#### ABOUT THE MATCH-UP

- The Lobos and Tigers will be meeting for the first time in program history.
- The game is the tipoff for the 2015 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic Tournament, in which the Lobos will play three games in four days. The winner/loser of this game will face off on Dec. 23 against the winner/loser between BYU and Harvard. The other side of the bracket includes No. 3/8 Oklahoma, Washington State, Northern Iowa and Hawaii.
- Although the Lobos have never faced the Tigers, they have a successful history against the Southeastern Conference, holding a 13-10 overall record. The Lobos have a winning record against teams such as Texas A&M, Missouri, Ole Miss and Georgia.
- Bruce Pearl and Craig Neal have yet to face each other as head coaches, but they share a common history, as both served as assistant coaches at Iowa prior to earning head jobs. Pearl assisted alongside head coach Tom Davis from 1986-92, while Neal served alongside head coach Steve Alford from 2004-07.
- The Tigers enter the Diamond Head Classic with a 5-3 record. While the Lobos are coming off a one-point loss at the hands of Rice. The Tigers travel to Hawaii after falling on the road to No. 10/18 Xavier, 85-61. Their last victory came at home against Mercer, 78-71. Pearl is in his second season as head coach at Auburn. In his career, Pearl has led teams to the NCAA Tournament 17 times.

## NEW MEXICO GAME NOTES

### LAST TIME OUT

The University of New Mexico men's basketball team (7-3) dropped a home game for the first time this season, falling to the Rice Owls (5-4), 90-89, in WisePies Arena Saturday. The Lobos were led by Elijah Brown's fourth consecutive 20-point game, with 21 points on 5-for-13 shooting. He also tallied five rebounds and two assists. Tim Williams scored 18 points on 9-for-12 shooting and pulled down a team-best nine rebounds. Cullen Neal was the team's leading distributor, with seven assists to go with 16 points. Obij Aget was the team's fourth double-digit scorer, with 11 points, seven rebounds and a career-high five blocks. Overall, the Lobos shot 50.8 percent (30-for-59) and 36.8 percent (7-for-19) from 3-point range. Rice shot 45.3 percent (29-for-64) and 40.7 percent (11-for-27) from deep. The Lobos won the rebounding battle, 40-31, but gave up more turnovers than Rice, 18-13.

### APPROACHING 50 CAREER WINS

Head coach Craig Neal is one victory away from his 50th career victory as head coach of the Lobos. He is currently sitting at 49-26, and if he can win one in the next two games, will be the fourth fastest head coach to ever win 50 games at New Mexico. If he reaches the mark, he will have served on two of the four fastest coaching staffs to reach 50, previously serving under Steve Alford, who reached 50 wins in 2009 in 71 games. The record is held by both Bob King and Norm Ellenberger, who each started their careers 50-16.

After a strong start last season, Neal reached 40 wins in just 53 games, the second fastest mark in program history. These are among several notable achievements in less than three years as head coach, including becoming the first rookie head coach to guide the Lobos to the NCAA Tournament.

### LOBOS IN NONCONFERENCE TOURNAMENTS

The New Mexico men's basketball team will be looking for positive results in the tough field at the 2015 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic. Over the years, early season nonconference tournaments have been kind to the Lobos and helped them collect big wins before Mountain West Conference play. Before last year's 1-2 finish in the ESPN Puerto Rico Tip Off the Lobos had finished their nonconference tournaments with a winning record for six straight years, dating back to the 2009-10 season.

### CRASHING THE BOARDS

Over the last three games against Northern Iowa, New Mexico State and Rice, the Lobos have been outrebounding opponents by a significant margin. During the stretch, the Lobos are averaging 38.7 rebounds a game, but holding opponents to 28 boards a game. The rebounding margin during the last three games is more than double the team's average this year. Four of the Lobos' starters are averaging at least four boards a game, with Tim Williams leading over the last three games at 7.3 per game. The high margin has given the Lobos plenty of second chance opportunities, with 10.7 offensive rebounds per game.

### BIG O BLOCK PARTY

During Saturday's game against Rice, starting center Obij Aget registered five blocked shots for the first time in his career. It was the first time a Lobo had blocked five shots since Ale Kirk swatted five against San Diego State on Feb. 22, 2014. In his three seasons, the junior had registered four blocks in a game on five separate occasions. The most recent game was this season on Nov. 21 at Southern California. Aget now has 61 blocks in his career and is 34 away from cracking the top-10 all time at New Mexico.

### STATISTICAL RANKINGS

Through games played Saturday, the Lobos hold the second highest RPI of any team in the Mountain West at 79. They rank only behind Boise State at 66th. They are also the highest ranked team in KenPom.com's rankings at 65th. The website is predicting the Lobos will win the Mountain West Conference regular season title with a 12-6 league record.

## LOBOS BACKCOURT

The starting backcourt duo of Elijah Brown and Cullen Neal are on pace to have a historic season if they can maintain their current standard. The duo is currently averaging a combined 34 points per game. That would be the most of any starting backcourt in the Neal/Alford era and the highest mark reached since 2002-03 (Ruben Douglas led the nation at 28 points per game). ## DEFENDING THE 3 BALL

Much of the Lobos' hype in the offseason was how effective the perimeter offense would be. However, nine games into the year the perimeter defense has been elite nationally and has been arguably the brightest aspect for New Mexico. The Lobos have held opponents to 28.7 percent shooting from 3-point range, which ranks 27th in the nation. They are just over five percent behind national leaders West Virginia at 22.4 percent. On Wednesday, the Lobos held New Mexico State to 0-for-7 from deep, marking the first time since the 2003 season opener in which a New Mexico opponent failed to make a trey.

## SEASON OF GIVING

Prior to leaving for West Lafayette, Indiana, the University of New Mexico men's basketball team participated in another community engagement activity, stuffing 30 stockings full of gifts for the Heart Gallery Foundation of New Mexico. The Heart Gallery Foundation was created to raise and manage funds to support at-risk foster children, and to educate the public and raise awareness of the need for adoptive and foster care families for New Mexico's foster children.

## OVERALL DEFENSE

The cherry and silver have continued last season's defense prowess. Last year, they held opponents to just 60.2 points per game, which was the second-best 4 defensive scoring mark posted by a UNM team in the last three decades. So far this year, the Lobos are living up to their lofty defensive expectations. The Lobos are holding teams to 40.1 percent shooting, 6.2 percent behind the national leaders in Purdue. New Mexico is one of four teams in the Mountain West to hold opponents to under 41 percent shooting for the year. San Diego State is the current conference leader at 35.5 percent.

## PROTECTING THE PIT

The Lobos are 6-1 in WisePies Arena this year, with wins over Texas Southern, Loyola-Chicago, Nicholls State, Oral Roberts, Northern Iowa and most recently New Mexico State. Prior to Saturday's loss against Rice by one point, the 6-0 start was the best home start in Craig Neal's three seasons as head coach with the Lobos, and the best since the 2012-13 season. That season, the Lobos started 7-0 at home and went on to win Mountain West regular season and tournament titles.

## 2016 WOODEN LEGACY

The University of New Mexico men's basketball team will participate in the 2016 DIRECTV Wooden Legacy, taking place Nov. 24-27 in Orange County, California, as announced by ESPN Events Friday. The first two days will be held on the campus of Cal-State Fullerton and the final day of competition will be at the Honda Center in Anaheim, California. Teams joining the Lobos in the field include Cal State-Northridge, Dayton, Nebraska, Portland, Texas A&M, UCLA and Virginia Tech.

## RIO GRANDE RIVALRY

The Lobos finished the Rio Grande Rivalry for the 2015-16 season and earned its eighth season sweep against the Aggies since 2002, the last year in which the Aggies recorded a sweep. The Lobos have won 15 of the last 17 meetings in the rivalry, and during the Neal/Alford era, have gone 15-3 against New Mexico State. The Lobos' win on Wednesday pushed the series record in Albuquerque to 73-68.

In this year's series, the Lobos shot 46.3 percent from the floor and 37.8 percent from 3-point range. The Aggies shot 42.6 percent from the floor and 16.1 percent from 3-point range. Elijah Brown averaged 25.5 points, seven rebounds and four assists per game against New Mexico State. Pascal Siakam, who has earned a double-double against every other opponent this year, averaged 22 points and six rebounds without recording a double-double.

## ALL-TIME ASSIST/TURNOVER RATIO

Starting point guard Cullen Neal is the Mountain West Conference leader at 5.2 assists per game. He is currently holding an assist/turnover ratio of 1.86 on the season, bumped up from his career-high nine assists against New Mexico State with just three turnovers. The starting point guard averaged eight assists per game last week, earning seven against Rice, tying his previous career high. If he can maintain his mark throughout this season, and improve as a junior and fifth-year senior, Neal has a chance to end his career as one of the most efficient Lobo court general. His current career ratio sits at 1.3 and has risen steadily as the season has progressed.

All-time, only five Lobos have ever finished their career with at least 300 assists and an assist/turnover ratio better than 1.86. Two of the top three players played under head coach Craig Neal, a prolific point guard during his playing days. Below is the all-time top-10:

## STRONG STARTS FOR NOODLES

Head coach Craig Neal led his team to five wins in their first six games for the second time in his three-year tenure. The victory over Oral Roberts pushed the Lobos to that mark for the sixth time since Neal joined the Lobos staff as an associate head coach in the fall of 2007. Prior to Neal coming to New Mexico, the last coach to open 5-1 or better in two of their first three seasons was Gary Colson, who joined the staff in 1981. Neal's winning percentage as a head coach is .653, which puts him in the top five all-time at New Mexico among coaches with at least 50 games. He currently sits .010 under the great Bob King. A strong season would put him in range of catching Norm Ellenberger, who finished his tenure at New Mexico with a .684 winning percentage. If he catches Ellenberger, Neal would have the distinction of coaching on two (his staff and Steve Alford's) of the top three winningest staff's in program history.

## ELIJAH BROWN - PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Brown has been named Mountain West Conference Player of the Week for the second time this season. In the Lobos' 76-57 win over Northern Iowa, Brown led the Lobos in both scoring and rebounding with 25 points and seven boards. His rebounding total was two short of his career high. For the game, Brown shot 9-for-15 from the floor and 5-for-6 from the free throw line. Brown previously was named MW Player of the Week after the first week of the season. Brown becomes the first Lobo to earn two of the first five MW Player of the Week honors since Roman Martinez in 2009.

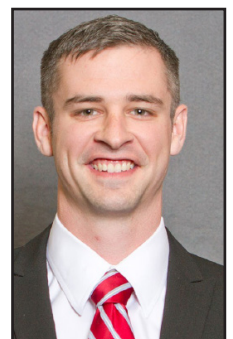
