

## 2008 REVIEW

As has been each season since Tim Gray took over the Auburn women's tennis program as head coach, 2008 proved to be one that redefined what had previously been to know to be Tiger tennis.

The firsts continued for Gray's team as Auburn had two players land on the First-Team All-SEC, had its first player named Southeastern Conference Player of the Year, had back-to-back NCAA Championships appearances for the first time in the program's history and for the first time, had multiple All-Americans.

The 2008 season saw the Tigers post a 17-10, 5-6 SEC record. The 17 wins are the most by a women's tennis team since 1989 when Auburn won 19 matches during the season.

In all, Auburn recorded nine shutout victories and defeated six nationally ranked opponents. Individually, the Tigers posted a 16-10 record against nationally ranked opponents. Highlighting the 2008 upsets were wins over No. 26 Arkansas and No. 15 Texas Christian, along with Fani Chifchieva knocking of the second-ranked player in the country in straight sets.

The SEC recognized a pair of Tigers on three occasions. Chifchieva was twice named Player of the Week (Feb. 19 and March 6) and Gaby Beelen was named Freshman of the Week (March 18). Individually, Chifchieva became the first Tiger to be honored twice in one season.

The season opener pitted top-10 teams against each other with No. 8 Auburn and No. 1 Georgia Tech. The Yellow Jackets won 7-0, but the Tigers bounced back and made a statement by blanking their next five opponents. Auburn suffered a 5-2 loss to Florida State, but finished out the non-conference portion of its schedule with an 8-2 mark.

Auburn embarked upon its rigorous Southeastern Conference schedule at the end of February, opening league play with a 4-3 upset over No. 26 Arkansas in Fayetteville. Whitney Chappell clinched the match for Auburn in the No. 4 spot.

Following a 4-3 loss at No. 34 LSU, the Tigers roared back by picking up a pair of conference wins over Ole Miss and Mississippi State. In a non-conference tilt against No. 15 TCU, it was freshman Gaby Beelen who clinched Auburn's 4-3 upset over the Horned Frogs in a three-set thriller. Beelen dropped her first match 7-5, but came back to defeat Kewa Nichols 7-5, 6-4.

The Tigers were unable to knock of a higher-ranked opponent for the second-straight week, falling to No. 11 Vanderbilt, 5-2, in Nashville, Tenn. Back in Auburn facing No. 23 Kentucky, the Tigers suffered a 4-3 loss.

Three days after losing to Kentucky, the Tigers rebounded with a 6-1 win over No. 73 Marshall. Auburn swept all three doubles matches and won five-of-six singles matches.

Heading into the second half of SEC play, Auburn faced Tennessee and a pair of top-10 opponents in ninth ranked Georgia and third-ranked Florida. The Tigers played closely with Tennessee and Florida, falling 4-3, and dropped a 5-2 decision to Georgia.

The conference schedule concluded in Auburn with a 4-3 win over No. 30 South Carolina and crushed Alabama, 6-1.

For the first time since 1995, Auburn was the host for the SEC Tournament April 17-20 at the newly constructed Yarbrough Tennis Center. The Tigers opened with a 4-0 shutout over No. 31 South Carolina. In the second round, No. 30 Auburn was handed a 4-0 setback at the hands of fifth-ranked Florida.

Auburn was selected for its second-straight NCAA Championship appearance and the fifth in the program's history. The No. 29 Tigers traveled to Gainesville, Fla., to take on No. 35 Ohio State in the first round and prevailed 4-3. The second round again matched Auburn against No. 6 Florida, like the SEC Tournament, and again it was the Gators who came out with a 4-0 win to end Auburn's season.

Although team competition was over for Auburn, the duo of Alex Haney and Melissa Koning, along with Fani Chifchieva, were still headed to the NCAA Championships in Tulsa, Okla. A year after sending three Tigers to the NCAA Individual Championships, the same trio returned to the Plains as All-Americans.

The No. 14 duo of Haney and Koning opened with a 6-7(5), 6-3, 6-3, win over No. 25 Elizabeth Ferris and Emily Kwok of Utah to advance to the second round, but suffered a 6-2, 6-7(4), 6-3 loss to Fresno State's No. 33 pair of Renata Kucerkova and Anastasia Petukhova to bow out of the tournament. By advancing to the round of 16, the Auburn pair was able to garner All-American accolades. Haney and Koning finished the season with a 16-3, 9-2 SEC record and were No. 10 in the ITA's final doubles rankings.

Chifchieva became the first women's tennis player at Auburn to earn All-American accolades in 2007 and in 2008 she returned for a second honor. The sophomore hailing from Plovdiv, Bulgaria, knocked off unseeded Beier Ko of Harvard, 6-3, 7-5 and then rallied from a first set 6-4 loss to Notre Dame's Kelcy Tefft to get the come from behind win 6-2, 7-5. The win over Tefft guaranteed Chifchieva All-American honors. She defeated second-seeded Ani Mijacika of Clemson 6-2, 6-4 to get into the quarterfinals and upended Southern Cal's sixth-seeded Amanda Fink 7-6(2), 3-6, 6-0 to move into the semifinals.

In the semifinals, Chifchieva went up against Georgia Tech's seventh-seeded Amanda McDowell. McDowell was only one of two opponents to defeat Chifchieva in 2008 and it was her that ended the Tigers' sophomore campaign, as McDowell won 6-3, 6-2.

Chifchieva closed out her stellar sophomore campaign with a 27-3, 10-1 SEC singles record and had a final ranking of No. 11.
