### Co-PLAYER OF THE WEEK

KAETLYN MURDOCH • DENVER



Junior Kaetlyn Murdoch led the Pioneers in their three games for the week with 18.3 points per game and a 70.3 shooting percentage from the field. In DU's loss to in-state rival Colorado State, the forward led the way with 20 points to extend her consecutive-game double-figure scoring streak to 25 games, while also finishing with three blocks. After a nine-point showing against No. 17/18 Georgia in the opening game of the LMU Courtyard by Marriott Los Angeles Westside Thanksgiving Tournament, hosted by Loyola Marymount, Murdoch turned in a career-high 26-point performance along with a 81.3 shooting percentage from the field to help the Pioneers defeat Stephen F. Austin 88-76 to win the Consolation game and finish third. Murdoch's performance also earned her a spot on the All-Tournament team, while her 26 points tied her for seventh all-time in the Tournament Record Books for most points in a game. For the season, Murdoch leads the Pioneers with 17.8 points per game and a .696 shooting percentage.

### Co-PLAYER OF THE WEEK

JERICA COLEY • FIU



Freshman Jerica Coley was named the MVP of the FIU Thanksgiving Classic after leading the Panthers to their first tournament championship title in five years and their sixth overall in the 16-year existence of the tournament. This weekend, the 5-foot-7 guard set career highs in points (18), rebounds (7, twice), assists (4, twice), steals (5) and blocks (4). Against Morehead State, Coley was one of three to score in double figures (14) to help the Panthers connect on a season-best 58.8 percent from the field en route to season-high 78 points. Two days later against Indiana State, she made her first career start and paced four Panthers in double figures – the third such game of her career – with an impressive stat line (18 points, 7 rebounds, game-high 4 assists, game-high 4 blocks). She finished the day with a 62.5 percent showing from the floor. Coley is averaging a team-best 13 points.

### AROUND THE SUN BELT CONFERENCE



Following a flurry of games surrounding the Thanksgiving Holiday, more than half of Sun Belt Women's Basketball teams currently boast a .500 record or better.

10 of 12 Sun Belt programs played in Thanksgiving tournaments, with only Middle Tennessee and Troy skipping out.

FIU is riding a league-best three-game win streak after claiming its first FIU Thanksgiving Classic championship title in five years and its sixth overall in the 16-year existence of the tournament this past weekend. Freshman Jerica Coley was named the tournament MVP after averaging 16 points and 7 rebounds over two games. Rakia Rodgers and Michelle Gonzalez were also named to the All Tournament team.

Middle Tennessee swept through a pair

of home games last week, knocking off ETSU, 87-71, and South Dakota State, 70-51. The two wins extended the Blue Raiders' current home winning streak to 14 games, dating back to last season, and improved their current season record to a Sun Belt-best 4-1 entering this week. The consecutive triumphs equal MT's longest winning streak of the season, as it started the campaign 2-0 for the first time since 2003-04 with victories over USF and Austin Peay.

Elsewhere around the league, teams will settle back into normal schedules with a few exceptions. WKU and Troy will play the first league game of the season on December 1 and final exams and the impending winter break will alter playing dates and practice schedules.

### ESPNU TO BROADCAST CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

For the second time in Sun Belt Conference women's basketball history, the Sun Belt Tournament Championship game will be broadcast nationally. The Sun Belt Conference's agreement with ESPN signed in early 2009 guarantees that this season's Tournament Championship game will be broadcast on ESPNU at 1 p.m. (CT) Tuesday, March 8.

### SUN BELT NETWORK EQUALS MORE AIRTIME

The Sun Belt Conference ventured into extraordinary deal with regional sport network partners Comcast Sports Southeast (CSS) and Cox Sports Television (CST) in the summer of 2009 to form the Sun Belt Network for regional conference television broadcasts. The agreement between the three parties results in the broadcasting of football, men's basketball, women's basketball, baseball, volleyball, and softball contests throughout the upcoming year. Compared to the previous regional television deals, the Sun Belt Network saw a 25% increase in football broadcasts, a 37% increase in men's basketball broadcasts, and a 40% increase in women's basketball broadcasts in only the first year.

### SUN BELT SENDS TWO TO NCAAS

With their overtime win over UALR in the 2010 Sun Belt Women's Basketball Championship Middle Tennessee assured themselves of their sixth NCAA tournament appearance in the last eight years. Meanwhile UALR received their first ever NCAA at-large bid. UALR's bid marked the second time in the last four years that the Sun Belt has sent multiple teams to the NCAA Women's Basketball Championship. In fact, in 16 of the league's 28 years of women's basketball the Sun Belt has sent multiple teams to the NCAA Women's Basketball Championship.

### UALR TAKES WIN IN FIRST EVER NCAA APPEARANCE

In the team's first-ever NCAA tournament appearance, UALR defeated higher-seed Georgia Tech 63-53 as the Trojans record the most overall wins in school history with a 27-7 after falling to eventual Final Four participant Oklahoma in the NCAA second round.

### PRESEASON ACCOLADES FOR REED

UALR's Chastity Reed was named to the John R. Wooden Award Women's Preseason Top 30 List, the 2010-11 Preseason "Wade Watch" list for The State Farm® Wade Trophy Division I Player of the Year and the 2010-11 Naismith Women's Preseason Watch List this preseason. Reed is the first UALR women's basketball player to be mentioned on any of the three preseason lists. Reed led the Trojans last season to the team's third-straight Sun Belt West Division Championship and first NCAA appearance and victory over Georgia Tech. The New Orleans, La. native averaged 24.8 points, ranking her fourth in the nation, and 7.8 rebounds last season. She was the first Trojan since 1985 to set both the UALR scoring and rebounding career records. The two-time first team All-Sun Belt and 2010 Associated Press Honorable Mention All-America honoree, Reed finished the season ranked first in the nation in field goals made with 346 and second in total points with 842.
