• SEC Player of the Week – Florida guard Tre Mann, a 6-foot-5, 190-pound sophomore from Gainesville, Fla., averaged 20.0 points, 10.5 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.5 steals in wins at Auburn and at Kentucky. Mann recorded his first career double-double with a 19-point, 13-rebound outing at Auburn. He scored 11 of the Gators final 20 points to close out the win at Kentucky and dropped in 14 of his 21 in the second half. Mann became the only Gator dating back to 1970 to lead the team outright in points and rebounds in back-to-back wins with both games on the road.

• SEC Freshman of the Week – Arkansas guard Moses Moody, a 6-foot-6, 205-pound freshman from Little Rock, Ark., averaged 21.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists in wins against No. 6 Alabama and LSU. Moody set career highs in assists in both games (4 vs. UA and then 5 vs. LS). He was 16-of-19 at the line in leading Arkansas with 24 points against Alabama. Moody had 18 points, eight rebounds and five assists against LSU.

• Five SEC teams rank in the Top 30 of the NCAA's March 5 NET rankings. That is the third-most in the nation.

• Five teams are receiving mention in the March 1 Associated Press Top 25 highlighted by Alabama (8th) and Arkansas (12th) Florida, Tennessee and Missouri are receiving votes.

• Seven teams rank among the Top 40 defensive teams in the nation according to KenPom.com.

• Alabama clinched its eighth SEC regular season championship and the No. 1 seed in the SEC Tournament. It is the Crimson Tide's first SEC title since 2002.

• The SEC won the eighth annual SEC/Big 12

Challenge by winning five of the nine games on January 30. The SEC has a 25-24 lead in the event over the last five years.

• Kentucky's Davion Mintz and Olivier Sarr & Tennessee's John Fulkerson and Yves Pons have been named candidates for the Senior CLASS Award.

• Georgia's Sahvir Wheeler recorded the first triple-double in the school's 116-season history with 14 points, 11 rebounds and 13 assists against LSU on Feb. 23.

• Tennessee was the favorite to win the 2021 SEC championship in a preseason poll of media from around the league and nation. Kentucky was picked to finish second and is followed by LSU, Florida and Alabama. Florida's Keyontae Johnson was selected by the media as the pre-season player of the year.

• Five former SEC players have been named 2021 NBA All-Stars. Washington's Bradley Beal (UF) was named a starter while the Los Angeles Lakers' Anthony Davis (UK), New York's Julius Randle (UK) and Philadelphia's Ben Simmons (LS) were named reserves. Phoenix's Devin Booker was added to the roster by Adam Silver.

• Seventy-seven players from SEC schools were on 2020-21 NBA Opening Day rosters. All 14 SEC schools were represented and at least one SEC player is on 28 of 30 NBA rosters.

• For the second year in a row, 12 SEC players were picked in the 2020 NBA Draft, including six who were chosen in the first round.

• Georgia's Anthony Edwards became the fifth SEC player to be picked first overall in the NBA Draft in the last 11 years.

• The 2020 NBA Draft marked the fourth time (1988, 2015 and 2018) that the SEC had four lottery picks in a single NBA Draft.

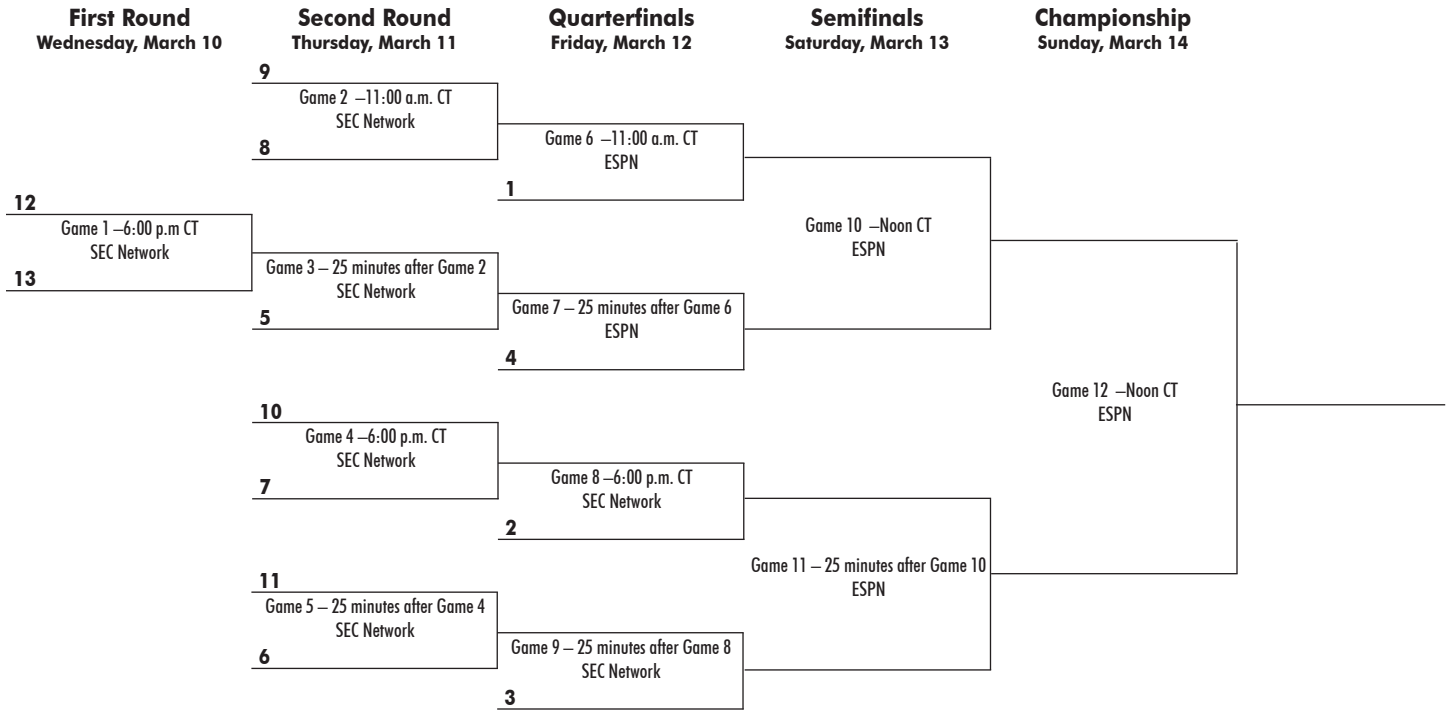

2021 SEC BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT • BRIDGESTONE ARENA • NASHVILLE, TENN.



The winner of the 13-game SEC Men's Basketball Tournament receives the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds are determined by the 18-game conference schedule during the regular season. Teams are seeded 1-14 based on their regular season conference finish.

Atlanta served as host of the inaugural SEC Tournament played following the 1932-33 season and did so again after the 1933-34 season. The event was held every year through 1952, with the exception of 1935. After a 26-year layoff (1953-78), the tournament was renewed in 1979. The 2020 tournament will be the 61st in league history and the 42nd since the renewal.

The event has helped set the stage for SEC teams in the NCAA Tournament, as 26 of the tournament champions since the tournament resumed in 1979 have advanced to at least the Sweet 16. Twenty of those teams have gone on to the Elite Eight, 12 to the Final Four and three have been crowned national champion. Six of the last 14 SEC Tournament champions have advanced to the Final Four with three of those teams winning a national championship. The SEC Tournament Champion has failed to win at least one NCAA Tournament game only four times.

Kentucky leads the league with 31 SEC Tournament titles. Alabama is second with six, while Tennessee and Florida are tied for third with four. Mississippi State has three championship trophies while Auburn, Georgia, Ole Miss and Vanderbilt have two. Arkansas, LSU and former league member Georgia Tech have each won one SEC Tournament championship.

SEC Tournament Tie-Break Procedures

Teams will be seeded No. 1 through No. 14 in the SEC Basketball Tournament bracket based upon the final regular season Conference winning percentage. Teams that finished No. 1 through No. 4 in the final regular season standings shall receive first and second-round byes.

Teams that have played at least two-thirds (or 66 percent) of the average number of conference games played by all conference teams will be seeded first. If a team does not meet the two-thirds average of conference games played by all conference teams, they will be seeded according to winning percentage after all teams that reached the minimum number of games required to be seeded.

1. **Two-Team Tie:** The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- A) Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two teams.
- B) Best winning percentage of the two teams versus the highest seeded common opponent (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) Coin flip by the Commissioner.

2. **Three-Team Tie (or more):** Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).

- A) Best winning percentage of games played among the tied teams (Example: Team A is 3-1, Team B is 2-2 and Team C is 1-3 – Team A would be seeded highest, Team B second-highest and Team C lowest of the three).
- B) Best winning percentage of the tied teams versus the highest seeded common opponent (and proceeding through the No. 14 seed, if necessary).
- C) If two teams remain, coin flip by the Commissioner.
- D) If three or more teams remain, draw by the Commissioner.

For the purpose of seeding, if an institution is precluded from participating in the tournament, such institution will automatically be seeded last. The No. 11 seed will then receive a bye. However, for the purpose of breaking ties, that team will remain where it finished in the regular-season standings BEFORE being seeded last.

SEC SUCCESS

The Nation's Best Coaches

- Thirteen of the 14 SEC coaches have led their teams to the NCAA Tournament. The one not included in that list just completed his first season coaching collegiately and was previously named NBA G League Coach of the Year.
- Eleven SEC coaches have taken their teams to the Sweet 16, nine have advanced to the Elite Eight and six have gone on to the Final Four.
- Six SEC coaches - Bruce Pearl, Tom Crean, John Calipari, Ben Howland, Frank Martin and Rick Barnes - have been head coaches in the Final Four with two winning national championships.
- The coaches have combined for 220 seasons of head coaching experience, more than 4,800 career wins, 55 conference titles and 117 NCAA Tournament appearances.

The Nation's Best Players

- 77 players from SEC schools were on 2020-21 NBA Opening Day rosters. All 14 SEC schools were represented and at least one SEC player was on 28 of 30 NBA rosters.
- Twelve SEC players were picked at the 2020 NBA Draft, including six who were chosen in the first round. It is the second year in a row a dozen SEC players were selected, including six in the first round.
- Of the 24 SEC players picked in the NBA Draft over the last two years, 21 had at least one year of eligibility remaining. All 12 first round selections had at least one year of eligibility remaining.
- The 2020 NBA Draft marked the fourth time (1988, 2015 and 2018) that the SEC had four lottery picks in a single NBA Draft.
- The SEC has had at least five first round NBA Draft picks in five of the last six years (2015-20).
- Georgia's Anthony Edwards was drafted No. 1 overall in the 2020 NBA Draft. He is the sixth SEC player to be picked first overall in the draft and the fifth in the last 11 years (2010-20).
- The SEC's 30 Lottery Picks since 2010 are the second-most of any conference.
- Over the last 11 NBA Drafts (2010-20), 88 SEC players have heard their names called. Fifty-one of those were selected in the first round and five were the No. 1 overall pick.
- Nine former SEC players from six different schools were on the rosters of the Los Angeles Lakers and Miami Heat in the 2020 NBA Finals. That was more than double the total of any other conference.
- Five of the 10 players named to the 2020 NBA All-Defensive teams were from SEC schools.

Postseason Success

- The SEC's 15 NCAA Tournament selections since 2018 are second-most in the nation.
- The SEC's eight NCAA Tournament selections in 2018 are the most in league history.
- The SEC's 10 teams advancing to postseason play in 2018 (8 NCAA, 2 NIT) ties for the most in league history. In 2001, six SEC teams received NCAA Tournament invites while four participated in the NIT.
- SEC teams are 67-36 (64.1 percent) in the NCAA Tournament since 2012.
- SEC teams are 37-12 (75.5 percent) in postseason opening games since 2014.
- The SEC has had at least one team advance to the Sweet 16 in 29 of the last 30 tournaments. All of the SEC's 14 members have advanced to the Sweet 16 since 1996.
- The SEC has had a team in the Final Four in six of the last nine tournaments.
- Eight different SEC teams (Arkansas, Auburn, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, LSU, Mississippi State and South Carolina) have appeared in the Final Four.
- Every team in the SEC has made at least one NCAA Tournament appearance in the last five editions of the NCAA Tournament.

Academics

- LSU's Skylar Mays was named the 2020 CoSIDA Academic All-America of the Year. He was a two-time first team CoSIDA Academic All-America (2019 and 2020).
- A total of 99 men's basketball students were named to the 2019-20 SEC Academic Honor Rolls for having a grade point average of 3.00 or above for either the preceding academic year or a cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or above.
- 461 men's basketball students have been named to the SEC's Academic Honor Rolls over the last six years.
