Tigers Take on Samford in Home Opener

On Tap

The Auburn women's tennis team returns to action on Saturday at 12 p.m., when the Tigers host Samford in their home opener. The Tigers are 3-1 this season with their only loss coming at Florida State, where Auburn fell 4-3. The match with Samford is being dedicated to the patients at the Children's Hospital in Birmingham, Ala., where the Tigers visited on Feb. 3. The Tigers own a perfect 7-0 all-time record against Samford.

Last Time Out

Auburn had its originally scheduled match with Florida State pushed back a day due to inclement weather. After pushing the match back to Jan. 30, Auburn (3-1) fell at Florida State (1-0) 4-3. The match came down to the final doubles point after the both teams agreed to play singles first due to the threat of inclement weather. Both teams split the singles matches, with Auburn winning the Nos. 2, 3, and 4 matches. At No. 2, Chappell moved to 3-0 on the year. Alex Haney won her match at No. 3 and Dzeljan Memisi was victorious in the No. 4 position. In doubles, Alex Haney and Leigh Tippins lost their match at No. 1, while Tori Almagno and Whitney Chappell won in the No. 2 position. The match came down to the No. 3 doubles position with Ashley Cowart and Erin Gray. The Tigers' duo battled until the end before falling 9-8 (10-5) to FSU's doubles team of Suzanna Mansour and Ania Rynarzewska.

Sunshine Tigers

Auburn opened the year with four straight matches in the state of Florida. The Tigers opened with matches with Jacksonville and North Florida on Jan. 22, before heading to Orlando, Fla., to play Stetson on Jan. 23. The Tigers ended their Florida road swing with their match at Florida State on Jan. 31.

Auburn will make its only other appearance of the year in Florida at the SEC Tournament from April 20-23 in Gainesville, Fla.

For The Kids

On Friday, Feb. 3, the Tigers took a break in

their practice schedule and drove to Birmingham, Ala., to visit the Children's Hospital. The Tigers spent four hours visiting with the patients from 3-7 p.m. Along with visiting with the patients, the Tigers also gave the patients 100 stuffed Tigers, which were made possible through the combined efforts of Tigers Unlimited, Anders Bookstore and J&M Bookstore.

Match Dedication

The Tigers will dedicate Saturday's match with Samford to the patients at the Children's Hospital in Birmingham, Ala.

About Samford

Samford is 1-0 this season (as of Feb. 8) with a 7-0 victory over North Alabama on Saturday. The Bulldogs play in the Ohio Valley Conference, where they were champions of the league in 2004. Before heading to the Plains, Samford will play a road match at Jacksonville State on Wednesday and a home match with Auburn-Montgomery on Friday. The Bulldogs finished fifth in the Ohio Valley Conference in 2005 with a 11-7, 5-4 record.

SEC Co-Player of the Week

It did not take Auburn junior Dzeljan Memisi long to make a strong impression in the SEC. On Tuesday, Memisi was named SEC Co-Player of the Week on Jan. 24 after starting the season 2-0 in singles and 2-0 in doubles. Memisi, a junior-college transfer from Tyler Junior College (Texas) won her first Division I match, 6-0, 6-3, over Jacksonville's Megan Williams. The second win was a 6-3, 6-3 win over Robin Rogers of North Florida. Memisi shared the award with Kentucky's Danielle Petrisko.

HEAD COACH TIM GRAY

Tim Gray is in his first season as the women's tennis coach at Auburn. Gray came to Auburn after spending the past three years as the head coach at Eastern

Michigan, where led the the university to a 41-20 mark and twice led the team to the finals of the Mid-American Conference Championships. Gray's success in the MAC carried beyond just the conference championships. During Gray's tenure, he compiled a conference record of 21-6. Prior to his arrival at Eastern Michigan, Gray was the head men's tennis coach at Florida Southern College in Lakeland, Fla., for seven seasons. During his tenure, Gray resurrected a program that had been reinstated in 1995, after being dropped in 1985. Gray compiled a 103-54 record and led the Mocs to seven consecutive NCAA Division II postseason appearances. Gray received his bachelor's degree from Washington College in Chesterfield, Md., in 1986. During this past summer, Gray received his master's degree from the United States Sports Academy.

Tigers Picked 11th In Coaches Poll

The Tigers were picked to finish 11th in the Southeastern Conference and sixth in the Western Division by the league's head coaches on Jan. 13. The Tigers accumulated 16 points in the poll, just four behind Mississippi State for fifth in the SEC West. Kentucky received the fewest votes with 12. Overall, Florida was picked as East Division and overall conference champion with 59 points. In the Western Division, Ole Miss led the way with 60 points, followed by LSU with 49.

Newcomers

Following the fall season when the Tigers just had six players on their roster, head coach Tim Gray signed three newcomers to start 2006. Joining the Tigers' squad is sophomore Leigh Tippins of Atlanta, junior-college transfer Dzeljan Memisi and freshman Fani Chifchieva. Chifchieva will redshirt during the spring season and will begin competing as a freshman in the fall. Memisi is a transfer from Tyler (Texas) Junior College, which won the 2005 NJCAA title. Memisi won the title in the No. 2 singles position at the 2005 Junior College National Championships. Memisi was a first-team All-American selection in singles and doubles in 2005. Tippins, who was the No. 4 player in the U.S. as a junior chose not to compete in college following high school. After two years out of tennis, Tippins contacted head coach Tim Gray and walked on to the team in the spring. Academically, Tippins is a junior, but given the NCAA five-year window, she has three years of eligibility.

New Era

Tim Gray is in his first season at the helm of the Tigers. Gray comes to Auburn after spending the past three years as the head coach at Eastern Michigan, where he accrued a record of 41-20. Gray has almost 20 years of head coaching experience at the collegiate level. While at Eastern Michigan, Gray led the team to the finals of the Mid-American Conference Championships two out of three seasons. Gray inherits a program that has finished higher than 10th in the Southeastern Conference just once in the past nine years.

All Ages Show

The 2005-06 roster is a unique mix of old and new. With the exception of sophomore Tori Almagno and juco transfer Dzeljan Memisi, everyone on the roster is either a senior or in their first year of collegiate tennis. Comprising the roster are two seniors, one junior, two sophomores and four freshmen.

Looking Ahead

Following the match vs. Samford, the Tigers face Georgia Tech at home on February 19 before traveling to Chicago to take on Southern Illinois and DePaul, Feb. 25-26.
