SETTING THE STAGE

The Auburn Tigers hit the road for the first time this year in Southeastern Conference play, traveling to Columbia, Mo., and Fayetteville, Ark., for a pair of matches this weekend.

Auburn (9-5, 0-2 SEC) will look to snap a four-match skid as they take on the undefeated Missouri Tigers (17-0, 2-0 SEC) at 6:30 p.m. Friday at the Hearnest Center. The Tigers will then travel to Arkansas to face the Razorbacks (9-5, 2-1 SEC) at 1:30 p.m. Sunday in Barnhill Arena.

AuburnTigers.com will have live streaming audio via Auburn All-Access for both matches. Live stats and live video (for a fee) will also be available via MUTigers.com (Friday) and ArkansasRazorbacks.com (Sunday), and fans can follow @AUVolleyball on Twitter for continuous updates.

AUBURN QUICK HITS

- Auburn has an all-time record of 565-565-4 (.500) in its 42nd season of intercollegiate volleyball.
- Auburn's all-time SEC record is 136-265 (.341).
- Head Coach Rick Nold is in his third season at Auburn. He has a career head coaching record of 209-135 over 11+ seasons and is 37-37 in two-plus seasons at Auburn.
- Seniors **Katherine Culwell** (6th - 848) and **Camila Jersonsky** (8th - 722) are among the top 10 active career kill leaders in the SEC.
- Senior **Camila Jersonsky** is Auburn's all-time leader in career hitting percentage (.352).
- Senior setter **Chelsea Wintzinger** earned her 2,000th career assist in the first match of the season and is now 5th all-time at Auburn with 2,286 assists.

FIRST SEC ROAD TRIP

After a disappointing first three matches in Auburn Arena, the Tigers are on the road in SEC play for the first time this year with their next three matches away from home. Auburn is 7-1 away from home this year, including 3-1 in true road contests. Last year, Auburn finished 3-7 in road SEC play, earning wins at Ole Miss, Mississippi State and South Carolina.

This will be the first time Auburn has ever played at Mizzou; however, the Tigers are 3-0 in the state of Missouri this year after sweeping through the Saint Louis tournament earlier in the year. Auburn is 3-16 all-time at Arkansas' Barnhill Arena.

A LOOK AHEAD

Auburn wraps up a three-match road swing next Sunday, Oct. 13, in Oxford, Miss., against the Ole Miss Rebels. The match is set for a 1:30 p.m. start at the Gillom Sports Center.

WINTZINGER HITS 2,000 ASSISTS

With her 15th assist in Auburn's 3-0 season-opening win over Saint Louis, senior **Chelsea Wintzinger** became the sixth player in Auburn history to record 2,000 career assists.

Then, with her 20th assist vs. Green Bay on 9/5, Wintzinger moved into 5th all-time at Auburn with her 2,078th career assist. She is 263 assists shy of fourth all-time (2,535).

SCOUTING THE MISSOURI TIGERS

• Missouri is one of four teams in the country still undefeated this season (17-0, 2-0 SEC) along with North Carolina, Washington and Colorado State.

• Of those four teams, Mizzou is the only unranked team;



however, the Tigers are receiving votes in the latest poll.

- Mizzou was picked to finish third in the SEC East this year. Last year, the Tigers were fourth in the East at 19-12 overall, 10-10 SEC.
- Missouri has the nation's leader in hitting percentage in Whitney Little (.588) and assists per set in Molly Kreklow (12.64). Kreklow also ranks 29th nationally and 2nd in the SEC in aces per set (0.46).
- Lisa Henning is ranked 14th in the nation in kills per set (4.50) and 15th nationally in points per set (5.15). She is second in the SEC in both categories.
- As a team, Mizzou leads the nation in hitting percentage (.400) and assists per set (14.48).

LAST TIME: MIZZOU 3, AUBURN 2 (10/21/12)

In a match where the Auburn volleyball team controlled every statistical category, visiting Missouri still found a way to leave the Student Activities Center with a 3-2 win (25-14, 16-25, 21-25, 25-19, 13-15) in the first SEC meeting between the schools. Auburn had more kills, digs, blocks, service aces and a higher hitting percentage than Missouri, but the visitors managed to come up with two huge plays late in the fifth set to break a 13-13 tie.

Sarah Bullock and Camila Jersonsky both had 18 kills. Jersonsky's 18 kills on .469 hitting matched a career-high, and she also contributed five blocks to the effort. Bullock hit at a .268 clip and tied for the team high in digs with 19.

Missouri's Lisa Henning led all hitters with 27 kills, and she hit .310 with just five errors on an astounding 71 attempts. Molly Kreklow fell two kills shy of a triple-double as she had eight kills, 42 assists and 10 digs.

SCOUTING THE RAZORBACKS

- Entering the weekend, Arkansas has an identical record to Auburn at 9-5 overall. The Hogs do have two SEC wins, though, defeating Ole Miss and Mississippi State last week.
- Arkansas was picked to finish third in the SEC West. Last year, the Hogs finished 2nd in the West at 22-10 overall (13-7 SEC) and advanced to the NCAA First Round.
- Meredith Hays is 22nd in the nation in kills per set

(4.28) and 28th nationally in points per set (4.74). She ranks third in the SEC in both categories.

- Libero Emily Helm leads the Razorbacks with 4.15 digs/set, which ranks 6th in the SEC.
- As a team, Arkansas is 28th in the nation and 3rd in the SEC in blocks (2.63/set). Ana Sofia Jusino is the team leader at 1.18/set.

LAST TIME: AUBURN 3, ARKANSAS 2 (11/2/12)

Camila Jersonsky had 17 kills and nine blocks to lead the Auburn volleyball team to a heart-stopping 3-2 victory (25-14, 15-25, 23-25, 25-20, 15-10) over Arkansas at the Student Activities Center, the Tigers' third straight SEC win.

The Tigers guaranteed themselves a winning record for the 2012 season as they avenged an earlier three-set loss at the hands of the SEC West-leading Razorbacks. Jersonsky and Courtney McDonald, the Tigers' two middle blockers, combined for 26 of Auburn's 55 kills and were in on a combined 14 blocks during the match. Both hitters topped the .400 mark as well as the Tigers snapped a three-match skid against the Razorbacks.

SEE YA LATER, STUDENT ACT

With the six matches of the Active Ankle Challenge concluded, Auburn will play just one more match at the Student Activities Center this season, a Nov. 8 tilt against Missouri. The remainder of the Tigers' home matches in 2013 will take place at Auburn Arena.

HISTORIC VICTORY

With a 3-1 win over No. 10 Nebraska on Aug. 31, Auburn picked up its first-ever victory over a top-10 opponent and just its second in history over a top-25 foe. The previous win over a ranked opponent came Sept. 24, 2010, when the Tigers defeated No. 24 Kentucky in five sets at home.

Auburn is 2-42 since 2002 against nationally-ranked opponents.

TIGERS PICKED FOURTH IN SEC WEST

Auburn was picked to finish fourth in the SEC Western Division by a poll of the league's coaches. The Tigers finished tied for third last season. LSU and Texas A&M were selected as Western Division co-champions. Florida was picked to win the SEC East and the overall conference title.

There will be no SEC East or West champion this year, however; the league's athletic directors voted to eliminate divisional play in volleyball after the preseason poll was released.

THREE MATCHES TELEVISED

Auburn volleyball will have three of its matches televised during the 2013 Southeastern Conference season.

Two matches will air on SportSouth. On Friday, Oct. 18, the Tigers will host LSU with first serve now set for 7:30 p.m. CT. The following Sunday, Oct. 20, Auburn will welcome Texas A&M to Auburn Arena with that match set for a 2 p.m. start. Two weeks later, the next home match against Mississippi State on Sunday, Nov. 3, will be broadcast by CSS at 3 p.m.

Rick Nold is in his third season as Auburn's head volleyball coach in 2013 after being named the 10th head coach in program history on April 10, 2011.

In his two seasons on the Plains, Nold has put together a 28-32 overall record (.467). His second season saw a six-match improvement from his first as he took the Tigers from an 11-19 mark (5-15 SEC) in 2011 to a 17-13 record (8-12 SEC) in 2012, the 18th winning season in 41 years of Auburn volleyball. He led the Tigers to nine straight wins to open the season, the second-longest winning streak in program history. Nold also picked up his 200th career head coaching victory on Nov. 4 with a 3-1 win over Georgia.

The 2012 season also saw senior outside hitter Sarah Bullock become the fifth player in Auburn history to record 1,000 career kills and 1,000 career digs. Bullock and junior Camila Jersonsky were named to the All-SEC Second Team following the season, and Jersonsky was a two-time selection as the SEC Defensive Player of the Week.

Nold directed Jacksonville State to unprecedented heights during his nine-year tenure, winning three regular season conference titles, three conference tournament titles and making three NCAA postseason appearances. He compiled an overall record of 172-98, while posting an impressive 107-42 (72 percent) mark in league games.

A three-time conference Coach of the Year, Nold led the Gamecocks to Ohio Valley Conference regular season or tournament title in four of the previous six seasons. He captured the OVC regular season in 2006, '07 and '09, while winning the conference tournament title in 2005, '06 and '09.

Jacksonville State advanced to the NCAA Division I Tournament in 2005, '06 and '09 under Nold, the only NCAA postseason appearances in the program's history. In 2009, Nold led the program to another milestone, by winning the school's first NCAA Tournament match, defeating Florida A&M.

Nold's 2009 team finished the season 27-8, which was the most wins in program history, swept both conference titles and advancing to the NCAA second round. He was rewarded by being named the OVC Coach of the Year as well as the Midwest Region Coach of the Year by the American Volleyball Coaches Association.

In 2006, the Gamecocks were 24-5 overall and posted a perfect 18-0 mark in conference play, sweeping all but one conference match. At one time that season, JSU won 49 consecutive games, the longest active streak in the nation.

Nold's teams not only excelled on the court, but also in the classroom. During his tenure, JSU had 46 volleyball players named to the OVC Commissioner's Honor Roll, eight OVC Academic Medal of Honor winners, one Academic All-American and a two-time OVC Female Athlete of the Year.

Nold came to Jacksonville State from Louisville, his alma mater, where he spent six years on the Cardinals' staff, the last four as a full-time assistant whose duties included recruiting coordina-

tor. During his time at Louisville, the Cardinals won four Conference USA titles and advanced to the NCAA Tournament five times, advancing to the Sweet 16 in 1996 and 1998. He was the head coach of the 16-and-under and 18-and-under teams for the Kentucky Indiana Volleyball Academy in Louisville, where he coached teams that won the 1996, 1997, 1998 and 1999 AAU National Championships.

Nold began his coaching career as an assistant at Assumption High School in his hometown, where he helped the girls' varsity squad to three state championships and a 137-9 overall record before joining the University of Louisville staff in 1996. Nold served as an intern with USA Volleyball, where he assisted the women's national team in preparations for the 1996 Olympics in Atlanta. He received a bachelor's degree from Louisville in the spring of 1998 in Sports Administration.

He is a member of the American Volleyball Coaches Association, the Association of Volleyball Professionals and USA Volleyball Impact Certified Coach. He also serves on the All-Region and All-America selections committees.
