

COACHING HISTORY

Auburn - Head 2015-Arizona State - Head 2003-2015 Tulsa - Head 2001-2002 Melissa Luellen is entering her ninth season as Auburn's head women's golf coach in 2023-24. She came to Auburn after spending the previous 13 years as the head coach at Arizona State, leading the program to an NCAA title in 2009, and then two years prior to that as the head coach at the University of Tulsa.

While at Auburn, Luellen guided the Tigers to three consecutive appearances in the NCAA Championship from 2019-2022, including a top-four finish in 2019 and 2022.

During the 2022-23 season, the Tigers finished in the top-5 in nine of 11 events played with two victories at the prestigious East Lake Cup in Atlanta and the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic in Athens, Georgia. The team captured a second place finish during the stroke play portion of the 2023 SEC Championship and earned the team's sixth consecutive NCAA Regional bid and the 28th in program history. The team set the second lowest all-time overall scoring average (290.73), par-4 scoring average (4.16), par-5 scoring average (4.89) and the lowest all-time par-3 scoring average (3.14). The Tigers also set the record for lowest 54-hole team score (835) as well as the second lowest 18-hole team score (274) at the Illini Women's Invitational.

Senior Megan Schofill received the program's 12th first-team All-American honor following the 2022-23 season and was a first team All-SEC member as well. Schofill and junior Elina Sinz each earned individual victories at the Mason Rudolph Championship and the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic, respectively. Junior Anna Foster received a second-team All-SEC nod and Casey Weidenfeld became the 10th Auburn golfer to be named to the SEC All-Freshman team.

In the 2021-22 season, the Tigers captured seven top five finishes and won the stroke play portion of the SEC Championship. They went on to finish in a tie for third at the NCAA Stillwater Regional and finished as a semifinalist at the NCAA Championship in Scottsdale.

In 2019-20, the season was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In seven tournaments, Auburn finished top five in five of them and won the Lake Oconee Invitational. Kaleigh Telfer and Megan Schofill both earned individual medalist honors with Telfer winning the Northrop Grumman Regional Challenge and Schofill taking first at Lake Oconee.

The 2018-19 season proved to be a breakthrough season for Auburn under Luellen. Not only did the team finish as a national semifinalist, they also captured two tournament victories: the Battle at the Beach and the Shootout at Shoal Creek. The Tigers tied for third in the SEC Championship, making it to the semifinals of match play, and they placed fifth in the NCAA Auburn Regional to earn their spot in the NCAA Championship.

Individually, four different players won titles in 2018-19 with Anika Bolcikova (Magnolia Invitational), Kaleigh Telfer (Battle at the Beach), Brooke Sansom (Shootout at Shoal Creek) and Julie McCarthy (Clemson Invitational). It's the first time that's happened since the 2011-12 season.

Julie McCarthy, who finished with the sixth-lowest stroke average per round (72.90) in single-season history, earned First-Team All-SEC and Honorable Mention All-American honors while teammate Brooke Sansom was named to the All-SEC Freshman Team.

In 2017-18, Luellen's third season on The Plains, Auburn made its first trip back to the NCAA Championship since 2013 after finishing third in the NCAA Austin Regional. The Tigers placed fifth or better in five tournaments and also earned one individual title (Kayley Marschke, Lake Oconee Individual Championship). Senior Kelli Murphy was named to the All-SEC Second Team, and Kaleigh Telfer made the All-SEC Freshman Team.

During her very successful tenure at Arizona State, Luellen led the program to an NCAA team title, 10 NCAA Top 10 finishes, two conference championships and 25 team titles. She also coached one NCAA Individual Champion, three Pac-12 Golfers of the Year, three NGCA Freshmen of the Year, 14 All-Americans and 21 individual tournament medalists.

Luellen's coaching accomplishments have earned her several personal coaching honors. After the Sun Devils' NCAA Championship run in 2009, she was named SkyCaddie NGCA National Coach of the Year. Luellen was also named Pac-10 Coach of the Year three times (2006, 2007, 2009) and West Regional Coach of the Year four times (2005, 2006, 2007, 2009). While at Tulsa, Luellen was named Central Regional Coach of the Year in 2002 and WAC Coach of the Year in 2001 and 2002.



Luellen's golfers have also achieved excellence in the classroom. NCAA Champion Azahara Munoz became the first two-time winner of the Edith Cummings Munson Award, which is given to the All-American with the highest grade point average. The following year, Sun Devil Juliana Murcia won the same honor.

In her two seasons as Tulsa's head coach, Luellen led her alma mater to seven tournament titles including back-to-back West-ern Athletic Conference and NCAA Central Regional championships in each year. The 2001-02 season saw her team win five tournaments, including the 2002 PING/ASU Championship at Karsten Golf Course, earn a No. 3 national ranking for most of the season, and finish 12th at the 2002 NCAA Championships. Luellen was named the Western Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in each of her two seasons and was the 2002 Central Regional Coach of the Year.

A four-time All-American for the Golden Hurricane, Luellen succeeded her mother, Dale McNamara, who retired in 2000 following a 26-year career that included four national championships.

As a player at Tulsa, Luellen won medalist honors at four tournaments and recorded 22 top-10 finishes in 41 career events. She capped off a stellar collegiate career by capturing a two-stroke individual victory at the 1988 NCAA Championship while leading the Golden Hurricanes to the national team title.

After graduating with a bachelor's degree in Marketing from Tulsa in 1988, Luellen competed on the Futures and Ladies European Tours in 1988 and 1989 before qualifying for the LPGA Tour in October of 1989. She spent 11 years on the LPGA Tour, winning the 1991 Stratton Mountain LPGA Classic and teamed with Mike Springer to win the 1993 JC Penney Classic. She was also elected to the LPGA Executive Committee in her final two years on the tour.

Prior to college, she was a three-time Oklahoma state high school champion, a two-time Women's Oklahoma Golf Association Girls' Junior Champion (1981, 1982), the 1983 WOGA State Amateur, and the 1983 AJGA Player of the Year. Luellen was inducted into the Women's Golf Coaches Association Player Hall of Fame in 1998, the WGCA Coaches Hall of Fame in 2014 and the University of Tulsa Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000.

Luellen and her husband, Mark, have a son, Drake, and a daughter, Sydney.



Kim Hall Associate Head Coach

Former LPGA and Stanford golfer Kim Hall joined the Auburn women's golf staff as a volunteer assistant coach prior to the 2018-19 season. Head coach Melissa Luellen then named Hall assistant coach on April 8th, 2020 and Hall was promoted to associate head coach before the 2022-23 season.

"Kim is a natural coach," Luellen said about Hall. "She possesses a daily quest for excellence with integrity and positivity. She has a thirst for knowledge and loves supporting our student-athletes and helping them grow and improve on and off the course. She is an excellent role model for our players to emulate."

Hall, a native of San Antonio, Texas, played five full seasons on the LPGA Tour from 2006-10, serving three seasons as Player Vice President on the LPGA Board of Directors. Her top finish as a professional was a third-place showing at the 2008 Bell Micro LPGA Classic. She retired from full-time competition in 2010 after the

birth of her first child.

Hall was a four-year letter winner at Stanford from 1999-2003. She was the team MVP for two seasons, earning one victory along with 13 top-10 finishes. She was also a three-time selection to the All-Pac 10 Team. Hall graduated from Stanford in 2003 with a degree in American studies and a minor in political science.

As a junior golfer in San Antonio, she was the 1996 Texas state champion, the 1997 South Texas Player of the Year and a four-time junior All-American.

The former Kim Rowton is married to Casey Hall, and the couple resides in Auburn with their two children, Maggie and AJ.

Additionally, Alexander led Louisiana State University to a pair of SEC titles in 1986 and 1987 as the head coach of the program from 1982 to 1987.

Golfers under Alexander's tutelage have produced 50-plus first team all-conference selections and 40-plus victories on the PGA tour.

A native of St. Petersburg, Florida, Alexander is a 1975 and 1980 graduate of Georgia Southern University where he was a two-time All-American as a student-athlete. He is married to Joan Alexander, who currently serves at the Tigers' director of operations for both the men's and women's programs, and is the father of Tyson Alexander, a current member of the PGA Tour, and Cortnee Gilchrist, the Director of the Spirit Squad at the University of Florida.

Jack Key Golf Teaching Facility



The Jack Key Golf Teaching Facility is named after Jack Key, a 1950 Auburn graduate and four-year letterman from Columbus, Georgia and features three indoor hitting bays, lounge and locker rooms, club repair and video analysis. Utilizing 29 acres, the practice facility features a range of nearly 400 yards with tees at both ends allowing players to train in a variety of wind conditions.







2022-23 Season In-Review

Auburn received the 28th NCAA Tournament bid in program history and the sixth consecutive bid in 2023. The Tigers finished the 2022-23 season with two team tournament victories (East Lake Cup, Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic) as well as two individual tournament victories (Mason Rudolph Championship, Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic).

The team set the second lowest all-time overall scoring average (290.73), par-4 scoring average (4.16), par-5 scoring average (4.89) and the lowest all-time par-3 scoring average (3.14). The Tigers also set the record for lowest 54-hole team score (835) as well as the second lowest 18-hole team score (274) at the Illini Women's Invitational.

Megan Schofill earned her fourth All-SEC team honor and second First-team All-SEC honor. Schofill also broke the program record for most rounds under par (43) and continues to hold the lowest career scoring average (72.14. The Auburn senior had a memorable season and continues to make her presence felt in the Auburn record books. In October, Schofill shot 207 (-9) to win the individual title at the Mason Rudolph Championship in Franklin, Tennessee for her third career individual victory and SEC Player of the Week recognition following the win. She also posted a runner-up individual finish at the 2023 SEC Championship. Schofill's 205 (-11) at the Illini Women's Invitational at Medinah in the fall tied her for the second all-time lowest 54-hole score in Auburn history, and her second round 65 (-7) at the event tied the second lowest 18-hole score in program history.

Anna Foster received back-to-back All-SEC honors with a second-team nod and her career scoring average of 73.06 (minimum 60 rounds) places her third in program history and she also sits seventh in program history in rounds under par at 25.

Casey Weidenfeld became the 10th Auburn golfer to be named to the SEC All-Freshman team. The Penbroke Pines, Florida native broke 60 four times this season and holds a perfect 3-0 record in match play events. Weidenfeld was named SEC Freshman of the Week in November after her performance at the 2022 East Lake Cup garnered national attention.



2023 U.S. Women's Amateur



Auburn's Megan Schofill won the 123rd U.S. Women's Amateur Championship, defeating Latanna Stone 4&3 in the 36-hole championship match in 2023. Schofill became the first Auburn player to ever win the event as Maria Martinez previously held the best U.S. Women's Amateur finish by a Tiger with runner-up honors in 2005. Schofill won the event in her third appearance since arriving on the Plains in 2019.

"It's definitely a dream come true, but I'd be lying if I wouldn't say I'm still in shock," Schofill said after the victory. "I feel like it still hasn't set in yet. Latanna [Stone] played a great match. It was really fun to be able to walk the fairways with her. And I felt like we both played really solid golf. I can't put into words the emotions I'm feeling and it's just such an honor to be able to say that I won this year."

In addition to a gold medal and custody of the Robert Cox Trophy for one year, Schofill also receives an exemption from qualifying for the 2024 U.S. Women's Open, an exemption from qualifying for the next 10 U.S. Women's Amateurs (if eligible) and an invitation to the 2024 Augusta National Women's Amateur. The victory will also likely give the Monticello, Florida native exemptions into the Chevron Championship, AIG Women's Open and Amundi Evian Championship.

"Just so excited for Megan," said Auburn Head Coach Melissa Luellen. "She truly played better golf than anyone else in the field this week. She swung the club so beautifully and when she lost a hole she fought right back. I am so honored that I was able to be here this week to witness it."

Stone, a fifth-year senior at LSU, took the initial lead with a win on the fifth hole, but Schofill gathered the lead with back-to-back wins on No. 7 and No. 8. Stone again tied the match with a birdie on the 12th hole before Schofill erupted with three consecutive

wins on holes 15 though 17 to take a commanding 3-up lead at the 18-hole break.



The two traded victories to begin the second set of 18 holes before halving the next three straight. After Stone closed her deficit to two holes with a birdie on the 24th hole, Schofill responded with back-to-back wins on the following two holes to expand the lead to 4-up.

A Stone victory on the 32nd hole moved Schofill's lead back to 3-up, but Schofill's win on the 33rd hole secured the championship victory.

After posting a 4-under 136 in the stroke play portion of the event to advance to match play, Schofill recorded match play victories over Jackie Rogowicz, Kelly Xu, Caitlin Peirce, fifth ranked world amateur Anna Davis and Hailey Borja to make it to the final match.
