## Team Notes

### Alabama

The Alabama women's basketball team (8-4) will play its final game before breaking for the holidays on Monday, Dec. 19, when it hosts Presbyterian (6-4) for the annual Fifth Grade Fast-break contest. Last time out, sophomore Jasmine Robinson scored a game-high 19 points to lead Alabama past Alabama State, 64-54. The Tide finished the game with 39 attempts from the free throw line, where Alabama scored 27 of its points. The Tide out-rebounded the Lady Hornets 45-33 and had nine steals compared to Alabama State's three. Alabama currently has three players averaging double-digit points, led by Robinson, who averages 13.8 points per game. She is followed by senior Ericka Russell (11.0 ppg) and junior Meghan Perkins (10.3 ppg). Junior Erin Hogue leads the team in rebounds with 7.8 boards per game, while sophomore Khristin Lee has dished out a team-high 2.7 assists per game. The Tide has four players with 17 or more steals on the season, led by Perkins (20) and sophomore Shafontaye Myers (20). They are followed by Robinson and Russell (17).

### Arkansas

The Arkansas Razorbacks were off from competition this week while taking finals. The Razorbacks return to competition hosting Morgan State Monday and Texas Southern Wednesday before the holiday break. Arkansas wraps up December and the non-conference scheduled hosting Mississippi Valley State Dec. 28, in double-header action with the Razorback men's team (the men host Charlotte). Senior C'eira Ricketts continues to move up in several career statistical categories at Arkansas. One to keep an eye on right now is career steals. Ricketts has 33 steals in nine games this year. That number brings her career total to 260 in a little over three seasons. The record is 293 held by Tracy Webb during her career from 1983-87. Ricketts needs 33 to tie and 34 steals to take over the top spot. Arkansas has won eight in a row after dropping the season opener to Minnesota. The Razorbacks won a school record 15 in a row to start the season in Tom Collen's first season.

### Auburn

The Auburn women's basketball team (6-3) went 1-1 last week, topping Big East member South Florida 62-45 before dropping a 62-54 decision to No. 22 Purdue. Sophomore Camille Glymph led the Tigers on the week. She earned her first career start against South Florida and scored a career-high 23 points in the victory. She scored four points against the Boilermakers to average a team-high 13.5 points on the week. Junior Blanche Alverson averaged 11.0 points per game, scoring seven against USF before tallying 15 points against Purdue. Alverson's 15 points against the Boilermakers came on five 3-pointers, a mark that tied her career high. The five treys also gave her 107 on her career, moving her into sixth all-time at Auburn in career 3-pointers. Freshman Hasina Muhammad came off the bench to lead the Tigers against Purdue, scoring 17 points with three blocks and two steals. Senior Parrisha Simmons tied her career high with nine points while pulling down a career-high 16 rebounds. The 16 boards were the most for an Auburn player in nearly two years. The Tigers will return to action this week at the New York Life Holiday Invitational hosted by Hofstra. Auburn will take on Marist on Wednesday before facing either Hofstra or Central Connecticut State on Thursday.

### Florida

The Gators return to the court following an 11-day layoff for final exams and play host to the 21st annual Gator Holiday Classic, Dec. 20 and 21. Florida plays Charleston Southern in the opening round, following the initial game between

Duquesne and Maine. The last time the Gators played in front of their faithful fans inside the O'Connell Center was 21 days ago, when the team thumped Belmont, 72-45, on Nov. 29. Since that win, Florida has lost to then-No. 11 Rutgers, won its first true road game of the year - at San Francisco - and dropped a hard-fought 78-73 decision at Pacific on Dec. 9. Florida's annual home tournament has traditionally featured some of the nation's finest teams and players. At least one team from the four-team field has earned an NCAA Tournament berth in 14 of the 20 years, including the 1994 field that featured all four future NCAA selections. A total of 31 alumnae competing in UF's Gator Classic have gone on to play professional basketball in the WNBA. Azania Stewart's next block will be 160th of career, tying for sixth all-time at UF. Jordan Jones has a 3-pointer in 9 of 10 games this year and in six straight games.

### Georgia

Georgia upped its record to 8-1 on the year with an 80-43 victory over Mercer on Tuesday night. The Lady Bulldogs scored 80 or more points for the fourth time this season and improved to 429-7 when reaching 80 points during Andy Landers' 33 seasons in Athens. Jasmine Hassell paced Georgia with 16 points against the Bears, while Khaalidah Miller added 15, 11 in the first half. Seven different Lady Bulldogs have reached double figures a combined 29 times during the first nine games of the season. Mercer is coached by former Lady Bulldog Susie Gardner, who played for UGA from 1982-186. During Gardner's career, the Lady Bulldogs compiled a 116-17 record, won the 1983, 1984 and 1986 SEC Championships, advanced to the 1983 and 1985 Final Fours and finished as 1985 NCAA runner-up. Georgia will enjoy a 13-day break from competition during Final Exams on the UGA campus. The Lady Bulldogs will next play in the Holiday Hoops Classic in Las Vegas, Nev. on Dec. 19 and 20. Georgia will face Gonzaga, an "Elite Eight" team in 2011, on Dec. 19 before taking on Montana State on Dec. 19. It will be the Lady Bulldogs' first-ever meetings with both schools. Jasmine James is now 97 points shy of becoming UGA's 32nd 1000-point scorer. Meredith Mitchell, the lone senior on the Lady Bulldogs' roster, will graduate at the completion of the Fall Semester. She is the 59th of 59 four-year letterwinner during Andy Lander' tenure to earn their diploma from the University of Georgia.

### Kentucky

No. 8/7 Kentucky dropped its first game of the season at No. 3 Notre Dame on Sunday, 92-83, snapping the Wildcats' 10-game winning streak. UK led by one point with five minutes to play before the Fighting Irish went on an 11-0 run to put the Cats' upset hopes out of reach. Sophomore center Samantha Drake led four Wildcats in double figures with a career-high 21 points on 8-of-11 shooting. Despite fouling out with 7:25 left in the game, junior A'dia Mathies scored 17 points to go along with three rebounds, three assists and two steals. Freshman guard Bria Goss and senior point guard Amber Smith followed with 14 and 13 points, respectively. In her UK debut, sophomore transfer Samarie Walker recorded seven points and seven rebounds in just 12 minutes of play. The Wildcats return to the friendly confines of Memorial Coliseum on Wednesday vs. Samford in their final game before Christmas break. UK's current 11-game home winning streak ties for the sixth-longest in school history.

### LSU

The LSU Lady Tigers have won four straight games by an average margin of 28 points. LSU (7-3) defeated UCLA and McNeese State (NCAA Tournament teams a year ago) and beat

Lamar on Sunday. The Lady Tigers have held four straight opponents to less than 45 points. Overall, LSU is surrendering only 46.4 points per game and holding opponents to a league-best 30.3 percent shooting. The Lady Tigers dished out a season-best 27 assists in the win over Lamar, representing the most assists in a game for LSU since Nov. 15, 2009. LaSondra Barrett continues to lead LSU in scoring (11.7 ppg) and rebounding (5.4 rpg). Adrienne Webb is second at 9.1 points per contest and freshman Krystal Forthan has raised her average to 8.2 points per game. LSU hosts Grambling at 12 p.m. Thursday before breaking for the Christmas holiday.

### Ole Miss

Ole Miss improved to 7-3 overall this season after a win at Lipscomb. Nikki Byrd recorded her 12th career double-double against Lipscomb with 14 points and 13 rebounds for her seventh double-double in the last eight games. Danielle McCray recorded a career-best nine points in a win at Lipscomb. Valencia McFarland recorded two 20-point games this weekend and tied her career high with 24 points against Central Michigan. Ole Miss has come back from double-digit deficits to win three times this year. Nikki Byrd has scored in double figures in 11 consecutive games dating back to last season and she has scored in double figures in all 10 games this season. Ole Miss will open a five-game homestand Monday hosting the annual Magnolia Classic. The Rebels will host Murray State Monday and Cleveland State on Wednesday.

### Mississippi State

Mississippi State improved to 8-2 overall as it defeated Southern Mississippi 71-57 on Friday in the team's lone action of the week. The Lady Bulldogs improved to 7-0 at home, the best start at Humphrey Coliseum since the 2009-10 team won nine-straight on the home floor to begin the year. The Lady Bulldogs were paced by a season-high 25 points from Porsha Porter. Porter eclipsed the 20-point mark for the second-straight game as she bettered her previous season best of 23 set against Louisiana Tech last Sunday. Porter was fantastic from the floor, hitting 8-of-10 shots, including 3-of-4 three pointers and 6-of-8 free throws. Porter has been averaged 20.7 ppg in her last three outings, shooting 48.8-percent from the field and 45.5-percent from three-point range in those contests. Mississippi State has now made a three-point basket in 173-straight games. Senior Diamber Johnson, the SEC's leading scorer, tallied 11 points against USM, but she dished out seven assists to put her eight out of 10th place in MSU career records. Johnson has tallied 12 assists in her last two games after posting 14 in the four games prior. Another senior, Ashley Brown, grabbed 10 rebounds Friday night, her third-straight game with double-figure rebounds. Brown is averaging 8.0 points and 9.6 rebounds since joining the starting lineup on Nov. 26. The Lady Bulldogs wrap the home non-conference slate Monday, hosting Louisiana-Lafayette prior to breaking to celebrate Christmas.

### South Carolina

South Carolina improved to 9-2 with a pair of wins last week, and the Gamecock defense has been the difference, allowing just 34 points per game over the last three outings. The Gamecocks closed last week with a commanding 79-48 win over No. 18/16 North Carolina on Sunday. It was the third-largest margin of victory over a ranked team in school history and the highest in a game in which the Gamecocks were not also ranked. The nation's second-ranked defense stopped the nation's top offense in the outing, and the Gamecocks provided their highest offensive output of the season. In fact, it was the most points for South Carolina since netting 79 against Kentucky on Jan. 14,

2010. Seniors La'Keisha Sutton and Markeshia Grant posted 21 and 20 points, respectively – the first game with multiple 20-point scorers since February 2010. Junior Leasia Walker rounded out the solid game for the starting backcourt with six assists. Sutton opened the week on a high note as well, scoring her 1,000th career point in a win over South Carolina State, becoming the 27th Gamecock to reach the milestone. South Carolina set a school record by allowing just 21 points in the game and holding the Lady Bulldogs to just 12.5 percent field goal shooting.

### Tennessee

UT's six ranked opponents within its first 10 games of the 2011-12 campaign marks the most since playing five teams in the AP poll in the first eight games of the 2007-08 season. Lady Vol senior Shekinna Stricklen has the nation's longest starting streak at 113 consecutive games. Senior Glory Johnson needs 60 rebounds to reach the 1,000 career boards plateau, making her the fourth in school history to tally 1,000 points and 1,000 rebounds. The Lady Vols games on the west coast – at UCLA and at Stanford – were both announced as advance sell-outs. Ariel Massengale, UT's rookie starting point guard has missed the last three games due to a dislocated finger on her left hand. She is now listed as day-to-day since suffering the injury in practice on Dec. 8. Against UCLA, Tennessee hit a school record 76 percent (19-of-25) of its shots in the first half eclipsing the previous record of 70.3 percent against Old Dominion (1/4/89). On the afternoon against UCLA, Tennessee shot 69.2 percent – the fourth-highest mark in program history. UT's season high shooting percentage going into the game was 49.2 percent against Pepperdine (11/13/11). In nine games, the Lady Vols have led at halftime seven times this season and were tied at the break in the other two contests. Tennessee is now 6-1 when it takes a lead into the locker room. Tennessee lost the rebounding battle for only the second time in 2011-12. Both UCLA and Virginia outrebounded UT. Last year, Tennessee was outboarded a total of three times on the season. Sophomore Meighan Simmons found her shot against UCLA and led the Lady Vols in scoring by tying her season high by dropping 18 points on an 8-of-14 shooting performance. Simmons came into the game connecting on just 26 percent of her field goal attempts on the year.

### Vanderbilt

Vanderbilt was defeated for the first time this season in its only contest of the week, falling at NC State, 66-59. The Commodores trailed by as many as 14 points in the second half, but rallied within three points with 44 seconds remaining before NC State was able to hold on. The second half rally was keyed by redshirt sophomore center Stephanie Holzer, who finished the game with 15 points and eight rebounds. Vanderbilt also got 13 points from Christina Foggie and 11 from Jasmine Lister. Kady Schrann added eight points and Elan Brown and Clair Watkins scored six apiece. The Commodores struggled to adjust to a line-up without reserve point guard Maggie Morrison, who suffered a knee injury in practice leading-up to the game and they continue to be without junior guard Gabby Smith, who is recovering from a concussion. Now 10-1, Vanderbilt returns to action on Thursday, December 22, when it plays host to Florida State.

**SEC Begins 30th Season Of Conference Play**

This will be the 30th season of conference play for the SEC. Women's basketball first came under the auspices of the SEC in the 1982-83 season. **Preseason Polls & Accolades**

- Five SEC teams were ranked in the national preseason polls. Tennessee was ranked third in both Associated Press and USA Today/ESPN Coaches polls. Georgia was ranked 13th in AP and 12th in the coaches, while Kentucky received enough votes to be 18th in AP and 15th in coaches. LSU was 21st in AP and 22nd in coaches, while Vanderbilt received votes in both polls.
- The media predicted Tennessee to win the regular season title. Tennessee topped the order of finish with 264 points, with Georgia (228), Kentucky (212), LSU (189), Vanderbilt (172) and Florida (151) rounding out the top half of the league. Arkansas (142), South Carolina (107), Auburn (94), Alabama (55), Mississippi State (54) and Ole Miss (48) round out the bottom half.
- Tennessee's Shekinna Stricklen was the overwhelming choice of the media for SEC Women's Basketball Player of the Year. Joining Stricklen on the All-SEC First Team are Georgia's Jasmine James, Kentucky's A'dia Mathies, LSU's LaSondra Barrett and Tennessee's Glory Johnson. Second Team includes Arkansas' C'eria Ricketts, Ole Miss' Valencia McFarland, Tennessee's Meighan Simmons, and Vanderbilt's Stephanie Holzer.
- Tennessee was predicted to win the Southeastern Conference women's basketball regular season championship by the coaches.
