Auburn In The Bank of Tennessee

Auburn is making its 8th appearance in the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate, formerly known as the Ridges Intercollegiate. The Tigers' best finish came last year, finishing runner-up to South Carolina.

Auburn Vs. The Field

The Tigers are 4-9 against teams in the Bank of Tennessee Intercollegiate this season. They have played in tournaments against Alabama, UAB, East Tennessee State, South Carolina, TCU, Tennessee, Virginia and Wake Forest.

Last Time Out

The Auburn men's golf team shot the low

round of the day for the second straight round and matched its school record for the lowest 18-hole score by firing a 13-under 271 to finish seventh with a 297-271-271--839 in the final round of the Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate at the par-71, 6,958-yard Old Overton Club in Birmingham Oct. 10. Backed by sub-par rounds from each golfer, the Tigers equaled Monday's record-setting second round and moved up three spots from tenth. Glenn Northcutt carded his second sub-par round of the tournament, a 1-under 70 to finish tied for 12th at 6-under 207. Jay Moseley had his best round of the tournament, shooting a 4-under 67 to finish in 26th at 2-under 211. Patton Kizzire also fired a 67 and finished tied for 32nd at even-par 213. Brent Cooper, playing in his first collegiate tournament, finished tied for 35th at 78-66-70--214 followed by Andrew Medley in a tie for 38th at 77-71-67--215.

Last Time In The Bank of Tennessee

The 25th-ranked Auburn men's golf team fired the lowest round of the day with a 6-under 282 to jump from sixth to a runner-up finish with an 867 in the 15-team Ridges Intercollegiate at the par-72, 7147-yard Ridges Golf and Country Club Oct. 16, 2005. True freshman Glenn Northcutt recorded the first top-10 finish of his career by tying for eighth carding a final round 1-under 71 to finish at even par 216. Junior Andrew Med-

ley tied for 12th with a 2-under 70 for a 2-over 218 total while senior All-SEC Stuart Moore continued his climb from 90th after a first round 81 to finish tied for 16th with stellar scores of 68 and 70 in his final 36 holes. Sophomore Jay Moseley carded his first subpar round of the tournament with a final round 71 to finish tied for 35th at 224 while sophomore All-SEC Patton Kizzire struggled with a closing 85 to finish 75th at 233.

Broken Record

In last week's Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate, the Tigers set a school record for the lowest 18-hole score, firing a 13-under 271 in the second and third rounds. The previous record was a 273, set in last year's Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate in Wahiawa, Hawaii.
