th in 2015-16 and ninth in 2020-21.

TIGERS IN OVERTIME

» With a 96-91 win in overtime vs. Saint Joseph's, Auburn is 58-53 in overtime games alltime, including a 9-0 mark since the start of the 2018-19 season and 2-0 against Saint Joseph's.

» The Tigers are 12-2 in overtime under head coach Bruce Pearl, including a perfect 5-0 last season.

» Auburn's 9-game winning streak in overtime is currently the second-longest active winning streak behind Florida State (10). The all-time national record for consecutive overtime victories is 11 by Louisville (1968-75), UMass (1991-96) and Virginia (1991-96). Temple (seven) and Kansas (six) are next in the country in terms of longest active winning streaks in overtime.

» The Tigers have recorded three straight 20-win seasons for the second time all-time after first accomplishing the feat from 1983-84 to 1985-86. After a win against LSU last year, Auburn secured its third consecutive 21-win season, a first in program history for the Tigers.

» Bruce Pearl joins Cliff Ellis and Sonny Smith as the only head coaches to lead Auburn to three 20-win seasons.

» In the 25 seasons that Bruce Pearl has been a head coach, including the 2019-20 campaign, his teams have amassed 20 20-win seasons. In simple math, Coach Pearl has won at least 20 games in a season in 80 percent of his seasons as the head coach.

OKORO MAKES HISTORY

Dreams became reality for former Auburn star Isaac Okoro Wednesday night when he was chosen with the No. 5 overall selection in the 2020 NBA Draft by the Cleveland Cavaliers.

Okoro's selection is tied for the third-highest selection in program history behind only Chris Morris (No. 4, 1988) and Chuck Person (No. 4, 1986). Charles Barkley was also chosen No. 5 in the 1984 NBA Draft.

The Powder Springs, Ga. native became the first one-and-done player in program history.

Okoro was just the sixth player in Southeastern Conference history to be named All-SEC, All-Defensive and All-Freshman in the same season.

Following Okoro's No. 5 selection and Chuma Okeke's No. 16 pick in the 2019 NBA Draft, Auburn has produced back-to-back first round draft picks for the first time in program history.

Okoro averaged 12.9 points, 4.4 rebounds, two assists, 0.9 steals and 0.9 blocks in 31.5 minutes per game while starting 28 games as a first-year player in senior-laden lineup. The Tigers posted a 25-6 record during the 2019-20 campaign.

Okoro scored in double figures 20 times and was named the SEC Freshman of the Week twice, becoming just the fourth freshman in program history to earn the conference distinction two times in a season.

Okoro is the second Tiger to be drafted by the Cavaliers, joining Mike Mitchell, who was taken with the 15th selection of the 1978 NBA Draft. Along with Mitchell (1978-82), former lettermen Eddie Johnson (1985-86) and Wesley Person (1997-2002) all played for the Cavs.

AUBURN VS. TOP-25 OPPONENTS

Auburn is 70-215 against teams from the AP Top 25 all-time. In 2018-19, the Tigers set a program record by defeating six top-25 teams, including five in a row from the SEC Tournament title to a trip to the Final Four.

The Tigers won two of their matchups against top-25 competition last season, taking down No. 13 Kentucky (75-66) and No. 18 LSU (91-90 in OT) in a span of seven days. Auburn lost its most recent top-25 battle at No. 8 Kentucky, 73-66.

Auburn has won seven of its last nine games against the AP Top 25, which is the best stretch in program history by far. The next-closest similar streak was when the Tigers defeated six of nine ranked foes between the 1984-85 and 1985-86 seasons

Auburn is 14-23 as a ranked team vs. a ranked opponent all-time, but has won seven of the last nine occurrences.
