

AUBURN TEAM STORYLINES

SEC SUCCESS: Auburn's program has had a lot of success at the SEC Championship, including a semifinal apperance in 2022 and 2023 as well as a championship win in 2021. Auburn boasts 10 titles since the event's inception in 1981, which is the second most of any school in the league. Additionally, six Tigers have been crowned SEC individual champions in program history and Megan Schofill has finished as the event's runner-up in each of the last two seasons.

LAST RIDE AT AUBURN: Megan Schofill is in her fifth and final season on the Plains in 2023-24. Schofill garnered national attention in August by winning the 2023 U.S. Women's Amatuer Championship at Bel-Air Country Club. Schofill became the first Auburn player to ever win the event as Maria Martinez previously held the best U.S. Women's Amateur finish by a Tiger with runner-up honors in 2005.

In addition to a gold medal and custody of the Robert Cox Trophy for one year, Schofill also received an exemption from qualifying for the 2024 U.S. Women's Open, an exemption from qualifying for the next 10 U.S. Women's Amateurs (if eligible) and an invitation to the 2024



Augusta National Women's Amateur. The victory will also give the Tiger exemptions into the Chevron Championship, AIG Women's Open and Amundi Evian Championship. The Monticello, Florida native is Auburn's all-time leader in career scoring average (72.01) and rounds under par (54).

FRESHMAN PHENOM: Auburn welcomed 2022 Augusta National Women's Amateur Champion, 2023 World Amateur Team USA member and two-time Junior Solheim Cup team member Anna Davis to its roster in January. Davis has participated in all five team events for the Tigers this spring and has posted two top-10 finishes and a 72.20 scoring average. In Auburn's most recent event at the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic, Davis shot 3-under (213) and finished runner-up individually.



WEIDENFELD'S WORLD: Redshirt sophomore Casey Weidenfeld has made a major impact on the Auburn's lineup during the 2023-24 season. After being named to the SEC All-Freshman team last season, Weidenfeld has finished top-10 three times this season, including a runner-up finish at the Mason Rudolph Championship. Weidenfeld shot a 206 (-10) at the event, which tied the fourth-lowest 54-hole score in program history.

Weidenfeld also recieved her first invitation to the Augusta National Women's Amateur in 2024 where she made the 36-hole cut and fired a 2-under 214 (-2) in the event to finish in a tie for fifth place. Her finish marked the highest by an Auburn golfer at the prestigous tournament only behind Anna Davis, who won the event in 2022

prior to joining the Tigers.

COMPETING IN THE OPEN: Auburn senior Anna Foster qualified for the 2023 AIG Women's Open at Walton Heath Golf Club in August. Foster qualified for the prestigious tournament through the Hankley Common final qualifying event.

The Auburn senior fired a 3-under 69 in the qualifier to secure a spot in the field, which was awarded to the top 12 finishers. The Dublin, Ireland native was one of 10 amateurs and one of two Irish players that participated in the event in 2023


