★ The Commodores are back on the road for a matchup with Auburn on Monday night from Auburn Arena. The game will be televised nationally on the SEC Network with Brenda VanLengen and Carol Ross on the call. Vanderbilt is coming off a 67-55 setback in Athens to No. 18 Georgia. The Dores are looking for their second SEC road win of the season after a win over Ole Miss on Feb. 1 and their first win at Auburn since 2013-14.

★ Vanderbilt enters Monday's game after a 67-55 loss to No. 18 Georgia on Thursday. Kayla Overbeck had a career night for the Commodores with a career-best 21 points, her first career 20-point outing, and her fourth consecutive game in double figures. Autumn Newby led the way on the glass with eight rebounds. Vanderbilt is looking to snap its current two-game skid and pick up some momentum heading into the final weeks of the season and the SEC Tournament.

★ Monday's meeting with Auburn will be the only meeting this season. The Tigers are riding a four-game win streak in the series entering Mondays' matchup and have 13 wins on their home court in the series. Vanderbilt last defeated Auburn in 2013-14 and until a loss in the second meeting in 2013-14, held a 21-game win streak in the series. In the last five games in the series, just one has decided by double digits and the average margin of victory is 8.0 ppg.

★ Kayla Overbeck has put together a pretty impressive stretch. Over the last eight games, Overbeck has reached double figures in six contests of those contests and currently has been in double figures in the last four games. Through the last eight, Overbeck is averaging 13.0 points per game and is shooting an impressive .727 (40-of-55) from the field. On the season, the California native is averaging 9.2 points per game, a figure that jumps to 11.2 in SEC play.

★ Christa Reed is making the most of her last SEC slate. Through the last eight games, Reed is averaging 13.0 points per game and shooting .493 percent from the floor (35-of-71). She's been extremely impressive from the charity stripe, shooting .955 percent (21-22) and is perfect from the stripe (16-of-16) through the last six games. She's reached double figures in six of the last seven games and enters the Auburn game needing just eight points to join the 1,000-point club.

CREDENTIALS

Season credentials are issued jointly for men's and women's basketball.

Credentials are available for pick-up at Media Will Call located near the playing floor at Memorial Gymnasium. Those media wishing to access Media Will Call should enter the service tunnel located at the end of Lot 71 behind the outfield wall of Vanderbilt's Hawkins Field baseball stadium. Proceed through the tunnel until you arrive at the Media Will Call table. If enough advance notice is given, credentials can be mailed or sent via next-day carrier at the expense of the media organization making the request.

INTERVIEW POLICY

All interview requests — coaches and players — MUST be coordinated through the Vanderbilt Communications office. During the week, head coach Stephanie White will generally be available for interview after practice Monday-Friday unless arranged otherwise. Stephanie White enters her second season at the helm of the Vanderbilt women's basketball team in 2017-18. White was named the head coach of the Vanderbilt women's basketball team in May of 2016, becoming just the fifth all-time head coach in the history of the Vanderbilt program.

When she arrived in Nashville, White inherited a young Vanderbilt team that featured only two seniors and relied heavily on five freshmen. White guided the Commodores to a 14-16 overall record in her first season with the team, including a 4-12 mark in the SEC during the 2016-17 campaign.

White's inaugural season on West End featured plenty of highlights, and was capped by a late-season surge that saw the Commodores win three of their final five games of the regular season. Other highlights included:

* The Commodores were ranked among the nation's top-5 in 3-point percentage throughout the season, and finished the season ranked No. 6 after shooting 38.6 for the year. Vanderbilt also led the SEC in 3-pointers per game (7.1).

* White guided Vanderbilt to 10 wins in its first 11 games during the first six weeks of the season. The hot start included a nine-game winning streak that spanned from Nov. 16 to Dec. 18. The winning streak was highlighted by an impressive victory over Duke on Nov. 20, along with quality wins over Robert Morris, Drexel and Tulane.

* At season's end, a pair of Vanderbilt freshmen -- Kayla Overbeck and Erin Whalen -- were named to the SEC's All-Freshman Team, as voted upon by the conference's coaches.

Having enjoyed success at virtually every level of basketball as a player and coach, White arrived at Vanderbilt after spending two seasons as the head coach of the WNBA's Indiana Fever. She took the Fever to the playoffs in each of her two seasons, including a trip to the WNBA finals in 2015.

"The opportunity to lead Vanderbilt's women's basketball program is an opportunity that I simply could not pass up," White said at her introductory press conference. "The combination of Vanderbilt's culture, where achievement -- both on and off the court - is so highly valued, together with the institution's fan support, and a legacy of winning basketball to build upon, is incredibly exciting to me. I appreciate the support and understanding that I have received from the Indiana Fever, from management to the players, regarding my passion to coach college basketball at an elite institution."

White -- who played five seasons in the WNBA after a decorated playing career at Purdue -- was named head coach of the Fever in September 2014. In 2015, she guided the Fever to the WNBA finals, becoming the first rookie coach in league history to lead a team to the finals. As a collegiate player, White enjoyed a highly successful career at Purdue, where she earned national Player of the Year honors after helping lead the Boilermakers to the 1999 NCAA championship as a senior. That season, she also received the Wade Trophy (given to the nation's top female player) and was named Big Ten Conference Player of the Year.

"Stephanie White has been a winner in every phase of her career," Vanderbilt athletic director David Williams said. "She was the nation's high school player of the year, she was the NCAA's Player of the Year on a national championship team and she led her WNBA team into the finals in her first year. She was an outstanding scholar. She wants to coach at Vanderbilt and we believe she is just the person to lead our program back into national prominence."

White averaged double-figure scoring in all four seasons of her college career, including 20.2 points per game as a senior, and amassed 2,182 points for her career. White was inducted into the Purdue Athletics Hall of Fame on April 21, 2006.

She was also a star in the classroom at Purdue. She was a member of Phi Beta Kappa and was an Academic All-American.

White was an assistant coach with the Chicago Sky from 2007-2010, then joined the Fever staff as an assistant in 2011. She was promoted to associate head coach in 2014 before being named head coach after Lin Dunn's retirement. While coaching in the WNBA, White served as a college basketball analyst for ESPN and the Big Ten Network. She also covered the NBA's Indiana Pacers for FOX Sports Indiana.

Prior to coaching in the WNBA, White coached in the college ranks, serving as an assistant at Toledo (2005-07), Kansas State (2004-05) and Ball State (2003-04).

Before beginning her coaching career, White enjoyed a productive five-year WNBA career, spending one season with the Charlotte Sting and four with the Indiana Fever, before retiring in 2004.

At the completion of her four seasons with the Fever, she ranked third in games played (112) and 3-pointers (92), and fourth in scoring (684). She was named to the Fever's All-Decade Team that was announced in 2009.

White and her wife, Michelle, have three young boys: Landon, and twins, Aiden & Avery.

Setting the Scene

-The Commodores are on the road for the second consecutive game on Monday with a trip to Auburn to take on the Tigers. Tipoff is set for 6 pm CT from Auburn Arena. The game will be televised nationally on the SEC Network.

Last Time Out

-Vanderbilt dropped a 67-55 road contest to No. 18 Georgia on Thursday. Kayla Overbeck was the lone Commodore in double figures with a career-best 21 points for her fourth straight game in double figures. Freshman Autumn Newby led the way on the glass with a team-best eight rebounds. The Bulldogs swept the season series and the loss was the second consecutive for Vanderbilt.

Scouting Report

-Auburn enters Monday's game with a 12-11, 3-8 SEC record after a 70-62 win over LSU on Thursday night. Janiah McKay leads a trio in double figures with 16.6 points per game. Daisia Alexander and Unique Thompson are also in double figures with 13.7 and 11.5 points per game, respectively. Thompson leads the way on the glass with 8.9 rebounds per game. The Tigers are a game ahead of the Commodores in the SEC standings and are 3-2 at home in SEC action with wins over Florida, Alabama and LSU.

With A Win

-The Commodores will pick up their third SEC win and their second SEC road win.
 -A win would also snap the Tigers current four-game win streak in the series.
 -A Vanderbilt win would make Vanderbilt 29-20 in the all-time series.

Road Trippin'

The Commodores will spend much of the final month of the season on the road. Vanderbilt will make five road trips in the final eight games of the season after making just two road trips the month of January. The Commodores picked up their first SEC road win since 2015-16 with a 75-72 win at Ole Miss. Last season, Vanderbilt didn't win an SEC road win and over the last four seasons Vanderbilt has won just seven SEC road games.

Kayla Overbeck a Case Study in Efficiency

Sophomore Kayla Overbeck has really stepped her game up since the start of SEC play. In the last eight games, Overbeck is shooting a blistering .727 percent from the field (40-of-55) and is averaging 13.0 points per game in that span. Overbeck's season average is 9.2 points per game a number that moves to 11.2 points per game against SEC foes. The California native averaged just 7.8 points per game in the non-conference.

Overbeck with a Big Night in Athens

Kayla Overbeck was a bright spot for the Commodores in Athens on Thursday. The sophomore went off for a career-best 21 points and was 10-of-14 from the floor and was an impressive 6-of-7 from the floor through the first half. Overbeck's 21 points marked her fourth consecutive game in double figures and was her first career 20-point game.

Christa Reed Closing Her Career Strong

Senior Christa Reed has been Vanderbilt's consistent this season. The Bay St. Louis, Mississippi native has put together quite the impressive eight-game stretch. Over the last eight games, she's averaging 13.0 points, shooting .497 percent from the field (35-of-71) and is knocking down .464 percent of her shots from long range (13-of-28). Probably the most impressive number is from the free throw line, where she's shooting .955 percent (21-of-22) and enters the Auburn game having made her last 16 foul shots.

Reed Approaching 1K

Reed is closing in on her 1,000th career point and entering the Auburn game is just eight points shy of the mark. Should she reach the mark, she will become the second Commodore to reach 1,000 points joining classmate teammate Rachel Bell. They will become the first pair to reach the milestone in the same season since 2012-13, when the Commodores had three players join the 1,000-point club.

Walker From Deep

Cierra Walker has quietly put together a very impressive SEC campaign. The Oregon City, Oregon native is averaging 10.8 points against SEC competition and has really stepped up her production from long range. In non-conference

action, Walker shot .379 percent (22-of-58 from deep but in SEC play, Walker is shooting .549 percent (28-of-51). In the last eight games, Walker has been especially productive shooting .559 (19-of-34) from long range. When the Commodores win, Walker is shooting .531 percent from deep.

Chelsie Hall Doing Chelsie Hall Things ...

Freshman Chelsie Hall has put together an impressive freshman campaign thus far. The rookie from Boca Raton, Florida is leading the Commodores in scoring with 13.0 points per game and has started every game this season. She's reached double figures in a team-best 17 games this season and in 10 of Vanderbilt's last 13 games, including a career-best 26 against Belmont. Hall's scored 20+ in three contests this season. Hall's 13.0 points per game make her the No. 2 SEC freshman scorer trailing just Texas A&M's Chennedy Carter.

Overbeck, Reed the X-Factors in Wins

Sophomore Kayla Overbeck is shooting .618 (21-of-34) in Vanderbilt wins and averages 10.8 points per game in Commodore victories. Overbeck has 12 games in double figures this season and of Vanderbilt's six wins, Overbeck has been in double figures in four of them. Christa Reed is also key in Vanderbilt victories. Reed is averaging 12.7 points per game in Vanderbilt wins and is shooting .550 percent (11-of-20) from long range in victories.

Offense Settling In

Vanderbilt's offense over the last seven games has been vastly improved. In the last seven games, the Commodores are shooting .472 percent from the field and as a team are shooting .405 percent from long range. Vanderbilt is averaging 69.7 points per game in this span. In comparison, through the first two SEC games Vanderbilt was shooting just .394 and averaging 58.5 points per game.

Charity Stripe Is Money for the Commodores

The Commodores are quite efficient from the line, shooting .726 which ranks No. 3 in the SEC. Vanderbilt has eight players shooting at least 70 percent or better from the stripe led by Erin Whalen who is a perfect 17-of-17 from the line this year while Christa Reed who is shooting an SEC-best .923 percent and hasn't missed a free throw in the last six games. Reed is the only SEC player shooting over 90 percent from the charity stripe.

Vanderbilt's Sharpshooters

Cierra Walker has been lethal from long range since the start of SEC play. Walker is shooting .549 percent (28-of-51) from long range against SEC foes and is averaging 2.14 3-PT field goals over the last seven contests. Erin Whalen has also got a hot hand from long range, she's shooting .359 on the season from deep and the number increases to .421 percent in SEC play. As a team, the Commodores are shooting .394 percent from long range on the season and .404 in SEC play. The Dores .394 percentage ranks No. 9 nationally and is tops in the SEC. The

Commodores have been ranked in the top 10 of the nation in 3-pt FG percentage in three of the last five seasons including finishing the year No. 3 in 2013-14.

Strong Start Against Cardinals

Vanderbilt had one of its best starts of the season against Louisville. The Commodores led 24-20 after one period of play. The Dores 24 points are the most scored in the first period this season and marked the first time Vanderbilt has led after one period of play this season. The Dores are averaging 16.2 points per quarter.

Dores are "Youthful"

Of the 14 players on the Vanderbilt roster 10 are underclassmen meaning that the 2017-18 Commodore roster is 71.4 percent underclassmen. The Dores added four true freshmen this season and had a five-member freshman class last year while welcoming Boston College transfer and redshirt sophomore Mariella Fasoula.

Bell Tough Against Syracuse In Paradise Jam

Senior Rachel Bell was on fire against Syracuse in the second game of the Paradise Jam. The Tennessee native tied her career best with 31 points against the Cuse and went 7-of-10 from long range to set a new career best and tie the Paradise Jam single-game three-point record. Bell's 31 points are the most points and individual scored in a single game over the three-day tournament. Bell averaged 18.0 points per game at the Paradise Jam.

Bell Shoots Her Way into Vandy Record Books

Bell's seven triples against Syracuse will earn her a spot in the Vanderbilt record books as her seven long-range bombs tie her for the second-most triples in a single-game. She joins Christina Foggie, Caroline Williams, Jillian Danker and Julie Powell as Dores to hit seven in a game. For her career, Bell is shooting .369 percent from long range.

Dores Were Road Strong in November

In the first month of the season, Vanderbilt has played six of its eight games on the road in a true or neutral site fashion. Vanderbilt sports a 2-4 road record to date. Through the first month of the season the Commodores traveled 2,115.3 miles for six road games. Vanderbilt is looking to right its road woes this season. Last season, the Commodores posted a 3-10 record away from Nashville and were 0-8 on the road in the SEC. Vanderbilt already has two road wins in the bag this season with wins at George Washington and at Saint Louis.

Volunteer State Bragging Rights on the Line

This season, Vanderbilt will face five teams from the state of Tennessee in Middle Tennessee, Memphis, Belmont, Lipscomb and Tennessee. Additionally, the Commodores are playing three teams from the greater Nashville area in Middle Tennessee, Lipscomb and Belmont. This will be the most teams from the state of Tennessee that Vanderbilt has played in the last six seasons. In each of the last three seasons, including this season, Vanderbilt has played at least two non-conference opponents from the Tennessee.

Speaking of Tennessee ...

Vanderbilt has several players that call Tennessee home. Currently, Vanderbilt has four players from Tennessee. Rachel Bell (Cumberland Furnace), LeaLea Carter (Dickinson), Kaleigh Clemons-Green (Chattanooga) and Myka Dancy (Antioch). The Dores will add two more from the state of Tennessee when they welcome Nashville area natives Brinae Alexander (Murfreesboro) and Jordyn Cambridge (Nashville).

Welcome to The Family Brinae and Jordyn

The Commodore women's basketball family expanded by two during the NCAA's early signing period as local products, Brinae Alexander (Murfreesboro, Tenn.) and Jordyn Cambridge (Nashville, Tenn.) inked with the Commodores. The duo is the No. 18 class nationally and are the second top 25 class for Vanderbilt in the last three seasons.

Freshmen Become Sophomores

The highly-touted freshmen from the 2016-17 season will be sophomores this season and have gained valuable experience. The five-member class of LeaLea Carter, Kaleigh Clemons-Green, Kayla Overbeck, Cierra Walker and Erin Whalen was a consensus top-20 class and was ranked as high as No. 6 by Blue Star Basketball. As freshman, the quintet averaged 32.7 points per game and 16.2 rebounds per game. The group also accounted for 48 percent of the Commodores scoring. This group gained valuable experience as freshman which will be beneficial in 2017-18.

Shooters Touch

Last year, the Commodores were ranked among the nation's best in three-point field goal percentage. Vanderbilt closed the season ranked

No. 6 nationally, shooting at a .386 clip from long range while leading the SEC in triples per game with 7.1 per game. The team returns it's top two three-point threats in Kaleigh Clemons-Green (.449) and Christa Reed (.446).

Hitting the Glass

The Commodores will have the tall task of replacing Marqu'es Webb's 9.1 rebounds per game but they won't be short on help. Vanderbilt returns the SEC's top freshman rebounder from last year in sophomore Kayla Overbeck who averaged 7.2 rebounds per game as a rookie. Additionally, the rebounding will be helped by Purdue graduate transfer Bree Horrocks who checks in at 6-5 as well as freshman Paige Warren who is 6-4.

Plenty of TV Time on Deck for Commodores

Vanderbilt's Big 12/SEC Challenge matchup with Iowa State on Dec. 2 will be televised on SEC Network and is the first of eight games set to air on the SEC's flagship. The Commodores will have four home games televised on the SEC Network: Iowa State (Dec. 2), Kentucky (Jan. 15), Texas A&M (Jan. 28) and Mississippi State (Feb. 15). Road games televised on the SEC Network include: at LSU (Dec. 31), at Tennessee (Jan. 7), at Auburn (Feb. 12), at Florida (Feb. 18). The home game with Tennessee on Feb. 4 will air on ESPNU.
