Holly Currie led Auburn with a .429 batting average and had a home run in the championship

game. Currie also finished with an 1.11 ERA in 19 innings of work, throwing the team's first no-hitter in postseason play as Auburn defeated Marist, 14-0.

Beth DiPietro threw a complete game shutout of her own in the Tigers' 4-0 win over Ohio State May 19 which advanced the team to the final game.

Tatiana Fernandez paced the team with six RBI, including three on a home run against the Buckeyes May 19.
