2006 SPRING (FRESHMAN):

Concluded spring with a 9-13 mark in singles play... Finished the year 10-15 overall... Played seven matches at No. 1, finishing 2-5... Also finished 5-6 at No. 2 and 2-2 at No. 3... Won two of final three matches and the first three matches of the spring... Only Auburn player ranked all season, ranking No. 89 in singles on Feb. 22 after winning three of her first four matches... Defeated Mississippi State's Martina Banikova, 6-1, 6-1, in the No. 2 match... Following winning the No. 1 match over Ole Miss' Virginia Tomatis, 6-1, 6-2... Earned third straight win by topping Louisville's Maria Klokozky in the No. 1 match, 7-5, 6-1... Defeated North Florida's Lauren Cockbill, Stetson's Maja Miladinovic and Florida State's Ania Rynarzewska to open the year 3-0... Also defeated Southern Illinois' Zuzana Palovic, 6-1, 6-2, in the No. 3 match... Topped South Alabama's Jelena Krivacevic, 7-6, 6-2, and Samford's Katie McMiller, 6-3, 6-3... Finished 9-12 in doubles in the spring and 12-13 overall... Paired with Tori Almagno to finish 6-6... Went 3-0 with Irina Pljusnyin... Also paired with Alex Haney and Erin Gray and finished 0-3 with each... Paired with Almagno to win three matches in a row, including two conference wins... Topped Kentucky's team of Coventry and Escamilla, 9-8, Vanderbilt's tandem of Taylor and Yahner, 8-4, and Troy's duo of Strauss and Masviba, 8-5... With Pljusnyin, the duo

defeated Alabama's team of Bentley and McElveen, 8-2... The duo also topped Southern Illinois' team of Bredniak and Maher, 8-1, and Samford's team of Jackson and McMiller, 8-3.
