#### » QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn is 7-0 in midweek games and is outscoring the opponent 60-19.
- The Tigers have turned in a 2.66 ERA and haven't allowed more than four runs in a midweek game.
- Last Tuesday's win at UAB marked the team's fifth win this season when trailing entering the sixth inning or later.
- Ike Irish (47) and Cooper McMurray (46) rank second and third in the league in RBI.
- Their combined 93 RBI are the most in the league and second most in the country.
- The duo has driven in 192 runs in 89 games since the beginning of last season.
- Auburn has hit multiple home runs in 21 of 31 games this season, including eight of the last nine.
- The team's 57 home runs are good for fifth in the league and 16th in the country.
- The offense is hitting .306 and has scored 71 runs in the last nine games.
- Christian Herberholz has made three straight midweek starts and has turned in a 4.46 ERA in 12 career starts in an Auburn uniform.
- The Tigers bullpen has turned in a 1.65 ERA with 47 strikeouts and 10 walks in 32.2 innings in midweek games this season.
- Auburn is 13-1 all-time against Alabama State (all games have been played at Plainsman Park).

**Butch Thompson enters his ninth season at the helm of the program in 2023, posting a record of 256-187-1 in his first eight seasons. He has led the program to the College World Series in two of the last four seasons.**

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his ninth season with the Tigers in 2024.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in seven seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 256-187-1 overall record and has advanced to the NCAA Tournament five of the last six seasons, including three Super Regional appearances in the last five years and two trips to the College World Series in the last four seasons.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 33 Division I All-Americans and 46 all-conference performers. He has seen 21 of his former pitchers called up to Major League Baseball, including 15 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 39 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 16 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the program record No. 4 class in 2017 and No. 5 class in 2022. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally.

In 31 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 22 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached nine College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019 and taking the team back for the second time in three seasons in 2022. Thompson became one of five active SEC coaches who have taken their program to a pair of College World Series in a three-year span. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 19 postseason appearances.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

During his tenure with the Tigers, Thompson led the team to three straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2017-19 for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals in 2018 and 2019 for the first time in program history, and has now hosted back-to-back regionals for the first time in program history.

Auburn's second straight regional host bid in 2023 came thanks to a second-half run for the record books, and the Tigers became one of five programs in the country and two in the SEC to host each of the last two seasons.

Auburn posted a league-best 12-3 record in the final five weeks of conference play and finished the SEC season with 17 wins, the most since winning the SEC West in 2010. The Tigers finished top five in the league in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2002-03. The 12-3 stretch was the program's best since also going 12-3 in the final 15 games of the 2010 season and the nine-game SEC winning streak at the end of the regular season and first game of the SEC Tournament was the team's longest since 1995.

Auburn has finished six of Thompson's eight seasons in the top 25, including three in the top 10. The No. 5 national ranking to finish 2022 was tied for the second highest mark in program history.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series



finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 22 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the American Baseball Coaches Association.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. He is a member of both the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame (Class of 2014) and MACCC Hall of Fame (Class of 2021).

Thompson earned a Bachelor's Degree in History at BSC in 1992 and completed a Master's Degree in Sports Administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters -- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail --and the grandparents of Mary Gail Moreman.

## THE FUTURE OF PLAINMAN PARK

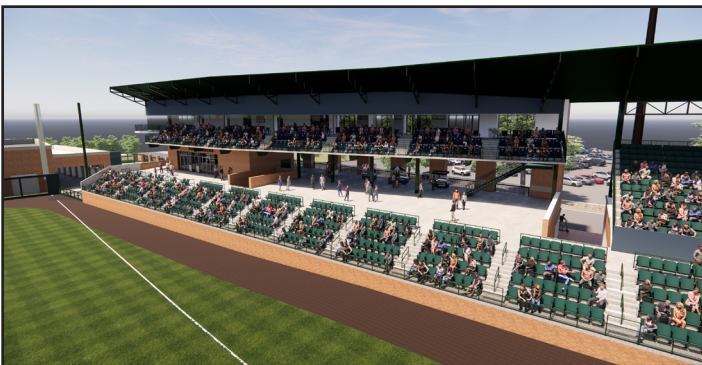
Auburn Athletics finalized plans for the previously approved \$30 million Plainsman Park renovation project last summer.

The renovations are highlighted by the additions of three new premium experiences – the Hall of Fame Club, First Base Club, and Home Plate Club – as well as a unique general admission space atop the War Eagle Wall in left field.



### HALL OF FAME CLUB

A tribute to Auburn, Southeastern Conference and Major League Baseball great Frank Thomas, the Hall of Fame Club will add approximately 100 premium seats at field level and is open for the 2024 season. Divided between two tiered rows, these high-end leather seats will offer a dynamic field-level view behind home plate. Club members will have access to a 3,000-square foot climate-controlled club space featuring food, drinks, televisions, restrooms, and indoor seating.



### FIRST BASE CLUB

A new three-story structure that will complement Plainsman Park's classic ballpark architecture, the expanded Plainsman Patio and First Base Club will provide a variety of new fan experience offerings, including indoor and outdoor viewing areas, new concession offerings, expanded restrooms, and more. The space will be completed for the 2025 season.

At inner-concourse level, the new covered Plainsman Patio space will provide expanded standing room space, while offering access to an all-new walk-in concession market.

The third level will feature an all-new upscale ballpark experience with the First Base Club. This area is expected to include approximately 200 new seats ranging in type from cushioned chairback seats to outdoor loge seating options, and will offer elevated food and beverage options, a climate-controlled indoor space, as well as private restrooms.



### HOME PLATE CLUB

By relocating the existing press box to a new location on the third level of the First Base Club structure, a new high-end club experience will be developed atop the home plate grandstands. With one of the best views in the ballpark, this area is expected to include approximately 50 high-end seats and a climate-controlled environment with access to food, drinks, restrooms, and more premium amenities. This space will be completed prior to the 2025 season.



### WAR EAGLE WALL

The experience Auburn fans love within the Tiger Terrace along the third base line will soon be expanded to provide access to a unique experience atop the War Eagle Wall in left field. A general admission space that will be completed for the 2025 season, this project will add a two-tiered terrace atop the wall to provide a one-of-a-kind experience in college baseball.

### ENHANCED STUDENT EXPERIENCE

As Auburn University students continue to pack Plainsman Park, the first phase of renovations prior to the 2024 season will provide an enhancement to the current standing room area beyond the right-center field fence. This portion of the project will provide a multi-tiered, elevated platform to bring students closer to the action while providing expanded standing room capacity.

### EXPANDED AND RENOVATED TEAM SPACES

The third phase of the project will include upgrades to the student athlete experience through renovated and expanded team spaces. These upgrades include a renovation and expansion of the Tim Hudson Locker Room, a new bullpen and pitching lab, new weight room and nutrition area, new team meeting room, and new coaches' offices. This phase of the project is scheduled to be completed throughout 2025-26.

- Alabama State enters the week with a 13-16 overall record and 5-6 record in league play.
- The Hornets swept Mississippi Valley State two weeks ago but got swept by Florida A&M last weekend.
- Alabama State is hitting .304 as a team with seven everyday players hitting .300 or higher, led by Randy Flores' .333 clip.
- On the mound, the Hornets have turned in a 6.15 ERA with 140 walks and 236 strikeouts in 244.1 innings.

**WEEKEND RECAP**

- Auburn won it's first series opener in SEC play, defeating Tennessee 9-5 Friday, but dropped the next two games in run-rule fashion.
- Back-to-back single-game attendance records at Plainsman Park were set, and the 15,183 fans over the three days was also a single-series attendance record.

**CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR**

- Auburn's run differential in eight SEC games from Mar. 17-Apr. 5 was -6, but the Tigers went 2-6 during the span.
- All eight games were decided by four runs or less, including three one-run games and two two-run games.

**BOMBS & BAGS**

- Auburn enters the week one of five teams in the country, including two Power Five programs, that has homered at least 50 times and stolen at least 50 bases this season.

**BATMAN & ROBIN**

- Ike Irish and Cooper McMurray are hitting a combined .450 (31-for-69) with 23 runs, five doubles, nine homers and 36 RBI in the last nine games.
- The duo has driven in a combined 93 runs this season, good for the second most in the country, and have 192 RBI in 89 games since the beginning of last season.

**GOLDEN BOY**

- Irish was on of 45 player named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List last week.
- He is Auburn's third straight representative on the midseason list, joining Sonny DiChiara (2022) and Bryson Ware (2023) and is the eighth player under head coach Butch Thompson to make the list.
- Irish is one of five catchers to make the list, including the only catcher from the SEC.

**IKE, IKE BABY**

- Irish went on a career-best 16-game hitting streak from Mar. 9-Apr. 5 and is hitting .422 (27-for-64) with 20 runs, seven doubles, six homers and 29 RBI during the streak.
- He has a hit in 27 of 31 games and has driven in at least one run in 25 of 31 games this season.
- The sophomore catcher ranks top 10 in the league in runs (38), hits (45), total bases (89) and RBI (47).
- In his first 89 career games, Irish has multiple hits on 40 occasions, including 12 this season.

**100-HIT CLUB**

- Irish collected his 100th career hit in his 68th career game played on Mar. 2 vs. UConn.
- He became the fourth fastest player in program history to reach the milestone.

  - Tim Hudson (1996-97): 66 games
  - Ike Irish (2023-pres): 68 games

**COOP KEEPS CRUSHING**

- In 26 games since hitting a grand slam and driving in a career-high six runs vs. Wichita State on Feb. 24, Cooper McMurray is hitting .411 (37-for-90) with 9 2B, 11 HR and 44 RBI.
- In 74 career games in an Auburn uniform, he has hit 26 homers and has driven in 95 runs.
- McMurray is the first player since Edouard Julien in 2018-19 to hit double digit home runs in back-to-back seasons.
- His 14 homers in 2023 were the third most by an Auburn newcomer in the BBCOR era - DiChiara (22 in 2022), Julien (17 in 2018).
- McMurray's .695 career slugging percentage currently ranks third in program history behind Frank Thomas (.722) and Bo Jackson (.715).

**FLARE FOR THE DRAMATIC**

- After the come-from-behind win at UAB, Auburn has now won five games this season in which it has trailed entering the sixth inning
  - Feb. 23 vs. Iowa
  - Mar. 8 vs. Austin Peay
  - Mar. 19 vs. South Alabama
  - Mar. 23 vs. Arkansas
  - Apr. 3 at UAB
- The go-ahead runs in four of those five games have come on home runs.
  - Bobby Peirce vs. Iowa (7th)
  - Mason Maners vs. Austin Peay (9th)
  - Cooper McMurray vs. Arkansas (6th)

**DIGGING THE LONG BALL**

- Auburn has homered multiple times in 21 of 31 games this season, including eight of the last nine contests.
- The team homered in 16 straight games to start the season, the longest season-opening-homer streak in program history, and has a long ball in 24 of 28 games.
- The team's 57 homers through 31 games are the most in the first 31 games of a season since 2009 (67), and the team ranks 16th in the country in the category.
- Two of the program's top six home run totals have come in the last three seasons - 86 (2021) and 84 (2023) - and Auburn is one of three SEC programs to have a player hit 20 or more home runs in each of the last two seasons - DiChiara (22 in 2022), Ware (24 in 2023).

**RUNNING AT A RECORD-SETTING RATE**

- Cooper Weiss leads the SEC and is third in the country with 24 stolen bases.
- He is the first Auburn player with 20 or more stolen bases in a season since Jay Gonzalez (30) and Creede Simpson (25) in 2012.
- Weiss has set Auburn's single-game record with four stolen bases twice this season - Feb. 18 vs. ECU and Feb. 27 vs. Samford - and has stolen multiple bases in eight games.
- Auburn has stolen 56 bases through 31 games, marking the most stolen bases through 31 games since 2012 (60) and surpassing the total from the last three seasons.

**MASON'S MAKING THE MOST OF IT**

- Senior outfielder Mason Maners is third on the team to McMurray and Irish with a .330 average in his first 30 games at Auburn.
- Maners went on a seven-game hitting streak from Mar. 22-Apr. 5 and homered in three straight games from Mar. 23-28, driving in seven during the span.
- Since going 3-for-4 in the series opener vs. UConn, Maners is hitting .360 (27-for-75) in the last 23 games.

**PUSHING ALL THE RIGHT BUTTONS**

- Since the series finale vs. Arkansas on Mar. 23, Auburn pinch-hitters are 7-for-10 with three doubles, two homers and four RBI.
  - Mar. 23 vs. Arkansas: Belyeu - 2B

- Cade Belyeu has a hit, including a homer and two doubles, in his last four pinch-hit opportunities. He is 4-for-5 with a walk and two HBPs as a pinch-hitter this season.

**CARLSON IS COMING ON STRONG**

- Parker Carlson earned back-to-back wins in as many appearances against South Alabama and Arkansas on Mar. 19 and 23, matching his win total from his first 25 career appearances.
- The junior is tied for second on the team with 10 relief appearances and hasn't allowed more than a run in any outing.
- Eight of his 10 appearances this season are scoreless.

**MR. McBRIDE IS MAKING MOVES**

- After making four straight midweek starts to begin the season, Conner McBride has entered the weekend rotation the last two weeks vs. Arkansas and Texas A&M.
- McBride leads the team with three wins this season and is second in ERA while ranking third in innings pitched.

**THE STRONG ARM OF ARMSTRONG**

- John Armstrong turned in a career-best outing in the series opener vs. Tennessee, striking out six batters in 4.0 scoreless innings en route to earning his first SEC save.
- Armstrong has turned in a 1.69 ERA in 11 appearances with 28 strikeouts and nine walks in 21.1 innings.
- He leads the team with a 1.86 ERA in SEC play.

**GONZO IS GOOD TO GO**

- After pitching in just one game last season, Joseph Gonzalez returned to the starting rotation the first three weeks of the season and earned a win in his first two starts.
- Gonzalez was out of the rotation vs. Austin Peay to work on mechanical issues in his delivery but returned for the first four weekends of SEC play.

**CANNON THE CLOSER**

- Junior right-hander Will Cannon returned to the closer role after ranking tied for fifth in the SEC in the category a season ago.
- Cannon has finished the game in 23 of his 29 relief appearances in an Auburn uniform.
- He was tabbed to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award Preseason Watch List, he earned his first save with 2.0 scoreless innings in the series finale vs. Arkansas.

**BAUMAN A KEY TO THE BULLPEN**

- After ranking second on the team in innings last season (53.0) and tied for third in appearances (22), Bauman leads the team with 13 appearance this season.
- His 35 appearances since the beginning of last season are the most by an Auburn pitcher.
- Nine of his 12 appearances this year have been scoreless outings.

**TILLY TAKES THE HILL**

- Freshman right hander Cam Tilly earned a win in three straight appearances against No. 18 Iowa, UConn and Austin Peay.
- Tilly turned in a season-high 4.0 innings against the Huskies and retired 10 of the final 11 batters he faced in the outing.
- Prior to arriving at Auburn, Tilly won gold with the USA Baseball U18 National Team at the 2022 WBSC baseball World Cup.

**WATTS IS A WINNER**

- Sophomore Dylan Watts turned in a season-high 2.2 scoreless innings in the series opener at Texas A&M, retiring eight of the nine batters he faced in the outing.
- Watts has turned in 18 strikeouts to one walk in his first nine appearances and 14.1 IP.
- Watts made his first career start in the series opener vs. Tennessee after making eight straight relief appearances to begin the season.

**TOP-RANKED TRANSFERS**

- Auburn was tabbed by D1Baseball.com to have the No. 14 transfer class in the country.
- The team's five transfers in the top 130 are tied for the sixth most in the nation.
  - Deric Fabian (Florida): No. 29
  - Mason Maners (Jax State): No. 77
  - Javon Hernandez (Jax State): No. 86
  - Cooper Weiss (Miami [OH]): No. 116
  - Carson Myers (UAB): No. 129
- Fabian, Maners, Hernandez and Weiss have made a combined 104 starts while Myers leads the team with a 4.13 ERA and is second in innings pitched (28.1).

**STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE**

- According to D1Baseball.com's preseason schedule analysis, Auburn was scheduled to play a league-high 33 quad one games in 2024 - home games vs. RPI 1-25, neutral site games vs. 1-40, road games vs. 1-60.
- All of Auburn's first five SEC foes have been ranked in the top 10, becoming the first SEC program since Georgia in 2016 to take on five straight top 10 opponents.

**THOMPSON'S TENURE**

- Auburn has hosted back-to-back regionals for the first time in program history and has made a NCAA regional in five of the last six postseasons under Butch Thompson.
- Prior to Thompson's arrival in 2016, Auburn made five tournament appearances in 14 seasons from 2002-15.
- The Tigers have also finished top five in the league in back-to-back years for the first time since 2002-03.
- The team has finished .500 or better in SEC play in four of the last six years under Thompson, and one of the seasons with a sub-.500 SEC record ended in Omaha (2019).
- Prior to Thompson's arrival, the program had turned in just one such season (2010) in 12 years between 2004-15.

**SECOND HALF SURGE**

- Auburn went a league best 12-3 in the second half of SEC play last year, marking the program's best 15-game stretch in conference play since also going 12-3 in 2010.
- The Tigers won five straight SEC series for the first time since 2010 and were one of two teams (Vanderbilt) to win five straight SEC series at any point during the year.

**.330+ HIT CLUB**

- The Tigers' quartet of Irish (.361), Bryson Ware (.350), Peirce (.343) and Cole Foster (.336) became the program's first quartet of qualified hitters to hit .330 or higher in a season since 2010 and the SEC's first quartet to accomplish the feat since Kentucky did so in 2017.

**CONGRATS GRADS**

- Three Auburn players in Christian Hall, Bobby Peirce and Cooper Weiss have earned their bachelor's degree and will wear the SEC graduate patch throughout the season.

**ASSISTANTS OF THE YEAR**

- Auburn has three coaches on its current staff who have been named the ABCA National Assistant Coach of the Year in their careers.
  - Butch Thompson (2014)
  - Scott Foxhall (2021)
  - Karl Nonemaker (2022)

**MLB EXPERIENCE ON STAFF**

- The Tigers coaching staff includes three members with big league experience totaling a combined 19 years of experience.

**PACK OUT PLAINSMAN PARK**

- Auburn set three attendance records from Mar. 23-Apr. 6 with the recent A-Day crowd of 5,566 now holding the top spot.
- The three-day attendance of 15,158 also marked a single-series record, surpassing the previous mark by approximately 1,500.
- The Opening Day crowd of 4,403 was a program record for Opening Day and the 1,091 students in attendance was an all-time high.
- Auburn has set back-to-back attendance records with attendance totals of 129,948 (2023) and 127,947 (2022) the last two years.
- Prior to the 2022 season, the previous attendance record from 2004 was 111,627.
- The program has again sold out of season tickets for the fourth straight season and has sold a record number of season tickets.

**MLB DRAFT HISTORY**

- With Cole Foster and Bryson Ware being drafted in the third and eighth rounds, respectively, of last year's MLB Draft, it marked the fifth straight year Auburn had multiple top-10 round draft picks, the longest streak in program history.
- Foster and Ware became the highest-drafted inflied duo since 1979. Chase Isbell was also selected in the 15th round.
- Foster became the eighth Auburn player in the last eight years drafted in the top three rounds. Prior to Butch Thompson taking over in 2016, Auburn's last top-three-round pick came in 2007.
- It marked the 49th consecutive year the Tigers had at least one player selected, tied for the longest active streak in the SEC.

**PATH TO THE PROS**

- In eight years under Butch Thompson, Auburn has had 39 draft picks, including 18 in the top 10 rounds and 13 in the top five rounds.
- Both top-10 and top-five rounds totals are good for the most in an eight-year span in program history.
