SETTING THE STAGE

The Auburn Tigers are headed to Knoxville, Tenn., for the 2012 SEC Swimming & Diving Championships, which run Feb. 15-18 at the Allan Jones Intercollegiate Aquatic Center on the campus of the University of Tennessee. This is Auburn's 32nd appearance in the SEC Women's Championships.

Preliminaries on Thursday, Friday and Saturday begin at 10 a.m. ET (9 a.m. CT), with finals each night set to begin at 6 p.m. ET (5 p.m. CT). Diving preliminaries will take place in the afternoon between sessions.

AUBURN'S WOMEN IN THE SEC CHAMPIONSHIP

Auburn's women have recorded five SEC Championships in the last nine years, winning the title in 2003, 2004, 2005, 2007 and 2008. The Tigers have finished first or second a total of 16 times since the championship began in 1981, and Auburn has finished third or better in every SEC Championship since 1992. In addition, Auburn has won at least one individual or relay title at every SEC meet for the last 20 years.

STREAKING

The Tigers will look to continue several streaks at this year's SEC Championships. Over the last few championships, Auburn's women have won:

- 10 of the last 12 400 IM titles
- Five out of the last six 400 medley relay titles
- Four out of the last five 400 freestyle relay titles

LAST TIME: 2011 SEC CHAMPIONSHIP RECAP

Auburn's women finished in third place at the 2011 SEC Championships in Gainesville, Fla., posting a total of 563 points in the meet. Georgia won its second straight title with 720 points while Florida was second with 678.

Arianna Vanderpool-Wallace was the star of the week for the Tigers, winning the 50 and 100 freestyle titles and setting SEC records in both events. In addition, her time of 46.81 seconds in the 100 freestyle (both prelims and finals) set a new SEC, NCAA and U.S. Open record in the event as she became just the second woman in history to break 47 seconds in the race (the other is Olympic medalist Natalie Coughlin). She also finished second in the 100 butterfly.

Vanderpool-Wallace was also part of three winning relay teams as the 200 and 400 free relay and the 200 medley relay captured SEC titles with NCAA automatic qualifying times. The 200 medley relay victory set a new SEC Championship record.

Vennie Dantin and **Anna Aguero** combined for five medals in the diving events as Dantin took third on the 1-meter and platform and runner-up in the 3-meter event. Aguero was runner-up on platform, third on the 3-meter and fifth in the 1-meter. In total, the two Auburn divers accounted for 96 points.

Two other Tigers ascended the medal stand. **Emily Bos** fin-

ished third in the 100 backstroke, and Micah Lawrence was the runner-up in both the 100 and 200 breaststroke.

DIVING RIGHT IN

Seniors **Vennie Dantin** and **Anna Aguero** return for their last shot at an SEC title. Dantin has one to her credit, a win on the 3-meter board at the 2010 championships, and has earned four other medals with three runner-up finishes and a third-place showing in her three previous conference meets. Dantin has been a force for the Tigers this year, winning 15 times in 22 events and earning five nods as SEC Diver of the Week.

Aguero, meanwhile, seeks her first conference title. She has come close, finishing runner-up on two occasions and taking third place two other times. She has one win on the year, taking the top spot on 1-meter at the Georgia Diving Invitational.

Two freshmen are in the mix to score for the Tigers as well. **Cinzia Calabretta** and **Shanna Schuelein** have steadily improved throughout the year and have posted NCAA Zone qualifying scores in all three events.

Coach **Jeff Shaffer**, in his 13th season, has coached two Auburn women's divers to an SEC title.

A LOOK AT AUBURN'S SWIMMERS

Auburn returns eight swimmers that scored at last year's SEC Championships as those eight combined for 30 scoring performances. Arianna Vanderpool-Wallace is the defending champion in the 50 and 100 freestyle, and she was also part of three winning relay teams. In all, Vanderpool-Wallace has 10 SEC titles to her name.

Vanderpool-Wallace once again has the nation's top time in the 50 free (21.77) and 100 free (46.99), while sophomore Olivia Scott is the nation's best in 2012 in the 100 fly (51.86) and is in Auburn's top three in the 50/100/200 free and 100 back. Sophomore Emily Bos will be a major factor in the backstroke events with Auburn's top time in both distances, while junior Katie Gardocki has emerged as one of the league's best in the distance freestyle.

Hannah Riordan, Scott, Vanderpool-Wallace and Lindsey Norberg are the defending 200 free relay champions, while Riordan was part of the 400 free relay title and Bos and Vanderpool-Wallace both helped Auburn to wins in the 400 FR and 200 MR. Riordan will be a factor in the sprint events as well.

Others to watch: junior Becca Jones (200 free), junior Lauren Norberg (100/200 breast), sophomore Haley Krakoski (50/100 free), Erica Belcher (backstroke), Abby Duncan (breaststroke), Sarah Peterson (200 fly/200 IM/400 IM).

FLORIDA 162, AUBURN 138 (1/21/12)

The seventh-ranked Auburn women fell on the road at No. 9 Florida, dropping a 162-138 decision in a long-course meet at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center Natatorium. Auburn won seven events on the day but could not overcome the Gators' depth, especially in the distance events. Auburn got the meet off to a strong start with the team of **Emily Bos, Lauren Norberg, Olivia Scott and Arianna Vanderpool-Wallace** winning the 200-meter medley relay in 1:54.44. Vanderpool-Wallace then took victory in the 100-meter freestyle with a time of 55.62. Scott, meanwhile, earned a win in the 100 butterfly with an Olympic Trials cut time of 1:00.30.

The 400 free relay also went Auburn's way as **Haley Krakoski, Scott, Hannah Riordan** and Vanderpool-Wallace touched first in 3:47.25. **Katie Gardocki** got her ninth individual win of the season, posting an 8:47.51 in the 800 freestyle. Bos was strong in the backstroke events, taking second place in the 100 back (1:03.88) and third in the 200 back (2:19.75). In the diving well, senior **Vennie Dantin** earned her 14th and 15th wins of the year. She won the 1-meter event with a score of 324.22, while freshman **Cinzia Calabretta** posted a season-best 266.02 to finish second. Dantin then came back with a 350.70 to win the 3-meter event.

AUBURN 167, TEXAS 133 (1/10/12)

Auburn's senior swimmers and divers made the most of their final home dual meet as **Arianna Vanderpool-Wallace** and **Vennie Dantin** combined for six wins in the No. 7 Tigers' 167-133 victory over No. 4 Texas at the James E. Martin Aquatics Center. The 400 medley relay team of **Emily Bos, Lauren Norberg, Olivia Scott** and Vanderpool-Wallace started things off with a dominating performance, winning by more than five full seconds in 3:37.38. Vanderpool-Wallace then won both sprints, clocking a 22.41 in the 50 free and a 48.44 in the 100 free to give Auburn a lead it would not relinquish. She then helped put the meet away with a strong leadoff leg in the 200 freestyle relay as she joined **Hannah Riordan, Megan Fonteno and Haley Krakoski** in winning the final race with a 1:31.99.

Dantin also kept up her strong performances with wins in both the 1- and 3-meter diving events. She posted a 307.05 to win by a wide margin in the 1-meter competition, then recovered from a shaky first dive to come from behind and win the 3-meter event with a 337.73. Junior **Katie Gardocki** put together a career-best time in the 1000 free with a time of 9:43.06. Gardocki then got a second win in the 500 free with a time of 4:46.38, winning by .15 seconds. Bos got a come-from-behind win of her own in the 200 back with a time of 1:58.70 to win by .25 seconds. Scott posted a victory in the 100 butterfly with a time of 53.22, and **Lauren Norberg** got a win in the 100 breast in 1:01.78.

AUBURN THIRD AT UGA INVITE (12/2-4/11)

Auburn's women took third place with 594 points at the Georgia Invite to wrap up the fall season in Athens, Ga. Host and No. 1-ranked Georgia finished first with 995 points while second-ranked California was runner-up with 745.5. **Arianna Vanderpool-Wallace** earned two NCAA 'A' cuts in the meet, posting a 46.99 in the 100 free and a 21.77 in the 50 free - both the best times in the country this year. **Olivia Scott** broke the Auburn record in the 100 fly with a 51.86 in prelims, then won the event with a 52.04 in the final.

Vennie Dantin earned two wins in the diving events, scoring a 348.30 to take the 3-meter title and a 287.90 to win on the platform. The 400 medley relay team of **Emily Bos, Lauren Norberg, Scott** and Vanderpool-Wallace also earned a victory with a 3:32.69.

Auburn swimmers posted a combined 35 NCAA 'B' cut times and three 'A' cuts during the three-day meet.

GEORGIA 133, AUBURN 110 (11/11/11)

The sixth-ranked Auburn women dropped a hard-fought battle to No. 1 Georgia, falling 133-110 at the James E. Martin Aquatics Center. The Tiger women won six events on the day and had numerous season-best swims, while Georgia won its 17th straight dual meet and 50th out of its last 51 outings.

Arianna Vanderpool-Wallace continued her dominance of the sprint events, winning all three races in which she competed. She posted a 22.31 in the 50 free to earn her first win of the day with teammate **Hannah Riordan** in second place (23.00), and she came back in the 100 free with a season-best 48.32. She was also the anchor leg of Auburn's 400 freestyle relay, splitting a smooth 48.79 to help the team of Riordan, **Emily Bos** and **Olivia Scott** to a time of 3:18.45, shaving more than six seconds off the team's best time from earlier in the year.

The women's 200 medley relay opened things up with a win as Bos, **Abby Duncan**, Scott and Riordan sprinted to a 1:40.19, their fastest of the season. Two more Auburn wins came courtesy of senior diver **Vennie Dantin**, who continued her early-season dominance of both boards. She started the day off with a 1-meter win, scoring 298.50 as senior **Anna Agüero** (287.85) took second and freshman **Cinzia Calabretta** (257.70) was third. On the 3-meter board, Dantin breezed to a win with a score of 344.40 with Calabretta second in 283.28.

AUBURN 138.5, PENN STATE 99.5 (11/4/11)

Auburn's women improved to 3-0 in the dual-meet season with a 138.5-99.5 win over Penn State at the James E. Martin Aquatics Center. The Tigers had the top times or scores in 11 of 13 events. **Katie Gardocki** earned three individual victories on the day, starting with a 1:48.38 in the 200 free to lead a sweep of the top four spots along with **Olivia Scott** (1:48.84), **Becca Jones** (1:49.03) and **Megan Fonteno** (1:50.84). She also took the top spot in the 500 free with a 4:49.50. But the most impressive performance of Gardocki's night came in the 400 IM. Her final 50-yard split of 26.62 saw her run down Penn State All-American Amy Modglin as Gardocki won the race with an NCAA 'B' cut time of 4:15.63.

Senior diver **Vennie Dantin** put together an equally impressive performance. Her score of 324.93 in the 1-meter event was 1.5 points shy of her own school record, and an outstanding final dive gave her a 359.18 in the 3-meter event. The 400 medley relay team of **Emily Bos, Abby Duncan, Olivia Scott and Arianna Vanderpool-Wallace** started off the meet with a winning time of 3:37.68, earning an NCAA 'B' cut. Vanderpool-Wallace later followed up with her first attempt at the 50 free this season, clocking a 22.34 to win by a wide margin. **Hannah Riordan** won the other sprint event, posting a season-best 50.18 in the 100 free. The team of Vanderpool-Wallace, Bos, Scott and Riordan then closed out the meet with a sizzling 1:30.89 in the 200 free relay for yet another 'B' cut. **Lauren Norberg** also earned another NCAA 'B' cut with an exhibition swim of 2:14.28 in the 200 breast, and **Siena DeVenuto** earned a win with a 10:07.61 in the 1000 free.

AUBURN 167, NOTRE DAME 125 (10/21/11)

Auburn continued their impressive early-season performances, posting 10 NCAA provisional qualifying times in a 167-125 road victory over Notre Dame at the Rolfs Aquatic Center. Senior **Arianna Vanderpool-Wallace** was part of

two wins on the day. She posted a 48.73 in the 100 free win by more than two and a half seconds. She led an Auburn sweep in the event with teammate **Becca Jones** clocking a 51.29 and freshman **Megan Fonteno** posting a 51.44.

Olivia Scott won the 100 butterfly, posting a provisional qualifier with a 53.61. **Emily Bos** continued to impress in the backstroke, winning the 100 back by a huge margin with a 53.62 to post her second `B` cut time of the year. Freshman **Abby Duncan** posted an NCAA `B` cut in the 100 breaststroke in her first collegiate attempt at the event, clocking a 1:02.01 to outpace junior teammate Lauren Norberg, who posted a 1:02.70 for a `B` cut of her own. It would be one of two `B` cuts for Norberg on the day; she came back later to win the 200 breast with a 2:15.86; Duncan would finish second in 2:16.68, and **Laura Johnson** took third with a 2:21.28.

Fellow junior **Katie Gardocki** picked up two more victories on the day, winning the 1000 free in 9:51.98 and taking top honors in the 500 free with a 4:56.68. And junior **Becca Jones** took a win in the 200 free with a 1:49.21. With the team swimming exhibition, freshman Sarah Peterson posted what would have been the winning time in the 400 individual medley, clocking a personal-best 4:20.73 in her first collegiate attempt at the event.

The 200 medley relay team of Bos, Duncan, Riordan and Vanderpool-Wallace got the meet off to a great start by improving on their NCAA `B` cut time, posting a 1:40.84 to shave four-tenths off the team's best time from the previous meet. And in the meet's final event, the team of Krakoski, Scott, **Kelsey Winters** and Fonteno put up an exhibition swim of 3:24.41 to post an NCAA `B` cut in the 400 freestyle relay.

AUBURN 142.5, ARKANSAS 100.5 (10/5/11)

Auburn swimmers posted six NCAA provisional qualifying times and two divers earned NCAA Zone qualifying scores as the Tigers opened the 2011-12 season with a 142.5-100.5 victory over Arkansas at the James E. Martin Aquatics Center. The Tigers won nine of the 13 events and posted strong times for an early-season meet.

Hannah Riordan took two individual victories on the day to lead the Tigers. She earned an NCAA `B` cut in the 50 free with a 22.77 to win the event, and was again triumphant in the 100 free with a 50.24. Sophomore **Emily Bos** earned a provisional cut in her first individual swim of the season, posting a 1:58.49 in the 200 back to win by more than two-and-a-half seconds. She also helped the top 200 medley relay team open the meet with a provisional cut of their own, swimming a 25.09 leadoff leg to help **Abby Duncan**, **Megan Fonteno** and **Kelsey Winters** to a winning time of 1:41.24.

Junior **Katie Gardocki** was already in midseason form in the 1000 freestyle, posting a time of 9:46.68, falling just .02 seconds shy of a personal best and bettering what already ranks as the fifth-best time in Auburn history. Junior **Lauren Norberg** picked up another individual win for the Tigers, taking top honors in the 200 breaststroke with an NCAA `B` cut time of 2:14.99. **Arianna Vanderpool-Wallace** earned a victory in the 200 freestyle with a 1:48.85, and junior Becca Jones took second place with a 1:50.27. In the diving well, senior **Vennie Dantin** got her 2011-12 season off to a great start by sweeping the top spots on both boards. She posted a 338.55 in the 3-meter event and a 301.20 on the 1-meter board - both NCAA Zone qualifying scores - to earn a pair of wins for the Tigers.

AUBURN SIGNS 15 FOR 2012-13 CLASS

The Auburn swimming and diving program signed 15 student-athletes to National Letters of Intent during the Early Signing Period in November, head coach Brett Hawke announced.

Joining the Tiger women's squad for next season will be Caroline Bryant, Katherine Criter, Caitlyn Forman, Alexandria Merritt, Morgan Mullins, Sarah Reynolds, Ashley Roberson, Carly Scheper and Jillian Vitarius. The Auburn men will add six swimmers and divers as Steyn Funk, Alex Hancock, Jordan Jones, Andrew Laing, Jacob Siar and Justin Youtsey will join the squad.

"Auburn swimming and diving has signed an exceptional class of young athletes," Hawke said. "We feel great about the type of people who have committed to carrying on the tradition of excellence at Auburn. We couldn't be happier with the potential of these student-athletes and the impact they can have on the future of this program. Jeff has pulled in some of the best up-and-coming divers in the country to round out this class. I look forward to working with them in the future and thank their club coaches for all their influence and support in shaping them into who they are today."

BRETT HAWKE

HEAD COACH / THIRD YEAR / AUBURN '10



In his third full year as head coach of Auburn swimming & diving, Brett Hawke has continued to uphold the championship tradition of the Tigers. And as the program heads into an Olympic year, Hawke and the rest of his staff are preparing not only to defend another SEC title and produce NCAA champions, but also to reach the pinnacle of the sport at the 2012 London Olympics.

Hawke's Tigers kept their men's SEC championship streak alive in 2011, capturing the program's 15th consecutive conference championship and 17th overall in winning a tight meet with the host Florida Gators. In the men's championship meet, Auburn athletes won five individual titles and two relays, while the Tiger women took two individual titles and three relays en route to a third-place finish. Under Hawke's guidance, junior Arianna Vanderpool-Wallace broke an NCAA and U.S. Open record in the 100 freestyle with a 46.81 at the SEC Championships; she would later win a national title in both that event and the 50 freestyle, becoming the first Auburn woman to capture an NCAA Championship in those events.

During his first full season as head coach, Hawke led the men's program to its 16th SEC title and its record 14th-straight conference championship in 2010. During the 2010 conference meet, Auburn swimmers recorded seven individual titles and five relay titles.

Under Hawke's direction as co-head coach in 2009, the Auburn men came away with their eighth national title, capturing the 2009 Men's Swimming and Diving NCAA Championship. During the three-day event, Auburn recorded 54 All-America honors and had one individual and four relay champions. The Tigers also set three US Open, three NCAA and 17 school records en route to the title.

Hawke returned to The Plains in the summer of 2006 as an assistant coach for the program. Hawke, a native of Sydney, Australia, was a 17-time All-American swimmer for Auburn from 1997 to 1999.

As a member of the coaching staff, Hawke works directly with the Auburn sprinters. Under his direction, Cesar Cielo provided one of the top highlights from the 2008 NCAA Championships as he became the fastest swimmer in the world with his 18.47 in the 50 free. What made the mark even more impressive was not that he did it once, but he reached the mark three times. He won the 50 free with a time of 18.52 after qualifying with an 18.79 in the preliminary. His time of 18.47 came as the 200 free relay leadoff.

In all, Auburn sprinters won six All-America honors with Cielo sweeping the 50 and 100 freestyle titles in 2008. He also became the first swim-

mer to break the 41-second barrier in the 100 free with a 40.92. For his efforts, Cielo was named the NCAA Swimmer of the Year for the second year in a row.

Hawke has also seen coaching success at the international level. He served as an assistant coach for the United States team at the 2011 World University Games, helping lead the Americans to 27 medals at the event.

During the 2009 World Championships, Hawke served as an assistant coach with the Brazilian national team and coached Cielo to two gold medals in the 50 and 100 freestyles. Cielo became the fastest swimmer in the world in the 100 free when he touched the wall in 46.91. Other Tiger sprinters medaling at the championships were Fred Bousquet (silver - 50 free, bronze - 100 free, 4x100 free relay) and Matt Targett (silver - 50 fly, bronze - 4x100 medley relay).

Hawke also had the opportunity to coach Cielo at the 2008 Olympic Games. Serving once again as an assistant coach with the Brazilian national team, Hawke mentored the South American star as he won a bronze in the 100m free and a gold in the 50m free with an Olympic record time of 21.30. Other Auburn sprinters trained by Hawke at the 2008 Olympics included Matt Targett, Fred Bousquet, Jakob Andkjær and Alexei Puninski. Targett and Bousquet both brought home medals after their performance on relay teams.

Auburn sprinters overall were very impressive at the 2007 NAAs with 13 swimmers advancing to finals. In the men's 50 free, Auburn took the top two spots with Cielo taking the title and Targett right behind him. Scott Goodrich and Bryan Lundquist also made the championship final. In the women's 50 free, it was Kara Denby leading the team in eighth.

In the 100 free, Cielo picked up another NCAA Championship with a time of 41.17 and Targett followed in sixth place. In the women's 100 free, it was Denby again leading the team in fourth place, followed by Emily Kukors in fifth.

During his time in Auburn, Hawke captured nine NCAA titles to go along with seven SEC crowns. In 1997, Hawke became part of Auburn history as he was a member of the first NCAA Championship team.

A two-time Olympian, Hawke finished sixth in the 50m free in Athens. Hawke has three Commonwealth Games medals in his collection, including silver in the 50m free from 2002. Adding to his long list of international experience, in 2001 and 2003, Hawke was a World Championship finalist in the 50m free and at the 2002 Pan Pacific Championships, Hawke won bronze in the 50m free.

Hawke is married to the former Trudi James and the couple have four children: Kirra (13), Kobe (9) and twins Yasmin and Lily (3). James was a member of the Auburn University soccer team from 1994-97. Hawke earned his bachelor's degree in psychology from Auburn in the summer of 2010.

JEFF SHAFFER

HEAD DIVING COACH / 13TH YEAR / WISCONSIN ('80)



Jeff Shaffer has been developing and guiding divers across the country to great accomplishments throughout their careers in the last 30 years. He came to Auburn almost 13 years ago as one of the most respected coaches in the diving community and has improved the Auburn diving program in Olympic-size proportions.

During his tenure at Auburn, Shaffer has made the diving program into a complete complement to the Auburn swimming program. Through his strong coaching ability and sound philosophy, Shaffer has guided his student-athletes to success.

"Our philosophy here at Auburn is developing divers from the ground up," Shaffer said. "It is a growing process and through the experiences gained here, our divers have the opportunity to become great."

Shaffer's coaching career kicked off in 1980 after he graduated from the University of Wisconsin with a bachelor's degree in physical education. He moved to Mission Viejo, Calif., and assisted diving legend Ron O'Brien from 1980-85. Shaffer followed O'Brien to Boca Raton, Fla., and continued to coach with him until 1988.

While with O'Brien and during his career coaching at the club level, Shaffer coached divers of all ages and ability levels and demonstrated the gift to develop divers to world renowned status. His talent was recognized by the United States Olympic Committee in 1996 when they honored him as the inaugural recipient of the USOC National Developmental Coach of the Year for all Olympic sports.

Throughout his club coaching career, Shaffer has guided divers to many distinguished accomplishments. Such honors include 10 World Junior champions, 39 National Junior champions, eight Senior National champions, three Junior National Team titles and three Senior National Team titles.

Shaffer carried his philosophy and achievements to the collegiate level, first to LSU, then to Southern California and now at Auburn. His divers have played crucial roles in contributing to the success Auburn has had on the national level, making an impact on 12 of Auburn's

NCAA team titles.

The contributions started through Shaffer's first recruiting class that included Caesar Garcia and Ashley Rubenstein and have continued throughout the last 13 years.

Evidence of Shaffer's philosophy of developing athletes can be seen through all of his pupils, including Garcia and Rubenstein. With Shaffer's guidance, Garcia grew from an All-American as a freshman to a two-time NCAA platform champion, the 2004 SEC and NCAA Male Diver of the Year and a XXVIII Olympian.

Rubenstein played a significant role in three NCAA championship teams. She was a member of Auburn's first-ever women's NCAA title in 2002 and as a senior in 2004, her fourth-place finish on the 1-meter contributed to the team's large margin of victory and its third-straight national title. Rubenstein has gone on to be a 2004 USA Olympic Team Trials finalist, a National Team member and most recently, the 2006 U.S. National title one the 1-meter.

Among the many successful divers Shaffer has instructed, some include NCAA champions Matt Bricker and Steve Segerlin and All-America honorees Corey Gerlach and Lynnsey Segraves.

In 2009, Auburn's Kelly Marx and Dan Mazzaferro played key roles on the team's eighth NCAA title run during the 2008-09 season. Marx was runner-up on the 3-meter and reached the finals on the one-meter, while Mazzaferro earned honorable mention All-America honors on the three-meter at the national meet. Both divers earned honorable mention All-America accolades on the 10-meter platform.

At the conclusion of the 2009-10 season, Shaffer's diving corp came away with three SEC titles and seven All-America honors. Marx concluded his senior season with three All-America honors, two SEC titles (1-meter, platform) and was named SEC Male Diver of the Year. Vennie Dantin captured the conference 3-meter championship, while she and Anna Aguerro competed in their first NCAA meet and came away with two All-America honors each. Thad Ellis was also honored by the SEC, being named SEC Male Freshman Diver of the Year.



The 2011 season saw Mazzaferro win the 3-meter and platform titles at the SEC Championships, earning SEC Male Diver of the Year and SEC Commissioner's Trophy honors, while Dantin and Mazzaferro both earned All-America honors.

All in all, the philosophy that Shaffer has embedded in his coaching has proven to be successful from his days with O'Brien to now as he continues to provide his student-athletes opportunities to grow into essential contributors to the continued accomplishments the Auburn swimming and diving teams experience, as well as success on the international level.

Shaffer and his wife, Jenny, have two daughters, Amy (23) and Kelly (22). The couple also has a son, J.J. (Jeffrey Jr.) (17). Amy is an Auburn graduate, while Kelly is a senior at Samford University.

FRANK BRADLEY

ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH / 2ND YEAR /
FLORIDA STATE ('97)

Frank Bradley is in his second season as associate head coach for the Auburn swimming and diving program.

His first year with the Tigers was a success as Auburn continued its streak of SEC men's championships, winning its 15th in a row in 2011. At the league meet, Auburn's men and women combined for five individual titles and five relay victories.

Bradley came to Auburn from Indian River State College, where he served the previous five years, including as head coach the last four years.

At Indian River, Bradley continued the storied legacy of the school's swim program as he guided both men's and women's teams to five National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) titles. The men have won 36-straight titles, while the women have won 29-consecutive national championships and 32 overall.

In his five years of coaching at Indian River, Bradley's student-athletes compiled an extensive list of accolades. A total of 45 NJCAA national records and 53 school records were set, 177 NJCAA national titles were earned and 13 student-athletes were named NJCAA Swimmer of the Year.

Among the long list of student-athletes Bradley coached is former Auburn swimmer Gideon Louw. Louw, the 2010 SEC Champion in the 50 and 100 free, was a seven-time NJCAA champion in 2008 under Bradley. Louw captured the 50 free, 100 free and 200 free individual races and was a part of four champion relay squads.

Bradley has been named NJCAA Coach of the Year four times (Men – 2007, 2008; Women – 2009, 2010) and the women's team has earned the Skull Award, an honor given to the Indian River team with the highest grade-point average, three times.

Prior to joining Indian River, Bradley served as an assistant coach at the University of South Carolina from 1999-2005. While with the Gamecocks, Bradley coached athletes such as 2000 SEC Swimmer of the Year Zsolt Gaspar. Bradley also guided the Gamecocks to 26 All-America honors, 34 school records and three SEC individual titles.

Bradley is a 1997 graduate of Florida State University, where he earned a Bachelor's degree in social science and was a four-year letterwinner for the Seminole swimming team. In 1995, Bradley won the Atlantic Coast Conference title in the 200 individual medley for the Seminoles. Following graduation, Bradley served as graduate assistant for the Florida State swimming team from 1997-1999.

Bradley, a native of Woodbury, N.J., and his wife Susan have two daughters, Grace and Paige.



RICHARD LONG

ASSISTANT COACH / 6TH YEAR / AUBURN ('05)

Richard Long begins his sixth season with the Auburn swimming and diving team as an assistant coach.

Under his guidance, the Auburn men captured their 15th consecutive SEC title and 17th overall in 2011, winning five individual titles and two relays at the SEC Championships.

Long assisted the Tiger men's team to their 16th overall and conference record 14th-consecutive SEC Championship in 2010. At the conference meet, Auburn swimmers came away with seven individual and five relay titles.

During the 2009 season, Long helped coach the men's swimming and diving team to both an SEC and NCAA championship title.

In the summer of 2009, Long served as an assistant coach for Paraguay at the World Championships in Rome. He coached two swimmers to two national records.

Long served as the team's videographer in 2008 and focused on gathering underwater and above water video of meets and taking footage of the swimmers in practice. The video provided the coaching staff the opportunity to use for stroke analysis. Using Dartfish for stroke analysis, he launched a Webcast over the Internet to allow swimmers to access footage at their convenience.

As a volunteer assistant in 2007, he helped coach the men's and women's teams to both SEC and NCAA championships.

Long completed his bachelor's of science degree from Auburn University in Exercise Science while spending two years on the swimming and diving team, earning three All-America honors (200 FR, 400 FR, 800 FR).

Long, a native of Hampton, Va., resides in Auburn and is married to the former Erin Hebert. Richard and Erin have a son, Tyson Long.

Sam Busch enters his first year as Auburn's assistant swimming coach in 2011-12. He comes to Auburn after spending a year as a volunteer assistant at West Virginia University.

Busch begins his first year as a collegiate assistant coach after volunteer seasons at the University of Arizona and West Virginia University. While in Tucson, Ariz., he assisted five seasons at Tucson Ford Aquatics, the 2010 National Club Champions. Busch also served three years as head coach of the women's program at Salpointe Catholic High School in Tucson, where he was a standout football and baseball player. In his career, he has worked with numerous high school All-Americans, NCAA champions and Olympic medalists.

Busch comes from a strong tradition of coaching excellence. His father, Frank Busch, recently wrapped up 31 years as a collegiate head coach at Arizona and Cincinnati, and he is now the National Team Director for USA Swimming. His brother, Augie, is the head coach of women's swimming at Houston.

Carrie Karkoska enters her fourth season on The Plains. The Columbus, Ohio, native was named assistant coach to the Auburn swimming and diving program after two seasons as a graduate assistant strength and conditioning coach. Working closely with PK in his weight room, Karkoska's primary area of focus was with the Auburn diving, cross country and gymnastics teams from 2007-2009.

Working with swimming and diving is nothing new to Karkoska, who was an accomplished diver herself while in college.

Karkoska lettered all four years on the diving team at Purdue and was a four-time All-America honoree. For her work on the boards, she was also honored twice as the Big Ten Diver of the Year. She is still the Purdue record holder on the platform, having a score of 346.05. In 2004, Karkoska swept all three boards at the Big Ten Championships. She returned in 2006 to take the title on the platform for her fourth conference championship.

Prior to coming to Auburn, Karkoska spent a year as an intern in strength and conditioning at Purdue, working mainly with the men's and women's tennis, men's and women's swimming and diving, cheerleading, soccer and softball teams.

Recently, Karkoska was honored by the Collegiate Strength & Conditioning Coaches Association (CSCCA), winning the 2009 John Stucky Award. The award is given in honor of Coach John Stucky and recipients are chosen based on characteristics and skills that they've shown throughout their work in the strength and conditioning profession.

Karkoska earned her undergraduate degree from Purdue in 2006 in organizational leadership and supervision. She received her master's degree in exercise science from Auburn in 2009.
