» QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn is 5-0 at home this season and has outscored the opponent 51-13.
- The Tigers have homered in eight straight games to start the season, marking the longest season-opening home run streak since at least 1979.
- The team's 15 home runs through eight games are the most since 2009 (17).
- Auburn has stolen 22 bases this season, good for 11th in the country and second in the SEC.
- The team didn't steal its 22nd base last year until Apr. 6 (30 games).
- Cooper Weiss leads the SEC and is third in the country with 10 stolen bases.
- He has set the program's single-game record with four stolen bases twice in his first eight games.
- The starting rotation of Chase Allsup, Joseph Gonzalez and Carson Myers is a combined 3-0 with a 3.62 ERA through two weekends.
- The Tigers have allowed more than three runs just once in five home games.
- Auburn is 1-0 all-time against UConn, defeating the Huskies 7-3 in Port Charlotte, Florida, to begin the 2014 season.

Butch Thompson enters his ninth season at the helm of the program in 2023, posting a record of 256-187-1 in his first eight seasons. He has led the program to the College World Series in two of the last four seasons.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his ninth season with the Tigers in 2024.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in seven seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 256-187-1 overall record and has advanced to the NCAA Tournament five of the last six seasons, including three Super Regional appearances in the last five years and two trips to the College World Series in the last four seasons.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 33 Division I All-Americans and 46 all-conference performers. He has seen 21 of his former pitchers called up to Major League Baseball, including 15 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 39 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 16 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the program record No. 4 class in 2017 and No. 5 class in 2022. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally.

In 31 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 22 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached nine College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019 and taking the team back for the second time in three seasons in 2022. Thompson became one of five active SEC coaches who have taken their program to a pair of College World Series in a three-year span. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 19 postseason appearances.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

During his tenure with the Tigers, Thompson led the team to three straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2017-19 for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals in 2018 and 2019 for the first time in program history, and has now hosted back-to-back regionals for the first time in program history.

Auburn's second straight regional host bid in 2023 came thanks to a second-half run for the record books, and the Tigers became one of five programs in the country and two in the SEC to host each of the last two seasons.

Auburn posted a league-best 12-3 record in the final five weeks of conference play and finished the SEC season with 17 wins, the most since winning the SEC West in 2010. The Tigers finished top five in the league in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2002-03. The 12-3 stretch was the program's best since also going 12-3 in the final 15 games of the 2010 season and the nine-game SEC winning streak at the end of the regular season and first game of the SEC Tournament was the team's longest since 1995.

Auburn has finished six of Thompson's eight seasons in the top 25, including three in the top 10. The No. 5 national ranking to finish 2022 was tied for the second highest mark in program history.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series



finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 22 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the American Baseball Coaches Association.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. He is a member of both the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame (Class of 2014) and MACCC Hall of Fame (Class of 2021).

Thompson earned a Bachelor's Degree in History at BSC in 1992 and completed a Master's Degree in Sports Administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters -- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail --and the grandparents of Mary Gail Moreman.

THE FUTURE OF PLAINMAN PARK

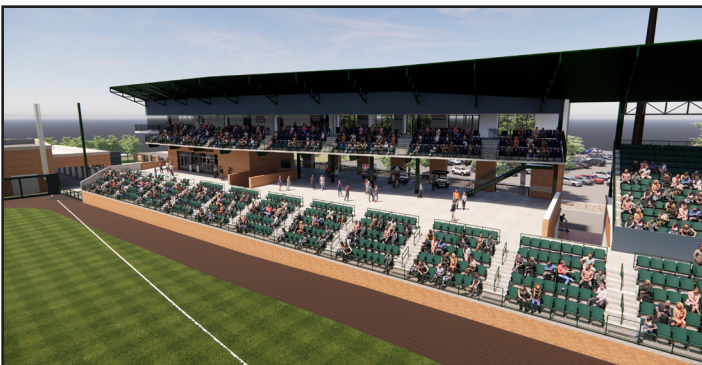
Auburn Athletics finalized plans for the previously approved \$30 million Plainsman Park renovation project last summer.

The renovations are highlighted by the additions of three new premium experiences – the Hall of Fame Club, First Base Club, and Home Plate Club – as well as a unique general admission space atop the War Eagle Wall in left field.



HALL OF FAME CLUB

A tribute to Auburn, Southeastern Conference and Major League Baseball great Frank Thomas, the Hall of Fame Club will add approximately 100 premium seats at field level and is open for the 2024 season. Divided between two tiered rows, these high-end leather seats will offer a dynamic field-level view behind home plate. Club members will have access to a 3,000-square foot climate-controlled club space featuring food, drinks, televisions, restrooms, and indoor seating.



FIRST BASE CLUB

A new three-story structure that will complement Plainsman Park’s classic ballpark architecture, the expanded Plainsman Patio and First Base Club will provide a variety of new fan experience offerings, including indoor and outdoor viewing areas, new concession offerings, expanded restrooms, and more. The space will be completed for the 2025 season.

At inner-concourse level, the new covered Plainsman Patio space will provide expanded standing room space, while offering access to an all-new walk-in concession market.

The third level will feature an all-new upscale ballpark experience with the First Base Club. This area is expected to include approximately 200 new seats ranging in type from cushioned chairback seats to outdoor loge seating options, and will offer elevated food and beverage options, a climate-controlled indoor space, as well as private restrooms.



HOME PLATE CLUB

By relocating the existing press box to a new location on the third level of the First Base Club structure, a new high-end club experience will be developed atop the home plate grandstands. With one of the best views in the ballpark, this area is expected to include approximately 50 high-end seats and a climate-controlled environment with access to food, drinks, restrooms, and more premium amenities. This space will be completed prior to the 2025 season.



WAR EAGLE WALL

The experience Auburn fans love within the Tiger Terrace along the third base line will soon be expanded to provide access to a unique experience atop the War Eagle Wall in left field. A general admission space that will be completed for the 2025 season, this project will add a two-tiered terrace atop the wall to provide a one-of-a-kind experience in college baseball.

ENHANCED STUDENT EXPERIENCE

As Auburn University students continue to pack Plainsman Park, the first phase of renovations prior to the 2024 season will provide an enhancement to the current standing room area beyond the right-center field fence. This portion of the project will provide a multi-tiered, elevated platform to bring students closer to the action while providing expanded standing room capacity.

EXPANDED AND RENOVATED TEAM SPACES

The third phase of the project will include upgrades to the student athlete experience through renovated and expanded team spaces. These upgrades include a renovation and expansion of the Tim Hudson Locker Room, a new bullpen and pitching lab, new weight room and nutrition area, new team meeting room, and new coaches’ offices. This phase of the project is scheduled to be completed throughout 2025-26.

SCOUTING THE HUSKIES

- Led by 21st-year head coach Jim Penders, UConn has played in game three of the Stanford Super Regional (2022) and won a game in the Gainesville Regional (2023) the last two seasons.
- The Huskies enter the weekend 2-4, coming off a series at Cal after opening the season with a couple of wins vs. Louisville and USF in the USF Baseball Tournament.
- Offensively, UConn has scored 27 runs in the first six games and is led by Korey Morton's .393 average.
- On the mound, Friday starter Garrett Coe has struck out 16 batters in two appearances and Sunday starter Stephen Quigley has turned in a 2.31 ERA in two starts.

JAX CLASSIC REWIND

- Auburn went 2-1 in the Jax College Baseball Classic with a comeback win vs. No. 18 Iowa, run-rule victory against Wichita State and hard-fought loss vs. No. 10 Virginia.
- Bobby Peirce was named the MVP after hitting two homers with six RBI. He was joined on the All-Tournament Team by Deric Fabian, Ike Irish and Cooper McMurray.

THOMPSON'S TENURE

- Auburn has hosted back-to-back regionals for the first time in program history and has made a NCAA regional in five of the last six postseasons under Butch Thompson.
- Prior to Thompson's arrival in 2016, Auburn made five tournament appearances in 14 seasons from 2002-15.
- The Tigers have also finished top five in the league in back-to-back years for the first time since 2002-03.
- The team has finished .500 or better in SEC play in four of the last six years under Thompson, and one of the seasons with a sub-.500 SEC record ended in Omaha (2019).
- Prior to Thompson's arrival, the program had turned in just one such season (2010) in 12 years between 2004-15.

PRESEASON ALL-SEC

- Ike Irish and Bobby Peirce earned Preseason All-SEC honors as voted on by the league's head coaches.
- Irish was a first-team honoree at designated hitter/utility player and Peirce was a second-team outfielder.

MR. ALL-AMERICA

- After becoming Auburn's 20th Freshman All-American in program history a season ago, including the program's first since 2018, Irish garnered Second Team Preseason All-America honors from the NCBWA.
- Irish set Auburn's freshman doubles record (24) and led freshmen nationally in the category.
- He started his sophomore season by going 4-for-5 with a homer and four RBI in the opener vs. ECU and is tied for the team lead with 11 RBI.
- His second homer of the season vs. UAB Tuesday came off the bat at 112 miles per hour.

.330+ HIT CLUB

- The Tigers' quartet of Irish (.361), Bryson Ware (.350), Peirce (.343) and Cole Foster (.336) became the program's first quartet of qualified hitters to hit .330 or higher in a season since 2010 and the SEC's first quartet to accomplish the feat since Kentucky did so in 2017.

100-HIT CLUB

- Sophomore catcher Ike Irish has collected 97 career hits in his first 66 games in an Auburn uniform and is approaching the 100-hit club at a near-record pace.

DIGGIN' THE LONG BALL

- Auburn has homered in eight straight games to start the season, the longest season-opening streak since at least 1979.
- The team's 15 homers through eight games are the most in the first eight games of a season since 2009 (17).
- Two of the program's top six home run totals have come in the last three seasons - 86 (2021) and 84 (2023) - and Auburn is one of three programs to have a player hit 20 or more home runs in each of the last two seasons - DiChiara (22 in 2022), Ware (24 in 2023).

COOP CRUSHES

- Redshirt junior Cooper McMurray has started to heat up, going 6-for-12 with two homers and nine RBI in the last four games, and is tied for the team lead with three home runs and 11 RBI, six of which came vs. Wichita State.
- His 14 homers in 2023 were the third most by an Auburn newcomer in the BBCOR era - DiChiara (22 in 2022), Julien (17 in 2018).
- Eleven of McMurray's homers last year came in conference play, tied for the eighth most in the league, and he became Auburn's first player since 2010 with three multi-homer SEC performances.

FABIAN WENT OFF IN FLORIDA

- Returning to his home state, junior infielder Deric Fabian went 4-for-7 with a double, homer and four RBI in three games in Jacksonville.
- Through eight games, Fabian is second on the team with a .333 average and is tied for the team lead with 11 RBI, 10 of which have come in the last six games.

ARMS APLENTY

- Auburn returns nearly 80 percent of its inning pitched from a season ago, including seven of its top eight innings guys.

CARSON CARVED 'EM UP

- The son of a former Auburn pitching coach, Carson Myers made his debut in the series finale vs. ECU and turned in 6.0 scoreless innings with a career-high eight strikeouts.
- The 6.0 innings were the most by an Auburn pitcher on Opening Weekend since Casey Mize also pitched 6.0 innings in 2018.
- Myers went on to be named the SEC Co-Pitcher of the Week, becoming the first Auburn pitcher to earn the distinction since Joseph Gonzalez in 2022.

WELCOME BACK, GONZO

- Redshirt junior Joseph Gonzalez returned to the Tigers rotation after making only one appearance (Opening Weekend) last year.
- He earned the win in the series-clinching victory against ECU opening weekend, allowing just one unearned run on two hits in 5.0 innings, and earned his second win in a run-rule victory vs. Wichita State Saturday.
- He has earned a win in three straight starts dating back to opening weekend in 2023.
- Gonzalez led Auburn with a 7-4 record and 3.22 ERA in 15 appearances and 14 starts during the team's run to Omaha in 2022.

CANNON THE CLOSER

- Junior right-hander Will Cannon returns to the closer role after ranking tied for fifth in the SEC in the category a season ago.
- Cannon finished the game in 15 of his 20 relief appearances, the fourth most games finished in the league last year, and has done so in both of his appearances this year.
- He was tabbed to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award Preseason Watch List after being named to the midseason list last year.

RUNNING AT A RECORD-SETTING RATE

- Graduate transfer Cooper Weiss has set Auburn's single-game record with four stolen bases twice in his first eight games - Feb. 18 vs. ECU and Feb. 27 vs. Samford.
- Weiss leads the SEC and ranks third in the NCAA with 10 stolen bases this season.
- Auburn has stolen 22 bases through eight games, marking the most through seven games since 2012 (27).
- The Tigers didn't reach 22 stolen bases last season until Apr. 6 (30 games).

TOP-RANKED TRANSFERS

- Auburn was tabbed by D1Baseball.com to have the No. 14 transfer class in the country.
- The team's five transfers in the top 130 are tied for the sixth most in the nation.
 - Deric Fabian (Florida): No. 29
 - Mason Maners (Jax State): No. 77
 - Javon Hernandez (Jax State): No. 86
 - Cooper Weiss (Miami [OH]): No. 116
 - Carson Myers (UAB): No. 129
