Auburn leads the all-time series 87-70...The Gators swept the Tigers last year by claiming a 78-70 victory in Gainesville on Feb. 18 and a 78-69 victory in the first round of the SEC Tournament on March 11.

By the Numbers

3.7 ... Scottie Wilbekin has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 3.7 with 41 assists to just 11 turnovers on the year

7 ... The Gators have won seven straight regular season games against SEC West opponents

14.3 ... The Gators have forced 14.3 turnovers per game in their 13 wins, just 9.5 per game in their four losses

22 ... The trio of Chandler Parsons (8), Erving Walker (7) and Kenny Boynton (7) have hit all 22 of UF's three-pointers during SEC play as they are combining for 7.3 per contest

72.7 ... UF is allowing opponents 72.7 points per game during SEC play after entering league play holding opponents to just 59.4 points per contest

tipoff

- ✓ Florida trails the all-time series with Auburn, 87-69, however has won 12 of the last 13 meetings...Last season the Gators swept the Tigers with a 78-70 victory in Gainesville on February 18 and a 78-69 victory in the first round of the SEC Tournament
- ✓ Florida finished 6-0 against the SEC West a year ago and is 51-16 against the West since 2000 (21-12 on the road)
- ✓ UF is 15-4 all-time vs. Auburn under Billy Donovan, 5-2 in Auburn with Florida winning the last five
- ✓ Despite the loss Saturday, UF has won eight of its last 10 games, six of those eight victories are against RPI top 100 teams
- ✓ UF is road-tested, entering with a 3-0 mark...they won at Florida State for the first time since 2002, for the first time at Tennessee since 2005 and snapped Xavier's 30-game home winning streak... The Gators are 5-1 away from Gainesville this year
- ✓ After struggling offensively, the Gators have seen a bit of a resurgence, averaging 76.4 points per game over the last five outings...The Gators have come alive from three-point range, hitting 46.2 percent (36-78) over those five games, including 46.8 in the first three SEC games
- ✓ All five Gator starters are averaging in double figures in SEC play led by Erving Walker's 17.3 ppg...He and Kenny Boynton have combined for 31.6 points per game during league play so far and are combining to hit 41.1 percent from three-point range
- ✓ Walker is averaging 17.3 ppg over his last eight outings and has scored 18+ in four of his last seven outings...He is hitting a team-high 44.8 percent from three-point range
- ✓ Chandler Parsons is averaging 14.0 ppg in SEC play and is hitting a scorching 72.7 percent on threes (8-11)...Parsons leads UF with 14 assists and just six turnovers in three SEC games
- ✓ Vernon Macklin had his second double-double of the season against South Carolina and fourth of his career (12 and 10)
- ✓ After holding opponents to 59.4 ppg during non-conference play, the Gators have surrendered 72.7 ppg in league play

about Auburn

Auburn enters with a 7-10 mark, seeking their first conference win. ...In a win over Florida State, team scoring leader Sophomore Earnest Ross notched his third double-double with 10 points and a career tying 11 rebounds...Ross also leads the team in rebounds with 6.9 rpg...Sophomore Josh Wallace is among the SEC leaders in steals with 1.9 spg...As a team, the Tigers are averaging 8.7 steals per game which has been a major contributing factor toward their 16.2 turnovers forced per game

gators' offense evolving

Florida went seven games between Nov. 28-Dec. 22 without reaching 70 points, a first in the Billy Donovan era...In the five games since, the offense has been its most efficient based on three main areas - taking care of the ball, hitting free throws and knocking down threes. In the seven games UF failed to reach 70 points they hit 28.6 percent from three-point range, 62.6 percent from the line, averaged 12.1 assists, turned it over 14.7 times per game and averaged 61.7 points per game...In the five games since, they are hitting 46.2 percent on threes, 66.0 percent from the line, averaging 17.0 assists, 11.2 turnovers and it has led to 76.4 points per game.

Boynton, walker breaking out

Kenny Boynton and Erving Walker have combined for 31.6 points per game in SEC play and have torched opponents, including 37 points against Ole Miss and 32 at Tennessee...The two have combined for 70 of UF's 99 three-pointers on the season and have combined for 30+ points in five of the last seven games...UF is 8-3 when the two combine for 25+ points.

parsons finding his stroke

Chandler Parsons has scored 60 points in his last four outings, scoring 18 against Rhode Island, 17 against Ole Miss and 16 at Tennessee...He had 35 points in his previous five games combined...In the last five games he has used great shot selection en route to 22-of-40 shooting and 12-of-17 shooting from three-point range...He has had five+ assists in five of the last six games, and continues to rebound well, leading UF with 6.5 rebounds per game on the season.

gators look to return to dominance on glass

The Gators have out-rebounded 13 of 17 opponents but none of the three opponents in SEC play...The Gators will look to return to establishing control of the glass...The Gators are out-rebounding opponents by +6.7 rebounds per game this year...Florida grabbed 22 offensive boards against Jacksonville, got 19 against Radford and 20 against Rhode Island, the sixth time in 17 games they've had 17+ offensive boards...UF is averaging 13.4 offensive boards per game and have been in double figures in offensive boards 14 of 17 games.

parsons among sec's most versatile players

Chandler Parsons is the Gators' most versatile player, and with a 6-10 frame has played every position but center during his four years in Gainesville...He is the only player in the SEC to rank among active career leaders in points, rebounds, assists and steals:

Walker joins parsons, tyus in 1,000-point club

On a bucket in the second half against Ole Miss, Erving Walker became the 47th member of the University of Florida's 1,000-point club, joining teammates Chandler Parsons and Alex Tyus... Walker is the 19th player to do so under Billy Donovan.

taking care of the ball

The Gators were at their best against Ole Miss, dishing out 22 assists to just seven turnovers, a game after dishing out 19 assists against Rhode Island...The trio of Scottie Wilbekin, Erving Walker and Chandler Parsons combined for 17 assists to just two turnovers against Ole Miss...UF is 23-2 all-time when Walker has five or more assists...As a contrast, in the Gators' four losses, they've averaged 11.3 assists and 14.5 turnovers.

searching for defensive consistency

In the Gators' 21 wins a year ago, they limited opponents to just 60.1 points per game, including holding their opponents to 60 points or less in 10 of their victories...In their 13 losses, opponents scored 76.6 points per game, a difference of better than 16 points per game...In their 13 wins this year they've allowed their opponents just 58.2 points per game, while they've allowed 73.2 ppg in their four losses.

donovan moves up sec I ladder

He's already the winningest coach in UF history, but in 2009, Billy Donovan became just the sixth coach in SEC history to reach 300 wins at an SEC school...He became the first UF basketball coach to reach the mark and became one of only four to get all 300 wins at one school...He currently has 344 wins at UF and took sole possession of third place all-time in SEC history with a win at Xavier on Dec. 31.

Team Notes

- UF is 123-14 over the last five seasons when holding opponents under 70 points (11-1 this year).
- Florida finished 8-2 when hitting 50.0 percent last year and 4-2 when reaching 80 points.

Team Offensive Notes

- UF is 219-34 during the last 11 seasons when it gets 15-plus assists in a game (92-65 when it gets less than 15 assists).
- UF has made a three-pointer in a school-record 629 consecutive games (dating back to Jan. 11, 1992 vs. Kentucky).

- Florida hit 50 percent in its exhibition opener against Florida Tech and 55.9 percent against Georgetown College, and 52.6 percent overall in exhibition play...Despite losing, Florida hit 61.2 percent against Ohio State and followed it by hitting 57.5 percent against North Carolina A&T...UF hit 53.5 percent against Kansas State, including 60.0 percent in the second half.

Team defensive Notes

- Florida is 241-40 when forcing more turnovers than its opponents under Donovan.
- During the last 12 years, UF is 253-35 under Billy Donovan when holding opponents to 70 points or less.
- Florida held Morehead State to just 20.0 percent from beyond the arc, hitting just 4-of-20 attempts...The Gators shut down a Rhode Island team averaging 8.3 threes per game, limiting them to 4-of-23 shooting, 17.4 percent.
- Florida forced 30 turnovers and turned it into 30 points against Florida Tech...Seven different players combined for 16 steals in the game...The Gators followed it by forcing 26 turnovers and getting 26 points against Georgetown College...On opening night UF forced 20 turnovers for 24 points against UNC Wilmington and then forced 23 turnovers for 35 points against N.C. A&T...The Gators forced 24 turnovers against Radford, turning it into 19 points.

chandler parsons Notes

- Averaged 12.4 points per game a year ago and tied with Alex Tyus for the team lead in rebounds at 6.9 per game.
- Hit a 75-foot prayer at North Carolina State on Jan. 3 at the buzzer to lift the Gators to victory, his only FG of the day... Became the first man in UF history with two true buzzer-beaters, draining a three at the buzzer against South Carolina on Jan. 23, the first buzzer-beater at the O'Dome since 2003.
- A preseason Second Team All-SEC selection by the league media and a First Team selection by the league coaches...named to the Naismith Preseason Watch List on Nov. 16.
- Opened exhibition play by scoring 15 points on 6-of-11 shooting...Came up with four steals and dished out four assists... Flirted with a triple-double with nine points, 10 rebounds and seven assists against Georgetown College.
- Went for a team-high 16 points and grabbed five rebounds on opening night against UNC Wilmington...Came up with 13 points and seven rebounds against Ohio State...Tied with a team-high 16 points against North Carolina A&T...Had his first double-double of the year, and eighth of his career with 13 points and 11 boards against Morehead State...Scored 13 points against American, hitting 5-of-7 shots...Had nine points, eight rebounds, five assists and two steals against Radford...Had 11 rebounds and seven assists, both team highs, in win at Xavier...Added his ninth career double-double against Rhode Island with 18 points, 12 boards and five assists...Hit 7-of-12 shots and 3-of-4 three-point attempts...Followed with a 17-point, seven-rebound effort against Ole Miss, hitting 5-10 shots and going 3-3 on threes...Came up with 16 points and hit 5-of-7 shots, 4-of-5 threes at Tennessee...Nine points and seven assists

- Boynton led UF in scoring at year ago at 14.0 points per game and hit 72 three-pointers, the second-highest total ever by a UF freshman (Anthony Roberson, 74 in 2002-03).

- A member of the 2010 SEC All-Freshman Team as voted on by the league coaches.

- Was on fire in the exhibition opener, scoring 24 points on 10-of-15 shooting, including 4-of-6 from behind the arc...Scored 22 points on 9-of-15 shooting from the floor against Georgetown College...Averaged 23.0 points, hit 63.3 percent from the floor and 53.3 percent from 3-pt range during exhibition play.

- Opened the season with 10 points and four rebounds against UNC Wilmington...Scored 21 points against Ohio State, hitting 5-of-8 shots from three-point range...Tied with a team-high 16 points against North Carolina A&T...Matched his season-high with 21 points against Florida Atlantic, hitting 8-of-15 shots... Gators picked to win sec

For the first time since the 2006-07 season, the University of Florida has been picked by the league media to win the Southeastern Conference title. The Gators were selected to win both the East Division and the outright title, out-distancing Kentucky in the East, while finishing ahead of West pick Mississippi State for the overall title. For those who have followed Billy Donovan's career it should come as no surprise that he has made Florida basketball a winner.

In his 15th year now, Donovan, Florida has set a school record with 13 straight post-season appearances, including 10 NCAA Tournament bids in those 13 years. UF made the school's first-ever appearance in the National Championship game in 2000 before winning back-to-back National titles in 2006 and 2007. Donovan is already the winningest NCAA Tournament coach in UF history and his 22 NCAA Tournament wins more than triple the total of seven in school history before his arrival. He guided the Gators to three Final Fours and two in a row in 2006 and 2007, a first in Gator history.

After the school had just one Southeastern Conference Championship in 77 seasons prior to his arrival, Donovan has tallied three SEC titles (2000, 2001 and 2007). Florida and Kentucky are the only two SEC schools to capture consecutive league crowns in the past 31 years. He led the Gators to their first SEC Tournament title in 2005 and then again in 2006 and in 2007.

Florida's 261 wins during the 10 seasons from 2000-09 was the best decade in school history and the fifth-highest total in the nation in that time. After only being ranked in the national polls 42 times prior to Donovan's arrival, UF had been ranked a school-record 94 consecutive weeks in the Associated Press poll and 99 weeks by the ESPN/USA Today poll before falling out on Feb. 16, 2004.

His winning percentage at UF (.706) is the best among all Gator coaches who spent more than one season at UF and he reached the 100 and 200 victory marks at UF quicker than any coach in school history, needing just 154 games to reach the century plateau and 292 games to reach 200 wins. Donovan became the school's all-time leader in wins on Dec. 20, 2006 and stands at 344. He ranks third in SEC history in wins as an SEC coach.

Donovan's teams have knocked off 53 ranked opponents during his tenure. UF has won 41 of its last 69 meetings with ranked teams.

Donovan's squads have led the SEC in a statistical category 46 times, including 37 offensive categories. Twenty of his players have captured All-League honors and 10 of his freshmen have been recognized. Eight of Donovan's players have been first round draft picks in the NBA Draft, after the school boasted only two before his arrival. In the 2007 NBA Draft, Florida became the first school to ever have three players drafted in the Top 10, as Al Horford went third, Corey Brewer seventh and Joakim Noah ninth. He has inked 13 McDonald's All-Americans after UF had just three prior to his arrival. The fans are taking notice, attendance is up over 5,000 since Donovan's arrival.
