

AUBURN TEAM STORYLINES

LAST RIDE AT AUBURN: Megan Schofill is in her fifth and final season on the Plains in 2023-24. Schofill garnered national attention in August by winning the 2023 U.S. Women's Amatuer Championship at Bel-Air Country Club. Schofill became the first Auburn player to ever win the event as Maria Martinez previously held the best U.S. Women's Amateur finish by a Tiger with runner-up honors in 2005.

In addition to a gold medal and custody of the Robert Cox Trophy for one year, Schofill also received an exemption from qualifying for the 2024 U.S. Women's Open, an exemption from qualifying for the next 10 U.S. Women's Amateurs (if eligible) and an invitation to the 2024 Augusta National Women's Amateur. The victory will also give the Tiger exemptions into the Chevron Championship, AIG Women's Open and Amundi Evian Championship. The Monticello, Florida native is Auburn's all-time leader in career scoring average (71.98) and rounds under par (51).



FRESHMAN PHENOM: Auburn welcomed 2022 Augusta National Women's Amateur Champion, 2023 World Amateur Team USA member and two-time Junior Solheim Cup team member Anna Davis to its roster in January. Davis has participated in both team events this spring for the Tigers.

BEST IN AMERICA: Two of the top three American amateurs in the world, Megan Schofill and Anna Davis, are each featured on the Tigers' roster. Megan Schofill is the top-ranked American amateur at 7th in the world while Anna Davis is the third-highest ranked American amateur at 13th in the world. (World Amateur Golf Ranking).



BACK TO AUGUSTA: The Tigers will have three representatives at this year's Augusta National Women's Amateur, as Anna Davis, Megan Schofill and Casey Weidenfeld have accepted invitations to the prestigious event. Davis won the event at 16 years of age in 2022, Schofill made the cut for the first time and finished in the top 15 and Weidenfeld will be playing in the tournament for the first time in 2024.

COMPETING IN THE OPEN: Auburn senior Anna Foster qualified for the 2023 AIG Women's Open at Walton Heath Golf Club in August. Foster qualified for the prestigious tournament through the

Hankley Common final qualifying event.

The Auburn senior fired a 3-under 69 in the qualifier to secure a spot in the field, which was awarded to the top 12 finishers. The Dublin, Ireland native was one of 10 amateurs and one of two Irish players that participated in the event in 2023

LUELLEN ERA: In what is currently her ninth season at Auburn, Melissa Luellen has won one SEC Championship (2021), recieved six NCAA Regional Berths (2017, 2018, 2019, 2021, 2022, 2023), punched a ticket to four NCAA Championship Appearances (2018, 2019, 2021, 2022), made three NCAA Championship Match Play appearances (2019, 2021, 2022), coached four All-Americans, four All-SEC players, and notched six tournament victories.
