» QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn finished every non-conference weekend with a winning record for the first time since 2019.
- The Tigers have continued to homer in every game to start the season, including eight straight games with multiple home runs.
- The 15 straight games with a home run is the longest streak since 2010 (26).
- The eight straight games with multiple homers is the longest streak since 2008-09.
- The teams' 33 home runs through 15 games are the most since 2009 the seventh most in the NCAA.
- The Tigers hit .331 and scored 45 runs on 42 hits, including 21 extra-base hits, last week.
- Five qualified hitters -Mason Maners (.600), Cooper Weiss (.563), Cooper McMurray (.533), Deric Fabian (.429), Gavin Miller (.400) - turned in a .400 or better average last week.
- Auburn's 24 runs and 11 extra-base hits in the series finale vs. Austin Peay were the most in a game since a 33-0 win against Alabama A&M on Feb. 24, 2021.
- The team has walked (107) more than it has struck out (92) this season.
- Auburn is 2-0 in games at Toyota Field the last two seasons and has outscored the opponent 17-4.
- The Tigers lead the all-time series against Troy 58-24, and the teams have split the eight matchups under head coach Butch Thompson.

Butch Thompson enters his ninth season at the helm of the program in 2023, posting a record of 256-187-1 in his first eight seasons. He has led the program to the College World Series in two of the last four seasons.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his ninth season with the Tigers in 2024.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in seven seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 256-187-1 overall record and has advanced to the NCAA Tournament five of the last six seasons, including three Super Regional appearances in the last five years and two trips to the College World Series in the last four seasons.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 33 Division I All-Americans and 46 all-conference performers. He has seen 21 of his former pitchers called up to Major League Baseball, including 15 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 39 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 16 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the program record No. 4 class in 2017 and No. 5 class in 2022. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally.

In 31 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 22 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached nine College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019 and taking the team back for the second time in three seasons in 2022. Thompson became one of five active SEC coaches who have taken their program to a pair of College World Series in a three-year span. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 19 postseason appearances.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

During his tenure with the Tigers, Thompson led the team to three straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2017-19 for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals in 2018 and 2019 for the first time in program history, and has now hosted back-to-back regionals for the first time in program history.

Auburn's second straight regional host bid in 2023 came thanks to a second-half run for the record books, and the Tigers became one of five programs in the country and two in the SEC to host each of the last two seasons.

Auburn posted a league-best 12-3 record in the final five weeks of conference play and finished the SEC season with 17 wins, the most since winning the SEC West in 2010. The Tigers finished top five in the league in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2002-03. The 12-3 stretch was the program's best since also going 12-3 in the final 15 games of the 2010 season and the nine-game SEC winning streak at the end of the regular season and first game of the SEC Tournament was the team's longest since 1995.

Auburn has finished six of Thompson's eight seasons in the top 25, including three in the top 10. The No. 5 national ranking to finish 2022 was tied for the second highest mark in program history.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series



finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 22 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the American Baseball Coaches Association.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. He is a member of both the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame (Class of 2014) and MACCC Hall of Fame (Class of 2021).

THE FUTURE OF PLAINMAN PARK

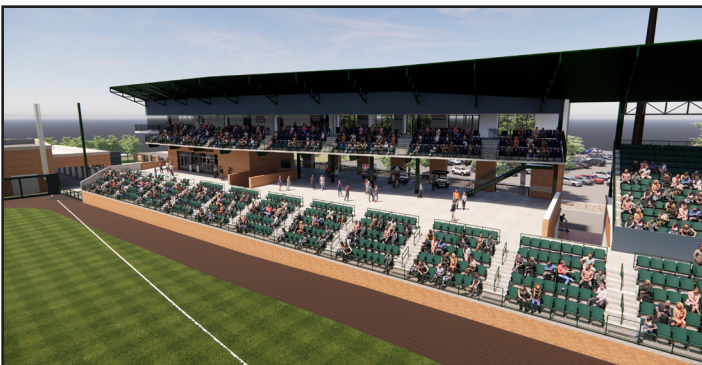
Auburn Athletics finalized plans for the previously approved \$30 million Plainsman Park renovation project last summer.

The renovations are highlighted by the additions of three new premium experiences – the Hall of Fame Club, First Base Club, and Home Plate Club – as well as a unique general admission space atop the War Eagle Wall in left field.



HALL OF FAME CLUB

A tribute to Auburn, Southeastern Conference and Major League Baseball great Frank Thomas, the Hall of Fame Club will add approximately 100 premium seats at field level and is open for the 2024 season. Divided between two tiered rows, these high-end leather seats will offer a dynamic field-level view behind home plate. Club members will have access to a 3,000-square foot climate-controlled club space featuring food, drinks, televisions, restrooms, and indoor seating.



FIRST BASE CLUB

A new three-story structure that will complement Plainsman Park’s classic ballpark architecture, the expanded Plainsman Patio and First Base Club will provide a variety of new fan experience offerings, including indoor and outdoor viewing areas, new concession offerings, expanded restrooms, and more. The space will be completed for the 2025 season.

At inner-concourse level, the new covered Plainsman Patio space will provide expanded standing room space, while offering access to an all-new walk-in concession market.

The third level will feature an all-new upscale ballpark experience with the First Base Club. This area is expected to include approximately 200 new seats ranging in type from cushioned chairback seats to outdoor loge seating options, and will offer elevated food and beverage options, a climate-controlled indoor space, as well as private restrooms.



HOME PLATE CLUB

By relocating the existing press box to a new location on the third level of the First Base Club structure, a new high-end club experience will be developed atop the home plate grandstands. With one of the best views in the ballpark, this area is expected to include approximately 50 high-end seats and a climate-controlled environment with access to food, drinks, restrooms, and more premium amenities. This space will be completed prior to the 2025 season.



WAR EAGLE WALL

The experience Auburn fans love within the Tiger Terrace along the third base line will soon be expanded to provide access to a unique experience atop the War Eagle Wall in left field. A general admission space that will be completed for the 2025 season, this project will add a two-tiered terrace atop the wall to provide a one-of-a-kind experience in college baseball.

ENHANCED STUDENT EXPERIENCE

As Auburn University students continue to pack Plainsman Park, the first phase of renovations prior to the 2024 season will provide an enhancement to the current standing room area beyond the right-center field fence. This portion of the project will provide a multi-tiered, elevated platform to bring students closer to the action while providing expanded standing room capacity.

EXPANDED AND RENOVATED TEAM SPACES

The third phase of the project will include upgrades to the student athlete experience through renovated and expanded team spaces. These upgrades include a renovation and expansion of the Tim Hudson Locker Room, a new bullpen and pitching lab, new weight room and nutrition area, new team meeting room, and new coaches’ offices. This phase of the project is scheduled to be completed throughout 2025-26.

SCOUTING THE TROJANS

- Led by third-year head coach Skylar Meade, Troy enters the week with a 12-5 overall record and is coming off a series win at Indiana.
- Offensively, the Trojans are hitting .309 as a team and are led by Ethan Kavanagh's .444 clip. The team top 20 in the country in doubles (40), home runs (31), runs (160) and on-base percentage (.447).
- On the mound, Troy has turned in a 4.63 staff ERA with 156 strikeouts and 70 walks in 140.0 innings. Midweek starter Garrett Gainous is 1-0 with a 1.69 ERA in three midweek starts.

WEEKEND REWIND

- Auburn took two of three games against Austin Peay and finished non-conference play with a winning record each weekend for the first time since 2019.
- Game one was decided on a walkoff homer run from Mason Maners, while games two and three saw margins of victories of nine and 19 runs.

OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION

- Auburn scored 24 runs on 15 hits, including seven doubles and four homers, in the series finale against the Governors.
- The 24 runs were the most in a game since scoring a program record 33 runs vs. Alabama A&M on Feb. 24, 2021.
- The 11 extra-base hits were also the most since recording 14 extra-base hits in the win against Alabama A&M.
- Four players collected multiple hits and six drove in multiple runs.

FLARE FOR THE DRAMATIC

- Two of Mason Maners' three home runs this season have been game-tying or game-winning homers in the seventh inning or later.
 - 7th inning vs. Iowa (2/23)
 - 9th inning vs. Austin Peay (3/8)

MR. ALL-AMERICA

- After becoming Auburn's 20th Freshman All-American in program history a season ago, including the program's first since 2018, Irish garnered Second Team Preseason All-America honors from the NCBWA.
- Irish set Auburn's freshman doubles record (24) and led freshmen nationally in the category.
- He started his sophomore season by going 4-for-5 with a homer and four RBI in the opener vs. ECU and leads the team homers (six) and RBI (23).
- Irish turned in the first multi-homer game of his career and matched a season high with four RBI vs. UConn (Mar. 3).

100-HIT CLUB

- Irish collected his 100th career hit in his 68th career game played with a solo homer in the first inning of game two vs. UConn (March 2).
- He became the fourth fastest player in program history to reach the milestone.

DIGGIN' THE LONG BALL

- Auburn has homered in 15 straight games to start the season and is one of two SEC programs to homer in every game this year.
- The team's 33 homers through 15 games are the most in the first 15 games of a season since 2009 (33), and the team ranks seventh in the country in the category.
- Two of the program's top six home run totals have come in the last three seasons - 86 (2021) and 84 (2023) - and Auburn is one of three programs to have a player hit 20 or more home runs in each of the last two seasons - DiChiara (22 in 2022), Ware (24 in 2023).

RUNNING AT A RECORD-SETTING RATE

- Graduate transfer Cooper Weiss has set Auburn's single-game record with four stolen bases twice this season - Feb. 18 vs. ECU and Feb. 27 vs. Samford.
- Weiss ranks second in the country with 14 stolen bases in 15 attempts.
- Auburn has stolen 33 bases through 15 games, marking the most stolen bases through 15 games since 2012 (48).
- The Tigers didn't reach 33 stolen bases last season until Apr. 30 (44 games).

COOP KEEPS CRUSHING

- Since hitting a grand slam and driving in a career-high six runs vs. Wichita State on Feb. 24, Cooper McMurray is hitting .500 (16-for-32) with 5 2B, 4 HR, and 19 RBI in 10 games.
- He went 4-for-4 with 3 2B, 1 HR and 4 RBI in the finale vs. Austin Peay and became the first player since Cole Foster in 2022 to record four extra-base hits in a game.
- His 14 homers in 2023 were the third most by an Auburn newcomer in the BBCOR era - DiChiara (22 in 2022), Julien (17 in 2018).
- Eleven of McMurray's homers last year came in conference play, tied for the eighth most in the league, and he became Auburn's first player since 2010 with three multi-homer SEC performances.

FABIAN IS CATCHING FIRE

- Deric Fabian has hit four of his five home runs this season in the last five games and is hitting .471 (8-for-17) with 10 RBI in the span.
- He turned in his first career multi-homer game vs. Alr Force last Tuesday and went 4-for-6 with three homers and six RBI in two games from Mar. 3-6.
- Through 15 games, Fabian is top five on the team in nearly every offensive category including average (.333), hits (15), home runs (five), RBI (21) and stolen bases (3-3)

ARMS APLENTY

- Auburn returns nearly 80 percent of its inning pitched from a season ago, including seven of its top eight innings guys.

CARSON CARVED 'EM UP

- The son of a former Auburn pitching coach, Carson Myers made his debut in the series finale vs. ECU and turned in 6.0 scoreless innings with a career-high eight strikeouts.
- The 6.0 innings were the most by an Auburn pitcher on Opening Weekend since Casey Mize also pitched 6.0 innings in 2018.
- Myers went on to be named the SEC Co-Pitcher of the Week, becoming the first Auburn pitcher to earn the distinction since Joseph Gonzalez in 2022.

CANNON THE CLOSER

- Junior right-hander Will Cannon returns to the closer role after ranking tied for fifth in the SEC in the category a season ago.
- Cannon finished the game in 15 of his 20 relief appearances last year, the fourth most games finished in the league, and has done so in all four of his appearances this year.
- He was tabbed to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award Preseason Watch List after being named to the midseason list last year.

TILLY TAKES THE HILL

- Freshman right hander Cam Tilly has earned the win in three straight appearances against No. 18 Iowa, UConn and Austin Peay.
- Tilly turned in a season-high 4.0 innings against the Huskies and retired 10 of the final 11 batters he faced.
- Prior to arriving at Auburn, Tilly won gold with the USA Baseball U18 National Team at the 2022 WBSC baseball World Cup.

TOP-RANKED TRANSFERS

- Auburn was tabbed by D1Baseball.com to have the No. 14 transfer class in the country.
- The team's five transfers in the top 130 are tied for the sixth most in the nation.
 - Deric Fabian (Florida): No. 29
 - Mason Maners (Jax State): No. 77
 - Javon Hernandez (Jax State): No. 86
 - Cooper Weiss (Miami [OH]): No. 116
 - Carson Myers (UAB): No. 129
- Fabian, Maners, Hernandez and Weiss have made a combined 42 starts while Myers leads the team with a 1.88 ERA.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

- According to D1Baseball.com's preseason schedule analysis, Auburn is set to play a league-high 33 quad one games in 2024 - home games vs. RPI 1-25, neutral site games vs. 1-40, road games vs. 1-60.
- Five of Auburn's opponents were ranked in the preseason top 10 and seven in the top 20.
- The Jax College Classic marked the first two of Auburn's 23 games against teams currently ranked in the top 25 of a major poll.
 - vs. No. 18 Iowa: W, 7-5
 - vs. No. 10 Virginia: L, 4-6

THOMPSON'S TENURE

- Auburn has hosted back-to-back regionals for the first time in program history and has made a NCAA regional in five of the last six postseasons under Butch Thompson.
- Prior to Thompson's arrival in 2016, Auburn made five tournament appearances in 14 seasons from 2002-15.
- The Tigers have also finished top five in the league in back-to-back years for the first time since 2002-03.
- The team has finished .500 or better in SEC play in four of the last six years under Thompson, and one of the seasons with a sub-.500 SEC record ended in Omaha (2019).
- Prior to Thompson's arrival, the program had turned in just one such season (2010) in 12 years between 2004-15.

SECOND HALF SURGE

- Auburn went a league best 12-3 in the second half of SEC play last year, marking the program's best 15-game stretch in conference play since also going 12-3 in 2010.
- The Tigers won five straight SEC series for the first time since 2010 and were one of two teams (Vanderbilt) to win five straight SEC series at any point during the year.

.330+ HIT CLUB

- The Tigers' quartet of Irish (.361), Bryson Ware (.350), Peirce (.343) and Cole Foster (.336) became the program's first quartet of qualified hitters to hit .330 or higher in a season since 2010 and the SEC's first quartet to accomplish the feat since Kentucky did so in 2017.

CONGRATS GRADS

- Three Auburn players in Christian Hall, Bobby Peirce and Cooper Weiss have earned their bachelor's degree and will wear the SEC graduate patch throughout the season.

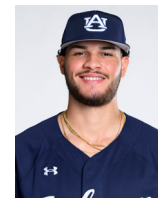
