#### **Memphis Twilight Recap**

The Auburn men's and women's cross country teams both finished in fourth place at the Brooks Memphis Twilight Cross Country Classic Saturday night. Senior Holly Knight and junior Ben Cheruiyot both won the individual crowns.

In the men's 8K race, Cheruivot clocked a time of 23:15.96 to come away with his first win of the season, beating a field of 264 runners. Knight completed the 5K race in 17:05.97 to add another win to her impressive resume, beating a field of 256 runners.

Freshman Colin Barker and junior Jeff Sanders were the next two Tigers to cross the line, running times of 24:32.31 and 24:49.39 to come in seventh and 13th place, respectively. The Tigers scored 122 total points while finishing fourth out of 30 teams.

Stephanie Barnes was close behind finished third in 17:29.00 and Elizabeth Briasco in 16th place with a time of 18:17.18.

#### **Tigers in the Polls**

The Auburn cross country teams

begin the 2010 season ranked among the top teams in the SEC and NCAA South Region. The men were tabbed fifth in the SEC Coaches Poll, and after three meets this season they fell to are currently sitting at sixth in 2009 NCAA Regional Finish the USTFCCCA South Region preseason poll. The women in the SEC poll and are ranked tenth after three meets this season in the USTFCCCA poll.

#### Auburn Tigers Honored

Ben Cheruiyot and Holly Knight were recognized by the SEC after their performances at the Brooks Memphis Twilight Cross Country Festival. They were named SEC Cross Country Kiboiywo and Ben Cheruioyt to All-America Athletes of the Week for week four of the 2010 regular season.

Cheruivot won the men's 8K in 23:17.99, after pulling stretch. Knight led the women's 5K the entire race and finished career at the NCAA South Regional. 24 seconds faster than the next closest competitor.

This was Knight's second and Cheruiyot's first SEC Cross Country Athlete of the Week honor.
