As a reward for their historic season and national title run, the Auburn men's golf team was invited to the White House for College Champions Day on July 22, 2024. **Ryan Eshleman** was selected as the team's on-stage representative for the ceremony on South Lawn.

LAST SEASON IN REVIEW

LAST MAN STANDING

A magical season with a magical ending – for the first time in program history, the Auburn men’s golf team are national champions! The Tigers shot 19-over at the Omni La Costa Champions Course in Carlsbad, California to clinch sixth place following stroke play and heading into match play. Auburn went on to defeat No. 3-seeded Virginia 3-1-1 in the quarterfinals, No. 7-seeded Ohio State 3-2 in the semifinals and No. 4-seeded Florida State in the final. **J.M. Butler** clinched the championship point as the only player in the field to never trail a single hole during the entirety of match play.



IT JUST MEANS MORE

For the fifth time in program history and the first time since 2018, the SEC Championship belongs to the Tigers of Auburn men’s golf. Auburn tied for first in stroke play, shooting 14-under. **Jackson Koivun** ran away with the individual title at 12-under, a six-shot margin of victory. In match play, the Tigers defeated No. 9 Alabama 3-2 in the semifinals, No. 11 Arkansas 4-1 in the quarterfinals and No. 2 Vanderbilt 3-2 in the final.

NOT BAD FOR A ROOKIE

Freshman **Jackson Koivun** exploded onto the collegiate scene with one of the best seasons in the history of the sport. The rookie recorded top-10 finishes in 12 of 13 starts, picked up two wins and 28 rounds below par. He became the first man in the history of the sport to win all three National Player of the Year Awards (Haskins, Hogan, Nicklaus) and the National Freshman of the Year Award (Mickelson) in the same season.



DEADLY DUO

After Auburn's commanding season, head coach **Nick Clinard** was named the SEC Coach of the Year and the Dave Williams DI National Coach of the Year. Assistant **Chris Williams** was named the recipient of the Jan Strickland Outstanding Assistant Coach Award.

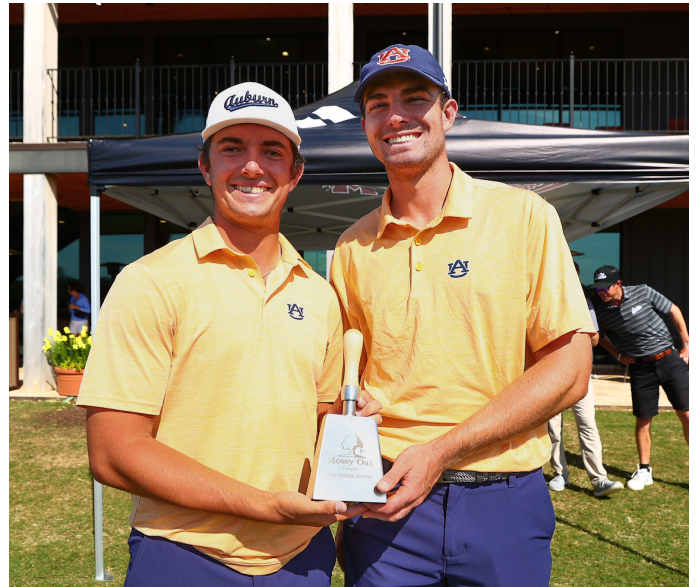

CLINARD'S RESUME

Nick Clinard is in his 24th year overall as a head coach and 16th season with the Auburn men's golf team in 2024-25.

The reigning National Coach of the Year, Clinard led the program to its fifth SEC title and first ever National Championship during the spring of 2024. The Tigers went on one of the most dominant runs the sport has ever seen, picking up 10 tournament wins, including seven in a row to close out the year.

Clinard's top player in 2024, freshman Jackson Koivun, was named the SEC Freshman of the Year and the SEC Player of the Year. He also became the first man in the sport's history to win the Haskins, Hogan, Mickelson and Nicklaus Awards in the same season.

Under Clinard's tenure, the Tigers have garnered 18 All-American selections, 41 All-Region team members and 45 All-SEC honorees.

Academically, Clinard has produced 26 All-American scholars and 96 SEC Academic Honor Roll members.

In 2018, after leading the Tigers to their first SEC Championship in 16 years, Clinard was voted SEC Coach of the Year as well as Southeast Region Coach of the Year. Clinard would also named a finalist for National Coach of the Year that season.

During his 15 seasons on The Plains, Auburn has amassed over 2,000 victories while never winning less than 63% of its head-to-head matchups in any given year.

WILLIAMS' RESUME

Chris Williams is in his sixth year overall as an assistant coach and fourth season with the Auburn men's golf team in 2024-25. The season marks his first as the associate head coach at Auburn.

Williams earned the title of Jan Strickland Assistant Coach of the Year in the spring of 2024 as he and Clinard led the Tigers to their first national title.

Williams arrives on The Plains from Marquette University where he was an assistant coach during the 2019-20 and 2020-21 seasons.

While with the Golden Eagles, Williams was instrumental in the development of Hunter Eichhorn, who was named the BIG EAST Player of the Year, PING All-American and became Marquette's career scoring average leader.

As a professional golfer, Williams competed in both the Mackenzie Tour in Canada and PGA Tour Latinoamérica after turning pro in 2013. He competed in a pair of U.S. Opens, one in 2011 after winning a sectional qualifying event, and in 2013 as the top amateur.

Williams was a four-time All-American at the University of Washington from 2009-13. While with the Huskies, he won six tournaments, earned 28 top-10 finishes and led the team in scoring his final three years.

The Moscow, Idaho native represented the United States at the 2011 Walker Cup and went on to win the Ben Hogan Award as the NCAA's top golfer in 2013. He was also awarded the Mark H. McCormack Medal by The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews as the leading player in the World Amateur Golf Ranking in 2012.

Williams spent 46 weeks ranked as the top amateur in the world after earning the distinction prior to his senior year at Washington.

ALEXANDER'S RESUME

Buddy Alexander is in his 37th year as a coach and third year on the Auburn staff entering the 2024-25 season.

Alexander's impact was nearly immediate as he helped lead the program to its fifth conference title and first national championship during the spring of 2024.

Alexander joins the Auburn staff with over 30 years of coaching experience at the Division I level, most notably as the head coach at the University of Florida from 1988 to 2014.

While at Florida, Alexander guided the program to eight SEC Championships and a pair of national titles in 1993 and 2001. He is a seven-time SEC Coach of the Year and three-time NCAA Coach of the Year.

Additionally, Alexander led Louisiana State University to a pair of SEC titles in 1986 and 1987 as the head coach of the program from 1982 to 1987.

Golfers under Alexander's tutelage have produced 50-plus first team all-conference selections and 40-plus victories on the PGA tour.

A native of St. Petersburg, Florida, Alexander is a 1975 and 1980 graduate of Georgia Southern University where he was a two-time All-American as a student-athlete.

He is married to Joan Alexander, who currently serves at the Tigers' director of operations for both the men's and women's programs, and is the father of Tyson Alexander, a current member of the PGA Tour, and Cortnee Gilchrist, the Director of the Spirit Squad at the University of Florida.

2021-22 (REDSHIRT FRESHMAN)

Averaged 72.96 strokes per round through 25 rounds of play... carded four top-20 finishes and one top-10 finish at the Nexus Collegiate... logged 11 rounds at par or better, six rounds below par and two rounds in the 60s... made birdie 89 times, averaging 3.56 per round... made eagle twice, good for second on the team... joined teammate Brendan Valdes as one of only six players of 154 total to eagle at the NCAA Championship, and the only duo from the same school to do so... counted 15 of 19 (.789) team rounds played... averaged a 3.96 shots per round win differential... made collegiate debut at the SEC Match Play Championship, earning victories over opponents from both Ole Miss and Mississippi State... closed out the fall with a stint at the Isleworth Collegiate, shooting 73-74-75-222 (+6) to finish just outside the top 30... earned first career top-10 finish at the Nexus Collegiate... finished below par at the Tiger Invitational with a 74-70-71-215 (-1) to aid Auburn's "B" team to a third-place finish, earning a spot on the All-Tournament Team... posted career lows for 18 (68/-4), 36 (138/-6) and 54 holes (214/-2) in a top-25 finish at the Hootie at Bulls Bay Intercollegiate... shot 73-69-73-215 (-1) at the NCAA Norman Regional to finish tied for 17th and help the Tigers to their first NCAA Championship appearance since 2019... led the Auburn lineup through three of four rounds at NCAAs as its top finisher at 76-70-71-70-287 (+7), earning a top-20 placement in his career debut at the tournament.



2022-23 (REDSHIRT SOPHOMORE)

Averaged 70.54 strokes per round through a career-high 37 rounds of competition, a 2.42 average stroke improvement from the previous year... average also stands as the fourth-best in a single season in Auburn history... carded 24 total rounds at or below par, including nine in the 60s... finished in the top 20 six times and in the top 10 three times... fired four eagles and 129 birdies... did not miss a team event... counted 34 of 37 team rounds played... heavily contributed to all three of the team's fall wins, finishing in the top 15 at the Maui Jim Intercollegiate, Marquette Invitational and Isleworth Collegiate... first top 10 of the season came at Marquette behind a 70-74-70--214(+4) scorecard... won first collegiate event, the Tiger Invitational, shooting 71-68-66--205(-11) to also earn SEC Golfer of the Week Honors... shot 206 (-10) for a tied for sixth outing at the Mossy Oak Collegiate... placed T13th at the NCAA Auburn Regional to aid the Tigers in tying the school record with five wins during the season... wins record had not been matched in nearly 30 years... named PING All-Southeast Region.

2023-24 (REDSHIRT JUNIOR)

Averaged 71.44 shots per round over 34 rounds of play... carded 22 rounds at par or better and seven top-20 finishes... made 126 birdies and two eagles... opened the year at the Mirabel Maui Jim intercollegiate, shooting 67-67-69 (-10) for a T13 finish... caught fire in the spring season, carding four consecutive top-six placements at the Pinehurst Intercollegiate (+3), Tiger Invitational (+6), Seahawk Intercollegiate (+1) and Mossy Oak Collegiate (-9), helping the Tigers win the team title in each of them... aided in the Tigers' SEC Championship run with a pair of match play wins in the semifinals against No. 11 Arkansas' John Driscoll (3&2) and in the finals against No. 2 Vanderbilt's William Moll (1-UP)... also secured one of Auburn's three points in its NCAA Championship quarterfinal match versus No. 9 Virginia with 2&1 victory over Josh Duangmanee... counted an impressive 31 of 34 team rounds played.

FACILITIES & COURSES



JACK KEY GOLF TEACHING FACILITY

The Jack Key Golf Teaching Facility, named after Jack Key, a 1950 Auburn graduate and four-year letterman from Columbus, Georgia, features three indoor hitting bays, lounge and locker rooms, club repair and video analysis. Utilizing 29 acres, the practice facility features a range of nearly 400 yards with tees at both ends allowing players to train in a variety of wind conditions.

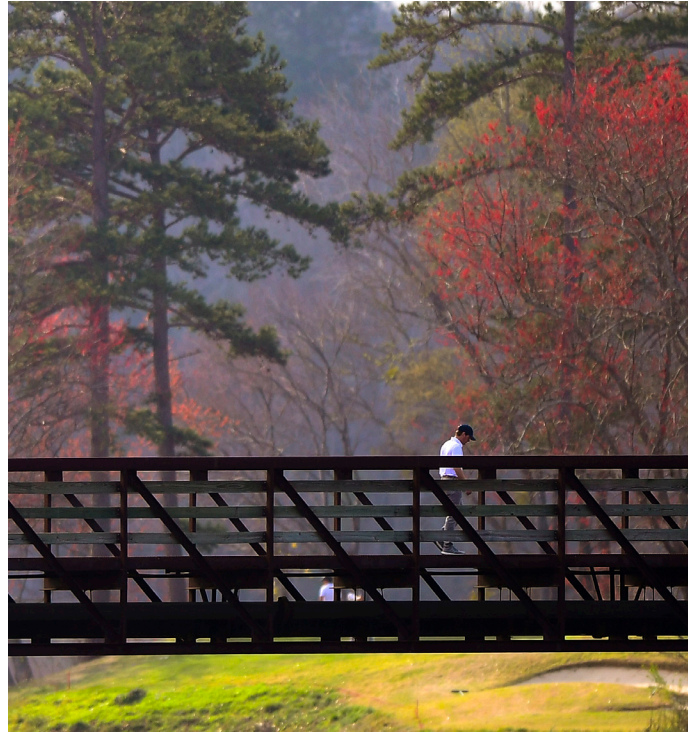




GRAND NATIONAL

The 54-hole Grand National complex, part of the world-renown Robert Trent Jones Golf Trail, has two 18-hole par-72 courses and one 18-hole par-3 course. The Lake Course played host to the 2004 NCAA Women's Golf Championship and the 2000 NCAA Men's Golf Championship.

It was also the site of the 1999 SEC Women's Golf Championship, 1998 LPGA Tournament of Champions, 1997 Nike Tour Championship, 1996 NCAA Women's Golf East Regional, 1994 NCAA Men's East Regional and the PGA Tour's Barbasol Championship from 2015-2017.



The Links Course ranks as one of the most impressive tracks in the country. It played host to the 1997 SEC Men's Golf Championship. The 18-hole, par-3 course is a truly beautiful layout that allows Tiger golfers excellent practice on their iron and short game play. The driving ranges at The Trail courses are also a spectacle to see.



AU CLUB AT YARBROUGH FARMS

The Auburn University Club features an 18-hole championship golf course, state-of-the-art practice facilities and a full service clubhouse as well as office spaces for the Auburn University golf coaches and locker rooms for both the men's and women's golf teams.

At 7,591 yards from the back tees, the golf course carves through magnificent trees, across wetlands, along creeks and streams and around the lake. Natural and man-enhanced water features play a prominent role at The Auburn University Club as they blend throughout the property and are visible on 14 of 18 holes.
