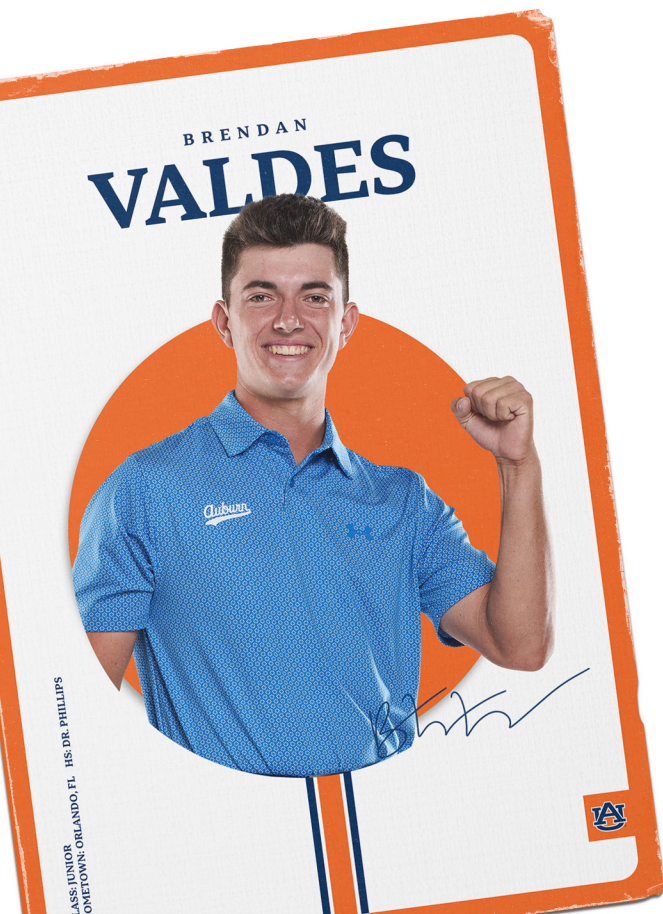

At one of amateur golf's most prestigious events, an Auburn Tiger came out on top. **Brendan Valdes** shot his way to victory at North Shore Country Club by way of a 269 (-15) scorecard. Valdes won the stroke play portion of the Western to solidify the first amateur win of his career.

THE CROWE SHOW

2019 Auburn golf alum, **Trace Crowe**, became the latest #AuburnMade golfer to capture a professional win at the NV5 Invitational. Crowe shot 259 (-25) and outlasted Patrick Fisburn on the second hole of a playoff to etch his name in history.

CHERRY HILLS HEROES

A total of five Tigers punched their tickets to the 2023 U.S. Amateur at Cherry Hills Country Club in Colorado. Four of the five men, made it to the round of 32 in match play, giving Auburn the most representatives of any school in the country. **Carson Bacha** saw the Sweet 16 and **Jackson Koivun** clinched the Elite Eight while **J.M. Butler** made it all the way to the semifinals before bowing out of the tournament.

INTRODUCTION

LAST SEASON IN REVIEW

MAUI JIM INTERCOLLEGIATE

The Tigers brought the heat to Arizona with a program-record 45-under victory at the Maui Jim Intercollegiate. Auburn bested a field that included 10 total ranked programs.

Ryan Eshleman caught national attention after joining The 60 Club with an outstanding 10-under performance in his opening round. **Evan Vo** carried the torch for the Auburn lineup with a top-three finish at 197 (-13). Following Eshleman's eighth place outing, **Carson Bacha** became the third Tiger to card a top-15 placement at 9-under 201.



HOTTEST FALL ON RECORD

History! The Tigers solidified the best start in the 75-year history of the program with a third fall win at the illustrious Isleworth Collegiate. Auburn dominated the 15-team field, earning top honors by 12 strokes.

Brendan Valdes shot 206 (-10) to capture the first individual crown of his collegiate career. Also propelling the Tigers to victory were **J.M. Butler**, who finished third at 208 (-8), and **Alex Vogel song**, who finished tied for fifth at 210 (-6). Valdes later became the third consecutive Tiger to be named SEC Golfer of the Week.

AUBURN MEN'S GOLF

POSTSEASON

After a less than ideal showing at the SEC Championship, the Tigers responded by toppling a field that included No. 1 Vanderbilt and No. 12 Tennessee at the NCAA Auburn Regional to not only punch their ticket to Nationals but also lock up a fifth team victory of the season, tying the program record from the 1996-97 season. At the NCAA Championship, Auburn shot 1,138 (+18) to finish in 10th for a second straight year.



HONOR ROLL

It was award season on The Plains as the Tigers were recognized frequently for a record-smashing season. Auburn golfers earned a whopping eight SEC Player of the Week bids, including three from rookie **Reed Lotter**. Lotter, **J.M. Butler** and **Brendan Valdes** were also voted All-SEC. **Carson Bacha**, **Evan Vo**, and **Alex Vogelsong** went on to earn spots on the Academic All-America team and Butler and Valdes became the program's 34th and 35th GCAA All-Americans.

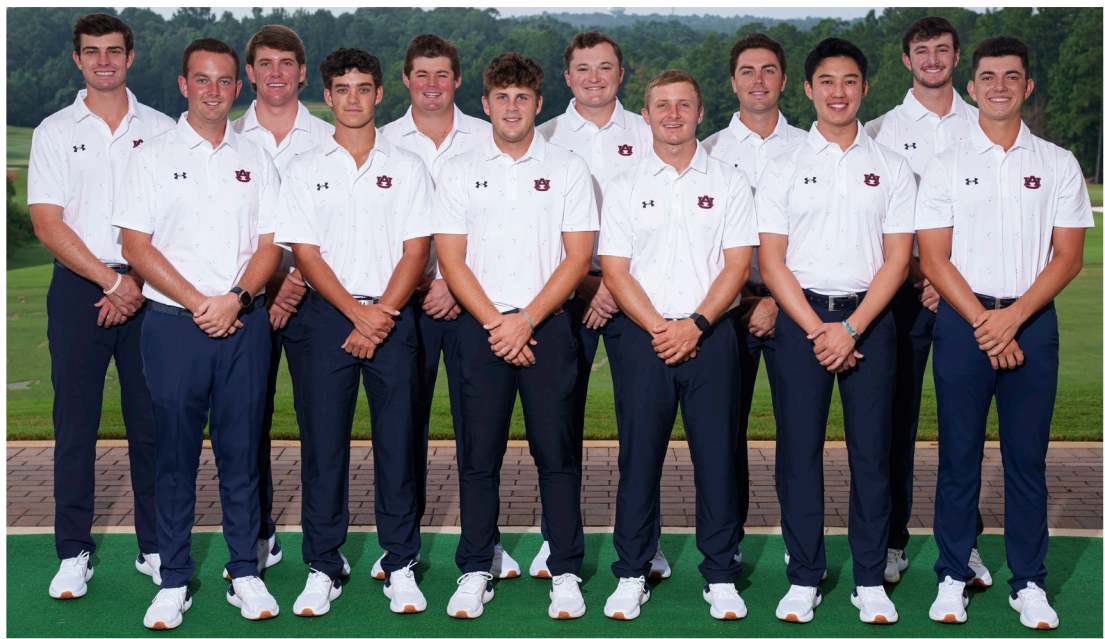

CLINARD'S RESUME

Nick Clinard is in his 23rd year overall as a head coach and 15th season with the Auburn men's golf team in 2023-24.

Under Clinard's tenure, the Tigers have garnered 15 All-American selections, 38 All-Region team members and 40 All-SEC honorees.

Academically, Clinard has produced 24 All-American scholars and 85 SEC Academic Honor Roll members.

In 2018, after leading the Tigers to their first SEC Championship in 16 years, Clinard was voted SEC Coach of the Year as well as Southeast Region Coach of the Year. Clinard would also named a finalist for National Coach of the Year that season.

During his 14 seasons on The Plains, Auburn has amassed over 1,500 victories while never winning less than 63% of its head-to-head matchups in any given year.

While team success is evident, Auburn individuals have also thrived under Clinard's leadership, as each individual record in the book, with the exception of one, is held by a player whom was coached by him.

Last year, Clinard guided Brendan Valdes to an All-American sophomore campaign in which he posted the best single-season scoring average in school history at 70.03 strokes per round.

Most recently, Clinard's crew matched the most wins by an Auburn golf squad in program history with five championships over the course of the 2022-23 cycle. Five wins had not been accomplished by a Tiger team since 1996-97.

WILLIAMS' RESUME

Chris Williams is in his fifth year overall as an assistant coach and third season with the Auburn men's golf team in 2023-24.

Williams arrives on The Plains from Marquette University where he was an assistant coach during the 2019-20 and 2020-21 seasons.

While with the Golden Eagles, Williams was instrumental in the development of Hunter Eichhorn, who was named the BIG EAST Player of the Year, PING All-American and became Marquette's career scoring average leader.

As a professional golfer, Williams competed in both the Mackenzie Tour in Canada and PGA Tour Latinoamérica after turning pro in 2013. He competed in a pair of U.S. Opens, one in 2011 after winning a sectional qualifying event, and in 2013 as the top amateur.

Williams was a four-time All-American at the University of Washington from 2009-13. While with the Huskies, he won six tournaments, earned 28 top-10 finishes and led the team in scoring his final three years.

The Moscow, Idaho native represented the United States at the 2011 Walker Cup and went on to win the Ben Hogan Award as the NCAA's top golfer in 2013. He was also awarded the Mark H. McCormack Medal by The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews as the leading player in the World Amateur Golf Ranking in 2012.

Williams spent 46 weeks ranked as the top amateur in the world after earning the distinction prior to his senior year at Washington.

ALEXANDER'S RESUME

Buddy Alexander is in his 36th year as a coach and second year on the Auburn staff entering the 2023-24 season.

Alexander joins the Auburn staff with over 30 years of coaching experience at the Division I level, most notably as the head coach at the University of Florida from 1988 to 2014.

While at Florida, Alexander guided the program to eight SEC Championships and a pair of national titles in 1993 and 2001. He is a seven-time SEC Coach of the Year and three-time NCAA Coach of the Year.

Additionally, Alexander led Louisiana State University to a pair of SEC titles in 1986 and 1987 as the head coach of the program from 1982 to 1987.

Golfers under Alexander's tutelage have produced 50-plus first team all-conference selections and 40-plus victories on the PGA tour.

A native of St. Petersburg, Florida, Alexander is a 1975 and 1980 graduate of Georgia Southern University where he was a two-time All-American as a student-athlete.

He is married to Joan Alexander, who currently serves at the Tigers' director of operations for both the men's and women's programs, and is the father of Tyson Alexander, a current member of the PGA Tour, and Cortnee Gilchrist, the Director of the Spirit Squad at the University of Florida.

2020-21 (FRESHMAN)

Did not see tournament action, redshirted.

2021-22 (SOPHOMORE)

Averaged 72.96 strokes per round through 25 rounds of play... carded four top-20 finishes and one top-10 finish at the Nexus Collegiate... logged 11 rounds at par or better, six rounds below par and two rounds in the 60s... made birdie 89 times, averaging 3.56 per round... made eagle twice, good for second on the team... joined teammate Brendan Valdes as one of only six players of 154 total to eagle at the NCAA Championship, and the only duo from the same school to do so... counted 15 of 19 (.789) team rounds played... averaged a 3.96 shots per round win differential... made collegiate debut at the SEC Match Play Championship, earning victories over opponents from both Ole Miss and Mississippi State... closed out the fall with a stint at the Isleworth Collegiate, shooting 73-74-75-222 (+6) to finish just outside the top 30... earned first career top-10 finish at the Nexus Collegiate... finished below par at the Tiger Invitational with a 74-70-71-215 (-1) to aid Auburn's "B" team to a third-place finish, earning a spot on the All-Tournament Team... posted career lows for 18 (68/-4), 36 (138/-6) and 54 holes (214/-2) in a top-25 finish at the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate... shot 73-69-73-215 (-1) at the NCAA Norman Regional to finish tied for 17th and help the Tigers to their first NCAA Championship appearance since 2019... led the Auburn lineup through three of four rounds at NAAs as its top finisher at 76-70-71-70-287 (+7), earning a top-20 placement in his career debut at the tournament.



2022-23 (JUNIOR)

Averaged 70.54 strokes per round through a career-high 37 rounds of competition, a 2.42 average stroke improvement from the previous year... average also stands as the fourth-best in a single season in Auburn history... carded 24 total rounds at or below par, including nine in the 60s... finished in the top 20 six times and in the top 10 three times... fired four eagles and 129 birdies... did not miss a team event... counted 34 of 37 team rounds played... heavily contributed to all three of the team's fall wins, finishing in the top 15 at the Maui Jim Intercollegiate, Marquette Invitational and Isleworth Collegiate... first top 10 of the season came at Marquette behind a 70-74-70--214(+4) scorecard... won first collegiate event, the Tiger Invitational, shooting 71-68-66--205(-11) to also earn SEC Golfer of the Week Honors... shot 206 (-10) for a tied for sixth outing at the Mossy Oak Collegiate... placed T13th at the NCAA Auburn Regional to aid the Tigers in tying the school record with five wins during the season... wins record had not been matched in nearly 30 years... named PING All-Southeast Region.

JACK KEY GOLF TEACHING FACILITY

The Jack Key Golf Teaching Facility, named after Jack Key, a 1950 Auburn graduate and four-year letterman from Columbus, Georgia, features three indoor hitting bays, lounge and locker rooms, club repair and video analysis. Utilizing 29 acres, the practice facility features a range of nearly 400 yards with tees at both ends allowing players to train in a variety of wind conditions.

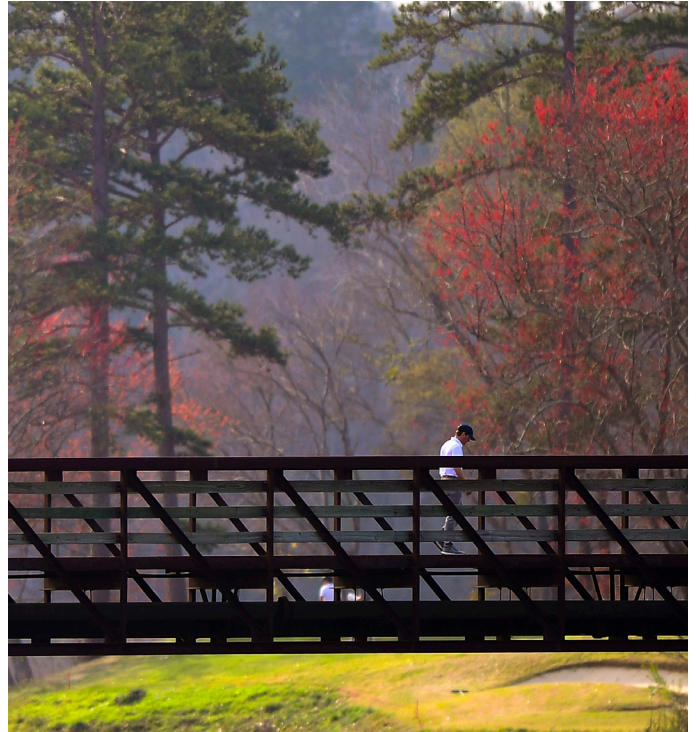




GRAND NATIONAL

The 54-hole Grand National complex, part of the world-renown Robert Trent Jones Golf Trail, has two 18-hole par-72 courses and one 18-hole par-3 course. The Lake Course played host to the 2004 NCAA Women's Golf Championship and the 2000 NCAA Men's Golf Championship.

It was also the site of the 1999 SEC Women's Golf Championship, 1998 LPGA Tournament of Champions, 1997 Nike Tour Championship, 1996 NCAA Women's Golf East Regional, 1994 NCAA Men's East Regional and the PGA Tour's Barbasol Championship from 2015-2017.

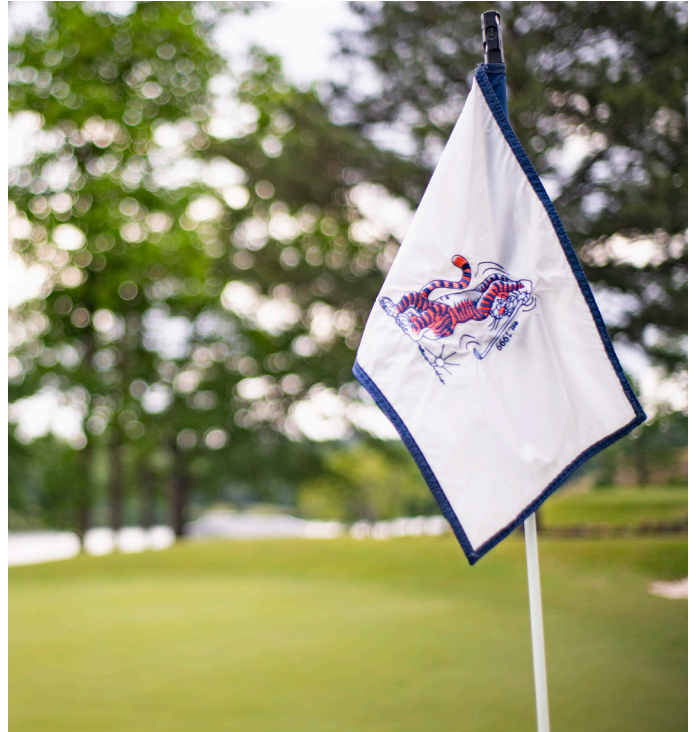


The Links Course ranks as one of the most impressive tracks in the country. It played host to the 1997 SEC Men's Golf Championship. The 18-hole, par-3 course is a truly beautiful layout that allows Tiger golfers excellent practice on their iron and short game play. The driving ranges at The Trail courses are also a spectacle to see.

The Auburn University Club features an 18-hole championship golf course, state-of-the-art practice facilities and a full service clubhouse as well as office spaces for the Auburn University golf coaches and locker rooms for both the men's and women's golf teams.
