TIGERS HEAD TO TUSCALOOSA REGIONAL...

The No. 22 Auburn gymnastics team continues in post-season competition this weekend, as the Tigers travel to Tuscaloosa, Ala., for the Tuscaloosa NCAA Regional beginning Saturday, April 2, at 6 p.m. CT.

"I think that the team is ready to go," Auburn head coach Jeff Graba said. "They were ready to go last weekend so part of it is we are just trying to keep them focused through this week. The danger this week is that you get a little unfocused going into it because you are thinking about the meet and not the preparation. I think they were ready to go last week, as was the staff."

Auburn was selected as the No. 4 seed for the upcoming regional and will take on that features the host school, No. 2 Alabama, as well as No. 11 Penn State, No. 14 Illinois, No. 25 Central Michigan and Kentucky.

The Tigers will face one of the toughest regionals in the country, as five of the six teams are ranked in the top 25. No. 1 seed Alabama is coming off a first place finish at the SEC Championship on March 19, posting a 197.225 for its seventh conference championship.

This will be the eighth straight year that Auburn has advanced to a NCAA regional. The Tigers last competed at Alabama in a NCAA regional in 2005, finishing third with a score of 194.800.

LAST TIME OUT

The No. 22 Auburn gymnastics team finished sixth with a score of 195.325 at the 2011 SEC Gymnastics Championship March 19 in Birmingham, Ala., at the Birmingham-Jefferson Convention Complex. Attendance was 8,025.

The Tigers fell to 7-11 finishing behind No. 2 Alabama, top-ranked Florida, No. 8 Georgia, then 11th-ranked Arkansas and then No. 19 LSU, but finished ahead of Kentucky.

“We did as good as we have done all year,” Auburn head coach Jeff Graba said. “It was our fourth highest score of the year at our toughest meet of the year. This is tougher than regionals. This is tougher than nationals and a longer meet than nationals. Basically you are in similar competition to what you would see at nationals. Four or five of these teams will go onto nationals. I couldn’t be happier with how the girls did.”

Auburn began the meet with a bye in the opening rotation before moving to vault for the second rotation. Sophomore all-arounder Toi Garcia led the Tigers with a 9.800, while junior all-arounder Kylie Shields and junior Justine Foster each posted scores of

9.750. Sophomore Petrina Yokay and junior Allyson Sandusky each added a 9.700, and senior Lauren Brzostowski scored a 9.675. Auburn finished with a 48.700 on the event, and took a third rotation bye.

The Tigers went to uneven bars on the fourth rotation. Shields and Yokay led for Auburn, each with a score of 9.800. Sandusky followed with a 9.775, while Garcia and senior Leah Vining each added a 9.725. Freshman Abbey Habicht rounded out the event for the Tigers with a 9.700, as they finished their second event with a 48.825.

Auburn proceeded to beam for the fifth rotation. Habicht tied her career high with a 9.825 to lead the Tigers. Sandusky posted a 9.775, while Garcia added a 9.750. Brzostowski and Shields each posted scores of 9.700, and senior Rachel Inniss scored a 9.200. Auburn posted a 48.750 on beam.

After a sixth-rotation bye, the Tigers moved to their last event on floor for the seventh and final rotation. Inniss led Auburn with a 9.875, and Garcia followed with a 9.850. Shields added a 9.800, and Foster posted a 9.775. Brzostowski earned a 9.750, and junior Laura Lane scored a 9.725.

TOP MARKS AT THE SEC CHAMPIONSHIP

Auburn had 22 individual scores of 9.700 or better at the SEC Championship. The Tigers also posted their fourth-highest score of the season with a 195.325, which is the sixth time this season and the fifth-consecutive week that the team has broken the 195.000 mark.

TOP 20 INDIVIDUAL RANKINGS

Senior Rachel Inniss is tied for 12th in the floor rankings this week. Inniss has been ranked in the Top 20 on floor for ten-straight weeks. Junior Kylie Shields is tied for 17th on beam, marking Shields' fourth appearance in the beam Top 20 this season.

TIGERS TAKING TITLES

Auburn has taken 26 individual titles in meets so far this season. Inniss and Shields lead the team in titles, each with seven. Inniss has a team-high five on floor and two on beam, while Shields has a team-high four on beam, a team-high two on bars and one in the all-around.

GRABA LOOKING FOR SUCCESS IN NCAA REGIONAL DEBUT

Jeff Graba is looking for a successful outing in his first NCAA Regional appearance as a head coach. Graba and the team went 2-4 against SEC opponents during the regular season, defeating LSU and Kentucky at home, but falling to Georgia, Alabama and Florida on the road and Arkansas at home. During his five years as an assistant at the University of Utah from 2006-2010, Graba helped the Utes to a 59-10 record with three first-place regional finishes and four top-three finishes at the NCAA Championships.

GRABA GETS FIRST WIN, FIRST SEC WIN

In only his second meet as a head coach, Jeff Graba earned his first win and first SEC win at Auburn against LSU, 194.775-194.457, on Jan. 14.

WALK-ONS STEP UP

Laura Lane, Kendall Swartz and Leah Vining are three walk-ons that have been seen heavily in the lineup. At different points during the season, Lane has competed on beam, bars and floor. She held the No.3 spot in the floor lineup in 10-of-12 meets this season and anchored at Alabama. Lane posted a career-high 9.850 against Pittsburgh. Swartz scored a season-high 9.750 on bars against LSU, and was in that lineup the first five meets of the season. Vining led off on bars in the first two meets of the season and has held the No. 3 spot in 8 of the other 10 meets since. She holds a season-high 9.825 that came against Arkansas on Jan. 28.

INJURED MAKE COMEBACK

Laura Lane and Kareen Kaveh missed 2009 and 2010 due to injuries but are steadily making their way back in the lineups. Lane has competed on vault, beam and floor in the season's first two meets and holds a spot in the floor lineup, while Kaveh has been in the bars lineup this season.

NEW ADDITION TO TEAM

Sophomore Katelyn Mohr joined the Tigers in January after transferring from the University of Utah. She graduated high school from Horizon Charter School in Lincoln, Calif. Mohr qualified as a Senior Elite in 2008, was a three-time USA National Championship Qualifier (2006-2008) and was the region 1AA Champion in 2009.

FRESHMAN SCORES BIG IN FIRST OUTING

Auburn's only freshman, Abbey Habicht, scored big in her first collegiate competition. She scored a 9.800 on beam as the Tigers were trying to come from behind and win at Iowa State. The Florida native holds a season-high 9.825 on beam coming against Pittsburgh and a 9.775 on bars at Southern Utah.

TIGERS ON TV

The SEC released the 2011 gymnastics television schedule with a total of 16 regular season meets and the SEC Championships being televised. The Tigers were featured on either ESPNU, CSS or FSN in their meets against Georgia, Arkansas and Alabama. The SEC Championships was televised on ESPN2. All meets aired on a tape delayed basis.

THREE INDIVIDUAL TITLES AT IOWA STATE

Three Auburn gymnasts won individual titles in the season opener at Iowa State. Petrina Yokay won the first vault title of her career after scoring a 9.825. Kylie Shields scored a 9.825 to win the bars title, and Rachel Inniss added a title, after she posted a 9.850 to win beam.

SENIOR LEADERSHIP RETURNS

The Tigers return four seniors to the 2011 squad. **Lauren Brzostowski, Katie Hurley and Leah Vining** all return to action this season, as well as **Rachel Inniss** who competed at the NCAA Championships as an individual qualifier in the floor exercise, scoring a 9.700 in rotation five. Inniss competed with the Florida Gators, and placed 34th in section two of the championship. Overall, she tied for 74th.

TIGERS IN THE POLLS

The Tigers opened the 2011 season ranked No. 15 in the preseason poll. Auburn has appeared in eight consecutive preseason polls, and this season's ranking marks the fourth time since 2006 they have been ranked among the nation's top 15 teams.

TOUGH SCHEDULE PAYS OFF

Auburn's 2011 gymnastics schedule was recognized as the 10th strongest amongst the nation's top 25 teams, according to collegegymfans.com. This season the Tigers faced off against eight teams who were in the top 25 at the beginning of the season.

GRABA'S FIRST OUTING AS A HEAD COACH

Jeff Graba is in his first year as Auburn head coach after spending the past five seasons as an assistant at Utah. While at Utah, he helped the Utes to three NCAA runner-up and one third place finish. Graba, who was the 2009 West Region Assistant Coach of the Year, coached two NCAA event champions and nine All-Americans that earned 20 All-America honors during his tenure at Utah.

One of the nation's most flourishing coaching talents, first-year head coach Jeff Graba joined the Auburn women's gymnastics program on August 16, 2010.

Graba comes to Auburn after spending five years as a Utah assistant coach. While with the Utes he was named 2009 West Region Assistant Coach of the Year while coaching bars, collaborating on floor routines and serving as the recruiting coordinator.

During his first four years as a Utah assistant, the Utes finished as the NCAA runner-up three times and placed third once. Graba has also coached nine NCAA All-American gymnasts to 20 All-America performances.

As Utah's bars coach, he tutored Kristina Baskett to a 2006 NCAA uneven bars title as a freshman in his first trip to the NCAA Championships. He has also guided nine gymnasts to qualify for the uneven bars finals, and has seen five turn in Top 5 finishes.

Under Graba's leadership, Utah received the highest bars score in the preliminary session of team competition at the NCAA Championships in 2006, 2007 and 2009. In 2006, Graba also helped the Utes post the best bars score in the Super Six.

Prior to his stint at Utah, Graba spent two years as an assistant coach at Utah State. In 2005, Graba coached the Aggies to their first Western Gymnastics Conference championship and their first regional appearance in three years. In addition to his coaching duties, he served as the head of recruiting and assisted with the strength and conditioning program.

From 1995 – 2003, Graba was the co-owner and head coach of Midwest Gymnastics Club in Arden Hills, Minn. He had three gymnasts qualify Elite in his last three years with the club, and had several level 8, 9 and 10 regional and national competitors. Graba coached Ashley Mutchler to a first-place finish at both the 2003 American and U.S. Challenge/Classic meets in the Senior National Elite Division.

Graba's collegiate coaching career began with a six-year stay at Hamline University from 1992-98. While in St. Paul, Minn., his highlights included six consecutive trips to the Division III National Championships and a runner-up finish in 1996. Eleven of his gymnasts combined to win 26 National Collegiate

Gymnastics Association (NCGA) All-America citations. He also coached more than 20 scholastic All-Americans.

In addition to coaching at Hamline, Graba was also head coach at Flips Gymnastics Center in Minneapolis from 1988-1995. While there, he coached level 10 gymnast Sarah Reiling-Hildebrand, who made the 2000 and 2004 U.S. Olympic Diving Teams.

From 1988-92, he coached at both North St. Paul High School and White Bear Lake High School. He served as an assistant coach at North St. Paul from 1988-90 and at White Bear Lake from 1990-91, before becoming the head coach at North St. Paul from 1991-92.

The Forest Lake, Minn., native is a 1992 University of Minnesota graduate with a bachelor's degree in economics. He and his wife Bridget have five children: Bryan, Jaymie, Jason, Kyla, and Shayla.

Kurt Hettinger enters his third season with the Auburn gymnastics program as an assistant coach. His primary duties include recruiting coordinator and head uneven bars coach, and he also assists in coaching the vault and floor events.

In his first two seasons with the Tigers, he helped the program rewrite the record books. Under his guidance in 2010, the Tigers ended the regular season ranked 14th nationally on bars with a hit rate of .931. Petrina Yokay earned a perfect 10.000 from one judge and an individual score of 9.950 on bars at Maryland, while Allyson Sandusky earned a matching 9.950 at the same meet. Yokay and Sandusky's scores contributed to a team total 49.450 on bars, the second-highest mark in school history.

In 2009, Hettinger helped Auburn to a No. 4 national ranking, the highest in school history. The Tigers had their longest stint in the Top 10 (eight weeks) that season, and finished the year ranked 11th on bars with a .962 hit rate. Auburn also finished fourth on bars at the 2009 SEC Championships with the help of Sandusky, who earned an All-SEC selection during that competition.

Hettinger came to Auburn after five years as an assistant with the women's gymnastics program at Kent State. He served as the head bars coach while assisting with technique on vault and floor. He helped guide the Golden Flashes to three team records, four individual top-10 scores on bars, and eight individual titles on his respective events at Mid-American Conference (MAC) Championship meets. Hettinger played an integral role in Kent State's three NCAA Regional Championship appearances, two MAC Championship titles, and three consecutive regular-season titles. Kent State's 2007 bars squad spent the entire season ranked in the Top 25, ending with a final regular season ranking at No. 22. Outside the gym, Hettinger served as Kent State's recruiting coordinator and summer camp director.

He and his wife Katherine, a counselor at Auburn, welcomed their son, Cameron, in June of 2010.

Jenny Rowland, a former All-American and USA World Championship team member, is in her first season as an assistant coach at Auburn.

Rowland joined the Auburn staff after spending the last four years as a gymnastics judge on the national and international levels. She is a six-time USA Championship judge, judged the US Olympic Trials in 2008, and still serves as an International Brevet judge.

Rowland spent five years (2001-06) as a women's assistant coach at the University of Oklahoma where she coached the 2004 Big XII Champions, three-time team NCAA qualifiers (2004-2006), and three Big XII Gymnasts of the Year.

As a gymnast, Rowland was a USA National Team member from 1985 - 1990, and was on the 1989 USA World Championship Team.

She competed collegiately at Arizona State University, where she was an uneven bar All-American in 1993.

Rowland received her bachelor's degree in health and sports sciences from the University of Oklahoma in 1997. She is married to Garon Rowland, a two-time All-American gymnast, and the couple has two daughters, Ella and Emmy.


