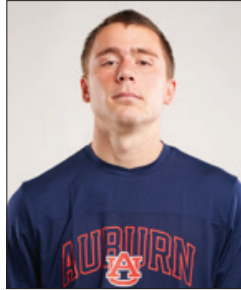

A veteran of competition at the highest levels of collegiate and professional tennis, Bobby Reynolds will begin his eighth season as head coach of the Auburn Tigers in 2023-24. He was named head coach at Auburn in June of 2016 and received a three-year contract extension in July of 2022.

During his seventh season on the Plains in 2023, the Tigers earned back-to-back bids to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since the program did so in 2013 and 2014. Auburn finished the season ranked 26th by the ITA with a 17-12 overall record and the team claimed four victories over top-25 opponents including then-No. 4 South Carolina on the road and then-No.13 Tennessee. Auburn also won the prestigious Blue-Gray National Tennis Classic for the first time since 1984.

In 2022, after Auburn advanced to the SEC semifinals and the second round of the NCAA tournament, he was named the ITA Southern Region coach of the year for the Tigers' continued progress in the nation's toughest conference. The Tigers posted a 21-11 overall record, marking the program's first 20-win season since 2002.

At Auburn, Reynolds has coached two doubles All-Americans (Tad Maclean/Finn Murgett), an NCAA qualifier in singles in 2021, 2022 and 2023 (Tyler Stice) as well as an NCAA qualifying doubles team in 2021, 2022 and 2023 (Tad Maclean/Finn Murgett, Raul Dobai/Finn Murgett). Under Reynolds' leadership, Auburn has made two NCAA Tournament appearances (2022, 2023) and a SEC Championship semifinal appearance (2021).

The Atlanta, Ga., product was the 2003 SEC player of the year and NCAA tournament Most Outstanding Player, leading Vanderbilt to the NCAA finals that season. He played 12 seasons of professional tennis, appearing in 17 grand slam main draws for singles and 20 for doubles, and was the 2012 MVP of World Team Tennis for the Washington Kastles.

Coach Reynolds and his wife Dr. Josie Reynolds, an All-America pentathlete and heptathlete at Vanderbilt, have three sons – Parker, Mason and Blake.



John Roddick **Associate Head Coach**

Former UCF and Oklahoma head coach John Roddick joined the Auburn men’s tennis coaching staff as an associate head coach in August of 2023.

Roddick joined the staff after spending the past seven seasons as the director of tennis and head men’s tennis coach at UCF. Under his guidance, the Knights received two NCAA Tournament bids, six All-American selections, 15 All-AAC selections and the 2021 AAC Championship title. The program also saw its best record since moving to the AAC in 2021 when Roddick led the team to a 22-4 record as well as its highest ITA ranking in program history, which was ninth in the nation.

Prior to his time at UCF, Roddick served as the head coach at the University of Oklahoma from 2010-2016. The Sooners posted three consecutive NCAA Championship runner-up finishes in 2014, 2015 and 2016. Oklahoma also earned its first Big 12 Conference championship in 2012 as well as a No. 1 overall seed in the

NCAA Tournament in 2015.

He was named the ITA National Coach of the Year once, the ITA Central Region Coach of the Year twice and Big 12 Conference Coach of the Year four times during his time with the Sooners.

Prior to taking his first head coaching job at Oklahoma, Roddick served as an assistant coach for two seasons at Florida State as well as for three seasons at Georgia, which included a national championship in 2001.

Roddick also coached his brother, Andy, who is a former ATP No. 1 player and the 2003 U.S. Open champion.

The Omaha, Nebraska native played collegiate tennis at the University of Georgia, where he earned All-American honors four times and was named the UGA Athlete of the Year in 1998.

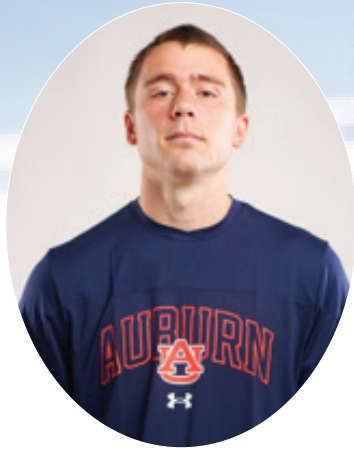

Yarbrough Tennis Center



In 2005, Auburn University set out to make its men's and women's tennis teams the best programs in the country, starting with a state-of-the-art facility. In August 2006, construction began on Auburn's new facility. On Nov. 2 2007, the City of Auburn/Auburn University Yarbrough Tennis Center opened as a new phase in Auburn tennis.

The facility has 33,314-square feet of indoor space with six indoor courts, 12 outdoor courts with stadium seating and 16 clay courts. The Yarbrough Tennis Center also houses a pro shop, men's and women's locker rooms, concessions and a meeting area. All 12 courts are world-class lighted courts used for both competition and practice by the Auburn tennis teams.

As one of the best facilities in the Southeastern Conference, Auburn hosted the 2008 SEC women's tennis championships and the men's tournament in 2009. The facility was named the 2015 Public Facility of the Year by the Professional Tennis Registry.

The City of Auburn/Auburn University Tennis Center replaced the Luther Young Tennis Complex, Auburn's tennis home since 1978.
