Tiger Headlines

The Auburn men's swimming and diving team won its third straight and fifth overall NCAA Championship with 491 points last season ... The Tigers are swimming/diving against Alabama for the 37th time in school history ... David Marsh is in his 16th season with the Tigers, owning a 97-18 (.843) dual meet record with five NCAA (1997, 1999, 2003, 2004, 2005) titles and nine straight (11 total) SEC crowns ... The Alabama meet will be the final dual meet in 2005 for Auburn swimming ... AUs dive team will compete at Ohio State in early December.

Auburn vs. the Competition

The Tiger men enter the meet with a 6-0 record having defeated #10 Indiana, #14 Purdue, #17 Virginia and #23 Penn State already this fall season, along with SEC foe's LSU and South Carolina. The Crimson Tide men come to Auburn with a 2-1 record with wins over Delta State and Henderson State. The group lost to Tennessee in the season opener on Nov. 4.

Tigers vs. Tide History

The Auburn men hold the all-time series advantage 20-16, with the Tigers taking the last 12 victories. Under Marsh, the AU men are 13-2 against the Crimson Tide. The last time an Alabama team defeated Auburn with Marsh at the helm was the 1992-93 meeting when UA won by 10 points. The other loss came in Marsh's inaugural season where the Tide defeated the AU men by just one point.

Winning Streaks

The Auburn swimming and diving winning streak currently sits at 38 straight dual meets. The Tigers are 37-0 since the start of the 2001-02 season and have not suffered a loss since Texas knocked off the Tigers 136.5-103.5 on Jan. 11, 2001.

Auburn at the Top of the Class

For the third week in a row, the Auburn men are ranked No. 1 in the CSCAA poll with all eight first-place voted and 200 points. In the course of the season Auburn will face 11 ranked opponents - the No. 21 Crimson Tide is the fourth straight ranked team Auburn will face this season.

To 'B' or not to 'B'

After last weekend's quad-meet, five Auburn men have met the 'B' cut in 12 events and the 400 medley relay team of James Wike, David Maras, Matt Targett and George Bovell had a 'B' cut performance at Virginia. One of the five men has qualified in four different events and another in three as Eric Shanteau has the 'B' time in the 200 breast, 200 fly, 200 IM and 400 IM, and G. Bovell made the 'B' cut in the 50, 100 and 200 free's at Virginia. The other 'B' qualifiers are Doug Van Wie (200 back, 200 breast), James Wike (200 back, 200 breast) and Shai Livnat (500 free).

A Look Ahead

The meet with Alabama will mark the Tiger's final dual meet in 2005 for the swim team, but the team will compete in the US Open on Dec. 1-3, hosted by Auburn in the James E. Martin Aquatics Center. The AU diving team will continue competition on Dec. 2-4 at the Ohio State Invitational in Columbus, Ohio.

Tigers Post Season Highs Against Three Top-25 Teams

In the meet at Virginia (with Penn State and Purdue), the Auburn men turned in season high's in every event except one (1000 free). The men won eight individual events and three relay's. In the 400 IM and 400 free relay the Tigers had the fastest times but exhibited in the event.

Segerlin Soars to the Top

In his first head-to-head competition this season, junior diver Steve Segerlin not only won both the 1- and 3-meter events, but qualified for zones with 345.82 and 397.27 marks, respectively. Segerlin extended his dominance in both events at LSU by taking the individual title with zone qualifying marks.

Taming the Cats

In Auburn's first road contest of the season at LSU, the men dominated the competition by winning 10 of 13 events (including both the 1- and 3-meter diving). Senior Doug Van Wie led the team with an individual event win (200 fly) and was part of both winning relay teams (400 medley and free).

Nothing as Sweet as a Sweep

Against the Hoosier's, the Tigers swept a trio of events. David Maras led the charge in the 100 breast with Sean Osborne and Kurt Cady following. James Wike took the win in the 200 back with Doug Van Wie and Nick Bovell in second and third. Auburn sealed the sweep in the breaststroke events with the 200 breast - Eric Shanteau (1st), Sean Osborne (2nd) and Andrew Callahan (3rd). In the season opener against South Carolina, Auburn men finished 1-, 2-, 3 in five individual events.

Trio of Tigers Named to National A and B Teams

Current AU senior Eric Shanteau was named to the National A Team for the 200 IM. Former AU swimmers Mark Gangloff (100 breast) and Bryce Hunt (200 back) were represented on the B team. National A team members are those who have achieved top-eight FINA world ranking and B team members are ranked in the top 16 in individual Olympic events during the traditional long course season.

Tiger Rowdy Gaines to be Inducted in U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame

Former triple Olympic gold medalist and eight-time national champion Rowdy Gaines was selected to the 2006 U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame inductee list. Gaines will join fellow 2006 inductees on Dec. 8 in Chicago at the Harris Theatre for the ceremony. NBC will televise a two-hour special later in the month on the new class of inductee's.

Tiger Men Make Early Splash

The Auburn men opened the 2005-06 season on Sept. 30, one of the earliest starts ever, against SEC foe South Carolina. The men downed the Gamecocks 124-70 for its 33 straight dual meet victory. Seven individual titles were won and the 200 MR also touched first.

Top Scorer's Return

The Tiger men return 13 NCAA qualifiers, nine of which were scorer's, on the 2005 NCAA Championship team. Gone from the mix are Chad Barlow, Matt Bricker, Fred Bousquet, BJ Jones, Nate Knopf and Ryan Wochomurka.

Running the Table

The Tigers have had a firm grasp on the Southeastern Conference over the past 12 years. Since the 1993 season, Auburn has claimed 11 SEC titles and five NCAA titles and won 78 dual meets against just seven losses for a .918 winning percentage. In conference dual meets alone, Auburn is an astounding 33-3 (.917) with its last loss coming at the hands and feet of Florida on Jan. 30, 1999, 123-119.

Leading the Way

Senior's Eric Shanteau and Doug Van Wie are the captains for the 2005-06 squad.

Fresh Faces

The Tigers added 11 newcomers to the mix this season. The group hales from eight different states and three foreign countries (Australia, Croatia, Trinidad & Tobago).

Seeing Double

Two current and one former AU swimmers won double medals at the World University Games in Izmir, Turkey. A total of eight medals were awarded to Auburn swimmers during the competition. Senior Eric Shanteau dominated the IM events, winning both.

Crossing the Border

At this summer's 2005 World Championships in Canada, Auburn had nine current or former athletes competing with David Marsh serving as the assistant men's coach. Former swimmer Mark Gangloff captured silver in the 50 breast.
