### TIGERS PLAY TROY IN FINAL GAME OF 8-GAME HOMESTAND

The Tigers are in their third season under head coach Tom Slater (62-61 at AU/110-161 overall) ... Auburn is playing the final game of an eight-game homestand in which it started 6-1 ... Auburn's 6-1 record is its best start since 2004 ... It is also the 10th time Auburn has started 6-1 or better since 1994 ... Auburn has already collected three quality starts from its starting pitchers after collecting seven in all of 2006 ... Three different relievers earned a save during the UNC Greensboro series (Jr. RHP Brett Butts, So. RHP Luke Greinke, Fr. RHP Scott Shuman) ... All three of Auburn's starting pitchers earned the win in the series against UNC Greensboro, the first time that has happened since 2002 ... Fr. INFs Robert Brooks and Eric Skinner have each recorded a hit in 6 of 7 games this season ... The pair are hitting a combined 18-for-58 (.310) ... Skinner and So. OF Mike Bianucci each have three-game hitting streaks entering Tuesday night ... Jr. C/IF Josh Donalson has started 93 consecutive games for the Tigers (39-C, 54-3B) ... Sr. OF Bruce Edwards is a perfect 21-for-21 in stolen bases dating back to the 2005 season ... Auburn's bullpen has allowed just 4 ER in 31.0 IP (1.16 ERA) ... Auburn's team ERA of 2.18 is tied for fourth in the SEC ... Tuesday's game is the first of eight games against in-state foes for Auburn ... Auburn is ranked by Collegiate Baseball for the first time since April 18, 2005.

## SCOUTING THE TROJANS

Troy heads north to Auburn sporting a 5-2 record, having swept St. Louis this past weekend after going 1-2 against Arkansas in the opening weekend. The Trojans bounced back from the Arkansas series by beating Alabama in Tuscaloosa last Wednesday to start its current four-game winning streak.

Steven Felix leads all Troy hitters with a .438 batting average while the Trojans as a whole are hitting at a .300 clip, having hit .365 during the St. Louis series.

On the mound the team has a team ERA of 6.27 due mostly to giving up 35 earned runs during the Arkansas series (11.67 ERA for the series).

Ryan Ellison is making his second start of the season for Troy, having started the game at Alabama. Against the Crimson Tide, Ellison allowed four runs on four hits and three walks while striking out three in 4.2 innings.

### AUBURN-TROY SERIES

Auburn leads the all-time series with Troy, 32-13. When the games are played on The Plains, Auburn leads 22-6, having won the last seven, dating back to the 2000 season. The two teams will play again later this season in Troy (Apr. 25).

### TOM SLATER VS. BOBBY PIERCE

Tom Slater is 3-2 all-time against Bobby Pierce as a head coach, with all five meetings coming in the last two years.

### TIGERS RANKED 29TH BY CB

Collegiate Baseball has the Tigers ranked 29th in this week's Top 30 poll. It marks the first time the Tigers have been ranked by Collegiate Baseball since Apr. 18, 2005, when Auburn was 23rd in the poll before dropping out for the final eight polls.

### THOMPSON TRYs TO MAKE IT 4-FOR-4

Fr. RHP Taylor Thompson will try to become the fourth straight starting pitcher to earn the win on Tuesday night, following in the footsteps of So. RHP Bryan Woodall, So. RHP Paul Burnside and So. LHP Evan Crawford, who all picked up wins in the starting role against UNC Greensboro this past weekend.

The last time Auburn had its three starting pitchers earn wins in a three-game weekend series was in March of 2002 when Levale Speigner, Eric Brandon and Colby Paxton

### 3 GAMES, 3 PITCHERS, 3 SAVES

Three different relievers earned saves during the UNC Greensboro series with Jr. RHP Brett Butts picking up the save on Friday, So. RHP Luke Greinke doing it on Saturday and Fr. RHP Scott Schuman closing out the game on Sunday. The three combined to throw 6.0 innings and struckout a combined six UNCG hitters.

### STARTERS NEARLY FLAWLESS

Auburn's starting pitchers were nearly flawless over the past weekend, not surrendering an earned run in 17.0 innings pitched as all three earned a victory.

### TIGER PEN STRONG AGAIN

The Auburn bullpen has earned high praise from head coach Tom Slater for its dominating performance over the first seven games of the season. The Tigers have used nine different relievers to throw 31.0 innings and combined they have allowed just four earned runs on 20 hits and five walks while striking out 33.

Combined, the bullpen has a 1.16 ERA and a .189 opponent batting average.

Since Slater has been the head coach at Auburn, the bullpen has had a combined 3.40 ERA.

**GOING UP THE MIDDLE**

Going up the middle, Auburn's catchers, middle infielders and centerfielder have had a very good start to the season. In seven games, the four positions (which have been manned by five different players) have a combined .333 batting average with 10 doubles and 28 RBIs (only games played at that position counted).

**BROOKS GOOD FOR TWO**

In four out of the first seven games this season, freshman Robert Brooks has pounded out two or more hits and has driven in a total of six runs (which is fourth on the team).

**QUALITY STARTS**

Auburn's starting pitchers have already recorded three quality starts after registering just seven in all of 2006. So. RHP Bryan Woodall has collected a quality start in both of his outings this season while So. RHP Paul Burnside also registered one in his first start of the season. So. LHP Evan Crawford led all Auburn starters with five quality starts in '06 while Chris Dennis collected the other two.

**EDWARDS' FLEET-FEET**

With his six stolen bases this season, Sr. OF Bruce Edwards has put together a string of 21 consecutive stolen bases without being caught. Having gone 6-for-6 this year and 14-for-14 as a junior, Edwards was 13-for-17 as a sophomore but was thrown out on his 16th attempt on May 22, 2005 vs. Alabama. The very next game he started his current streak, successfully stealing second base off of PJ Walters of South Alabama in the third inning of the first game of the 2005 NCAA Regional in Tallahassee.

**SUPER SOPHS**

Auburn's sophomore class - Tom Slater's first recruiting class - has had a very good start to the season both offensively and on the mound. At

the plate the sophomore class is hitting .353 (compared to the team average of .314) while on the mound they are a combined 5-0 with a 1.64 ERA in 38.1 IP (out of 66.0, team ERA of 2.18).

**DENNIS EXCELS BACK IN PEN**

Sr. RHP Chris Dennis seems to be comfortable back in his role of reliever. In his career, Dennis has a 3.07 ERA in 42 relief appearances, compared to a 5.90 ERA as a starter. His K/9 is also much better as a reliever (9.89) than as a starter (5.90).

**AUBURN VS. THE SUNBELT**

Auburn owns a combined 75-62 (.547) record against current members of the Sunbelt Conference. Troy is the first of two Sunbelt opponents for the Tigers this season as AU will face South Alabama this coming weekend and again in April in a mid-week game.

**SEASON NOTES**

**DONALDSON NATIONAL POW**

Junior Josh Donaldson was named the Collegiate Baseball/Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week following his stellar opening-weekend series against Hofstra in which he went 7-for-13 with two doubles, three home runs, seven runs scored and 11 RBIs. He is just the fourth Tiger to be honor by Collegiate Baseball as its National Player of the Week, joining Gabe Gross (2/14/00), Eric Brandon (3/4/02) and Colby Paxton (3/18/02).

**DONALDSON IN ELITE COMPANY**

Junior Josh Donaldson joined some elite company with his three home run barrage in the first two games of the season. Since 1993, only three

other Tigers have hit even two home runs in the first two games of the season. The others were Tim Hudson in 1996 [he finished with just three home runs that season], Dominic Rich in 2000 [he finished the year with seven round-trippers] and Karl Amonite in 2005 [he finished with 11].

**BIANUCCI'S QUEST**

Not since the end of the 1988 and 1989 seasons has the same person led the Tigers in batting average at the end of the season in back-to-back seasons. Mike Bianucci hit a team-best .359 as a freshman in 2006. The last person to do it in back-to-back seasons was Frank Thomas (.385 in '88, .403 in '89).

Mailon Kent led the Tigers in 1999 with a .379 average and repeated the feat in 2001 with a .350 mark. His streak was interrupted in 2000 despite hitting .342 as the Tigers had two players break the .400 barrier that season (Gabe Gross - .430, Todd Faulkner - .423).

**HOME SWEET HOME**

Auburn will play its first eight games of the season at Plainsman Park before going on the road Feb. 23-25 for a tournament at South Alabama. The Tigers then return home for 10 more games before leaving the state of Alabama for the first time March 16-18 to play at Georgia.

**STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE**

Auburn will play a total of 35 games against NCAA Tournament teams from a year ago and entered the season with a strength of schedule of 29th in the country, second in the SEC to only Georgia (18th).

**TIGER RECRUITS RATE HIGH**

Auburn's 2005 and 2006 recruiting classes were ranked 12th and 18th, respectively, by Baseball America, making the Tigers one of only five schools to have back-to-back top 18 recruiting classes. The other schools are: Texas (3rd in '05, 12th in '06), South Carolina (4th in '05, 2nd in '06), UCLA (5th in '05, 13th in '06) and Tennessee (6th in '05, 15th in '06).

**BA RANKS TWO TIGERS IN TOP 100**

Junior catcher Josh Donaldson and sophomore outfielder Mike Bianucci were both ranked in the top 100 of Baseball America's top 100 draft eligible prospects. Donaldson was ranked 24th and was the third catcher listed while Bianucci checked in at 72nd.

**BA LOVES THE FRESHMEN, TOO**

Baseball America also ranked two Tigers among its top 100 freshmen in 2007, listing Ross Smith 48th and Taylor Thompson 49th.

**NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES**

After starting 21 games at third and 22 as the designated hitter, sophomore Mike Bianucci has moved to leftfield this season for the Tigers, a position he started in just once in '06. Also making a big move for the Tigers will be sophomore Justin Bristow, who started 52 games at short-stop in '06 but has been moved to the pitching mound this season. Bristow did not make any appearances on the mound for the Tigers last season.
