#### WELCOMING THE BEARS

» Auburn hosts the California Bears on Saturday, September 7, at Jordan-Hare Stadium in Auburn, Ala. ESPN2 will televise the 2:30 p.m. CT non-conference matchup, a return of last year's contest in Berkeley.

Fans are asked to wear white. The 2024 NCAA runner-up men's track team and the 2004 NCAA swimming and diving national championship team will be among those recognized.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

- » Auburn leads the series with California by a 1-0 margin. The first meeting was last September 9 at Memorial Stadium in Berkeley, when Auburn posted a 14-10 win in the first road contest of the Hugh Freeze era.
- » Auburn holds a 123-83-9 (.593) overall record against current members of the Atlantic Coast Conference: Boston College (1-2); Clemson (34-15-2); Florida State (13-5-1); Georgia Tech (47-41-4); Louisville (2-0); Miami (7-4); North Carolina (2-4); North Carolina State (1-1); Syracuse (1-1-1); Virginia (2-1); Virginia Tech (3-1-1); and Wake Forest (7-2). Auburn's last meeting with an ACC team was a 14-6 loss at Clemson in 2017. Auburn is 53-17-1 when playing at home, 57-52-5 on the road and 13-14-3 in neutral-site locations against these teams.

### **IN SEPTEMBER**

» Auburn is 187-62-5 (.746) all-time in the month of September; the Tigers are 120-24-1 (.831) all-time at home in September, and 67-38-4 (.631) away from Auburn in that month. Since 1970, the Tigers have had a winning record in the month of September in 46 of 53 seasons.

The Tigers are 5-0 all-time in games played on September 7 and 5-0 in Auburn on that date.

- "The 70-point win over Alabama A&M was a Jordan-Hare Stadium record, breaking the old record margin of 66 set against Chattanooga in 1995 (76-10) and ULM in 2003 (73-7)
- » Captains for 2024 are Eugene Asante, Luke Deal, Jerrin Thompson and Payton Thorne. Deal is a two-year captain, while Thorne, twice captain at Michigan State, is one of two current four-year FBS captains, along with Utah's Cameron Rising
- » Auburn season tickets sold out for the second consecutive season at a record 63,500 purchased; the capacity at Jordan-Hare Stadium is 88,043

### IN THE SEASON OPENER

» Auburn's 73-3 victory over Alabama A&M was a recordsetter all around. It was the ninth win by 70 or more points in program history and the first since a 77-0 win over Erskine in 1932.

The 70-point win is also a Jordan-Hare Stadium record, breaking the old mark set in a 76-10 victory over Chattanooga in 1995, and a 73-7 victory over ULM in 2003.

The 73 points are the second-most Auburn has ever scored in a season opener and the most since scoring 78 points against Marion to open the 1915 season.

Auburn's 451 passing yards rank second in program single-game totals, behind Nick Marshall's 456 yards in the 2014 Iron Bowl.

28 is the most points scored in the first quarter by Auburn since the 2018 Music City Bowl vs. Purdue, and 52 is the most first-half points for Auburn since 56 vs. Purdue in the 2018 Music City Bowl. 49 points ties the largest halftime lead since that Purdue bowl game.

Jarquez Hunter's first-quarter TD with 14:13 remaining was the fastest score at the start of any Auburn game since 2010 against Chattanooga (14:30; pass from Cam Newton to Darvin Adams).

436 yards were the most yards of total offense in the first half by Auburn since 2016 vs. Arkansas State (452).

#### **ON OFFENSE**

Seven Tigers making their Auburn debut combined to catch 14 passes for 393 yards and six touchdowns in the season-opening win over Alabama A&M.

This includes nine catches for 268 yards and three scores from four true freshmen receivers. Freshman Malcolm Simmons led the Tigers with 91 yards on three catches, including a 57-yard touchdown, Perry Thompson added a pair of receptions for 82 yards and a 70-yard score, Cam Coleman also caught two passes, including a 44-yard touchdown,

ending the game with 62 yards, and Bryce Cain recorded two catches for 33 yards.

Transfer KeAndre Lambert-Smith caught three passes for 80 yards, including touchdowns of 67 and four yards. Transfer Sam Jackson's lone catch in his Auburn debut went for a 37-yard touchdown, while transfer Robert Lewis recorded an eight-yard reception in the Tigers' victory.

>> The Tigers return 91% of their rushing yardage from a season ago, and eight of 11 players who recorded a carry last season.

Auburn was fourth in the SEC averaging 189.0 rushing yards per game and eighth in the league with 22 rushing touchdowns last season. Eight different Tigers scored a rushing touchdown.

The Tigers had rushed for at least 125 yards in 16 straight games before the New Mexico State loss. Auburn gained 244 yards rushing against Alabama.

- » Auburn, which returns RB Jarquez Hunter, who rushed for 909 yards, and QB Payton Thorne, who rushed for 515 yards last season, joins Georgia Tech and Liberty as the only three FBS programs that return a running back who rushed for 900 yards and a QB who rushed for 500 yards last season for the same program.
- " Quarterback Payton Thorne was 13-21 passing against Alabama A&M, with 4 touchdown passes and 322 yards passing, best of his Auburn career. His 70-yard TD pass to Perry Thompson was Thorne's longest completion at Auburn. He added a TD run as well against the Bulldogs.

Thorne is now the 10th active FBS quarterback with 700 career completions.

Thorne was 162-265 passing last season for 1,755 yards and 16 touchdowns. He also added 519 yards and 3 scores on the ground

A transfer from Michigan State, Thorne threw for 6,494 yards (223.9 per game) in three seasons with the Spartans. He was 524-860 (.609) in 29 career games, 26 of those as the starter.

He ranked among MSU's career leaders in passing TD (49), completion percentage (.609), passing yards (6,494), pass completions (524), pass attempts (860) and passing efficiency (137.6 rating).

» Auburn has scored in 143 consecutive games, the second-longest streak in school history. The Tigers are averaging 30.76 ppg (4,398 total points) during that stretch.

Auburn was last shut out by No. 2 Alabama 49-0 in Tuscaloosa in 2012.

The longest streak in program history is 149 games, beginning with a 55-16 victory over Richmond (10/4/80) in Doug Barfield's final season as head coach and lasting until the final game of Pat Dye's 12-year tenure as Auburn head coach, when the Tigers lost 17-0 to No. 2 Alabama in the 1992 Iron Bowl.

» Jarquez Hunter, a 2023 second team all-SEC honoree, has 2,225 career rushing yards, ranking 16th among Auburn career rushers; he had 909 rushing yards in 2023.

He has 18 career rushing TDs; he started the season with a 34-yard score against Alabama A&M.

" Tight end Rivaldo Fairweather led Auburn in receiving last season with 38 catches for 394 yards and six TD; he broke John Samuel Shenker's single season TE record of 33 catches (2021).

The transfer from FIU scored his first Auburn touchdown on the game-winning 5-yard catch from Payton Thorne with 6:31 remaining in the game at California.

He also had scores against Ole Miss, Vanderbilt, two at Arkansas and vs. New Mexico State, leaving him one short of tying Philip Lutzenkirchen's Auburn TE record of seven TD in a season (2011). » Auburn has three players on the 2024 roster who led an FBS team in receiving in 2023; only the Tigers and Notre Dame claim that feat

Rivaldo Fairweather led Auburn with 38 catches for 394 yards and six TDs, while KeAndre Lambert-Smith led Penn State with 53 catches for 673 yards and four scores and Robert Lewis paced Georgia State with 70 catches for 877 yards and seven touchdowns.

Lewis has caught at least one pass in 22 straight games, dating back through the last game of the 2021 season at Georgia State.

### N.O.T. GOING TO LOSE

» Auburn is 29-2 since the start of the 2013 season in games when scoring a non-offensive touchdown, the latest being Malcolm Simmons' touchdown recovery of a Micah Riley blocked punt against Alabama A&M in the season opener. Last season: Eugene Asante's 67-yard fumble return for a score at Texas A&M, a Jaylin Simpson interception return against UMass and Keionte Scott's 74-yard punt return at Arkansas.

Before the 2020 Outback Bowl, Auburn had won 21 straight games when the Tigers scored a non-offensive touchdown (NOT).

### FOR THE DEFENSE

» Preseason all-SEC linebacker Eugene Asante led Auburn in tackles in five games last season: against UMass (6); 12 tackles, a sack, 1.5 TFL, 2 QB hurries and a pass breakup at California, earning SEC defensive player of the week honors; at Texas A&M (9) and LSU (12; sack) and against Mississippi State (10 tackles, 2 QB hurries, TFL). He scored his first career touchdown on a fourth-quarter 67-yard fumble recovery at Texas A&M.

Asante ranked ninth in the SEC in total tackles per game with a team-best 86 stops. He was one of four SEC players with 80 tackles, 8.0 TFL and 5.0 sacks last year.

» Edge rusher Jalen McLeod was Auburn's leading tackler against Alabama A&M, with five stops, two TFL and a sack.

Last season, McLeod had 50 tackles, 10.5 TFL, 5.5 sacks, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery. He led the Tigers with eight tackles against Alabama and four against Maryland.

McLeod was the SEC defensive player of the week against Arkansas, recording nine tackles, three sacks, four TFL and a forced fumble, all career highs.

McLeod was second on the squad last season with 5.5 sacks and 10.5 TFL, followed by Asante (5.0 sacks, 8.5 TFL).

Auburn is 72-38 when it forces a turnover since the start of the 2013 season and 44-14 when it forces multiple turnovers over that span, compared to just 13-18 when it fails to force a turnover.

Auburn had a 19-game string of forcing at least one turnover snapped against New Mexico State last year.

Auburn's defense has allowed only 41 first-quarter touchdowns in its last 92 games.

Auburn was one of 37 FBS teams that returned a fumble and an INT for a TD and was one of 63 teams with multiple defensive scores last season.

### **ON SPECIAL TEAMS**

Against Alabama A&M, Micah Riley's blocked punt and Malcolm Simmons' recovery for a touchdown was a career first for both; it was the first punt blocked by Auburn for a score since Caylin Newton blocked a punt recovered by Barton Lester vs. Georgia State in 2021.

Auburn has seven field goal blocks and 10 punt blocks since the start of 2016.

Punter Oscar Chapman ranks fourth among Auburn career punting leaders with a 43.80 yard average (205/8,980 yds).

Chapman's 71-yard punt against Georgia in 2023 was a career long, tied for the third-longest punt in Auburn history and was the longest punt since 2006, earning weekly honors from the Ray Guy Award.

The Australian now shows 41 career punts of 50 yards or longer.

Chapman ranked fourth among SEC punters (44.8) last season with 23 punts inside the 20 and 16 of 50 yards or longer.

- » Auburn had 47 former lettermen on NFL training camp rosters, representing 25 different NFL teams

- Neionte Scott led the SEC in punt return average for the 2023 season, averaging 14.8 yards on 15 returns. That mark ranked him third nationally.

Scott's 74-yard punt return for a touchdown at Arkansas, earning him SEC special teams player of the week, was Auburn's first punt return TD (not blocked) since 2014. He was one of 29 players nationally with a punt return TD last season.

- » Auburn continues the longest FBS current span of games (192) without having a punt blocked; Auburn last had a punt blocked vs. Mississippi State in 2009.
- Freshman All-American and Lou Groza Award semifinalist Alex McPherson set an Auburn record with his current string of 19 consecutive field goals made, breaking Daniel Carlson's previous mark (16).

McPherson is 19-20 for his career on field goals and 49-49 on PAT. He's one of two FBS kickers (Mason Shipley, Texas State) who made at least one FG per game and did not miss a kick last season.

### **MORE TIGER STRIPES...**

- » Auburn is looking to win its first two games in a season for the 79th time all-time, including the fourth straight year and sixth time in the last seven seasons.
- "> The Tigers are one of six FBS teams, all in the SEC, that play at least three road games against teams ranked in the top 15 of the preseason AP poll.

Auburn is one of four teams that play three road games against New Year's Six bowl game teams from last season, joining Florida, Georgia and Mississippi State.

Auburn has an all-time record of 347-95-7 at Jordan-Hare Stadium since 1939; the .781 winning percentage ranks seventh nationally.

For the 2023 season, capacity was increased to 88,043 with updates to premium seating.

All home games in 2023 sold out in advance for the first time since 2015. Auburn season ticket sales set a record with 63,500 purchased during the summer, repeated in the summer of 2024, along with a record student ticket purchase, bringing the total season packages sold to 83,043.

Auburn plays its first five games of the season inside Jordan-Hare Stadium, but then the Tigers play three straight road games: at Georgia (Oct. 5), Missouri (Oct. 19) and Kentucky (Oct. 26) before returning home to face Vanderbilt on November 2.

It's the first time in two years, and just the fifth time ever, the Tigers open the season with five straight home games (1982, 2005, 2016, 2022 and 2024). It is the first time since 2019 and just the second time since 1949 Auburn will not have a home game during the month of October. It's also the first time since 2019 the Tigers will play three straight SEC road games.

- » In all-time SEC play, Auburn holds a 338-273-18 mark (.551) back through 1933. In SEC games played in Auburn, the Tigers are 145-69-6 (.675) all-time; away from Auburn, the Tigers are 193-203-12 (.486) overall in SEC play.
- » In non-conference play, Auburn's alltime regular season record since 1933 is 264-72-6 (.781). Before the 2022 Penn State game, Auburn had won 17 straight home games against non-conference opponents dating back to 2016.
- » On the 2024 Auburn roster, 42 players had at least one college start to their credit, 23 on offense and 19 on defense.

There are nine Tigers who have started 20 or more collegiate games: 39 Payton Thorne (26 at Michigan State); 39 KeAndre Lambert-Smith (38 at Penn State); 32 Jerrin Thompson (31 at Texas); 29 Dorian Mausi Jr. (28 at Duke); 25 Dillon Wade (12 at Tulsa); 24 Trill Carter (24 at Minnesota); 24 Rivaldo Fairweather (12 at FIU); 20 Robert Lewis (20 at Georgia State); and 20 Keionte Scott.

» Since 2001, Auburn is 170-40 (.810) when scoring 20 or more points in a game. Dating back to 1993, Auburn is 226-48-1 (.824) when scoring 20 or more points. All-time, Auburn is 565-68-9 (.887) when scoring 20 or more points.

# THE LAST TIME VS. ALABAMA A&M AUBURN 55, ALABAMA A&M O

>> The thousands wearing orange and blue in 100-year-old California Memorial Stadium were delighted to be called Fairweather fans.

Rivaldo Fairweather scored the go-ahead touchdown and D.J. James ended Cal's last chance with an interception to lead Auburn to a 14-10 win, the Tigers' first in four tries in the Golden State.

After generating only four first downs and 99 yards in the first half while going 1-for-6 on third down, the Tigers offense found its rhythm in the fourth quarter, marching 69 yards on 10 plays to take a 14-10 lead on Payton Thorne's 5-yard touchdown pass to Fairweather with 6:31 to play.

Fairweather was Auburn's leading receiver with three catches for 39 yards.

Six plays earlier, Thorne and Fairweather connected for Auburn's biggest gain of the game, a critical 28-yard pickup on third-and-17 from the Tigers' 31-yard line.

After Fairweather's TD, Auburn's defense stopped the Bears and forced a punt, but the Tigers' fourth turnover gave Cal another opportunity with 4 minutes remaining from Auburn's 41-yard line.

An 11-yard pass and a penalty gave Cal the ball on Auburn's 15-yard line but once again, the defense rose to the occasion.

On fourth-and-13 from the 18, James intercepted Cal's attempt at a game-winning touchdown in the end zone with 1:44 to play to secure the victory.

Cal capitalized on an early Auburn turnover and kicked a 39-yard field goal to lead 3-0 at the 9:42 mark in the first quarter.

An Auburn three-and-out gave Cal another short

field at the Tigers' 33-yard-line but Marcus Harris' sack on thirdand-10 forced a missed 42-yard field goal attempt.

Auburn's defense delivered again on Cal's first offensive play of the second quarter when Donovan Kaufman forced and recovered a fumble on the Bears' 17-yard line.

On third-and-6, Thorne hit Jay Fair on a crossing route for a 13-yard touchdown to give Auburn a 7-3 lead at the 11:50 mark of the second quarter.

Auburn forced another punt and drove across midfield but fumbled at Cal's 35-yard-line. The Bears changed quarterbacks and drove 65 yards, taking a 10-7 lead on Jadyn Ott's 14-yard touchdown run with 4:47 left in the first half

An Auburn interception, the Tigers' third turnover of the half, gave Cal possession in Auburn territory for the third time in the half but a holding penalty negated a 51-yard field goal and Jaylin Simpson intercepted a long pass at the goal-line to end the first half.

Auburn's defense continued to produce in the second half, stopping Cal's opening possession of the third quarter on Jalen McLeod's tackle on fourth-and-4 after a 1-yard-pass.

Auburn drove across midfield but Cal stopped the Tigers on fourth-and 2 from the Bears' 42-yard-line.

Eugene Asante led Auburn with 12 tackles, making a tackle for loss and a sack on third downs on plays that preceded missed Cal field goals in the second half.

- Hugh Freeze was named the 31st head football coach in Auburn's 129-year history on November 28, 2022. Freeze holds a 110-54 overall record as a head coach and is 47-27 in conference games.
- With Auburn's selection to the Music City Bowl in 2023, Freeze has now led four teams to a postseason bowl during his career. That ties him for the most schools among active coaches and fifth among coaches all-time. Freeze has guided Arkansas State, Ole Miss, Liberty and Auburn all to bowl games.
- >> The head coach at Liberty from 2019-22, Freeze led the Flames to four bowl games and a 34-15 record. During his tenure at Liberty, he took former Auburn quarterback Malik Willis and developed him into one of the nation's top quarterbacks in 2021.
- Freeze has experienced similar success at each of his head coaching stops prior to Liberty that include Lambuth University (2008-09), Arkansas State (2011) and Ole Miss (2012-16). The Oxford, Mississippi, native led each school to double-digit win seasons, while helping Ole Miss to a top 10 national finish in 2015. His on-field coaching record in 12 years is 109-54.
- Freeze guided Liberty to a 10-1 overall record in 2020 and the team's first-ever national ranking as it finished No. 17 in the country. That season Liberty had the best start in program history (8-0), tied the program record for wins (10) and defeated two Power 5 programs in Syracuse and Virginia Tech. For his efforts, Freeze was a finalist for the George Munger Collegiate Coach of the Year Award that season.
- >> While the head coach at Ole Miss, Freeze led it back to championship form during his five seasons, guiding it to bowl games during three of his five years, including wins in the 2013 Music City bowl and the 2016 Sugar Bowl.
- >> Freeze's time in Oxford was highlighted by a 10-3 campaign in 2015, the program's first 10-win season since 2003. The Rebels won their first four games of the 2015 season, including a 43-37 road victory over No. 2 Alabama, Ole Miss' first win in Tuscaloosa, since 1988.

Pat Dye Field at Jordan-Hare Stadium, the nation's 11th-largest on-campus stadium with a capacity of 88,043, is in its 83rd year as home to the Auburn Tigers.

On football Saturdays in Auburn, Jordan-Hare Stadium becomes Alabama's sixth-largest city. A record number of 63,500 season tickets were sold before the 2023 and 2024 seasons

The stadium is named for Ralph "Shug" Jordan, Auburn's all-time winningest football coach, and Clifford Leroy Hare, a member of Auburn's first football team, president of the old Southern Conference and long-time chairman of Auburn's Faculty Athletic Committee.

Legendary coach Pat Dye has also had his name forever attached to Jordan-Hare Stadium, as the turf officially became known as Pat Dye Field at Jordan-Hare Stadium prior to the 2005 Iron Bowl. Dye, who served as coach and athletics director at Auburn (1981-92) and was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame (2005), led Auburn to a 99-39-4 record and four SEC titles in his 12 seasons on the Plains.

What is now Jordan-Hare Stadium was dedicated November 30, 1939, at the Auburn-Florida game. Babe McGehee, who passed away in 2005, scored the first touchdown in what was then called "Auburn Stadium," by catching a pass from Dick McGowen. McGowen, who later coached at Auburn under Jordan, kicked the extra point and Auburn tied Florida, 7-7.

That first stadium held 7,500 seats and consisted of what is now the bottom part of the lower west stands. When the stadium was renamed "Cliff Hare Stadium" in 1949, 14,000 seats—the present lower east stands—had been added, raising capacity to 21,500.

Jordan became head coach in 1951 and the stadium underwent three major expansions in 15 years. More than 40,000 seats, virtually half of the stadium's present capacity, were added while Jordan was the coach.

Cliff Hare Stadium became Jordan-Hare Stadium in 1973. It was the first stadium in the country to be named for an active coach.

Overall, Auburn has played 445 games in Jordan-Hare Stadium, winning 347, losing 95 and tying seven for a winning percentage of .781 against some of the best teams in college football.

Payton Thorne accounted for five first-half touchdowns and Auburn kicked off the season with a 73-3 victory over Alabama Á&M at Jordan-Hare Stadium, win No. 800 in program history.

Thorne completed 13 of 21 passes for 322 yards and four touchdowns in the half, adding 49 rushing yards and another TD on the ground before sitting out the second half.

It took Auburn only four plays and 47 seconds to take the lead. After Thorne opened the game with a 12-yard completion to freshman Malcolm Simmons, Jarquez Hunter scored on his first carry, racing 34 yards through a sizable hole on the right side. After Auburn's defense forced a three-and-out on A&M's first possession, the quick-strike Tigers needed only one play to double their advantage. Thorne stepped up in the pocket and fired deep down the middle to KeAndre Lambert-Smith for a 67-yard touchdown and a 14-0 Auburn lead

Auburn repeated that winning formula, a three-and-out and a one-play scoring drive, with Thorne finding freshman Cam Coleman on a stop-and-go route for a 44-yard touchdown to put the Tigers ahead 21-0 at the 11:39 mark of the first quarter. The Tigers increased their lead to 28-0 with 2 minutes left in the opening quarter on Thorne's second touchdown pass to

Keionte Scott's 29-yard punt return set up Town McGough's 32-yard field goal to give Auburn a 31-0 lead early in the second quarter. Thorne connected with another member of Auburn's highly touted quartet of in-state receivers, Perry Thompson, for a 70-yard touchdown and a 38-0 lead with 10:10 left in the second quarter.

Alabama A&M kicked a field goal midway through the quarter, but Auburn added two more rushing scores before the half, Thorne's 4-yard run and Damari Alston's 2-yarder to put the Tigers on top 52-3 at intermission. Auburn tallied 436 yards in the half despite possessing the ball for only 9 minutes and 37 seconds.

The team's mutually agreed to shorten the second half by playing 10-minute quarters. The Tigers scored on special teams when Micah Riley blocked a punt that Simmons recovered in the end zone for a 59-3 Auburn advantage at the 8:25 mark of the third quarter. Hank Brown took over for Thorne in the second half, hitting the speedy Simmons for a 57-yard touchdown

that gave Auburn a 66-3 lead after the Tigers' only possession of the third quarter.

Brown displayed his deep-ball touch on his second drive, teaming up with a leaping Sam Jackson V for a 37-yard touchdown that gave Auburn a staggering 70-point lead. Brown was 3-for-5 for 96 yards and two scores. Holden Geriner played the remainder of the abbreviated fourth quarter.
