**Shekinna Stricklen • Tennessee
Junior • Forward • Morrilton, Arkansas**

- Leading the Lady Vols to three tough wins last week, Shekinna Stricklen averaged 17.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg, 2.3 apg and 1.7 spg.
- At #15/18-ranked Kentucky, she recorded her eighth double double of the season and 14th of her career with 20 points and 12 rebounds.
- Continued her dominant stretch with 17 points, including 12 in the first half on 4-of-5 shooting, and grabbed six boards.
- Against Vanderbilt, Stricklen scored 14 points (12 in the second half) on 4-of-8 shooting and grabbed nine boards. She also dished three assists. It's her seventh straight double figure game.

Freshman of the Week



**Meighan Simmons • Tennessee
Guard • Cibolo, Texas**

- Against #15/18 Kentucky on the road, rookie Meighan Simmons stayed tough and focused, scoring 15 points and making some big shots down the stretch. Simmons' three with 4:25 left in the game put UT up 65-61. She also increased Tennessee's cushion to 71-67 with two clutch free throws with 15 seconds left in the contest.
- Against Vanderbilt on the road, Meighan Simmons' three-pointer with 5:54 left in the game gave UT a 44-42 advantage - its first lead since being up 5-2 at the 16:01 mark in the first half. She followed that with a key steal and a fastbreak bucket two minutes later.
- In three games, she averaged 9.3 ppg, 1.7 rpg while hitting clutch shots in two come from behind wins on the road.

2011 SEC Tournament



On Feb. 7, 1980, the first SEC women's basketball tournament began play. It ended four days later with Tennessee defeating Ole Miss for the title. Fast forward 31 years later and the SEC Tournament is still enjoying success and increased popularity.

Beginning with its inception and through 1986, the tournament was held at campus sites. The tournament was then sent to Albany, Ga., which served as the site for six years from 1987-92. The tournament then moved to Chattanooga, Tenn., where it was held from 1993-2000, with the exception of 1998 when the tournament moved to Columbus, Ga.

Since 2001 the tournament has enjoyed many new sites, including Memphis (2001), Nashville (2002, 2004, 2008, 2011), North Little Rock, Ark. (2003, 2006, 2009), Greenville, S.C. (2005) and Duluth, Ga. (2007, 2010).

The winner of the 11-game tournament will receive the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. The tournament seeds and conference champion will be determined by the 16-game regular-season SEC schedule. The top four seeds earn a first-round bye.

The 2011 SEC Women's Basketball Tournament will once again enjoy live television coverage. FSN continues its dedication to SEC events by televising all first round and all second round games. They can be seen on SportSouth, FS Southwest and SUN Sports. The semifinals will be aired on ESPNU, while the championship game will again be televised on ESPN2.

Public tickets for this year's event went on sale October 1 and can be purchased through the SEC website or by calling 1-800-732-4849.

Prices are: reserved tournament book, \$90; general admission Dr Pepper Six-Pack tournament book, \$60; reserved single-session (six sessions total), \$17; and general admission single-session, \$12 (can only be purchased day of event at arena box office).

Team Notes

Alabama: Senior forward Tierney Jenkins scored a game-high 18 points to lead the Alabama women's basketball team to a 64-59 win over the Florida Gators in its first game at newly renovated Foster Auditorium on Sunday afternoon. Junior guard Ericka Russell and freshman forward Kaneisha Horn each scored 12 points as the Crimson Tide notched its first victory in the historic building since last playing here on Dec. 3, 1981. Trailing 34-24 at intermission, Alabama embarked on a 13-1 run over the first 6:04 of the second half to take a 37-35 lead. During the stretch, the Tide forced 10 Florida turnovers, including five straight at one point, and held the Gators without a field goal.

Arkansas: Junior Ashley Daniels scored a career-best 22 points and tied her career-best with 11 rebounds Sunday against Auburn. Arkansas (16-8, 4-8 SEC) had a pair of players in Daniels and sophomore Sarah Watkins in double digits with Watkins scoring 12 and pulling in 10 boards. The Razorbacks are in the home portion of their schedule with four SEC regular season games, five total games and the SEC Tournament remaining on the schedule. Junior Lyndsay Harris enters this week (Ole Miss) with 993 career points needing just seven point to become the 24th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point milestone.

Auburn: The Auburn women's basketball team (14-11, 7-5 SEC) went 1-1 last week with a 52-55 loss at LSU and a 64-59 win at Arkansas. Senior Alli Smalley led the Tigers on the week with 18.5 points and 6.0 rebounds per game. Freshman Courtney Strain followed with 8.5 points, including a career-high 12 points at Arkansas. Sophomore Blanche Alverson led the team in rebounding with 6.5 per game. At LSU, Auburn led early in the second half, but a 16-3 LSU run put the Bayou Bengals up for good. Auburn hit three 3-pointers in the final 39 seconds, but could not get over the hump in the three-point loss.

Florida: The Gators have a midweek bye and return to competition on Sunday, Feb. 20 playing host to Mississippi State at 4:30 p.m. Florida has just three regular-season games remaining prior to the start of the SEC Tournament. The Gator's remaining dates include Feb. 24 at Vanderbilt and Feb. 27 hosting Georgia. These last three games all will be the second time the teams will be playing each other this season. Florida defeated MSU 67-60 during the Jan. 30 contest in Starkville and has won four consecutive games in the series against the MSU Lady Bulldogs.

Georgia: Georgia enters this week with a 19-6 overall record and a 9-3 mark in SEC play. The Lady Bulldogs are one victory shy of their 26th 20-win season under Andy Landers. The Lady Bulldogs suffered their first home loss last Thursday, dropping a 69-59 decision to Vanderbilt after 11 straight home wins. Georgia rallied from a 16-point deficit with 8:59 remaining to pull within one with 2:56 left but failed on four chances to tie the game. Porsha Phillips led the Lady Bulldogs with 12 points. The Lady Bulldogs rebounded with a 61-56 victory at Ole Miss on Sunday. Jasmine James scored a game-high 19 points. James was playing in front of about 40 family and friends from her hometown of Memphis.

Kentucky: Kentucky snapped a two-game losing streak Sunday with a thrilling last-second win over LSU in front of a season-high 7,646 fans in Memorial Coliseum. A'dia Mathies found Brittany Henderson open in the paint with :04 seconds remaining, giving UK a 49-47 win over the visiting Lady Tigers. It marked UK's first win in Lexington over LSU since 1994. Mathies recorded a game-high 16 points and four steals in the win, her third-straight game with 16 or more points. All-America candidate Victoria Dunlap added 15 points, a team-high four rebounds and a game-high three blocks.

LSU: The LSU Lady Tigers went 1-1 last week with a 55-52 win over Auburn and a near upset of No. 15 Kentucky in Lexington on Sunday. LSU held the Wildcats to their lowest point total of the SEC season, but Brittany Henderson's layup with four seconds left lifted UK past LSU, 49-47. LSU sits at 17-10 and 7-6 in SEC play. LaSondra Barrett recorded her 11th career double-double in the loss with 11 points a career-high 14 rebounds. The 14 boards were the most by an LSU player since Kristen Morris grabbed 16 rebounds in the 2009 NCAA Tournament First Round versus Green Bay. Katherine Graham led LSU with 18 points against Auburn.

Ole Miss: Ole Miss fell to No. 24 Georgia Sunday afternoon. With the loss the Rebels fell to 10-14 overall and 3-9 in the SEC. Ole Miss' last two losses against top-25 teams have been six points or fewer. Valencia McFarland led Ole Miss with 15 points against Georgia and she has scored at least 15 points in the last four games and at least 15 points in six of the last seven games. Maggie McFerrin scored a career-high 12 points for Ole Miss in a career-high four three pointers. Nikki Byrd also scored in double figures against Georgia with 10 points. With the loss Ole Miss fell to 6-7 at home this year.

Mississippi State: Despite a four-point half-time lead, Mississippi State (10-14, 2-10 SEC) dropped a 60-53 decision to South Carolina on Sunday. The Lady Bulldogs shot 39 percent for the game but allowed South Carolina to shoot 55 percent in the second half and were outscored 41-30 in the final 20 minutes. Diamber Johnson led the scoring charge for MSU, pouring in 21 points on 8-18 shooting. Ashley Brown added 10 points while Mary Kathryn Govero had seven. Mississippi State will continue its homestand Thursday at the Humphrey Coliseum when they play host to Vanderbilt. Game time is set for 7 p.m.

South Carolina: South Carolina has won five of its last six games en route to a 7-5 SEC record and a 15-10 mark overall. Both win totals are high-water marks in the Dawn Staley era as the seven SEC wins ties last season's mark. South Carolina has been 7-5 SEC record since 2002-03, a season that ended in the second round of the NCAA Tournament. The Gamecocks' defense has locked down in the last six games, holding four of six opponents below 60 points and forcing 16.0 turnovers per game. Offensively, South Carolina had three players average double figures last week as junior guard Markeshia Grant joined the regular double-figure scoring duo of Ieasia Walker and La'Keisha Sutton.

Tennessee: Tennessee has won the last 15 games dating back to a Dec. 14 loss at now #1-ranked Baylor. The Lady Vols have also collected 23 consecutive SEC regular season victories – UT's last loss was at #8-ranked Georgia, 53-50, on Jan. 21, 2010. After feeling like January road warriors, the Lady Vols will enjoy a little time at home entertaining South Carolina (Feb. 17), Georgia (Feb. 21) and LSU (Feb. 27) with one travel date remaining to Ole Miss (Feb. 24). Tennessee has a 31-game home court winning streak on "The Summitt." Currently, it is the fourth longest active streak in the NCAA for women's hoops.

Vanderbilt: Vanderbilt split its two game last week, winning at No. 24 Georgia on Thursday and suffering its first home loss of the year to No. 4 Tennessee on Sunday. Vanderbilt was bidding to start 13-0 at home for the first time in school history, but lost a 13-point lead. Vanderbilt is 17-8 overall and 8-4 in the SEC. Before the loss to Tennessee, Vanderbilt had won four in a row, moving from fifth to second in the SEC during that stretch. Vanderbilt was led by Jence Rhoads' 15 points and Hannah Tuomi's 12 rebounds. The Commodores play at Mississippi State on Thursday and host Kentucky in their Pink Out game on Sunday.

SEC In The Polls

In terms of rankings, the SEC has the richest history of any conference in the nation, boasting more poll appearances than any other.

Since the 1982-83 season, SEC teams have been ranked in the AP poll for 529 consecutive weeks. League teams have been ranked 2,642 times including 1,303 Top 10 appearances and 740 Top Five appearances.

Overall, the league teams have been ranked 604 consecutive weeks, with teams ranked a total of 2,799 times. The SEC has 1,441 Top 10 appearances and 798 Top Five appearances overall.

SEC teams can also boast of 136 No. 1 rankings in the AP Poll and had had the top three teams in the AP Poll twice. In week three in 2005 and in week eight in 1989.

A nation-leading eight SEC teams were ranked at one point in the AP and CNN/USA Today Top 25 polls during the 1995-96 season. The league mirrored that feat during the 1996-97 season.
