## » QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn has won eight straight weekends dating back to the final two series of 2024, marking the longest streak since '03.
- The team's 4-2 start to SEC play is tied for the best since starting the 2017 SEC season 5-1.
- This weekend wraps up the team's seven-game road trip, the longest of the season.
- Cooper McMurray cracked the top-10 in program history with his 35th career home run Tuesday.
- Ike Irish is hitting .550 (11-for-20) with two doubles, four home runs and seven RBI in four games since his return to the lineup.
- The pitching staff ranks top 25 in the country in WHIP (1.25), strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.91) and walks allowed per 9.0 innings (3.48).
- Auburn is 6-2 against ranked opponents, including 3-1 away from home.
- The team is in the midst of six straight series against ranked opponents, including the next four against teams currently ranked in the top 10.
- The Tigers hold an 88-65-4 all-time record against Georgia but are 75-88 in Athens.

**Butch Thompson enters his 10th season at the helm of the program in 2025, posting a record of 283-213-1 in his first nine seasons. He has led the program to the College World Series in two of the last five postseasons.**

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his 10th season with the Tigers in 2025.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in his nine seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 283-213-1 overall record and has advanced to the NCAA Tournament five of the last seven postseasons, including three Super Regional appearances in the last six years and two trips to the College World Series in the last five postseasons.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 33 Division I All-Americans and 48 all-conference performers. He has seen 24 of his former pitchers called up to Major League Baseball, including 18 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 42 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 17 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the program record No. 3 freshman class in 2024, surpassing the 2017 signing class (No. 4) for the highest in program history.

In 32 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 23 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached nine College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019 and taking the team back for the second time in three postseasons in 2022. Thompson became one of five active SEC coaches who have taken their program to a pair of College World Series in a three-year span. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 19 postseason appearances.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

During his tenure with the Tigers, Thompson led the team to three straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2017-19 for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals in 2018 and 2019 for the first time in program history, and hosted back-to-back regionals for the first time in program history in 2022-23.

Auburn's second straight regional host bid in 2023 came thanks to a second-half run for the record books, and the Tigers became one of five programs in the country and two in the SEC to host each of the last two seasons.

Auburn posted a league-best 12-3 record in the final five weeks of conference play and finished the SEC season with 17 wins, the most since winning the SEC West in 2010. The Tigers finished top five in the league in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2002-03. The 12-3 stretch was the program's best since also going 12-3 in the final 15 games of the 2010 season and the nine-game SEC winning streak at the end of the regular season and first game of the SEC Tournament was the team's longest since 1995.

Auburn has finished six of Thompson's nine seasons in the top 25, including three in the top 10. The No. 5 national ranking to finish 2022 was tied for the second highest mark in program history.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series



finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 23 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the American Baseball Coaches Association.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. He is a member of both the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame (Class of 2014) and MACCC Hall of Fame (Class of 2021).

Thompson earned a Bachelor's Degree in History at BSC in 1992 and completed a Master's Degree in Sports Administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters -- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail --and the grandparents of Mary Gail and Hayes Grady Moreman.



## SAMFORD STADIUM-HITCHCOCK FIELD AT PLAINSMAN PARK

Auburn baseball's home for the past 75 seasons, an expanded and renovated Samford Stadium-Hitchcock Field at Plainsman Park makes its debut for the 2025 season.

After completing a \$30+ million project that has spanned the last two seasons, the ballpark now features premium club areas including the Broadway Club at Plainsman Park located at the top of the stadium behind home plate and the 984 Club located down the first base line to go along with the pre-existing Hall of Fame Club located at field level behind home plate, which opened prior to the 2024 season.

Along with the premium club areas, Plainsman Park now features multiple expanded general admission areas. The renovated Tiger Terrace now includes three tiers of paved terrace space with the bottom tier featuring nine terrace boxes equipped with soft seating and drink rail viewing areas, Traeger pellet grills, refrigerators and more. Additional general admission areas include the two-tiered standing room space atop the War Eagle Wall in left field and the expanded Plainsman Patio at concourse level down the first base line.

The new and improved ballpark, which continues to feature the timeless elements inspired by Camden Yards, Wrigley Field and Fenway Park that were included in the initial renovation spearheaded by former head coach Hal Baird nearly 30 years ago, has a capacity of 7,189. The design continues to combine the look of old-time ballparks with academic buildings on the Auburn campus to create a facade of brick and painted steel.

Kickstarted by the completion of the Josh Donaldson Hitting Facility prior to the 2021 season, Auburn baseball's player development areas also continue to take a step forward. Along with the hitting facility, the program has a new state-of-the-art locker room, bullpen and pitching lab, weight room and nutrition center, and soon-to-be new coaches offices and team meeting space.

Plainsman Park, which has hosted six NCAA Regionals (1978, 1999, 2003, 2010, 2022, 2023) and also had the privilege of hosting President George W. Bush on Oct. 24, 2002, has twice been named one of the best facilities in college baseball. Baseball America initially voted it the best facility in the country prior to the 2003 season, and D1 Baseball named it one of the top venues in the nation in 2016.

### SCOUTING THE BULLDOGS

- Georgia enters the weekend with a 25-2 overall record, good for the most wins in the country, and is tied for first in the SEC with a 5-1 record in league play.
- Offensively, the Bulldogs are hitting .320 as a team and lead the country in hits (292), runs (282), home runs (74) and slugging percentage (.632). Ryland Zaborowski and Robbie Burnett rank first and second in the league in home runs (14 and 13, respectively) and OBP (.588 and .597, respectively).
- On the mound, Georgia has turned in a 4.97 staff ERA with 272 strikeouts and 123 walks in 232.0 innings. The Bulldogs are last in the league in walks allowed and 14th in the league in hits (196) and runs (135) allowed.

- Auburn has won eight straight weekends dating back to the final two series of 2024.
- The eight-weekend winning streak is the longest since winning 10 straight series to begin the 2003 season.

**20-WIN MARK**

- Auburn's 13-5 win against South Alabama Tuesday marked the team's 20th win of the season in its 25th game.
- It's the fewest games needed to reach 20 wins since 2019 (22 games).

  - 2021: 43 games

**IKE'S ON ANOTHER LEVEL**

- After missing six games from Mar. 9-18 with a fractured scapula, Ike Irish is hitting .550 (11-for-20) with two doubles, four home runs and seven RBI in four games since his return.
- Irish has hit multiple home runs in two of the last three games, marking the second and third multi-homer games of his career.
- His five hits in the middle game at Kentucky were the most by an Auburn player in a league game since Tony Caldwell in 2011.
- His four hits Tuesday vs. South Alabama marked the 50th multi-hit game of his career (124 games played).

**COOP STAYS CRUSHIN'**

- Cooper McMurray hit four home runs in four games from Mar. 5-9, including his fifth career multi-homer game at UAB on Mar. 5, and cracked the top 10 in program history with his seventh home run of the season and 35th of his career vs. South Alabama Tuesday.
- He has multiple hits in a team-high 12 games this season and has reached base in all 24 games, including multiple times in 18 games.
- In 120 games in an Auburn uniform, McMurray has collected 124 hits, including 26 doubles, 35 homers and 130 RBI. His .458 OBP and .623 SLG would both be good for top-10 marks in program history.

**DOUBLE DIGIT DINGERS**

- McMurray has hit double digit home runs in back-to-back seasons with 14 apiece in 2023 and 2024 and has seven long balls this season.
- Only three players in program history have hit 10+ home runs in three straight seasons.
  - Josh Etheredge (1996-98)
  - Brian Fletcher (2008-10)
  - Hunter Morris (2008-10)
- McMurray ranks top 10 among active SEC players in career home runs (44), RBI (149) and walks (136).

**NEWCOMERS MAKING A NAME**

- Four of Auburn's top five hitter in the first two weeks of SEC play are newcomers.
  - Chase Fralick: .333 (7-for-21)
  - Lucas Steele: .333 (6-for-18)
  - Chris Rembert: .278 (5-for-18)
  - Bub Terrell: .261 (6-for-23)
- Two of the team's four SEC wins were also earned by newcomers in Samuel Dutton and Andreas Alvarez, while Ryan Hetzler has earned each of the two saves in league play.

**FRESHMEN OF THE WEEK**

- An Auburn player has been named the SEC Freshman of the Week in three of the first six weeks of the season.
  - Bub Terrell: Feb. 24
  - Chris Rembert: Mar. 3
  - Andreas Alvarez: Mar. 17
- The three Freshman of the Week honors are already tied for the most in a single season since the awards inception in 2006.

**BELYEU'S BIG SWING**

- Cade Belyeu hit a go-ahead grand slam with two outs and two strikes in the 8th inning of the series finale against Vanderbilt.
- It marked Auburn's first win in the last two seasons when trailing after seven innings.
- It was also Auburn's first go-ahead grand slam in the 8th inning or later since Jonathan Schuerholz hit an 8th inning grand slam in a 6-3 win at Alabama on May 6, 2000.
- Since his go-ahead grand slam, Belyeu is hitting .500 (9-for-18) with seven runs, two doubles, a triple, two homers and eight RBI.

**STEELE'S SWINGING A HOT STICK**

- Junior designated hitter Lucas Steele hit a grand slam to give Auburn a 9-6 lead in the fourth inning of the team's win vs. Alabama State (Mar. 18) and hit his third home run in a four-game span in the series opener at UK.
- In his last 11 starts since Feb. 25, Steele is hitting .359 (14-for-39) with three doubles, three homers and 15 RBI.

**FRALICK CAN FLAT OUT HIT**

- Through six weeks this season, Chase Fralick leads the team and ranks second among SEC freshmen with a .371 average.
- He is currently riding his second hitting streak of seven or more game this season after previously going on a 10-game hitting streak from Feb. 16-Mar.7, hitting .478 (22-for-46) during the span.
- He is hitting .333 (7-for-21) in his first five SEC games and drove in the tying run with a two-out double in the 9th inning of the series opener at UK.

**REMBERT IS RAKING**

- Chris Rembert was named the SEC Co-Freshman of the Week on Mar. 3 after hitting .385 with two home runs and 10 RBI in four games from Feb. 25-Mar. 2.
- Rembert ranked tied for second in the league with 10 RBI during that week and drove in a run in all four contests.
- He doubled, homered and drove in four runs in both the midweek win vs. Samford and weekend win vs. No. 8 Oregon State.
- Rembert reached base in his first 19 games played and is hitting .278 (5-for-18) in his first five league games.

**BUB IS PLAYING SOME GOOD BALL**

- Bub Terrell was named the SEC Co-Freshman of the Week after hitting .368 with two homers and seven RBI in five games from Feb. 18-23.
- Terrell scored the walk-off run in the 9th inning vs. Troy and drove in the go-ahead run in the 6th inning vs. North Alabama the next day.
- He went on to hit the first three homers of his Auburn career in a span of four games vs. Wright State (Feb. 21-23) and Samford (Feb. 25).
- Terrell led the team with a .471 average (8-for-17) in five games from Mar. 11-18, including four multi-hit efforts, and is hitting .261 (6-for-23) in his first six league games.

**LET IT SNOW**

- Junior Eric Snow turned in back-to-back three hit games vs. Old Dominion (Mar. 9) and UT Martin (Mar. 11) and had multiple hits in four straight games from Mar. 7-11, hitting .500 (10-for-20) during the span.
- He ranks second on the team with a .397 average in non-conference games but is hitting .136 (3-for-22) in his first six SEC games.
- A transfer from South Florida, Snow leads the team and ranks 10th in the SEC in runs (32), while leading the team in doubles (eight) and tying for the team lead in hits (34).

**FABIAN THE FIELD GENERAL**

- Senior shortstop Deric Fabian has started all but one game at the position.
- He has committed two errors in 97 chances, good for a .979 fielding percentage, and has helped turn 10 of Auburn's 20 double plays, which rank third in the SEC.

**GOOD TO GET GUEVARA BACK**

- Sophomore infielder Eric Guevara returned to the lineup for the first time since Opening Weekend vs. UT Martin on Mar. 11 and went 2-for-4 with two runs and a double.
- He hit his first home run of the season to start Auburn's comeback in the fifth inning of the series finale vs. Vanderbilt and went 4-for-12 in the series.
- Guevara played in 21 games at the end of last season after tearing his ACL in October of 2023 - taking him less than six months to recover.

### **DUTTON HAS DELIVERED**

- In his first six starts in an Auburn uniform, Samuel Dutton is 3-1 with a 2.48 ERA and ranks top 10 in the SEC in ERA and innings (32.2) while ranking 14th in strikeouts (38).
- Dutton made his first SEC start in an Auburn uniform vs. Vanderbilt on Mar. 14 and earned the win in a career-long 7.0 innings, the longest start by an Auburn pitcher since 2023.
- He didn't allowed a run in two starts and 11.2 innings pitched from Feb. 21-28, striking out 16 and walking just one during the span.

### **CADE IS COMING ALONG**

- After logging just 9.1 innings in his first four starts and missing a the second weeked of the season with an injury, Fisher turned in a season-long 4.0 innings in game two at Kentucky last weekend.
- He allowed just one run on two hits with a walk and a strikeout in his 58th career appearance.

### **CARSON + CARLSON CARVE 'EM UP**

- Senior Carson Myers and Parker Carlson went 2-0 with a save and a 0.00 ERA in a combined five appearances and 8.0 innings last week.
- Myers made three appearances and started the week with his third 3.0-inning save of the season vs. Alabama State.
- Carlson earned a win in back-to-back appearances in the first two games of the series at Kentucky, retiring all eight batters he faced and throwing out a runner attempting to steal home to end game two.

### **JETT BRINGS THE JUICE**

- Sophomore right hander Jett Johnston earned his team-best fourth win of the season in 2.0 scoreless innings vs. South Alabama Tuesday.
- Johnson has earned a win or save in five of his first seven appearances in an Auburn uniform.
- He earned his first career save by recording the final two outs with the tying run on base vs. No. 8 Oregon State on Mar. 1.

### **HUM NOW, HETZLER**

- Sophomore right hander Ryan Hetzler leads the team and ranks tied for fifth in the league with seven games finished this season.
- Hetzler earned back-to-back SEC saves in the series finale vs. Vanderbilt and series opener at Kentucky, marking his first two saves in an Auburn uniform.
- Cal Baptist's saves leader from a year ago, he allowed just two baserunners - 1 H, 1 R - in 7.0 innings pitched in his first seven appearances before coming back to pitch for a second straight day and allowing four runs in the middle game at Kentucky.

### **DYNAMIC DUO**

- Preseason All-SEC honorees Ike Irish (first team) and Cooper McMurray (second team) combined to hit 28 homers with 115 RBI last year.
- Only two returning duos in the league can claim higher home run and RBI production - Jace LaViolette and Gavin Grahovac at Texas A&M (52 homers, 144 RBI); Slate Alford and Kolby Branch at Georgia (34 homers, 127 RBI).

### **ALL-AMERICA IKE**

- Along with his second straight Preseason First Team All-SEC nod, Irish was named Preseason All-America by Perfect Game (first team), Baseball America (second team) and D1 Baseball (third team) and a member of the Golden Spikes Award preseason watch list.

### **CREAM OF THE CROP**

- Auburn's 2024 signing class was ranked as high as No. 3 in the country, marking a new program record for highest ranked recruiting class - surpassing the 2017 class that was previously ranked No. 4.
- On top of the freshman class, the Tigers also brought in the No. 4 ranked transfer class.

### **SWEET HOME AUBURN**

- Auburn's signing class features five of the top eight players in the state according to Perfect Game, including four players ranked No. 1 at their respective positions.
  - C. Gatwood: No. 2 overall, No. 1 RHP
  - C. Chatterton: No. 3 overall, No. 2 RHP

- The Tigers are 6-2 against ranked opponents.

### **PACKING OUT PLAINSMAN PARK**

- Playing in a newly-renovated Plainsman Park, Auburn set both single-game (5,718) and series (15,300) attendance records during Opening Weekend on The Plains.
- Auburn has set a single-season attendance record for three straight seasons and has announced a sellout for 34 of 66 home games the last two years, including 27 of 30 SEC games.

### **THOMPSON'S TENURE**

- The 2025 season marks head coach Butch Thompson's 10th season on the Plains, making him the third longest-tenured coach in program history and the fourth longest-tenured coach in the league.
- He surpassed the 300-win milestone with the team's 13-9 win against Alabama State on Mar. 18, joining Paul Nix (1963-84) and Hal Baird (1985-2000) as the only coaches in program history to reach the milestone.
- Under Thompson, Auburn has hosted back-to-back regionals for the first time in program history (2022-23) and has made a NCAA regional in five of the last seven postseasons, including three Super Regional appearances (2018-19, '22) and two College World Series appearances (2019, '22).

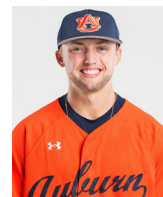
