VS. FLORIDA STATE AND ARKANSAS

When: Saturday, Feb. 9 at 12 p.m.

Where: James E. Martin Aquatics Center in Auburn, Ala.

Who: Florida State is currently ranked 22nd in the nation and finished 17th at the 2007 NCAA Championships, scoring 52 points. Arkansas is receiving votes in the top 25 and is the first team out for a technical No. 26 ranking.

TIGER BITES

The Auburn women's swimming and diving team is coming off its second-straight, fifth overall, NCAA team championship... The Tigers have won five of the past six NCAA Championships... Auburn returns 13 letterwinners and 10 All-Americans from last year's championship squad... The Tigers also bring back one NCAA and six SEC individual champions... Auburn is under the direction of co-head coaches Richard Quick and Dorsey Tierney-Walker... Quick, who is in his 30th year as a head coach, has a 220-42 overall record in dual meets while Tierney-Walker, who is in her 10th year as a head coach, has a 67-19-1 record in dual meets... Quick has a 44-24 record as Auburn's head coach (1978-82, 2007-present) while Tierney-Walker is 20-2.

SENIOR DAY

Saturday's meet is also Senior Day for Auburn's three seniors. Competing in their last home dual meet are 17-time All-American Kara Denby (Simi Valley, Calif.), three-time All-American Kristen Hastrup (Fresno, Calif.) and 19-time All-American Emily Kukors (Auburn, Wash.).

ABOUT FLORIDA STATE

Florida State enters this week as the 22nd-ranked team in the nation. The Seminoles have an 15-2 record in dual meets so far this season. The only common opponents between Auburn and FSU are Alabama and Florida. Both teams came out with identical results as the Tigers and Seminoles beat the Crimson Tide before losing to the Gators. FSU is coached by Neil Harper, who is in his 10th season at the helm of the program.

LAST TIME VS. FLORIDA STATE

This weekend's meet is the 13th meeting all-time between Auburn and Florida State with the Tigers holding a dominant 11-1 advantage in the all-time series. Auburn won the last meeting, facing the Seminoles last season in Auburn, by a 129-112 margin (Auburn was ranked No. 2 at the time while FSU was ranked No. 7). The win was the ninth-straight win over FSU for Auburn with the last Seminole win coming on Nov. 18, 1983 (77-63).

ABOUT ARKANSAS

The first team left off the top-25 poll, Arkansas technically comes into the meet as the No. 26 team in the country. The Lady Razorbacks have a 6-3 dual meet record so far this season with wins over North Texas, Denver, Utah, Missouri State and Vanderbilt. The losses have come against Georgia, Florida and Missouri. Arkansas is coached by Jeff Poppell, who is in his third season at the helm of the swimming and diving program.

LAST TIME VS. ARKANSAS

This weekend's meet is just the second meeting all-time between Auburn and Arkansas with the Tigers holding a 2-0 advantage in the all-time series. Auburn won the last meeting, facing the Lady Backs on Jan. 28, 2006, by a 149-69 margin (Auburn was ranked No. 2 at the time). The only other meeting was an 81-58 Auburn win that opened the 2003-04 season.

UP NEXT FOR THE TIGERS

The weekend marks the final dual meet of the season for the Tigers with the focus now shifting to the Championship portion of the season. Some Auburn swimmers will travel to Columbia, Mo. next weekend for the Missouri Grand Prix

for a chance at Olympic or Olympic Trials qualifying times. The team will return to action Feb. 20-23 for the SEC Championships in Tuscaloosa, Ala.

QUICK RETURNS

With the departure of 17-year head coach David Marsh, Auburn went back to its roots in a replacement and welcomes Richard Quick back to the Tiger program. Quick coached at Auburn from 1978-82 and compiled a 12-13 women's dual meet record during that time, leading Auburn to a fourth-place finish in its first NCAA Championship. After leaving Auburn, Quick went on to win 12 NCAA titles and five NCAA Coach of the Year honors. He has also been on the Olympic coaching staff for every Olympics since 1984, serving as the women's head coach in 1996 and 2000.

TIGERS IN THE POLL

After the Jan. 26 loss at Florida, the defending national champion Auburn swimming and diving team fell to No. 5 in the Feb. 1 CSCAA Top 25 poll. The current poll is only the second one of the season without Auburn in the top spot. The only other time this season the Tigers were ranked lower than first was the second poll of the season. The College Swim Coaches Association of America (CSCAA) poll is a dual meet poll that is a prediction of a team's dual meet strength.

CURRENT AND FORMER AUBURN SWIMMERS NAMED TO U.S. NATIONAL TEAM FOR SHORT COURSE CHAMPIONSHIPS

Three current and former Auburn swimmers will travel to Manchester, England to represent the United States National Team at the 2008 FINA Short Course World Championships. Earning spots on the women's team was Olympian Margaret Hoelzer, along with current Tigers Maggie Bird (Muncie, Ind.) and Kara Denby (Simi Valley, Calif.). Also chosen to represent the United States was former head coach David Marsh, who was selected to be the head coach for the women's team.

CAITLIN GEARY NAMED SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK FOR SECOND TIME THIS SEASON (Jan. 29)

Despite losing 165-135 at Florida, Freshman Caitlin Geary scored 27 points for the top-ranked Tigers and won all three individual events she competed in, tallying a NCAA automatic time, two "B" cut times and three Olympic Trials cuts to earn SEC Freshman of the Week honors for the second time this season.

The Orlando, Fla., native started off with a win in the 200 free with a converted "A" cut time of 1:46.58 and followed it up with back-to-back wins in the 50 free (converted 22.99) and 100 free (converted 49.81). Geary also swam the freestyle leg on the fourth-place 200 medley relay team, swimming a converted split of 23.15.

EMILY KUKORS NAMED SEC SWIMMER OF THE WEEK (Jan. 15)

Following her performance on the Texas trip, senior Emily Kukors became the second Auburn female to earn SEC Swimmer of the Week honors. She earns it almost exactly a year after picking up the award last season (1-18-07). The senior from Auburn, Wash., led the Tigers to three wins last week as Auburn topped No. 16 Texas (157-80), No. 6 Texas A&M (155-139) and No. 12 Southern Methodist (218-72). Kukors swam four NCAA automatic qualifying times and three provisional times in the meets. She also won six out of the seven events she competed in, including a win in the 400 IM at Texas in which she swam a 4:10.97, a mark that ranks her sixth all-time at Auburn. She had two key swims at Texas A&M that helped her team to the 155-139 victory. With the Tigers down three points and two events left to swim, Kukors led a 1-3-4 Auburn finish in the 200 IM with an "A" cut time of 1:59.05 to give AU a seven-point lead. Kukors then swam anchor on the winning 400 free relay team, posting Auburn's fastest split in the event (49.15) to lead the Tigers to victory.

AVA OHLGREN NAMED SEC SWIMMER OF THE WEEK (Dec. 4)

Sophomore Ava Ohlgren became the first female Auburn swimmer to earn SEC Swimmer of the Week honors in the 2007-08 season after her performance at the USA Swimming Short Course National Championships. Ohlgren, who won the 200 IM national at the meet, capped off the Short Course Championships as the third overall point scorer, tallying 70 points in the three-day meet. She also picked up six medals at the meet, taking gold in the 200 IM, silver in the 400 free relay and 400 medley relay, and bronze in the 100 free, 400 IM and the 800 free relay. In all, the Northville, Mich. native posted NCAA automatic qualifying times in the 100 free, 200 free, 200 fly, 200 IM and 400 IM while posting "B" cuts in the 50 free and 100 fly.

CAITLIN GEARY NAMED SEC FRESHMAN SWIMMER OF THE WEEK (Dec. 4)

Caitlin Geary became the second Auburn swimmer to earn SEC Freshman of the Week honors after her work at the USA Swimming Short Course National Championships. Geary, an Orlando native, becomes the second Tiger this season to be named SEC Freshman of the Week, following Melanie Roberts who accomplished the feat on Nov. 13. She posted three "A" cut times at the U.S. Short Course Championships as she earned three bronze medals at the meet. Geary finished third in the 200 free with a NCAA automatic time of 1:44.85 while also picking up "A" cuts in the 500 free (12th, 4:44.69) and the 1,650 free (5th, 16:13.41). Geary also earned bronze medals as part of the third-place 800 free relay and 400 medley relay teams.

AVA OHLGREN NAMED COLLEGESWIMMING.COM NATIONAL SWIMMER OF THE WEEK (Nov. 15)

For her efforts last weekend against Tennessee, Auburn sophomore Ava Ohlgren has been named the CollegeSwimming.com National Swimmer of the Week for the week of Nov. 7-13.

The Northville, Mich., native set a personal-best and NCAA provisional qualifying time of 54.34 in the 100 butterfly, a mark that ranks eighth all-time at Auburn. She also posted Auburn's first "A" cut of the season as she won the 400 IM with a time of 4:14.82.

Ohlgren wrapped up her individual events with another "B" cut time as she finished runner-up in the 200 fly with a time of 2:00.46. She also helped Auburn to a pair of relay victories. She swam the butterfly on the winning 400 medley relay team, finishing with a "B" cut time of 3:42.50. She was also the leadoff on the winning 400 free relay team that finished with a NCAA provisional time of 3:20.59. Her leadoff split of 50.29 on the relay is also a "B" cut time for the 100 free.

MELANIE ROBERTS EARNS SEC FRESHMAN SWIMMER OF THE WEEK (Nov. 13)

Freshman swimmer Melanie Roberts has been named the Southeastern Conference's Female Freshman Swimmer of the Week, the conference announced Nov. 13. It is the first time this season for an Auburn athlete to pick up one of the league's swimming and diving honors. Roberts was a key performer for the No. 1-ranked Tigers as Auburn beat No. 12 Tennessee, 201-146 in the team's first dual meet of the season. Competing for her first time at Auburn, Roberts went on to post NCAA provisional "B" cut times in three of her four individual events. The Rochester, N.Y., native also earned her first win as a Tiger as she won the 200 breast with a time of 2:16.11, the fourth-fastest time in the SEC this season. She also finished runner-up in the 100 breast (1:03.54) and 200 IM (2:03.26). Her 100 breast time ranks eighth in the SEC this season while her 200 IM time comes in at fifth. Roberts also helped out in the relays with a "B" cut performance in the 400 medley relay. She swam the breaststroke leg with a split of 1:03.20, helping Auburn post a time of 3:42.50 in the win. The time is the second best in the SEC this season in the 400 medley relay.

AU OPENS SEASON AT WAR EAGLE INVITATIONAL

The Auburn swimming and diving team opened the 2007-08 season with the War Eagle Invitational, Oct. 19-21 in the James E. Martin Aquatic Center. Emily Kukors posted the top performances in the un-scored meet, finishing first among AU swimmers in the 400 IM, 100 free and 200 fly. Her times of 4:20.59 (400 IM), 56.71 (100 free) and 2:01.03 (200 fly) all qualify as "B" cuts. Ava Ohlgren also earned a "B" cut time, finishing the 100 fly in 2:01.06.

AU vs. TENNESSEE (11/9-10)

The Auburn women's swimming and diving team opened up its dual season with a win this past weekend, taking down No. 12-ranked Tennessee, 201-146, in the James E. Martin Aquatic Center. The Tigers won 11 of the 17 swimming events and eared a first-through-third sweep in the 100 back and 200 fly. Auburn finished first-second in an additional seven events. Sophomore Ava Ohlgren highlighted the meet with an "A" cut time of 4:14.82 in the 400 IM. Auburn also posted 30 "B" cut times in the two-day meet. Sophomore Melissa Marik followed Ohlgren with a win in the 200 back (1:58.24). Freshman Melanie Roberts earned her first victory as a Tiger, winning the 200 breast in 2:16.11 while fellow freshman Micah Martindale pulled off wins in the 500 free (4:49.09) and the 1000 free (9:51.15). Keeping the freshman trend going, Caitlin Geary earned her first win in the 200 free with a time of 1:47.48. Also earning individual wins over the weekend were junior Julianne McLane (100 back, 55.37), and seniors Kristen Hastrup (200 fly, 1:59.16) and Emily Kukors (200 IM, 2:02.47). Auburn also picked up wins in the 400 medley and freestyle relays.

AU vs. ALABAMA (11/16)

The Auburn swimming and diving team continued its domination over Alabama with a 144-97 victory. The women's team improves to 20-8 against Alabama and continues its 12-meet win streak against the Crimson Tide.

The Tiger women's squad won eight of the 11 swimming events while Courtney Brown made her first career appearance diving for Auburn, picking up fifth on both springboards. Auburn's freshmen and sophomores had a solid showing in their second meet of the season, picking up five of the six individual event wins. The other two Tigers wins came in the relays.

Sophomore Ava Ohlgren led Auburn with two wins as she took top honors in the 50 free (23.38) and the 500 free (4:51.53). Her "B" cut time in the 500 free was also one of three NCAA provisional times earned by the Tigers in the meet. Other posting "B" cuts were freshman Melissa Marik (1:44.30) in the 200 free and senior Emily Kukors (4:52.29) as she finished second to Ohlgren in the 500 free.

TIGERS STAY BUSY TO CLOSE OUT 2007

Auburn finished strong in 2007, dominating at its final meets of the season. The Tigers finished as the top university at the ConocoPhillips Short Course National Championships while current and former Auburn swimmers won 10 medals at the three-day event, including a national championship in the 200 IM won by Ava Ohlgren. Swimmers that did not go to Atlanta for Short Course Nationals made their way to Tuscaloosa for the Alabama Longcourse Classic. Josefin Wede and Margo McCawley picked up wins for Auburn. While the swimmers were in Atlanta and Tuscaloosa, Auburn's divers traveled to Baton Rouge, La. for the LSU Diving Invitational. Courtney Brown posted season bests of 197.50 (1-meter) and 178.75 (3-meter).

DIVERS KICK OFF NEW YEAR AT GEORGIA DIVING INVITE

Auburn's divers wasted no time kicking off the 2008 year, traveling to Athens, Ga., Jan. 3-5, for the Georgia Diving Invitational. Courtney Brown finished 38th on the 1-meter with a 157.60 and 39th on the 3-meter with a score of 160.20.

AU vs. TEXAS (1/10)

The No. 1-ranked Auburn women's swimming and diving team showed why they are the best in the country Thursday as the Tigers dominated No. 16 Texas, 157-80. The Tigers came out and swept Texas in the first event of the meet, taking the top three spots in the 200 medley relay, and never looked back as Auburn cruised to a 157-80 win. AU won all 11 swimming events at the meet, led by senior Emily Kukors and sophomore Ava Ohlgren. Kukors earned her fifth "A" cut of the season, winning the 400 IM with a time of 4:10.97 - a mark that also ranks sixth all-time at Auburn. The rest of the Tigers accounted for 12 NCAA provisional times, including three from Ohlgren, along with her three wins.

AU vs. TEXAS A&M / SOUTHERN METHODIST (1/10)

Competing with out two of the team's top swimmers, Ava Ohlgren and Julianne McLane, the No. 1-ranked Auburn women's swimming and diving team battled from behind in the last two events to take the win over the

Aggies. Down three points with two events left, Emily Kukors, Erica Meissner and Melanie Roberts all finished in the top four of the 200 IM, with Kukors taking the win, giving Auburn a seven-point cushion going into the 400 free relay. In the final relay, Auburn held the top two spots for the first half of the event, but Texas A&M battled back to take over second place. The relay team of Caitlin Geary, Kara Denby, Emile Ewing and Kukors were able to hold them off for the win, giving the Tigers the 155-139 win. Against SMU, Auburn jumped out to an early lead and never looked back as the Tigers picked up the 218-72 win.

AU vs. FLORIDA (1/26)

The top-ranked Tigers posted seven wins at Florida, but came up short in the end as the Tigers fell to seventh-ranked Florida, 165-135. In all, Auburn posted three "A" cut times, 15 "B" cut times and eight Olympic Trials cuts. Freshman Caitlin Geary led the Tigers as she won the 50 free, 100 free and 200 free. She earned Olympic Trial cuts in all three events, an "A" cut in the 200 free and "B" cuts in the 50 free and 100 free. The matchup of Auburn vs. Florida was selected as the Swimming World Magazine Meet of the Week.

RALPH CROCKER CLASSIC (2/1-3)

Five Auburn Tigers returned to action Feb. 1-3 at the Ralph Crocker Classic with freshman Micah Martindale leading the pack with a NCAA automatic qualifying time in the 1,650 free (16:13.78). Fellow freshman Julie Golden also had a good outing with "B" cut times in the 200 free (1:50.17) and the 200 back (2:00.15). Junior Blakeley Bunch came in with a "B" cut of her own, finishing the 400 IM in 4:20.67.

FRESH FACES

The Auburn swimming team welcomes four eight faces to the team for the 2007-08 season: Courtney Brown (Gulf Breeze, Fla.), Jessica Froning (Charlotte, N.C.), Caitlin Geary (Orlando, Fla.), Julie Golden (Vestavia Hills, Calif.), Micah Martindale (Shreveport, La.), Erica Meissner (Ashburnham, Mass.), Melanie Roberts (Rochester, N.Y.) and Josefin Wede (Landskrona, Sweden).

TIGERS COMPETE ON NATIONAL TEAMS

Auburn swimmers stayed busy over the summer of 2007 as nine current and former Tigers competed on national teams, winning 10 medals along the way. At the Pan Am Games, three Auburn swimmers were on national team rosters, with Alana Dilletta competing for the Bahamas while Emily Kukors and Ava Ohlgren were on the U.S. national team. Kukors won two gold medals and a silver while Ohlgren earned two golds. At the World University Games, senior Kara Denby represented the United States as she earned a gold medal. Dilletta also competing for the Bahamas, making her second international appearance of the summer. At the Japan International Grand Prix, former Tiger Kristy Coventry of Zimbabwe led the way with three gold medals. Emile Ewing, Abby MacGregor, Julianne McLane and Melanie Roberts all represented the U.S. at the event. MacGregor earned a silver medal while in Japan.

AUBURN SIGNS FOUR DIVERS FOR 2008-09

Four divers signed National Letters of Intent to join the Auburn diving team during the early signing period in November, head diving coach Jeff Shaffer announced Jan. 17. The four divers come from Alabama, Georgia, Ohio and Texas. The signees are Mary Catherine Cochran of

Birmingham, Ala., Anna Agüero of Moultrie, Ga., Mackenzie Wickliffe of Westlake, Ohio, and Vanessa Dantin of The Woodlands, Texas.


