### SETTING THE STAGE

The Auburn Tigers return home for a pair of televised Southeastern Conference matches this weekend as LSU and Texas A&M visit Auburn Arena on Friday and Sunday. Friday's match is set for a 7:30 p.m. start, and Sunday's match begins at 2 p.m. SportSouth will carry both matches live, with Pete Pranica and Phil Bush on the call. Fans outside SEC territory can watch the match on ESPN3.com. Admission is free for both matches.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Auburn snapped a 6-match losing skid last Sunday with a 3-1 win at Ole Miss.
- LSU went 3-0 last week with wins over Texas A&M (3-2), Ole Miss (3-1) and Mississippi State (3-0).
- Texas A&M was 1-1 last week, falling to LSU (2-3) and defeating Mississippi State (3-0).

### AUBURN QUICK HITS

- Seniors **Katherine Culwell** (6th - 884) and **Camila Jersonsky** (8th - 755) are among the top 10 active career kill leaders in the SEC.
- Senior **Camila Jersonsky** is Auburn's all-time leader in career hitting percentage (.352).
- Senior setter **Chelsea Wintzinger** earned her 2,000th career assist in the first match of the season and is now 5th all-time at Auburn with 2,344 assists. She needs 191 more (14.7/match) to move into 4th all-time.
- Auburn has an all-time record of 566-567-4 (.499) in its 42nd season of intercollegiate volleyball.
- Auburn's all-time SEC record is 137-267 (.341).
- Head Coach **Rick Nold** is in his third season at Auburn. He has a career head coaching record of 210-137 over 11+ seasons and is 38-39 at Auburn.

### 1,000 DIGS FOR WRO

Senior Sarah Wroblicky became the 10th member of Auburn's "1,000-Dig Club" on Sunday, eclipsing the 1,000-dig mark with her fourth dig in the Tigers' win over Ole Miss. During the game, she also moved up the all-time charts at Auburn, passing Bailey Veit (1,001) for ninth and Jaunelle Hamilton (1,002) for eighth.

### A LOOK AHEAD

Auburn hits the road again for a pair of tough SEC tests. The Tigers will take on second-ranked Florida at 6 p.m. CT Friday, Oct. 25, at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center in Gainesville, then travel to Columbia, S.C., to face the South Carolina Gamecocks at 12:30 p.m. CT Sunday, Oct. 27.

### SCOUTING THE LSU TIGERS

- LSU enters the week at 13-3 overall, 3-1 in SEC play and currently 4th in the conference standings.
- Last week, LSU was a perfect 3-0 with wins over Texas A&M (3-2), Ole Miss (3-1) and Mississippi State (3-0). Ole Miss is the only common opponent for LSU and Auburn so far, and both earned 3-1 wins over the Rebels.
- LSU was the preseason pick to share the SEC West title with Texas A&M. Last year, LSU was 12-17 overall, 8-12 in SEC play.
- LSU has overcome three 2-0 deficits this season, including their nationally televised win over Texas A&M last Wednesday.
- Middle blocker Briana Holman was last week's SEC



Player of the Week with 3.83 kills/set and a .417 hitting percentage in the Tigers' three wins.

- LSU is the top blocking team in the SEC, averaging 2.73 blocks/set. Holman leads the league at 1.53/set.
- Head coach Fran Flory is in her 16th season as LSU's head coach. She picked up her 400th career victory earlier in the season.

**LAST TIME: LSU 3, AUBURN 1 (10/19/12)**

Auburn got double-digit kills from three players and a season-high 87 digs, but a relentless defensive effort from LSU gave the purple and gold Tigers a 3-1 victory (22-25, 30-32, 25-22, 20-25) at the Student Activities Center.

It was the first home loss of the season for Auburn and it went as the 22nd consecutive win in the series for LSU, dating back to the 2000 season.

Sarah Bullock led a group of three Auburn players in double-digit kills. She had 17 kills on the night and also contributed a career-high 24 digs. Katherine Culwell and Camila Jersonsky had 15 kills each; Culwell added 15 digs for a double-double and Jersonsky contributed five blocks.

**SCOUTING THE AGGIES**

- Texas A&M enters the week at 10-6 overall, 2-3 in SEC play. Auburn and Texas A&M have one common opponent this season - A&M defeated Florida State 3-0 on Sept. 12, and Auburn fell to FSU, 3-2, the following week.
- Last year, Texas A&M won the SEC West and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.
- A&M is third in the SEC in kills (14.28/set) and digs (16.24/set). Jazzmin Babers is the league's #2 blocker at 1.26 blocks/set.
- Laurie Corbelli is in her 21st season at Texas A&M and has more than 500 career wins in 28 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Auburn is winless in four all-time meetings with A&M.

**LAST TIME: TEXAS A&M 3, AUBURN 1 (11/9/12)**

Auburn could not take advantage of numerous opportunities against Texas A&M, falling 3-1 (21-25, 24-26,

25-22, 23-25) to the Aggies at the Student Activities Center.

The Tigers saw their four-match SEC winning streak come to an end at the hands of Texas A&M, which added to its lead in the SEC Western Division. All four sets were competitive to the last point, but all the bounces seemed to go the Aggies' way. Camila Jersonsky had another strong performance, putting down 17 kills on 30 attacks with just five errors for a .400 hitting percentage. Sarah Bullock and Katherine Culwell both recorded double-doubles; Bullock had 13 kills and Culwell had 12 while both finished with 11 digs.

Chelsea Wintzinger was one assist shy of her season-high with 34 on the night, and libero Sarah Wroblicky had a team-high 13 digs.

**SEE YA LATER, STUDENT ACT**

With the six matches of the Active Ankle Challenge concluded, Auburn will play just one more match at the Student Activities Center this season, a Nov. 8 tilt against Missouri. The remainder of the Tigers' home matches in 2013 will take place at Auburn Arena.

**HISTORIC VICTORY**

With a 3-1 win over No. 10 Nebraska on Aug. 31, Auburn picked up its first-ever victory over a top-10 opponent and just its second in history over a top-25 foe. The previous win over a ranked opponent came Sept. 24, 2010, when the Tigers defeated No. 24 Kentucky in five sets at home.

Auburn is 2-42 since 2002 against nationally-ranked opponents.

**TIGERS PICKED FOURTH IN SEC WEST**

Auburn was picked to finish fourth in the SEC Western Division by a poll of the league's coaches. The Tigers finished tied for third last season. LSU and Texas A&M were selected as Western Division co-champions. Florida was picked to win the SEC East and the overall conference title.

There will be no SEC East or West champion this year, however; the league's athletic directors voted to eliminate divisional play in volleyball after the preseason poll was released.

**TIGERS ON TV**

Auburn will be featured on TV three times this season, but the Tigers hope to reverse their trend of falling in televised matches.

Last season, Auburn lost both of its TV matches - at Florida (Oct. 14) and at Alabama (Nov. 18). In 2011, the Tigers were televised five times, dropping road matches at Florida, LSU, Miss. State and Georgia and falling at home to Miss. State.

Auburn's last win in a televised match came Oct. 6, 2010, when the Tigers defeated Georgia 3-0 at home.

Rick Nold is in his third season as Auburn's head volleyball coach in 2013 after being named the 10th head coach in program history on April 10, 2011.

In his two seasons on the Plains, Nold has put together a 28-32 overall record (.467). His second season saw a six-match improvement from his first as he took the Tigers from an 11-19 mark (5-15 SEC) in 2011 to a 17-13 record (8-12 SEC) in 2012, the 18th winning season in 41 years of Auburn volleyball. He led the Tigers to nine straight wins to open the season, the second-longest winning streak in program history. Nold also picked up his 200th career head coaching victory on Nov. 4 with a 3-1 win over Georgia.

The 2012 season also saw senior outside hitter Sarah Bullock become the fifth player in Auburn history to record 1,000 career kills and 1,000 career digs. Bullock and junior Camila Jersonsky were named to the All-SEC Second Team following the season, and Jersonsky was a two-time selection as the SEC Defensive Player of the Week.

Nold directed Jacksonville State to unprecedented heights during his nine-year tenure, winning three regular season conference titles, three conference tournament titles and making three NCAA postseason appearances. He compiled an overall record of 172-98, while posting an impressive 107-42 (72 percent) mark in league games.

A three-time conference Coach of the Year, Nold led the Gamecocks to Ohio Valley Conference regular season or tournament title in four of the previous six seasons. He captured the OVC regular season in 2006, '07 and '09, while winning the conference tournament title in 2005, '06 and '09.

Jacksonville State advanced to the NCAA Division I Tournament in 2005, '06 and '09 under Nold, the only NCAA postseason appearances in the program's history. In 2009, Nold led the program to another milestone, by winning the school's first NCAA Tournament match, defeating Florida A&M.

Nold's 2009 team finished the season 27-8, which was the most wins in program history, swept both conference titles and advancing to the NCAA second round. He was rewarded by being named the OVC Coach of the Year as well as the Midwest Region Coach of the Year by the American Volleyball Coaches Association.

In 2006, the Gamecocks were 24-5 overall and posted a perfect 18-0 mark in conference play, sweeping all but one conference match. At one time that season, JSU won 49 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the nation.

Nold's teams not only excelled on the court, but also in the classroom. During his tenure, JSU had 46 volleyball players named to the OVC Commissioner's Honor Roll, eight OVC Academic Medal of Honor winners, one Academic All-American and a two-time OVC Female Athlete of the Year.

Nold came to Jacksonville State from Louisville, his alma mater, where he spent six years on the Cardinals' staff, the last four as a full-time assistant whose duties included recruiting coordina-

tor. During his time at Louisville, the Cardinals won four Conference USA titles and advanced to the NCAA Tournament five times, advancing to the Sweet 16 in 1996 and 1998. He was the head coach of the 16-and-under and 18-and-under teams for the Kentucky Indiana Volleyball Academy in Louisville, where he coached teams that won the 1996, 1997, 1998 and 1999 AAU National Championships.

Nold began his coaching career as an assistant at Assumption High School in his hometown, where he helped the girls' varsity squad to three state championships and a 137-9 overall record before joining the University of Louisville staff in 1996. Nold served as an intern with USA Volleyball, where he assisted the women's national team in preparations for the 1996 Olympics in Atlanta. He received a bachelor's degree from Louisville in the spring of 1998 in Sports Administration.

He is a member of the American Volleyball Coaches Association, the Association of Volleyball Professionals and USA Volleyball Impact Certified Coach. He also serves on the All-Region and All-America selections committees.
