2011 SEC Tournament



On Feb. 7, 1980, the first SEC women's basketball tournament began play. It ended four days later with Tennessee defeating Ole Miss for the title. Fast forward 31 years later and the SEC Tournament is still enjoying success and increased popularity.

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011), North Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009), Greenville, S.C. (2005) and Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010).

The winner of the 11-game tournament will receive the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds and conference champion will be determined by the 16-game regular-season SEC schedule. The top four seeds earn a first-round bye.

The 2011 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament will once again enjoy live television coverage. FS South continues its dedication to SEC events by televising all first round and all second round games. The semifinals will be aired on ESPNU, while the championship game will again be televised on ESPN2.

Public tickets for this year's event went on sale October 1 and can be purchased through the SEC website or by calling 1-800-732-4849.

Prices are: reserved tournament book, \$90; general admission Dr Pepper Six-Pack tournament book, \$60; reserved single-session (six sessions total), \$17; and general admission single-session, \$12 (can only be purchased day of event at arena box office).

Team Notes

Alabama: The Alabama women's basketball team fell to No. 20 Arkansas on Sunday, 57-53, in Coleman Coliseum. The loss dropped the Crimson Tide to 11-7 overall and 0-5 against Southeastern Conference opponents, while the Razorbacks improved to 15-2 on the season and 3-2 versus league foes. Leading Alabama in scoring was freshman Jasmine Robinson with 12 points. She was followed by senior Tierney Jenkins and sophomore Celiscia Farmer, who added eight points apiece. Jenkins also recorded a game-high seven rebounds. For the game, the Tide shot 40.0 percent (18-45) from the floor, while the Razorbacks hit 39.1 percent of their attempts (18-46). Arkansas was able to collect five more three pointers than Alabama and collected five more rebounds. Next up, the Tide will take on Georgia on Thursday, Jan. 20. Tipoff is slated for 8 p.m. CT on CSS.

Arkansas: The Razorbacks picked up a big road win at Alabama Sunday as SEC action continues. The win moves No. 20/23 Arkansas to 15-2 overall and 3-2 in the SEC. Arkansas' 15 wins is one more than all of last season. Junior Lyndsay Harris leads the team with 13.6 ppg. Harris tied a school record with six three pointers in a half leading Arkansas to a dramatic comeback against Georgia. Arkansas travels to Vanderbilt Thursday as league play continues.

Auburn: The Auburn women's basketball team (11-7, 4-1 SEC) went 2-0 last week with home wins over Ole Miss (85-73) and LSU (65-53). With the wins, the Tigers have now won seven of their last eight games. Sophomore Blanche Alverson led Auburn on the week, averaging 18.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.5 steals per game. Jordan Greenleaf averaged 13.5 points while sophomore point guard Morgan Toles averaged 11.5 points and 7.0 assists per game. Against Ole Miss, Alverson scored a career-high 27 points with three steals and four rebounds. Greenleaf followed with 15 points and four steals.

Florida: The Gators look to rebound on Thursday when the team plays host to Kentucky. The Wildcats are the fourth nationally ranked team Florida will be facing this season, owning a 1-2 record in those games. Florida has also dropped back-to-back decisions for the first time this season, falling to Tennessee and at Georgia last week. Junior Azania Stewart became the seventh Gator in program history to block 100 career shots, doing so in the first half against Georgia. Junior newcomer Deana Allen posted a double-double on Sunday and became the fifth different Gator this year to do so. UF is 8-1 in the O'Connell Center this season, with the lone setback coming in its most recent outing.

Georgia: Georgia improved to 14-3 overall and 4-0 in SEC play with victories at No. 20 Arkansas and over Florida last week. Thursday's win at Arkansas was the 800th in the history of Lady Bulldog Basketball, making Georgia the 10th Division I women's basketball program to reach that milestone. Andy Landers enters this week four victories shy of 850 career wins. Jasmine James paced the Georgia offense in both wins last week, with 15 points at Arkansas and 18 versus the Gators. Meredith Mitchell had her first double-double of the season at Arkansas with 10 points and a career-high 12 rebounds. Khaalidah Miller hit the game-winning three-pointer with 13.8 seconds left at Arkansas.

Kentucky: Kentucky improved to 13-4 overall, 2-2 in SEC play with wins over South Carolina and Mississippi State last week in Memorial Coliseum. Senior forward Victoria Dunlap led the way, averaging a team-high 21.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and 4.0 steals per game. She moved up several UK career charts, including points (No. 5 – 1,567), double-doubles (No. 3 – 26) and blocks (No. 2 – 157). She also needs only four more rebounds to become UK's No. 2 all-time rebounder. Also helping UK get back on the winning track has been the stellar play of sophomore A'dia Mathies. The reigning SEC Freshman of the Year moved to the point guard position in the second half of the Georgia game and has since led UK to a 2-0 record while averaging 15.5 points, 5.5 assists and 5.0 rebounds in her new role.

LSU: The LSU women's basketball team went 1-1 last week in SEC play, defeating Mississippi State, 72-55, and losing at Auburn by a score of 65-53. The Lady Tigers drained the third-most three-pointers in school history in the win against the Bulldogs, finishing 10-of-20 from beyond the arc. Adrienne Webb had a career-best 26 points and Jeanne Kenney tied an LSU freshman record in an SEC game with five made threes. She finished with a career-best 17 points. Webb was LSU's leading scorer in the loss at Auburn. For the season, she is averaging 13.4 points and LaSondra Barrett is second on the team with 12.3 points per game.

Ole Miss: Ole Miss fell to 8-8 overall and 1-3 in SEC play with a 63-58 loss at home to South Carolina. Ole Miss has now lost both of its overtime games this year including a 64-57 double-overtime loss at Hawaii back in November. Senior Kayla Melson recorded her 1,000th career point against South Carolina as she entered the game with 995 and ended the game with a team-high 21 points. Melson became the 24th player in Ole Miss history to record at least 24 points. Ole Miss had three freshmen in the starting lineup for the first time this year (Valencia McFarland, Pa'Sonna Hope and Shae Nelson).

Mississippi State: Mississippi State (8-8, 0-4) used a strong second half effort but ultimately came up short, falling 72-60 at #19 Kentucky on Sunday. Against the Wildcats, State shot 48 percent from the floor but had 22 turnovers including 16 in the first half. The Lady Bulldogs had three players in double figures led by junior Diamber Johnson who scored 20. Johnson was 7-11 from the floor for the game. Mary Kathryn Govero had 16 point while Catina Bett added 12. Mississippi State will host Auburn on Thursday night before traveling to Athens, Ga., to face Georgia on Sunday.

South Carolina: South Carolina captured its first road win of the season with a 63-58 overtime win at Ole Miss on Sunday. Sophomore guard leasia Walker turned in her first career double-double with a career-high 11 rebounds to go with 20 points, but it was senior guard Valerie Nainima's showing in overtime that sealed the victory. Nainima netted seven of her 11 points in the extra five minutes, including a pair of clutch 3-pointers. The Gamecocks out-rebounded both their opponents last week for a +8.5 rebounding margin over the two road games. Nainima hit 45.0 percent of her shots during the stretch to average 12.0 points. Senior Jewel May was the top rebounder of the week with 6.5 boards per game, while junior La'Keisha Sutton handed out 4.0 assists per game.

Tennessee: The attendance for the Lady Vol nightcap game against Vanderbilt was 17,853. To date, it is the largest crowd of the season and the largest crowd for a Lady Vols game at Thompson-Boling Arena since 20,249 watched Tennessee defeat Mississippi State, 72-46, on Feb. 24, 2008. The Lady Vols have a 29-game home court winning streak on "The Summitt" including a 10-0 mark at home this season. Tennessee went undefeated at home in 2009-10 at 17-0 and has not lost a game in Thompson-Boling Arena since Feb. 16, 2009 (a 62-64 loss to Duke). The 29-game streak is the fourth longest in Lady Vol history and fourth longest active streak in the NCAA.

Vanderbilt: Vanderbilt dropped to 12-6 overall and 3-2 in the SEC with a 68-56 loss at No. 5/6 Tennessee on Saturday. The loss came in front of a national television audience on ESPN's College GameDay. It was just the second women's game to be a part of College GameDay. Vanderbilt is now 0-26 all-time at Tennessee. The Commodores started the game 2-for-25 in the first half and shot just 18 percent for the half. Vanderbilt was led by freshman Jasmine Lister, who finished with 17 points. The Commodores will face Arkansas at 7 p.m. Thursday at Memorial Gym, where Vanderbilt is 9-0.

SEC In The Polls

In terms of rankings, the SEC has the richest history of any conference in the nation, boasting more poll appearances than any other.

Since the 1982-83 season, SEC teams have been ranked in the AP poll for 525 consecutive weeks. League teams have been ranked 2,630 times including 1,299 Top 10 appearances and 736 Top Five appearances.

Overall, the league teams have been ranked 600 consecutive weeks, with teams ranked a total of 2,791 times. The SEC has 1,436 Top 10 appearances and 794 Top Five appearances overall.

SEC teams can also boast of 136 No. 1 rankings in the AP Poll and had had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.

A nation-leading eight SEC teams were ranked at one point in the AP and CNN/USA Today Top 25 polls during the 1995-96 season. The league mirrored that feat during the 1996-97 season.
