TIGER BITES

The Auburn Volleyball team is in its 22nd year of existence and holds an all-time record of 335-344 for a .493 winning percentage... Head Coach Laura Farina is in her sixth season with the team and holds a 54-111 (.327) record at Auburn... Last season the Tigers finished with a 13-18 record and were 5-15 in SEC play, finishing sixth in the SEC West... Auburn returns six letterwinners, four starters, from 2006 and welcomes nine newcomers.

SERIES HISTORY

Georgia holds a 24-6 advantage all-time over Auburn and has won nine of the last 10 meetings after dowing the Tigers, 3-0, earlier this season in Athens. The Bulldogs also hold an 11-2 advantage over the Tigers in Auburn. Arkansas leads Auburn 25-3 in the series, but the Tigers have won two of the last three meetings. Only one of Auburn's wins has come at home as the Lady Backs have a 12-1 record in Auburn.

NEXT ON THE SCHEDULE FOR AUBURN

Following this week's matches, Auburn hits the road to finish out the regular season with matches at Ole Miss and LSU. The Tigers and Lady Rebels square off at 7 p.m., Nov. 16 while Auburn and LSU will meet at 1:30 p.m., Nov. 18.

LAST TIME OUT

The Tigers are coming off a 3-1 (32-30, 24-30, 27-30, 28-30) loss at Alabama on Sunday. Auburn out-hit the Crimson Tide with a .250 attack percentage, but could not pull out the road win. Whitney Jacob led the Tigers with 18 kills while hitting .472. Defensively, Rachel Shanks and Liz Crouch had 19 digs each with Alyssa Davis adding in five blocks.

LAST TIME OUT FOR GEORGIA

The Bulldogs are coming off a 2-0 weekend that includes a sweep of Alabama, the leader in the SEC West. In their last outing, Georgia swept Mississippi State, 30-27, 30-23, 30-22, to improve to 16-10, 7-9 SEC on the season. Erika Clark led the Bulldogs with 12 kills and 24 digs. Maria Taly finished with 13 kills while Lindsay Gehan hit .588 for 12 kills in the win. As a team, UGA hit .330 with seven aces and eight team blocks.

LAST TIME OUT FOR ARKANSAS

The Lady Backs have lost six straight matches coming into their meeting with Auburn. In their last time out, Arkansas was swept by No. 10-ranked Florida, 30-28, 30-23, 30-25. Heather Royal had a double-double with 10 kills and 10 digs while Jessica Dorrell led the team with 13 kills. Libero Ashley Miller led the team with 16 digs while Sarah Freudenrich posted five blocks. As a team, Arkansas could only hit .178 against the Gators.

LAST TIME VS. GEORGIA

Georgia's defense had 11 team blocks and held Auburn to .135 hitting as the Bulldogs swept the Tigers (30-23, 30-27, 30-24) in Athens. UGA hit .318 and was led by Maria Taylor with

16 kills. Whitney Jacob and Jelena Sekulic led Auburn with 13 and 11 kills, respectively. Sekulic also led the team with nine digs in the match. For the Bulldogs, Erika Clark and Taylor led the squad with nine digs each while Lindsay Gehan finished with nine blocks.

LAST TIME VS. ARKANSAS

Playing in Fayetteville, the Tigers and Lady Razorbacks traded wins in the first four games before Auburn came out with a dominating 15-8 win in the fifth game for the 3-2 win. The win was only the third all-time against Arkansas. Jelena Sekulic, Jessica Glover and Rachel Shanks all hit in double figures to lead Auburn to the win with Sekulic leading the way with a match-high 25 kills. Shanks led the team with 16 digs while Sara Shanks and Whitney Jacob came up with five blocks each. Arkansas had a balanced attack with five players finishing in double figures, led by Catherine Fowler with 18. Yun Tang led the team with a match-high 11 blocks.

1,000 / 1,000 FOR SHANKS

At the 14-5 mark in Auburn's win over Kennesaw State, senior Rachel Shanks picked up her second kill of the match and the 1,000th of her career. She becomes only the 10th player in Auburn's history to pull off the feat and still has the rest of the season to build on it. Currently, she is fifth all-time at Auburn in career kills with 1,249.

With Auburn leading 10-6 in the first game at Arkansas, Shanks hit another milestone as she picked up her 1,000th career dig, becoming the seventh player in Auburn's history to reach the mark. Currently, she is third all-time at Auburn with 1,125 digs.

By reaching the mark in both categories, she becomes just the fourth Tiger ever to tally 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs in their career.

JACOB REACHES 1,000

Throughout most of her career, middle blocker Whitney Jacob has been relied upon as a consistent, efficient hitter and currently ranks in the top 10 all-time at Auburn in career attack percentage. But, she joined an elite group of Auburn players on Oct. 28 as she posted her 1,000th career kill.

She entered the match at Tennessee with 992 and earned No. 1,000 at the 4-0 mark in the second game. She now has 1,043 career kills and ranks 10th all-time at Auburn.

She is only the 11th player in Auburn's history to reach the mark, following teammate Rachel Shanks who reached it earlier this season. It represents the second time in Auburn's history that two Tigers reached 1,000 kills in the same season. The other time came in 1991 when Bridgitte Sims and Jenifer Kleyn reached the milestone.

WELCOME ALYSSA DAVIS TO THE LINEUP

Since becoming a regular in Auburn's starting lineup in the Oct. 19 match against Florida, freshman Alyssa Davis has made her presence known. Her numbers have improved with each outing and in the past six matches she has averaged 1.71 kills and 1.00 blocks per game. In those six matches, she has 36 kills and 21 blocks.

CAN YOU DIG IT?

With 62 digs against DePaul at the Denver Invitational, the Tigers set a school record for digs in a three-game match, breaking the previous record of 60 (vs. McNeese State on Aug. 29, 2003).

SEC Volleyball Notes

- The 2006 season marked the 17th consecutive season in which the SEC has placed at least two teams in the NCAA Tournament.
 - A record-breaking seven SEC teams earned berths in the NCAA Tournament, breaking the previous record of six teams.
- Ten of the 11 teams in the SEC posted wins in double-digits in 2006, with LSU posting 26 and Florida 20 respectively.
 - LSU claimed the Western Division crown in 2006, with Florida earning the Eastern Division championship.
 - Florida captured its 16th SEC Championship and advanced to the NCAA regional semifinals.
 - Three players were selected as the Sports Imports/AVCA National Player of the Week.
 - Two players were selected to the ESPN The Magazine Academic All-American Team.
- Two players were named AVCA All-American and eight players were named to the AVCA Division I All -South Region Team.
- In the past 16 years, 908 student-athletes have earned selection to the SEC Academic Honor Roll.

Four Tigers finished in double-digit digs in the match against DePaul, led by Liz Crouch with 18.

AN ACE IN THE HOLE

Auburn shattered the record for service aces in a four-game match earlier this season with 16 against Tennessee State in the War Eagle Invitational. The mark breaks the record of 11 aces that had been done three times in the team's history (Sept. 11, 1993 vs. UNC-Asheville / Sept. 7, 2002 vs. Marist / Sept. 6, 2003 vs. Bethune-Cookman). Rachel Shanks led the Auburn effort in the match against TSU with five aces.

KILL IT, JEL!

Senior Jelena Sekulic, not always known for her offense, has definitely made an impact this season. The Serbia native has twice made the Auburn record book for her offensive work, first with her .600 attack percentage at Georgia State on Aug. 28. The mark ties her for 17th all-time at Auburn in single-match hitting percentage. A little more than a month later, Sekulic did it again at Arkansas on Oct. 7. Her 25 kills in the match tie her for 28th all-time at Auburn in single-match kills.

OPENING WITH A WIN

Auburn took down a couple losing streaks in the SEC opener against South Carolina. With the 3-2 win, the victory marked the first win over USC since the 1995 season at the first win in Columbia since 1994. The win is also Auburn's first victory in a SEC-opener since 1999.

IRON WOMAN

Coming into this week's matches, Auburn senior Whitney Jacob has started in 109 consecutive matches - every match played since she enrolled at Auburn - and 412 straight games. The Coppell, Texas native started in all 27 matches as a freshman, 24 as a sophomore and 31 as a junior. She has now started in all 27 matches this season. If she finishes out in the remaining games this season, she will become just the 16th player in NCAA history to play in every game of their career.

BREAKING THE STREAK

After opening the SEC schedule with a win, the Auburn volleyball team hit a rough patch, losing six straight matches - the team's longest losing streak of the season. The Tigers rebounded against Arkansas with a 3-2 win to end the win drought.

TAKING DOWN THE VOLS

Auburn broke another losing streak when it beat Tennessee, 3-1, on Oct. 28. Not only did it break a five-match losing streak for the season, but it was the first time the Tigers beat the Lady Vols since 1998. It was also the first win in Knoxville since 1996.

SHANKS AND JACOB MAKE UTSA CLASSIC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Leading Auburn to second place at the UTSA Classic, seniors Rachel Shanks and Whitney Jacob earned spots on the all-tournament team.

Shanks finished the tournament with 34 kills, five aces, five blocks and 31 digs. Jacob led the team in hitting with a .218 attack percentage. She also had 25 kills, six aces and five blocks.

JACOB NAMED TO ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Following her performance at the University of Denver Invitational volleyball tournament, Auburn's Whitney Jacob was selected to the all-tournament team.

The Coppell, Texas native was the most efficient Tiger, hitting .362 in the three matches with 27 kills in 58 attempts with only six errors. The senior also had four service aces, six digs and 11 total blocks over the weekend.

AUBURN WINS WAR EAGLE INVITATIONAL

The Auburn volleyball team improved to 11-11 all-time record in season-openers on Aug. 24 as the Tigers opened up the War Eagle Invitational with a 3-1 win over Troy, eventually holding on to win the tournament with a 3-0 record. Auburn is now 4-2 in season-opening matches under head coach Laura Farina and 5-1 when they open the season at home. Following the win over Troy, the Tigers downed Nicholls State in a sweep and came from behind to beat Tennessee State, 3-1, in the nightcap to take the tournament title.

THREE NAMED TO ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

For their performance the opening-weekend's War Eagle Invitational, three Auburn players earned their way on to the All-Tournament team. Rachel Shanks led the way, being named Most Outstanding Player and making the team for the fourth year in a row - a distinction that only she holds. Shanks averaged five kills per game over the course of the two-day tournament. Also on the team were fellow seniors Whitney Jacob and Jelena Sekulic. Jacob led the team, hitting .357 with nine aces while Sekulic finished with 38 kills, hitting .273, including a career-high of 21 kills against TSU.

SISTER-TO-SISTER

Fans attending the Nicholls State match got to see something you do not see very often as redshirt-freshman setter Sara Shanks found her older sister, Rachel, in back-to-back points, picking up the assists for her older sibling. With Auburn leading 19-12 in game three, Sara came in for Nicki Gerig and set four of the next five Tiger points, including two to her older sister.

YOUTH AND EXPERIENCE

The starting lineup in Auburn's season-opener against Troy illustrated the mix of youth and experience that head coach Laura Farina is working with right now. Of the seven Tiger starters (six players + libero), three were freshmen, three seniors and one junior. Auburn won the season-opening match, 3-1.

SCOUTING GEORGIA

Georgia has gone 3-6 since its last meeting with Auburn, picking up wins over South Carolina (3-2), Alabama (3-0) and Mississippi State (3-0). The Bulldogs are currently third in the SEC East with a 7-9 league record. One of its wins last weekend was a 3-0 sweep over SCE West leader Alabama.

Leading the Bulldogs is Maria Taylor with her 4.74 kills per game average, standing out as the dominant offensive force on the team. Next to her on the list is Erika Clark with 2.82 kills per game. The primary setter is Mara Martin with 11.35 assists per game. She has already hit the 1,000-assist mark for the season as she has 1,044. Defensively, it is Renee Johnson and Clark leading the way as both average more than three digs per game. Johnson leads the team with 3.72 per game. Lindsay Gehan and

Maria Taylor both average more than a block per game with Gehan leading the team with 1.42 blocks per game. As a team, UGA hits .220 while allowing its opponents to hit .184.

SCOUTING ARKANSAS

Arkansas has been a team of peaks and valleys since losing to Auburn, 3-2, in Fayetteville earlier this season. Immediately following the loss, the Lady Razorbacks picked up wins over Florida and South Carolina - giving the Gators their only loss of the season. Following the wins, though, the Lady Backs hit a rough streak and come into Friday's match having lost their last six matches. Of the six losses, three are sweeps, including a 3-0 loss at Florida on Sunday.

Leading Arkansas is Jessica Dorrell with her 4.22 kills per game while the team's most efficient hitter is Christina Lawrence with a .295 attack percentage. Lindsay Scanlan and Nicole Martin have shared the setting duties for the Lady Backs this season. Martin leads the team with 6.23 assists per game, followed closely by Scanlan with 5.98 per game. Defensively, libero Ashley Miller leads the team with 4.67 digs per game while Sarah Freudenrich leads the Lady Backs with 1.47 blocks per game. Catherine Fowler and Yun Tang also average more than a block per game. As a team, Arkansas hits .201 while allowing its opponents to hit .224.

COACH FARINA ON GEORGIA

COMING BACK STRONG

Even with all the new faces around the Auburn volleyball team this season, the Tigers bring back a strong core from last year's team. With six returning players, including four that were

starters, Auburn brings back 76% (1,338 of 1,726) of its kills, 77% (1,512 of 1,957) of its digs and 53% (253 of 473) of its blocks from the 2006 season.

AUBURN NETWORK TO BROADCAST 12 VOLLEYBALL MATCHES IN 2007

For the fourth-straight year, the Auburn Network will broadcast play-by-play coverage of Auburn Volleyball, carrying 12 matches in 2007. Of the 12 matches, 11 are at home with the lone road broadcast being the Nov. 4 match at Alabama. Ben Taylor returns for his third season behind the microphone, calling the play-by-play.

AUBURN VOLLEYBALL PICKED FIFTH IN PRESEASON POLL

The Auburn University volleyball team was voted to finish fifth in the SEC Western Division for the second consecutive year by the league's head coaches, conference officials announced Tuesday, Aug. 14.

In 2006, the Tigers finished with a 13-18 record, going 5-15 in SEC play to finish sixth in the SEC West. AU returns seven players from last season's squad, four of which were starters, and brings nine newcomers to the team for the 2007 season.

In-state rival Alabama tops the SEC West with 14 points and is followed closely by LSU at second with 17 points. Arkansas comes in at third (28), followed by Ole Miss (36) and Auburn (47). Mississippi State rounds out the division in sixth with 53 points. In the SEC East, Florida comes out on top with 10 points while also earning the distinction of being the favorite to win the SEC overall crown with 10 of 11 possible first-place votes.

WADE BENSON JOINS AUBURN STAFF

Wade Benson, the head volleyball coach at Eastern Washington University the past seven seasons, has been named an assistant coach at Auburn, announced head coach Laura Farina Friday. Benson replaces Liz Underwood, who accepted a head coaching position at Lee-Scott Academy in Auburn in June.

Under Benson's direction, EWU won three Big Sky Conference regular-season titles (2002, 2003, 2004) and a Big Sky Tournament title in 2001. The 2001 title gave the Eagles a berth in the NCAA Tournament and a victory over Oregon State, equaling the highest advancement in league history. Benson tallied a 154-55 record during his tenure at EWU for a .737 winning percentage. Prior to coming to Eastern, Benson was the head coach at Western Oregon where he put together a 42-7 record and finished third in the NAIA Championship.

Head Coach Laura Farina

Beginning her sixth season leading the Auburn volleyball program is Laura Farina. Named the Tigers' eighth head coach on March 29, 2002, the 38-year-old Farina is in the process of returning the program back to the prominence it once enjoyed during late 1990's.

Farina's rebuilding process took a major step toward solidifying the foundation during the 2004 campaign as the Tigers collected six conference wins, the most for the Tigers since the 1999 season.

Auburn's trip to the SEC post-season was also its first since 1999 as the Tigers battled eventual SEC Tournament Champion Tennessee through a tough four-game match.

Throughout the course of the season, Farina's recruits began to show why they were so highly sought after with the culmination coming in late November when then-freshman Whitney Jacob was named to the SEC's All-Freshman team.

In 2006, Farina led the Tigers to 13 wins, the most for her as Auburn's head coach and the most for the team since the 2000 season. Highlighting the season was a sweep over Alabama on Sept. 22 in front of 1,211 fans at Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum, giving her Farina her first career win over the Tide.

Also during the 2006 season, Farina produced Auburn's first CoSIDA/ESPN The Magazine Academic All-American in nearly 15 years as Rachel Shanks picked up third-team honors for her work both in the classroom and on the court. Shanks was also named SEC Volleyball Scholar-Athlete of the Year, making her the first AU volleyball player to earn the honor.

In her second year as head coach, she guided the Tigers to an incredible nine-win turnaround, posting 10 wins following consecutive one-win seasons for the program. With the change in record was a renewed enthusiasm for Auburn volleyball.

Farina came to the Plains after a three-year stay at Marquette University in Milwaukee, Wisc., where she took over a Golden Eagle team that had won just 11 matches in the year prior to her first year on the job. During her stint in Milwaukee, her teams collected two 18-plus win seasons as well as two sixth-place finishes in Conference USA. Farina's first year at the helm in 1999 saw MU go 18-13 for a .581 winning percentage, the best by a Marquette team since 1985. The Golden Eagles' 9-7 C-USA record also represented MU's highest number of conference wins since joining the league in 1995.

The Strasburg, Ill., native has coached a SEC All-Freshman selection, seven All-Conference USA players, one all-region selection and 15 of her players have earned all-academic honors during her tenure.

Prior to her arrival at Marquette, Farina spent six seasons (1993-98) at Michigan State where she served as the first assistant coach.

During her time with the Spartans, Farina helped build a program that won Big Ten Championships in 1995 and 1996, made five consecutive NCAA Tournament Championships (1994-98) and was a NCAA national semifinalist in 1995. She developed and implemented the team's national recruiting strategy that enabled the Spartans to land six Fabulous 50 recruits during that span.

Farina went to Michigan State after a year as a teacher and coach of the Mile High Volleyball Club in Denver, Colo.

During the summer of 1998, she toured Europe with the American Management Group (AMG), which exposed college players to international volleyball.

Farina, the former Laura Bush, led Illinois to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances as a player including back-to-back trips to the national semifinal in 1987 and 1988.

A two-time Academic All-American, Farina was also named to the AVCA/Russell All-America Second Team in 1989. She was named the Illinois Female Athlete of the Year in 1990 and still ranks among the top 10 in several Illini all-time categories, including career aces and digs.

A 1992 graduate of the University of Illinois, Farina earned her bachelor's degree in English.

While pursuing her master's degree in student affairs administration from Michigan State, which she received in 1998, she was a 1995 NCAA Post-Graduate Scholarship recipient. Farina was also selected as a role model for the NCAA Student-Athlete Leadership Conference in May of 1997.
