### NOTABLES

IF Tyler Johnstone has a 33-game streak of reaching base safely intact and has scored 30 runs in those 33 games ... The Tigers have hit at least one home run in each of their last three games ... Tuesday is the return of former Auburn standout Casey Dunn as he is now the skipper at Samford ... RHP Andy Masten saw the most work of any AU pitcher over the course of last week, throwing 4.2 innings in relief in each of his last two outings and allowing just one earned run with eight Ks ... Of the eight positional players that have started at least 15 games for the Tigers, three of them (Mike Bianucci, Andy Bennett and Justin Bristow) are in their first year with the team and are hitting a combined .320 (72-for-225) ... Auburn has used 20 different starting lineups in its 23 games ... Auburn is in the midst of a string of eight consecutive home games (3-4) and will have played 21 out of 24 games (10-10) at Plainsman Park to start the season ... Including Tuesday night, the Tigers have just 14 home games remaining ... IF Andy Bennett, IF Mike Bianucci and C/IF Josh Donaldson have 58 of AU's 108 RBIs and 11 of 15 AU home runs on the season ... Donaldson has already picked off five would-be base stealers, and as a team, Auburn has already picked off seven would-be base stealers, which is just one less than the team had all of last season ... Auburn has come back to win in six out of 11 victories this season.

## NOTES ON AU'S STARTING PITCHING TIGERS ARE TBA

The Auburn coaching staff has yet to announce a starter for Tuesday's game with Samford after using eight different pitchers during the series with South Carolina.

### OFFENSIVE QUICK HITS

- Auburn enters the week ranked 10 in the SEC in hitting (.276) and runs scored (117), second in doubles (51) and tied for sixth in home runs (15) and stolen bases (21).
- IF Andy Bennett is fourth in the SEC in RBI with 27.
- Tyler Johnstone is tied for fifth in the conference with 30 hits.
- The 2-3-4 spots in Auburn's lineup has produced 55 of Auburn's 108 RBIs (51%) and the 1-2-3-4 spots have scored 65 of Auburn's 117 runs (56%).

### PITCHING QUICK HITS

- Auburn enters the week ranked 12th in the SEC in ERA (4.52) and eighth in strikeouts (158).
- The Auburn pitching staff did not issue a walk in Saturday's loss to South Carolina. The last time AU had gone nine innings without issuing a walk was on April 12, 2005, at Samford, or 48 games ago. The last time they did it in SEC play was on April 3, 2005, against Arkansas (22 games).
- Jr. RHP Johnny Thompson has allowed just 15 hits in 21.0 innings of work and is tied for third on the team with 20 strikeouts.
- Thompson and Fr. RHP Luke Greinke have a combined line of 36.0 IP, 26 H, 8 ER, 13 BB and 33 K in 24 appearances, going a combined 1-0 with 3 saves and a 2.00 ERA.

### DEFENSIVE QUICK HITS

- Auburn's fielding percentage of .955 ranks 12th in the league.
- So. C Josh Donaldson leads the league in pick-offs with five. Donaldson, who was Auburn's starting third baseman in 39 games last season, has been the starting catching in just 11 games in his career, the first coming in the Saturday game vs. Hofstra.

### THE TIGERS VS. THE BULLDOGS

Auburn and Samford have played a total of 58 times with Auburn holding a commanding 48-10 advantage in the series. Going back to 1996, Auburn has lost just twice in the series, though both losses did come in Auburn. Whenever the game is played in Auburn, however, AU is 31-7 all-time against Samford.

Tuesday's game will be the first of two between the teams this season as they will meet again in two weeks at Hoover Metropolitan Stadium, home of the SEC Tournament, in a Samford home game.

### THE RETURN OF DUNN

Former Tiger standout Casey Dunn returns to the diamond where he found much success as a collegiate player as Dunn, a 1999 graduate of Auburn, is in his second year as the head coach at

Samford. In three games as a coach against his alma mater, Dunn is 1-2, having won his first game as a coach against Auburn last season.

### CHICKS DIG THE LONG BALL

For the first time since the 2000 season, Auburn hit three home runs in its first three SEC games. Coincidentally enough, in 2000 it was South Carolina that served up the three home runs to the Tigers to start the conference season, just as it was this year. AU finished the 2000 season with a total of 63 home runs but is on pace to hit just 37 this season.

### SUNDAY, SUNDAY, SO GOOD TO ME

The Auburn pitching staff has its lowest team ERA in Sunday games of any of the three weekend days. On Sunday's, AU's ERA drops down to a 4.21 while it is slightly over 5.00 on both Friday and Saturday. The current team ERA stands at 4.52.

The team ERA is even lower on Tuesdays, checking in at 2.89

### MASTEN HAS TWO SOLID OUTINGS

Over the course of the last week, RHP Andy Masten pitched a complete game out of the bullpen. Masten came on in two big spots for the Tigers last week, entering Tuesday's game with Davidson after just 0.1 innings were played due to an injury to AU's starter and earning the win and came in again in Saturday's game with South Carolina game as the long reliever. His combined line for the week was 9.1 IP, 10 H, R, 0 BB, 8 K

### REACHING BASE BY ANY MEANS

OFs Jeff Boutwell and Bruce Edwards each had an on-base percentage of .500-or-better for the South Carolina series with Boutwell going 2-for-8 with four walks and two sac bunts while Edwards was 1-for-6 with four walks and three HBP.

Edwards has now been plunked seven times on the season, the most since Jonathan Schuerholz took it on the chin 10 times and Brett Burnham 14 times in 2001.

Johnstone, who has started 83 consecutive games as the top man in the order, has reached base safely in his last 33 games and has also scored 30 runs in his last 33 games.

He has now reached base in 76 out of 83 career games at Auburn and has scored at least one run in 50 out of 83 career contests.

#### DIXON IN THE 2-HOLE

Since moving into the second spot in the lineup, OF Russell Dixon is hitting .319 (15-for-47) and has scored six runs and driven in another 13. That is a big change from the rest of the number two hitters on the team, who were a combined 9-for-47 (.191) with just nine runs and one RBI.

#### ANYONE, ANYTIME, ANYWHERE

Keeping up with the hard schedule that he put together last season, which saw the Tigers play 32 regular-season contests against teams in the Top 25, AU Head Coach has the Tigers playing another tough schedule this season. The Tigers have already played eight games against teams in the top 25, which is tied with Florida for the most in the conference, and has another 18 games scheduled against teams currently in the top 30. Auburn's victory over Florida State on Feb. 10 remains the top-ranked Seminoles' only non-conference loss of the season.

#### PICKOFF EXTRAORDINAIRE

So. Josh Donaldson, who has started just 11 games behind the plate, has already picked off five base runners. Going back to 1993, no AU catcher has had more than three pickoffs in a year and only four times in those 13 seasons has the team had more than Donaldson's five with the team high being nine in 2004.

#### KILLER B'S

Jr. IF Andy Bennett, Fr. IF Mike Bianucci and Sr. OF Jeff Boutwell are hitting a combined .335 (73-for-218) with 19 2B, 9 HR and 47 RBIs.

#### THE WRECKING CREW

IF Mike Bianucci and OF Russell Dixon have each had a multi-homer game this season, with both of them tying up a game with a two-run home

run and then winning a game with a three-run shot. Bianucci did it to Hofstra in the 8th and 10th innings while Dixon did it to Davidson in the 5th and 6th innings.

#### JOHNNY ON THE SPOT

Jr. RHP Johnny Thompson has already seen action in 15 of 23 games this season, which puts him on pace to appear in 37 games this season. John Madden established the school record for single-season appearances last season when he appeared in 44 games, all in relief. At the same point last season, Madden had pitched in 16 out of the first 23 games.

#### NEW FACES ON THE FIELD

Of the 18 Tigers that have seen action in the field this season, 10 of them are new to the Auburn program.

#### TIGERS ON THE MOUND

Auburn features an almost complete new set of arms this season. Through the first seven weeks of the season, returnees Chris Dennis (26.2), Clarence Nicely (11.0), Grant Cardwell (1.1) and Ted Bryant (0.1) have thrown just 39.1 innings of the 209.0 team innings thus far and have a combined 4.81 ERA.

All together Auburn's new pitchers have a combined 4.46 ERA in 169.2 IP (84 ER).

#### MR. AUTOMATIC

Freshman RHP Greinke is near untouchable once the game reaches the eighth inning, allowing just seven hits and walking five with nine K's after seven complete. In eight appearances on the year, he has already racked up three saves and held the opponent hitless in four of his outings.

#### TIGERS ON THE TUBE

Auburn games will be televised nine times this season on various channels. The Tigers, who are 0-1 on TV this season already, will appear on CSS on Saturday at Vanderbilt (3/25).

AU's next appearance on TV will be on Saturday, April 22, when the Tigers battle Florida in Gainesville in the SEC-TV Game of the Week.

The Tigers will close out the season with five of

- Auburn started the season 11-for-11 in stolen bases.
- Tyler Johnstone tied the school record for stolen bases in a game when he swiped three against VMI on Saturday, Feb. 4.
- Auburn will play 34 regular season home games this year. Four of AU's home opponents (12 games) competed in 2005 NCAA Regionals
- Of the Tigers' 21 road games, 16 of them are against teams that played in Regionals last year, including six against College World Series teams
- Auburn will play 22 of its first 25 games at home including 14 straight home dates to open up the season (Feb. 3-28), not leaving the Plains in the month of February, which they finished 8-5. AU will then play 16 out of 24 games away from Plainsman Park.
