THE TOURNAMENT FIELD

The SEC Championship will feature a very tough field as five teams are ranked in the GolfWeek/Sagarin rankings as well as six teams included in the GolfWorld/NIKE Golf Coaches Poll. Teams ranked in the top 25 are No. 2/2 Alabama, No. 4/3 Auburn, No. 9/10 Arkansas, No. 17/21 LSU, No. 23/23 Florida, and No. 26/25 Georgia. Other SEC teams appearing in the GolfWeek rankings are: Tennessee (44), South Carolina (49), Ole Miss (63), Mississippi State (65), Vanderbilt (78), and Kentucky (80).

AGAINST THE FIELD THIS SEASON

The Tigers have faced all other 11 SEC institutions in tournaments this season, compiling a 20-2-1 mark. The Tigers own a winning record against every team and is undefeated against 10 of them with their only losses coming against Alabama. Auburn's record against SEC teams this season: Alabama (3-2), Arkansas (1-0), Florida (2-0-1), Georgia (1-0), Kentucky (3-0), LSU (2-0), Mississippi State (2-0), Ole Miss (1-0), South Carolina (3-0), Tennessee (1-0) and Vanderbilt (1-0).

THE COURSE

Rated No. 1 in the U.S. among the "World's 50 Best Golf Hotels" by Golf Digest Index, Sea Island Golf Club offers three exceptional 18-hole championship courses. The Seaside Course, home to the PGA TOUR's McGladrey Classic, is a links course graced by majestic ocean vistas in the tradition of St. Andrews. The Seaside Course was totally reconfigured by Tom Fazio and reopened in October 1999.

THE WEATHER

Weather could pose a problem at this year's tournament with a potential for thunderstorms throughout the weekend. Friday calls for a high of 80 with isolated thunderstorms. Saturday is predicted to have scattered thunderstorms and a high of 77 while Sunday calls for severe thunderstorms and a high of 75.

IN THE RANKINGS

Auburn has been ranked in the top-25 polls throughout the season and enters the SEC Championship ranked in the top-5 in both polls, coming in at the No. 4 spot in the GolfWeek Rankings and No. 3 in the GolfWorld/NIKE Golf Division I Coaches' Poll. In the GolfWeek ratings, Blayne Barber is ranked as the No. 8 men's collegiate player in the nation. Behind Barber, Auburn has three other golfers in the GolfWeek top-100 ratings: Will McCurdy (48), Niclas Carlsson (60), and Dominic Bozzelli (64).

AUBURN AT THE SEC CHAMPIONSHIP

Auburn has won three SEC Championships including victories in 2002, 1976 and 1981. Auburn has had four individual champions in the tournament, including Jimmy Green (1991), Bryan MacKellar (1997), Roland Thatcher (2000), and Patton Kizzire (2007).

HOME OF THE SEC CHAMPIONSHIP

This is the 12th year the Southeastern Conference Championship will be held on the Sea Island Golf Club's Seaside Course. The SEC has conducted its annual championship on St. Simons Island since 2001 (Seaside Course 2001-2007, 2010-2011; Frederica Golf Club 2008-2009). This year, the course will play a par-70 at 6,898 yards. The Tigers won the 2002 SEC Championship on the same course.

AROUND THE SEC

Blayne Barber enters the SEC Championship as the No. 1-ranked active golfer in the conference, by stroke average, with his 70.92. Barber is one of five Auburn golfers ranked in the top 25, followed by Will McCurdy (72.00) at 11th, Niclas Carlsson (72.04) at 12th, Dominic Bozzelli (72.17) at 13th, and Michael Johnson (72.67) at 23rd. Other Auburn players in the rankings are junior Michael Hebert (73.57) at 36th, and freshman Blake Soni who is first among players with less than 10 rounds played at 71.67 after competing in his first collegiate

tournament at the Gary Koch Invitational.

#WINNING

Since 2009 when Nick Clinard took the helm, Auburn has won eight team titles including three wins this season at the Carpet Capital Collegiate, the Gator Invitational, and the Hootie at Bulls Bay. Auburn's eight wins in three years are the most since the Tigers had nine team wins from 1994-97. Under Clinard's tutelage, Auburn has had eight individual medalists including three this season with Dominic Bozzelli at the U.S. Collegiate Championship and Gator Invitational, and Niclas Carlsson at the Hootie at Bulls Bay.

TOP-5 TIGERS

Under Clinard, the Tigers have finished in the top-5 25 times, marking the most successful three-year span in history. Auburn has finished in the top-5 in every tournament this season.

TIGERS GOING LOW

The Tigers currently hold a 285.44 team scoring average this season, which is the best in school history by nearly a stroke. Last season, the Tigers set the record by shooting 286.39.

BARBER CHASING RECORDS

With his scoring average of 70.92, junior Blayne Barber is just .02 strokes away from breaking the Auburn school record which was set by Buddy Gardner in 1976. In his first year of competition as a Tiger last season, Barber finished the season with an average of 70.91.

DOMINATION

After winning medalist honors at the U.S Collegiate in October and winning the Gator Invitational by five strokes in February, junior Dominic Bozzelli became the first golfer in Auburn history to win back-to-back tournaments. In the process of winning the Gator Invitational, Bozzelli carded the lowest round of his career, a 6-under 64, in the

second round.

SWEDISH SENSATION

At the Hootie at Bulls Bay, sophomore Niclas Carlsson won his second career tournament after firing a 5-under 211. The Enebyberg, Sweden, native entered the final round in ninth place, and was one of only 10 players to shoot an even par or better in the third round. The win marks Carlsson's second win of his career after winning the Jerry Pate Invitational last season.

AUBURN WINS CARPET CAPITAL COLLEGIATE

The Tigers started the 2011-12 campaign with its first season-opening title since 1978 after finishing with a 13-under 851. Junior Dominic Bozzelli and senior Will McCurdy led the way for the Tigers finishing tied for eighth at 3-under.

TIGERS FINISH TIED FOR SECOND AT OLYMPIA FIELDS

In the team's second tournament of the year, Auburn earned a tie for second place finish at the Olympia Fields Invitational. The Tigers entered the final round of the tournament in third place, but shot a 287 in the third round to finish tied with Oklahoma State at 25-over. Blayne Barber finished tied for seventh shooting a 5-over 215.

TIGERS TAKE FOURTH PLACE AT JERRY PATE

Senior Will McCurdy finished in the top-10 for the second time this season leading the top-ranked Tigers to its 12th consecutive regular season top-five finish. Auburn fired a 24-over 864 at the tournament which only saw one team finish below par.

BOZZELLI EARNS CO-MEDALIST HONORS AT THE U.S. COLLEGIATE

Junior Dominic Bozzelli earned the first collegiate medalist honors of his career after shooting a 6-under. No. 1 Auburn finished tied for second with No. 12 Washington, falling to No. 3 UCLA by three strokes. Junior

AUBURN, BOZZELLI WIN AT GATOR INVITATIONAL

Auburn won its second tournament of the season by 16 strokes behind junior Dominic Bozzelli's five-stroke victory. The Tigers shot 279-281-288--848 (+8) in the two-day tournament defeating No. 8 Arkansas by 16 strokes who shot 288-289-287--864 (+24). Bozzelli carded a 6-under 64 in the second round to set a new career low. Coming off a second round 6-over 76, junior Blayne Barber notched his second-straight top-five finish after firing a 1-under 69 in the third round to finish at 3-over.

TIGERS FINISH THIRD AT DESERT INTERCOLLEGIATE

Auburn continued its successful season at the University of Wyoming Desert Intercollegiate, finishing in third place at 9-under. Junior Blayne Barber finished in the top-five for the third straight time this season after carding a 5-under 211. Sophomore Niclas Carlsson also finished in the top-10 after shooting a 3-under 213. Junior Michael Hebert jumped 24 spots in the final round after carding a 3-under 69, to finish tied for 17th at 1-under for the tournament.

AUBURN TIES FOR THIRD AT E-Z-GO SCHENKEL INVITATIONAL

The Tigers finished tied for third place at the E-Z-GO Schenkel Invitational with Florida at 17-under. Blayne Barber finished in second place after carding a 15-under 201. Barber shot his career-best 54 holes while also tying his best round of his career, a 6-under 66. Niclas Carlsson finished tied for 13th at 4-under while senior Will McCurdy finished tied for 16th at 3-under.

TIGERS PICK UP THIRD WIN OF THE SEASON AT HOOTIE AT BULLS BAY

Auburn picked up its third win of the season, and eighth under Nick Clinard, after winning the Hootie at Bulls Bay by nine strokes over No. 24 Virginia. Sophomore Niclas Carlsson won the individual title after carding a 1-under 71 in the third round to finish at 5-under 211, one stroke ahead of Auburn junior Blayne Barber who finished tied for second and two strokes ahead of senior Will McCurdy, who

finished in fourth. Barber shot a 2-over 74 in the final round to secure his fifth top-five finish of the season. After starting the day tied for 15th, McCurdy carded a 2-under 70 in the final round to finish in fourth place, his first top-five finish of the season.

AUBURN CLOSES OUT REGULAR SEASON WITH THIRD PLACE FINISH AT THE GARY KOCH INVITATIONAL

The Tigers finished third at the Gary Koch Invitational shooting an even-288 on Sunday for a 4-over total at the Old Memorial Golf Club in Tampa, Fla., marking its eighth top-3 of the season. Freshman Blake Soni, who was playing as an individual, finished tied for seventh at 1-under in his first ever tournament for Auburn. Senior Will McCurdy finished tied for 12th at 1-over after shooting an even-72 on Sunday, for his fifth top-20 finish of the season. After starting the day tied for 42nd, junior Dominic Bozzelli fired a 4-under 68 to finish tied for 15th. The Pittsford, N.Y., native eagled on No. 9 before carding birdies on 14 and 16. Junior Blayne Barber placed tied for 23rd after shooting a 3-over 75, while Niclas Carlsson finished tied for 27th at 5-over. Junior Michael Hebert finished tied for 32nd at 7-over.
