LEADING OFF

- Coming off the program's second consecutive 40-win season, Auburn softball returns to the diamond led by SEC Pitcher of the Year and All-American Maddie Penta and seventh-year head coach Mickey Dean.
- Head Coach Mickey Dean returns after leading the program to its ninth consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances. In his 17th season of collegiate softball, Dean is 16 victories shy of surpassing 700 wins in his head coaching career.
- Auburn holds a 22-4-1 all-time record in season openers with wins in nine of its last 10. Last season, Auburn opened the 2023 campaign with a 6-0 victory over St. John's in Clearwater.
- After leading the country a season ago with 478 total strikeouts as a staff, Auburn returns its entire bullpen from 2023 with additions of true freshmen Chalea Clemmons and Malayna Tamborra.
- Hitting the transfer portal during the offseason, Auburn's offense added power hitters Amelia Lech (Maryland) and Anna Wohlers (DePaul) to the lineup. The duo combined for 28 home runs and 85 RBÍ in 2023.
- After turning in an undefeated record at Jane B. Moore Field last season, Maddie Penta has not lost a game on The Plains since May 1, 2022 and holds a 15-0 home record during that stretch.

PLAYER TO WATCH: MADDIE PENTA

» All-American and reigning SEC Pitcher of the Year, Maddie Penta returns to the circle after a record-breaking 2023 campaign. Penta closed her junior season as just the second Tiger in program history to record 300 strikeouts in a single season and is on pace to set numerous program records in 2024. The right-handed ace is just eight wins shy of setting the all-time wins record on the Plains.



NOTEBOOK

FIRST PITCH

- » Coming off its best season in the Mickey Dean era, Auburn softball returns to the diamond looking to capitalize off a second straight season of 40+ wins.
- » Dean returns for his seventh season on the Plains after securing the third 40-win season of his tenure. Auburn's lineup returns four starters, including All-SEC shortstop Nelia Peralta. Led by All-American and SEC Pitcher of the Year, Maddie Penta, the Tiger pitching staff returns all five members from 2023 with the addition of a pair of true freshmen.
- » Opening Day on The Plains is set for Feb. 9 as Auburn hosts Virginia Tech at 1 p.m. CT as part of the Tiger Invite. Belmont and Illinois travel to Jane B. Moore Field to compete in the three-day tournament.
- » Auburn also hosted the Tiger Invite to open the 2022 season. Behind four run-rule victories, Auburn went undefeated and outscored opponents 50 to 4 over the course of the weekend
- » Saturday and Sunday's contests will air on the SEC Network+ with JJ Jackson and Auburn softball alumna Amy Rief of the call.
- » Brit Bowen will have Opening Day radio coverage on WEGL 91.1 FM on Friday with Jacob Hillman taking over in the booth for the remainder of the weekend.

AN AUBURN WIN WOULD...

- » Be Auburn's 10th Opening Day win over the last 11 seasons.
- » Be Auburn's first over a ranked opponent to open a season since 2017. (Auburn 3, No. 1 Oklahoma 2)

INSIDE THE SERIES: TIGER INVITE VIRGINIA TECH

» Virginia native Mickey Dean will led Auburn against the Hokies to open the 2024 season.
» Auburn leads the all-time series 2-1, picking up wins in both 2012 and 2010. The two programs first met in 2007 with Virginia Tech squeaking out a 1-0 victory at Jane B. Moore Field.
» All three games in the series have been decided by two runs or less with the victor in each winning via a shutout.

BELMONT

» Belmont is returning to The Plains for the first time since the 2011 season. In the lone meeting between the two squads, Auburn topped the Bruins 8-5 as part of the War Eagle Classic.

ILLINOIS

» A recent foe from a season ago, Auburn will take on Illinois after coming away with a 10-0 victory in five innings to close the 2023 NFCA Kickoff Classic. In that contest, Auburn homered three times behind Aspyn Godwin, Icess Tresvik and Annabelle Widra to claim the win.

» The Tigers lead the all-time series 2-1. The
meeting marks the first on either teams' campus.
All three previous meetings have happened in
Clearwater, Florida.

BY THE NUMBERS: OPENING DAY

» Auburn holds a 22-4-1 record in season openers, dating back to the program's 1997 inaugural season. The Tigers have won nine of their last 10 season openers. The lone loss came during the shortened 2020 season with Auburn falling to Baylor during the NFCA Leadoff Classic in Clearwater, Florida. During the Mickey Dean era, Auburn is 5-1 in season openers.

RANKINGS ROUND UP

- » Off the heels its best season under head Coach Mickey Dean, Auburn softball enters the 2024 campaign ranked across all four major polls.
 » Auburn's highest preseason ranking came from both the USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll and D1 Softball as both publications placed the Tigers at No. 19. Auburn earned a No. 20 ranking in both the ESPN.com/USA Softball Top 25 and Softball America Top 25.
- » Dating back to the 2022 season, Auburn has been ranked in at least one major poll for 32 consecutive weeks, which is the second longest stretch in program history.

WELCOME (BACK) TO THE PENTA-GON

- » Returning for her final season on The Plains after an All-American performance in 2023, Maddie Penta enters her senior campaign with a long list of preseason accolades and poised for a repeat record-setting performance.
- » Over the course of January, Penta was showered with multiple preseason honors that included a spot on the USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year Watchlist. Penta was also selected to the Preseason All-SEC Team and was named a Preseason All-American by Softball America.
- » The honors came after Penta turned in one of the most dominating pitching performances a season ago where she finished second in the nation with 303 strikeouts, becoming just the second Tiger in program history to record 300+ strikeouts in a season.
- » After leading the SEC with 27 victories a season ago, Penta is just eight shy of becoming the winningest pitcher in school history. With a repeat effort in the circle, Penta would become the first pitcher in school history to record 250+ strikeouts in three consecutive season.
- » Among her staggering numbers, she also ranked second in the league in earned run average (1.33), innings pitched (220.2), shutouts (8) and hits allowed per seven innings (3.93) while closing her junior season ranked in the

top 10 in 11 Auburn single-season pitching categories.

» Next for Penta is to close her swan song by cementing her lasting legacy on the Auburn softball record book. While currently ranked in the top 10 in 20 career pitching categories, she's in a league of her own.

- » After three consecutive seasons of double-digit steals, Makayla Packer is chasing down an Auburn record and a fourth season of base-running havoc could seal the deal.
- » Despite turning in her lowest stolen bases number of her career with 14 last season, Packer still ranked in the top 15 in steals across the SEC. Packer also joined elite company with the 50th stolen base of her career, a mark only two other Tigers have ever reached.
- » Packer needs a 20+ stolen base season, a feat she's done once before as a freshman to take down Shannon Anderson's career stolen base mark that has stood since 2004.

NOTEBOOK

a season ago, junior Nelia Peralta returns as the heart of the Auburn offense.

» A staple at the top of the lineup, Peralta led the team in hits (54), runs scored (39) walks (43) and on-base percentage (.479) last season. She was the first player to record 50 hits in a season since a quartet of Tigers did so in 2019. She finished sixth in the SEC in walks per game and ninth in the league in on-base percentage. Her first hit of the 2024 season will be the 100th of her collegiate career.

» Peralta is expected to have a bigger role in generating runs this season and will likely be moved down in order for more RBI

opportunities.

» While her offense shined, Peralta overhaul on defense went under the radar. Playing every inning at shortstop, Peralta cut her error in virtually half from 19 in 2022 to just eight in 2023. One of just two Tigers to start all 62 games last season, Peralta will be the veteran of Auburn's infield entering the season.

PORTAL POWER

» Auburn dipped into the transfer portal over the offseason to bulk up its offense with the addition of Amelia Lech (Maryland) and Anna Wohlers (DePaul). » The powerful duo combined for 62 runs, 96 hits, 56 extra-base hits including 28 home runs and 85 RBI during their 2023 campaigns.

» Coming off the best season of her career to date, Lech was honored as a NFCA Midwest All-Region Team member last season. Wohlers as a two-time All-BIG EAST selection in her two seasons at

DePaul.

» Touted as a top-25 recruiting class by Extra Inning Softball, a talented group of freshmen look to leave their mark on The Plains. The group features high school All-Americans, three second-generation student-athletes and some of the nation's top ranked position players.

» The friendly confines of Jane B. Moore Field has been too friendly for opposing teams in recent seasons.

» Since taking over the program in 2018, Mickey Dean has led the Tigers to at least 18 home wins in five of his six seasons. The only exception was the shortened 2020 campaign as the Tigers finished 11-2 at Jane B. Moore Field before the season was suspended.

» Dean currently holds the second-highest winning percentage in home games by a head coach and has also recorded the second most overall home wins.

CAREER WINNING PERCENTAGE AT HOME

» Dean isn't the only one that shines when on their home turf. Auburn ace Maddie Penta has not lost a home contest since a 3-6 decision versus Georgia on May 1, 2022.

» Since that defeat, Penta is 15-0 at Jane B. Moore Field after an undefeated performance at home last season. Penta is the only Tiger in program history to make at least 20 home appearances and not suffer a loss in a season.

» During her 15-0 performance, Penta has added a 0.68 earned run average behind five shutouts and has struck out 140. She's had three double-digit strikeout performances in this 20-game span.

THE CAT IN THE HAT: MICKEY DEAN **ERA**

» Entering his seventh season on the Plains, Mickey Dean is coming off his best season at Auburn and looks to continue to build off the foundation of set during the 2023 campaign.

» Since Mickey Dean took over the helm in 2018, Auburn is just one of four programs in the country to surpass 250,000+ accumulated attendance, joining Alabama, LSU and Arizona. Since that span, Auburn ranks fourth in the country in average attendance with a mark of 1,566.

IT JUST MEANS MORE... WINS » Since the expansion of the SEC with the additions of Missouri and Texas A&M in 2014, Auburn has cemented itself as one of the winningest programs in the SEC.

Winning 40 or more games in eight of the last 10 seasons, Auburn ranks fourth in the SEC with 411 wins in the last decade behind only Florida (489), Alabama (449) and Tennessee (423).

K-KOUNTER

» One of the top coaches when it comes to developing pitchers, Auburn during the Mickey Dean era has been a strikeout powerhouse

» Since 2018, Auburn is just one of 15 teams in the country to record 2,000 or more strikeouts. Auburn ranks 10th in the nation with 2,089 while ranking fourth in the SEC behind only Alabama, Mississippi State and Florida.

HEAD COACH MICKEY DEAN

Mickey Dean enters his seventh season as the head coach of the Auburn softball program. In 17 years at the collegiate level, Dean has coached 12 NCAA Tournament teams, including one super regional participant, and won nine conference championships. He is one of four active head coaches to led three different programs to the NCAA Tournament.

A native of Elkton, Va., Dean has guided 84 all-conference players, 47 all-region honorees and nine all-Americans, including 2017 National Player of the Year, Megan Good, and 2023 SEC Pitcher of the Year, Maddie Penta. He has also been touted as the conference coach of the year eight times.

During his time on the Plains, Dean has guided the Tigers to a 206-109 overall record behind three 40-win seasons to become the second winningest coach in Auburn softball history. He has guided the Tigers to five NCAA Regional appearances. Dean's resume at Auburn also includes seven NFCA All-Region selections, eight All-SEC selections and one NFCA All-American. During his tenure, Bri Ellis became the program's first undisputed SEC Freshman of the Year while Maddie Penta earned the program's first SEC Pitcher of the Year honor.

In his latest season on the Plains, Dean led Auburn to its best season during his tenure. Behind a second straight 40-win season, Auburn closed 2023 with a 43-19 record its most wins in a season under Dean. Auburn finished conference action with a 15-9 record to finish third in SEC play, its first winning record under head and its highest league finish since 2017. The Tigers also earned their first series win over LSU and first series win at Alabama since 2017 and their first sweep of Missouri in school history. Auburn earned its ninth consecutive NČAA Regional appearance and forced the "if necessary" game at No. 10 Clemson.

Dean reached a coaching milestone during his sixth season at the helm of the Tigers, picking up his 200th victory on the Plains in Auburn's 10-0 victory at South Carolina on April 30.

Offensively, Auburn ranked in the top five in the SEC in runs scored (323) and home runs (64). Nelia Peralta was the heart of Auburn's offense during the 2023 as she led the Tigers in hits (54), runs scored (39), walks (43), batting average (.329) and onbase percentage (.479). Peralta was the first Tiger to record 50 or more hits in a season since 2019 and her efforts were rewarded with an All-SEC Second Team and NFCA All-Southeast Region Third Team honors. Denver Bryant joined Peralta as an All-SEC Second Team member after tuning in a .322 batting average in SEC play.

It was in the circle where a star was born as Maddie Penta put on an all-American performance during her breakout junior season. Penta became just the 16th NFCA All-American in school history and was the first Tiger pitcher to ever earn first-team accolades.

The SEC leader in wins with 27 to tie the program's single-season record, Penta was dominating throughout the season. The first SEC Pitcher of the Year in program history, Penta ranked second nationally with 303 strikeouts to her credit, which shattered Auburn's junior strikeout record. She is just the second pitcher in program history to record 300 strikeouts in a season, joining Kristen Keyes (2004).

She closed her junior season ranked in the top 10 in 11 Auburn single-season pitching categories, which included finishing first or tied for first in wins, games started and combined shutouts in a season. She also sits in the top 10 in 20 Auburn career pitching categories, including wins, strikeouts, earned run average, innings pitched and shutouts.

Dean came to Auburn in 2018 after five seasons as the head coach at James Madison. During his five-year stint at James Madison, Dean complied a record of 237-56 (.809). He amassed five 40-win seasons, including the final two campaigns with 52 and 50 victories, respectively. The Dukes broke 104 program records, including over 40 pitching records while boasting one of the nation's top staffs under Dean's guidance.

Prior to his reign in Harrisonburg, Va., Dean spent six seasons as the head coach at Radford where he took the Highlanders to their first-ever NCAA Tournament appearances in 2009 and 2010. On October 20, 2023, Radford Athletics inducted Dean into its Hall of Fame.

Before taking the position at Radford, Dean served as an assistant coach at Akron (2001-02), Indiana (2002-04) and Longwood (2005-06).

In addition to his collegiate coaching experience, Dean has also worked on the professional and international level.

He was the pitching coach for the Venezuelan National Team (2002-08) and the head coach for the Chicago Bandits (2004-10) that finished as the National Pro Fastpitch regular season champions five times and won the title in 2008.

Dean was named NPF Manager of the Year three times and coached world-renowned pitcher Jennie Finch, who was the NPF's Co-Pitcher of the Year in 2005 and has a gold and silver medal from her two Team USA Olympic appearances.

A 1987 graduate of Elon University, Dean was a pitcher on the baseball team where he was a four-year letterwinner.

Dean and his wife, Liz, and have two adult children: Isaac and Eli.
