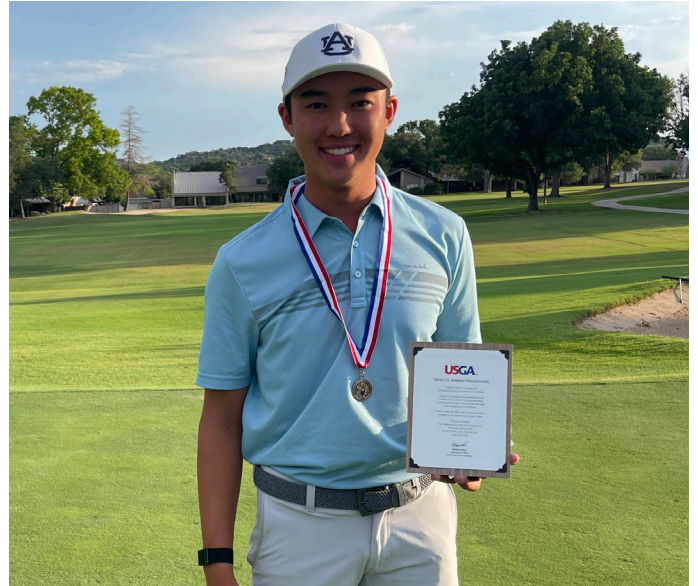

# THE STARS OF SUMMER

## THRICE AS NICE

A trio of current Tigers punched their tickets to the 122nd annual U.S. Amateur. **Carson Bacha**, **J.M. Butler** and **Evan Vo** each competed at the esteemed event which was jointly hosted by The Ridgewood Country Club and Arcola Country Club in Paramus, New Jersey. Butler qualified via exemption as a top-50 points leader in the World Amateur Golf Rankings while Bacha and Vo each paved their way via respective qualifiers.

## BACHA FLOCKA FLAME

The year's amateur circuit headliner, **Carson Bacha**, captured not one, not two, but three victories over the offseason. First, the rising junior wowed at the 55th annual Dogwood Invitational, shooting 266 (-12) through four rounds of competition to win the event by five shots. After the Dogwood, Bacha became the 63rd champion of the Porter Cup with a 274 (-6) through another four frames of action. Finally, over winter break, he carded a 206 (-8) over three rounds at the Orlando International Amateur to secure his third title in just six months.

## VOGEY NO BOGEY

**Alex Vogel song** delivered in his hometown to capture the 105th Florida State Amateur Championship, the first amateur title of his career. Vogel song shot 280 (-8) over four rounds at the Bears Club in Jupiter, Florida to tie for first before edging out Kentucky men's golf alum Reid Bedell on the first hole of the playoff. The rising senior became the second Auburn man to leave the event victorious, joining Blayne Barber, who won the title in 2009.

## FALL SEASON IN REVIEW

### MAUI JIM INTERCOLLEGIATE

The Tigers brought the heat to Arizona with a program-record 45-under victory at the Maui Jim Intercollegiate. Auburn bested a field that included 10 total ranked programs. **Ryan Eshleman** caught national attention after joining The 60 Club with an outstanding 10-under performance in his opening round. **Evan Vo** carried the torch for the Auburn lineup with a top-three finish at 197 (-13). Following Eshleman's eighth place outing, **Carson Bacha** became the third Tiger to card a top-15 placement at 9-under 201.



### SEC FALL PREVIEW

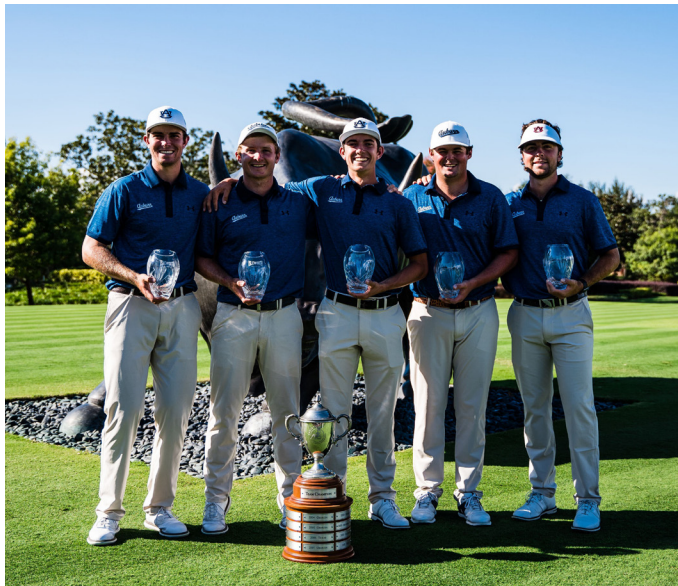
The top-ranked Tigers put their talent to the test against the best in the country at the SEC Fall Preview. Led by the duo of **Evan Vo** and **Brendan Valdes** at -9, Auburn claimed third in the stroke play portion before dropping a tight battle to No. 6 Texas A&M, 3-2, in match play. Both Vo and **J.M. Butler** won their respective matches with Butler defeating the Aggies' Maichon 3&2 and Vo handily topping the reigning U.S. Amateur Champion, Sam Bennett, 7&6. Vo would go on to earn SEC Golfer of the Week honors for his hot start to the season.

## MARQUETTE INTERCOLLEGIATE

Auburn returned to the winner's circle once more with a victory in its first ever appearance at the Marquette Intercollegiate. All six players in the Orange & Blue carded top-30 finishes with three finding their way into the top-10. **Carson Bacha** collected his second top-15 outing of the fall at T10 while both **Ryan Eshleman** and **J.M. Butler** shoved their way into the event's top-5, finishing fourth and tied for second, respectively. Butler would be rewarded for his performance, capturing SEC Golfer of the Week as the second consecutive Tiger to do so.

## ISLEWORTH COLLEGIATE

History! The Tigers solidified the best start in the 75-year history of the program with a third fall win at the illustrious Isleworth Collegiate. Auburn dominated the 15-team field, earning top honors by 12 strokes.

**Brendan Valdes** shot 206 (-10) to capture the first individual crown of his collegiate career. Also propelling the Tigers to victory were **J.M. Butler**, who finished third at 208 (-8), and **Alex Vogelsong**, who finished tied for fifth at 210 (-6). Valdes later became the third consecutive Tiger to be named SEC Golfer of the Week.

### CLINARD'S RESUME

Nick Clinard is in his 22nd year overall as a head coach and 14th season with the Auburn men's golf team in 2022-23.

Under Clinard's tenure, the Tigers have garnered 13 All-American selections, 34 All-Region team members and 37 All-SEC honorees.

Academically, Clinard has produced 21 All-American scholars and 78 SEC Academic Honor Roll members.

In 2018, after leading the Tigers to their first SEC Championship in 16 years, Clinard was voted SEC Coach of the Year as well as Southeast Region Coach of the Year. Clinard would also named a finalist for National Coach of the Year that season.

During his 14 seasons on The Plains, Auburn has amassed over 1,500 victories while never winning less than 63% of its head-to-head matchups in any given year.

While team success is evident, Auburn individuals have also thrived under Clinard's leadership, as each individual record in the book, with the exception of one, is held by a player whom was coached by him.

Last year, Clinard guided J.M. Butler to an All-American sophomore campaign in which he posted the second-best single-season scoring average in school history at 70.56 strokes per round.

Most recently, Clinard's crew solidified the best start to any season in program history by winning three of its four fall events, including a school-record, 45-under victory at the Maui Jim Intercollegiate.

## WILLIAMS' RESUME

Chris Williams is in his fourth year overall as an assistant coach and second season with the Auburn men's golf team in 2022-23.

Williams arrives on The Plains from Marquette University where he was an assistant coach during the 2019-20 and 2020-21 seasons.

While with the Golden Eagles, Williams was instrumental in the development of Hunter Eichhorn, who was named the BIG EAST Player of the Year, PING All-American and became Marquette's career scoring average leader.

As a professional golfer, Williams competed in both the Mackenzie Tour in Canada and PGA Tour Latinoamérica after turning pro in 2013. He competed in a pair of U.S. Opens, one in 2011 after winning a sectional qualifying event, and in 2013 as the top amateur.

Williams was a four-time All-American at the University of Washington from 2009-13. While with the Huskies, he won six tournaments, earned 28 top-10 finishes and led the team in scoring his final three years.

The Moscow, Idaho native represented the United States at the 2011 Walker Cup and went on to win the Ben Hogan Award as the NCAA's top golfer in 2013. He was also awarded the Mark H. McCormack Medal by The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews as the leading player in the World Amateur Golf Ranking in 2012.

Williams spent 46 weeks ranked as the top amateur in the world after earning the distinction prior to his senior year at Washington.

### ALEXANDER'S RESUME

Buddy Alexander is in his 35th year as a coach and first year on the Auburn staff entering the 2022-23 season.

Alexander joins the Auburn staff with over 30 years of coaching experience at the Division I level, most notably as the head coach at the University of Florida from 1988 to 2014.

While at Florida, Alexander guided the program to eight SEC Championships and a pair of national titles in 1993 and 2001. He is a seven-time SEC Coach of the Year and three-time NCAA Coach of the Year.

Additionally, Alexander led Louisiana State University to a pair of SEC titles in 1986 and 1987 as the head coach of the program from 1982 to 1987.

Golfers under Alexander's tutelage have produced 50-plus first team all-conference selections and 40-plus victories on the PGA tour.

A native of St. Petersburg, Florida, Alexander is a 1975 and 1980 graduate of Georgia Southern University where he was a two-time All-American as a student-athlete.

He is married to Joan Alexander, who currently serves at the Tigers' director of operations for both the men's and women's programs, and is the father of Tyson Alexander, a current member of the PGA Tour, and Cortnee Gilchrist, the Director of the Spirit Squad at the University of Florida.

Averaged 72.96 strokes per round through 25 rounds of play... carded four top-20 finishes and one top-10 finish at the Nexus Collegiate... logged 11 rounds at par or better, six rounds below par and two rounds in the 60s... made birdie 89 times, averaging 3.56 per round... made eagle twice, good for second on the team... joined teammate Brendan Valdes as one of only six players of 154 total to eagle at the NCAA Championship, and the only duo from the same school to do so... counted 15 of 19 (.789) team rounds played... averaged a 3.96 shots per round win differential... made collegiate debut at the SEC Match Play Championship, earning victories over opponents from both Ole Miss and Mississippi State... closed out the fall with a stint at the Isleworth Collegiate, shooting 73-74-75-222 (+6) to finish just outside the top 30... earned first career top-10 finish at the Nexus Collegiate... finished below par at the Tiger Invitational with a 74-70-71-215 (-1) to aid Auburn's "B" team to a third-place finish, earning a spot on the All-Tournament Team... posted career lows for 18 (68/-4), 36 (138/-6) and 54 holes (214/-2) in a top-25 finish at the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate... shot 73-69-73-215 (-1) at the NCAA Norman Regional to finish tied for 17th and help the Tigers to their first NCAA Championship appearance since 2019... led the Auburn lineup through three of four rounds at NCAAs as its top finisher at 76-70-71-70-287 (+7), earning a top-20 placement in his career debut at the tournament.

Averaged 72.33 strokes per round, good for fifth on the team and fourth in the regular lineup... named to the SEC All-Freshman Team... voted SEC Freshman of the Week three times... logged four top-20 finishes... had 14 rounds at or below par, including 11 under par... logged six rounds in the 60s... counted 24 of 30 team rounds played (.800)... was the sole player to start in all eight regular season tournaments... set a career low 18 (66) at the Vanderbilt Legends Collegiate in the third round, finishing tied for 18th with a six under par mark (69-72-66)... fired a 209 (72-69-68) to finish one below par at the Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate, placing tied for 19th... finished tied for 24th at four under par (69-70-67) at the Gator Invitational, logging a personal low 36 (139) and low 54 (206)... shot four under par at the Tiger Invitational (73-69-70) to finish tied for 13th... logged a near top-ten finish at Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate, placing 12th at two under par (72-71-71).

### 2021-22 (SOPHOMORE)

Pieced together one of the most prolific seasons in program history, logging top-15 finishes in nine of 11 tournaments and averaging 70.56 shots per round, the second-best mark in Auburn single-season history... scoring average also ranked 12th amongst all SEC competitors... voted Second Team All-SEC, PING All-Region, Second Team PING All-American and Golfweek Second Team All-American... was also named to the watch list for the Palmer Cup, Ben Hogan Award and Fred Haskins Award... led the team in nearly all statistical categories: rounds played (34), scoring average (70.56), rounds at par or better (23), rounds below par (19), rounds in the 60s (14), birdies made (140), top-20 finishes (9), top-10 finishes (7), top-5 finishes (5) and win differential per round (2.15)... rounds below par total also ranks tied for the third-best in a single season in Auburn history... counted 30 of 34 (.882) team rounds played... captured first individual title in fall-opener at the Maui Jim Intercollegiate, also smashing the school record for lowest 54-hole score at 66-64-63-193 (-17)... also jumped into the top-10 for 18-hole score and 36-hole score at Maui Jim... earned another top-five outing to close out the fall at the Isleworth Collegiate, shooting 70-69-73-212 (-4)... led the Auburn charge at the Nexus Collegiate, finishing tied for second to help the team secure its first win of the season... placed fourth at the General Hackler Championship, shooting 68-70-60-206 (-10) to aid the team in its second victory of the year... was the Tigers' top golfer at the SEC Championship, finishing tied for 11th at 75-64-69-208 (-2)... pushed the team to its first berth at the NCAA Championship in three seasons with a third place showing at the NCAA Norman Regional, carding a 66-69-72-207 (-9)... owns the second-best career scoring average in school history following sophomore campaign at 71.39 shots per round.

# JACK KEY GOLF TEACHING FACILITY

The Jack Key Golf Teaching Facility, named after Jack Key, a 1950 Auburn graduate and four-year letterman from Columbus, Georgia, features three indoor hitting bays, lounge and locker rooms, club repair and video analysis. Utilizing 29 acres, the practice facility features a range of nearly 400 yards with tees at both ends allowing players to train in a variety of wind conditions.

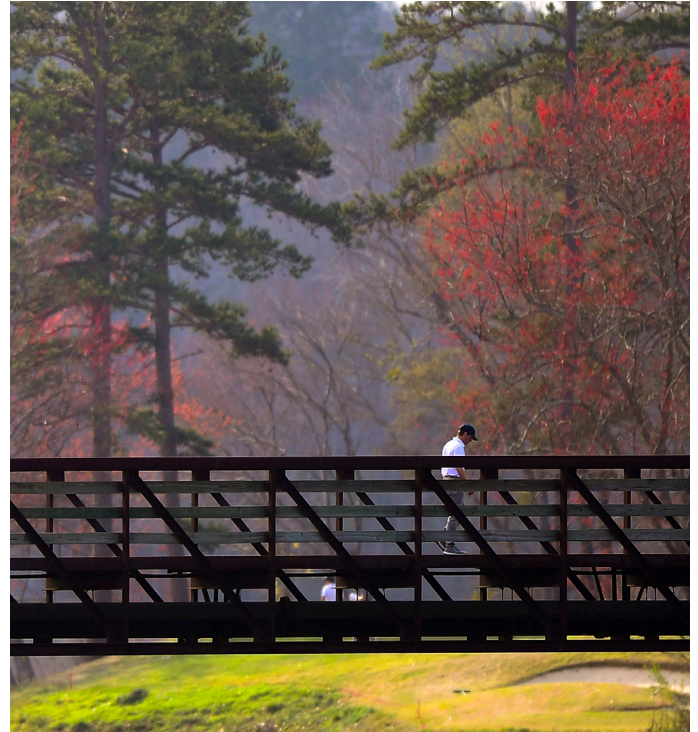




# GRAND NATIONAL

The 54-hole Grand National complex, part of the world-renown Robert Trent Jones Golf Trail, has two 18-hole par-72 courses and one 18-hole par-3 course. The Lake Course played host to the 2004 NCAA Women's Golf Championship and the 2000 NCAA Men's Golf Championship.

It was also the site of the 1999 SEC Women's Golf Championship, 1998 LPGA Tournament of Champions, 1997 Nike Tour Championship, 1996 NCAA Women's Golf East Regional, 1994 NCAA Men's East Regional and the PGA Tour's Barbasol Championship from 2015-2017.



FACILITIES & COURSES



The Links Course ranks as one of the most impressive tracks in the country. It played host to the 1997 SEC Men's Golf Championship. The 18-hole, par-3 course is a truly beautiful layout that allows Tiger golfers excellent practice on their iron and short game play. The driving ranges at The Trail courses are also a spectacle to see.

# AU CLUB AT YARBROUGH FARMS

The Auburn University Club features an 18-hole championship golf course, state-of-the-art practice facilities and a full service clubhouse as well as office spaces for the Auburn University golf coaches and locker rooms for both the men's and women's golf teams.



At 7,591 yards from the back tees, the golf course carves through magnificent trees, across wetlands, along creeks and streams and around the lake. Natural and man-enhanced water features play a prominent role at The Auburn University Club as they blend throughout the property and are visible on 14 of 18 holes.
