AUBURN WILL SELECT ONE CO-ED SQUAD MADE UP OF 10 FEMALES, 10 MALES, & ONE MIC-MAN, FOR 2024-2025.

- Must have been enrolled as a full-time Auburn University student Fall Semester, 2023.
- Must be currently enrolled as a full-time Auburn University student now, during Spring Semester, 2024 classes.
- NO <u>FIRST SEMESTER</u> AUBURN UNIVERSITY STUDENT MAY TRY OUT.
- NO <u>CURRENT</u> HIGH SCHOOL OR <u>CURRENT</u> TRANSFER STUDENT, WHO IS ENROLLED THIS SEMESTER AT ANOTHER COLLEGE OR SCHOOL, MAY TRY OUT.
- Must have an overall cumulative <u>Auburn</u> Grade Point Average of a 2.0 or better.

The 2024-2025 Auburn Cheerleading tryout application, grade release form and \$50 application fee are due by <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>May 1 at 4:45 p.m.</u> in order to be eligible to try out this year. You can turn the packet in at an upcoming clinic or contact Latisha Durroh at <u>Latisha@auburn.edu</u> to make arrangements to drop them off.

REQUIREMENTS FOR FEMALES:

Back handspring, Standing Back Tuck, Toss Extension, Liberty, Dance to two Auburn Band Songs, which will include tumbling and/or stunts, 3 cheers: Bodda Getta, TI GE R S and Shove It, an Optional Stunt, and an Entrance which <u>MUST</u> include running tumbling (must perform a Round off and at least 3 back handsprings in a row or more, at a minimum. May perform layouts, tucks, fulls, etc.).

REQUIREMENTS FOR MALES:

Toss Extension, Liberty, two Auburn Band Songs, which will include stunts, 3 cheers: Bodda Getta, TI GE R S, and Shove It, Optional Stunt, and an Entrance, which may include running an Auburn flag. Tumbling is not required for males but can be substituted for running the flag in the Entrance.

REQUIREMENTS FOR MIC-MAN:

Bodda Getta, Track 'Em, Two Bits, Spell out Auburn, War Eagle (at the end of Spell out), Cheer of your choice, Orange/Blue or Auburn/Tigers, It's Great to be an Auburn Tiger, an Entrance, which may include running an Auburn flag and a Game Day Situation (that will be given to the candidate on tryout day. The candidate must do a cheer to match the game day situation given).

CLINICS:

Clinic 1- Sunday, April 14 from 2:00-5:00 p.m. Clinic 2- Thursday, April 18 from 6:00-9:00 p.m. Clinic 3- Monday, April 22 from 6:00-9:00 p.m. Clinic 4- Thursday, April 25 from 6:00-9:00 p.m.

All clinics are open to current Auburn University students only, are free and will be held in the old Auburn Football indoor practice facility, across from Watson Fieldhouse/behind the Auburn Athletic Complex.
