# MELISSA LUELLEN

## HEAD COACH

Melissa Luellen is entering her eighth season as Auburn's head women's golf coach in 2022-23. She came to Auburn after spending the previous 13 years as the head coach at Arizona State, leading the program to an NCAA title in 2009, and then two years prior to that as the head coach at the University of Tulsa.

"I was able to see Auburn from the eyes of a recruit when I was brought in for my 'official visit' during the interview process," Luellen said when she was hired in June 2015. "Auburn has everything a coach and student-athlete could possibly want to be amazing in their sport and their life. Kim Evans built an incredible program at Auburn. My goal is to build on what she accomplished and continue to win championships."

While at Auburn, Luellen has guided the Tigers to three consecutive appearances in the NCAA Championship, including a top-four finish in 2019 and 2022.

In the 2021-22 season, the Tigers captured seven top five finishes and won the stroke play portion of the SEC Championship. They went on to finish in a tie for third at the NCAA Stillwater Regional and finished as a semifinalist at the NCAA Championship in Scottsdale.

The 2018-19 season proved to be a breakthrough season for Auburn under Luellen. Not only did the team finish as a national semifinalist, they also captured two tournament victories: the Battle at the Beach and the Shootout at Shoal Creek. The Tigers tied for third in the SEC Championship, making it to the semifinals of match play, and they placed fifth in the NCAA Auburn Regional to earn their spot in the


NCAA Championship.

In 2017-18, Luellen's third season on The Plains, Auburn made its first trip back to the NCAA Championship since 2013 after finishing third in the NCAA Austin Regional. The Tigers placed fifth or better in five tournaments and also earned one individual title (Kayley Marschke, Lake Oconee Individual Championship). Senior Kelli Murphy was named to the All-SEC Second Team, and Kaleigh Telfer made the All-SEC Freshman Team.

With Luellen's help, Auburn has also hosted the Evans Derby Experience in each of the past two seasons. It's the first full-field, regular-season event hosted by the Tigers in nearly 10 years.

During her very successful tenure at Arizona State, Luellen led the program to an NCAA team title, 10 NCAA Top 10 finishes, two conference championships and 25 team titles. She also coached one NCAA Individual Champion, three Pac-12 Golfers of the Year, three NGCA Freshmen of the Year, 14 All-Americans and 21 individual tournament medalists.

Luellen's coaching accomplishments have earned her several personal coaching honors. After the Sun Devils' NCAA Championship run in 2009, she was named SkyCaddie NGCA National Coach of the Year. Luellen was also named Pac-10 Coach of the Year three times (2006, 2007, 2009) and West Regional Coach of the Year four times (2005, 2006, 2007, 2009). While at Tulsa, Luellen was named Central Regional Coach of the Year in 2002 and WAC Coach of the Year in 2001 and 2002.

Luellen's golfers have also achieved excellence in the classroom. NCAA Champion Azahara Munoz became the first two-time winner of the Edith Cummings Munson Award, which is given to the All-American with the highest grade point average. The following year, Sun Devil Juliana Murcia won the same honor.

In her two seasons as Tulsa's head coach, Luellen led her alma mater to seven tournament titles including back-to-back Western Athletic Conference and NCAA Central Regional championships in each year. The 2001-02 season saw her team win five tournaments, including the 2002 PING/ASU Championship at Karsten Golf Course, earn a No. 3 national ranking for most of the season, and finish 12th at the 2002 NCAA Championships. Luellen was named the Western Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in each of her two seasons and was the 2002 Central Regional Coach of the Year.

A four-time All-American for the Golden Hurricane, Luellen succeeded her mother, Dale McNamara, who retired in 2000 following a 26-year career that included four national championships.


After graduating with a bachelor's degree in Marketing from Tulsa in 1988, Luellen competed on the Futures and Ladies European Tours in 1988 and 1989 before qualifying for the LPGA Tour in October of 1989. She spent 11 years on the LPGA Tour, winning the 1991 Stratton Mountain LPGA Classic and teamed with Mike Springer to win the 1993 JC Penney Classic. She was also elected to the LPGA Executive Committee in her final two years on the tour.

Prior to college, she was a three-time Oklahoma state high school champion, a two-time Women's Oklahoma Golf Association Girls' Junior Champion (1981, 1982), the 1983 WOGA State Amateur, and the 1983 AJGA Player of the Year. Luellen was inducted into the Women's Golf Coaches Association Player Hall of Fame in 1998, the WGCA Coaches Hall of Fame in 2014 and the University of Tulsa Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000.

Luellen and her husband, Mark, have a son, Drake, and a daughter, Sydney.

## KIM HALL ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

Former LPGA and Stanford golfer Kim Hall is entering her fifth season of coaching on the Plains. Hall was initially hired as the volunteer assistant coach in August of 2018. She was then promoted to assistant coach in April of 2020.

"I am extremely grateful to Coach Luellen for the opportunity to be part of Auburn women's golf," Hall said. "This program has such great history and tradition, and it is truly an honor to be involved. I look forward to helping these young athletes succeed on and off the course."

Hall, a native of San Antonio, Texas, played five full seasons on the LPGA Tour from 2006-10, serving three seasons as Player Vice President on the LPGA Board of Directors. Her top finish as a professional was a third-place showing at the 2008 Bell Micro LPGA Classic. She retired from full-time competition in 2010 after the birth of her first child.

"We are thrilled to have Kim join me as our assistant coach," Luellen said. "Kim is an accomplished player and has been successful at every level. A competitive spirit and enthusiasm for excellence will fit in perfectly with our mission here at Auburn. Our players will truly benefit from her knowledge and experience."

Hall was a four-year letter winner at Stanford from 1999-2003. She was the team MVP for two seasons, earning one victory along with 13 top-10 finishes. She was also a three-time selection to the All-Pac 10 Team. Hall graduated from Stanford in 2003 with a degree in American studies and a

minor in political science.

As a junior golfer in San Antonio, she was the 1996 Texas state champion, the 1997 South Texas Player of the Year and a four-time junior All-American.

The former Kim Rowton is married to Casey Hall, and the couple resides in Auburn with their two children, Maggie and AJ.



## BLAYNE BARBER

### VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT COACH

Former Auburn golf legend and PGA Tour professional Blayne Barber joined the Auburn women's golf staff as a volunteer assistant for the 2022-23 season.

"We are thrilled to add Blayne to our coaching staff. His experience playing golf at the highest level will be a positive for our student-athletes," Luellen said. "More important than that is his strong character and desire to influence young people on and off the course."

Barber joins the staff after wrapping up a successful professional golf career that spanned from 2013-2022. Barber initially earned his PGA Tour card in 2015 and played on the tour for over four years.

"I love Auburn Golf, so when Coach Luellen asked me to join their squad as a volunteer assistant, it was an easy 'yes,'" said Barber about his new role. "We have a wonderful group of young women, and I can't wait to see what we achieve this year."

Prior to his time as a professional, Barber lettered for two seasons with the Auburn men's golf program (2010-2012) and is currently the program record holder for lowest career stroke average at 70.83. He also posted 32 rounds under

par and 24 rounds in the 60s during his time on the Plains.

In his senior season at Auburn, Barber became the first All-American first-team selection at Auburn since 1995 and finished the season ranked No. 7 in the country according to Golfweek. Barber is also one of two Tiger golfers to ever represent the United States at the prestigious Walker Cup. He also represented the United States at the Palmer Cup in 2011 and 2012.

Barber finished his collegiate career as a three-time All-American, a two-time first team All-SEC performer, and an All-American Scholar.

This is not Barber's first experience coaching collegiate golf, as he also served as the volunteer assistant for the Auburn men's golf team from 2019-2022.

The Lake City, Fla. native lives in Auburn, Ala. with his wife, Morgan, and his three children, Emma, Ford, and Lawson.
