» QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn is one of two teams - joined by Texas - to win seven SEC series in the last nine conference weekends dating back to the final two weeks of last season.
- Tennessee represents Auburn's sixth top-10 opponent of the season, including its fifth in the last six weeks, three of which have come on the road.
- Auburn has the No. 1 strength of schedule in the country, and the team's .552 opponent win percentage in SEC play is one game shy of Missouri (0-21) for the highest in the league.
- The Tigers are 13-9 against ranked opponents this season, including 4-7 away from home.
- Friday night starter Samuel Dutton leads the team and ranks top 10 in the SEC in ERA (2.48), innings pitched (61.2) and strikeouts (73).
- In his last four starts, Dutton has turned in a 1.46 ERA - four earned runs in 24.2 innings pitched - and has 28 strikeouts with five walks while holding opponents to a .174 average against.
- Auburn leads the all-time series vs. Tennessee 98-43, including a 40-21 mark on the road, but the Tigers are looking for the first series win against the Volunteers since 2019.

Butch Thompson enters his 10th season at the helm of the program in 2025, posting a record of 283-213-1 in his first nine seasons. He has led the program to the College World Series in two of the last five postseasons.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his 10th season with the Tigers in 2025.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in his nine seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 283-213-1 overall record and has advanced to the NCAA Tournament five of the last seven postseasons, including three Super Regional appearances in the last six years and two trips to the College World Series in the last five postseasons.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 33 Division I All-Americans and 48 all-conference performers. He has seen 24 of his former pitchers called up to Major League Baseball, including 18 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 42 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 17 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the program record No. 3 freshman class in 2024, surpassing the 2017 signing class (No. 4) for the highest in program history.

In 32 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 23 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached nine College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019 and taking the team back for the second time in three postseasons in 2022. Thompson became one of five active SEC coaches who have taken their program to a pair of College World Series in a three-year span. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 19 postseason appearances.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

During his tenure with the Tigers, Thompson led the team to three straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 2017-19 for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals in 2018 and 2019 for the first time in program history, and hosted back-to-back regionals for the first time in program history in 2022-23.

Auburn's second straight regional host bid in 2023 came thanks to a second-half run for the record books, and the Tigers became one of five programs in the country and two in the SEC to host each of the last two seasons.

Auburn posted a league-best 12-3 record in the final five weeks of conference play and finished the SEC season with 17 wins, the most since winning the SEC West in 2010. The Tigers finished top five in the league in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 2002-03. The 12-3 stretch was the program's best since also going 12-3 in the final 15 games of the 2010 season and the nine-game SEC winning streak at the end of the regular season and first game of the SEC Tournament was the team's longest since 1995.

Auburn has finished six of Thompson's nine seasons in the top 25, including three in the top 10. The No. 5 national ranking to finish 2022 was tied for the second highest mark in program history.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series



finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 23 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the American Baseball Coaches Association.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. He is a member of both the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame (Class of 2014) and MACCC Hall of Fame (Class of 2021).

Thompson earned a Bachelor's Degree in History at BSC in 1992 and completed a Master's Degree in Sports Administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters -- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail --and the grandparents of Mary Gail and Hayes Grady Moreman.

SAMFORD STADIUM-HITCHCOCK FIELD AT PLAINSMAN PARK

Auburn baseball's home for the past 75 seasons, an expanded and renovated Samford Stadium-Hitchcock Field at Plainsman Park makes its debut for the 2025 season.

After completing a \$30+ million project that has spanned the last two seasons, the ballpark now features premium club areas including the Broadway Club at Plainsman Park located at the top of the stadium behind home plate and the 984 Club located down the first base line to go along with the pre-existing Hall of Fame Club located at field level behind home plate, which opened prior to the 2024 season.

Along with the premium club areas, Plainsman Park now features multiple expanded general admission areas. The renovated Tiger Terrace now includes three tiers of paved terrace space with the bottom tier featuring nine terrace boxes equipped with soft seating and drink rail viewing areas, Traeger pellet grills, refrigerators and more. Additional general admission areas include the two-tiered standing room space atop the War Eagle Wall in left field and the expanded Plainsman Patio at concourse level down the first base line.

The new and improved ballpark, which continues to feature the timeless elements inspired by Camden Yards, Wrigley Field and Fenway Park that were included in the initial renovation spearheaded by former head coach Hal Baird nearly 30 years ago, has a capacity of 7,189. The design continues to combine the look of old-time ballparks with academic buildings on the Auburn campus to create a facade of brick and painted steel.

Kickstarted by the completion of the Josh Donaldson Hitting Facility prior to the 2021 season, Auburn baseball's player development areas also continue to take a step forward. Along with the hitting facility, the program has a new state-of-the-art locker room, bullpen and pitching lab, weight room and nutrition center, and soon-to-be new coaches offices and team meeting space.

Plainsman Park, which has hosted six NCAA Regionals (1978, 1999, 2003, 2010, 2022, 2023) and also had the privilege of hosting President George W. Bush on Oct. 24, 2002, has twice been named one of the best facilities in college baseball. Baseball America initially voted it the best facility in the country prior to the 2003 season, and D1 Baseball named it one of the top venues in the nation in 2016.

SCOUTING THE VOLUNTEERS

- Tennessee enters the weekend with a 36-9 overall record, tied for the fourth most overall win in the league, and a 13-8 mark in SEC play. The Volunteers have dropped three of their last four SEC series, including two at home.
- Offensively, the Volunteers are hitting .305 as a team and rank top five in the country in home runs (100) and slugging percentage (.577). Six players are hitting .300 or higher and five have double digit home runs, led by Andrew Fischer's 16.
- On the mound, Tennessee ranks fourth in the country with a 3.35 staff ERA and has struck out the second most batters per 9.0 innings (11.9). Friday night starter Liam Doyle leads the SEC with a 2.23 ERA and leads the country with 110 strikeouts.

STACKING SERIES WINS

- Dating back to the final two series of the 2024 season, Auburn has won seven of its last nine SEC series.
- The Tigers are one of two teams (Texas) to win seven SEC series in the span.

POSTSEASON RESUME

- Auburn is currently No. 4 in the RPI with the No. 1 strength of schedule in the country.
- The Tigers have played 20 quad one games - home games vs. 1-25, neutral games vs. 1-40 and away games vs. 1-60 - and are 11-9 in those contests.

A LEAGUE OF ITS OWN

- The SEC has the No. 1 conference RPI and has posted a 3121-60 record (.842) against non-conference opponents.
- The next closest conference (ACC) is 257-79 (.765) against non-conference opponents.

GOING THROUGH A GAUNTLET

- Auburn has played nine ranked teams this season, including five in the top 10.
- Each of the first six and eight of 10 SEC series are against ranked teams, including the stretch of four straight vs. top-10 teams that the Tigers completed at Texas from Apr. 17-19.
- Starting with the weekend at Georgia (Mar. 28-29), Auburn's four-week stretch was against the No. 2, No. 8, No. 3 and No. 1 teams in the country.
- The Tigers recently completed a stretch of 20 of the last 24 games coming against ranked opponents and went 11-9 in the span.

OPPONENT WIN PERCENTAGE

- Auburn's 10 SEC opponents have a combined record of 116-94 (.552) in league games.
- The .552 league winning percentage is the second highest in the league behind Missouri (117-93, .557), who is 0-21 in conference play.
- The Tigers have seven of the top eight teams in the current standings on their schedule and do not play three of the bottom five teams.

SUCCESS IN SERIES OPENERS

- Auburn is 9-2 in series openers this season, including 5-2 in SEC play, with the two losses coming on the road at No. 2 Georgia (Mar. 28) and No. 1 Texas (Apr. 17).
- Offensively, the team is hitting .314 and has outscored the opponent 79-30 in game one.
- On the mound, the Tigers have a 2.87 ERA with 108 strikeouts and 20 walks in 91.0 innings in series openers.

RACKING UP (RANKED) WINS

- Auburn enters the weekend 13-9 against ranked opponents, including 4-7 against ranked teams away from home.
- Entering the seventh weekend of SEC play against Mississippi State last week, the team had already surpassed last season's overall (28) and SEC (9) win totals.

CLOSE CALLS

- The Tigers are 10-3 in one-run games this season after going 4-9 in such games last year.
- Nine of the team's last 15 games dating back to Apr. 15 have been decided by two runs or fewer (7-2).

BUSTED OUT THE BROOMS

- Auburn's sweep of LSU from Mar. 11-13 marked the program's first against the Bayou Bengals since 1988.
- It also marked the team's first sweep against a top-five team since sweeping No. 5 Florida at Plainsman Park from Mar. 17-19, 2017.

PROTECTING HOME TURF

- Auburn is 21-6 at home this season, including 9-3 in SEC play, and has won eight straight home series dating back to the Alabama series at the end of last season.
- The eight straight winning weekends at Plainsman Park are the most since 2002-03.

SLINGING SHUTOUTS

- Auburn has turned in back-to-back two-hit shutouts in its last two midweek wins against Georgia Tech (1-0) and Samford (3-0), marking the fourth and fifth shutouts of the season.
- The five shutouts are the most in a season since turning in five shutouts in 18 games in the shortened 2020 season.
- The 1-0 win against Georgia Tech on Apr. 22 marked the program's first 1-0 win since defeating Mercer 1-0 in the Tallahassee Regional on May 30, 2015.
- The Tigers have held the opponent to two hits six times this season and have held the opponent to four runs or fewer nine times in the last 17 games since Apr. 1.

DUTTON IS DEALING

- Through his first 11 starts in an Auburn uniform, Samuel Dutton ranks third in the SEC with a 2.48 ERA and ranks top 10 in innings pitched (61.2) and strikeouts (73).
- He leads the team with five quality starts this season, including three of his last four.
- In his last four starts, three of which game against top-10 opponents, he is 2-0 with a 1.46 ERA with 28 strikeouts and five walks in 24.2 innings and has held opponents to a .174 average against.

TILLY'S TURN

- Cam Tilly made his first career start in the series-clinching win vs. Mississippi State last Sunday and matched a career high with 4.0 innings pitched while allowing three runs on three hits with three walks and three strikeouts.
- In 27 career appearances and 53.2 innings, Tilly has registered 66 strikeouts and held opponents to 36 hits (.188 average against).

WEEKLY AWARDS

- An Auburn freshman was named the SEC Freshman of the Week in three of the first five weeks of the season
 - Bub Terrell: Feb. 24
 - Chris Rembert: Mar. 3
 - Andreas Alvarez: Mar. 17
- After being named the Freshman of the Week earlier this year, Chris Rembert became the first freshman in the league to be named the Player of the Week on Monday.
- He is Auburn's first freshman position player to be named the SEC Player of the Week since Mike Bianucci in 2006.

RED-HOT REMBERT

- Rembert led the league with nine hits in four games last week and hit a pair of homers in the series win against Miss. State.
- He is second on the team with a .348 average (24-for-69) in SEC play and leads the way with a .471 on-base percentage.
- Rembert has collected multiple hits 10 times in the last 18 games and leads the team with a .388 average (26-for-67) during the span.
- He is 11-for-22 with a .560 OBP in five games since the beginning of last week.
- He has reached base in 38 of 40 games with an at-bat this season, including multiple times on 31 occasions.

IKE'S ON ANOTHER LEVEL

- After missing six games from Mar. 9-18 with a fractured scapula, Ike Irish is hitting .358 (34-for-95) with eight doubles, one triple, 10 home runs and 24 RBI in 24 games since his return.
- In three SEC road series, Irish is hitting .432 (16-for-37) with three doubles, eight homers and 12 RBI.
- Irish homered four times at Texas, becoming the first Auburn player since Cooper McMurray in 2023 to homer four times in a SEC series (Mississippi State, Apr. 21-23), and has three multi-homer games since Mar. 22.
- Irish enters the weekend with 194 career hits, including 44 doubles and 31 home runs, and 146 RBI in 144 games played.

DOUBLE DIGIT DINGERS

- Cooper McMurray has hit double digit home runs in back-to-back seasons with 14 apiece in 2023 and 2024 and is second on the team with nine long balls this season.
- With his next home run, McMurray would become just the fourth player in program history to have hit 10+ home runs in three straight seasons.

FRALICK CAN FLAT OUT HIT

- Heading into the 12th weekend of the season, Chase Fralick leads the team with a .340 average and ranks second with 54 hits and 11 doubles and third with 34 RBI.
- Fralick ranks second on the team with 16 multi-hit games, eight of which have come in SEC play, highlighted by a four-hit effort in the series opener vs. Alabama.
- He ranks third on the team with a .333 average and second with 16 RBI in SEC play.

HURT SO GOOD

- Despite missing two weeks with a shoulder injury, Cade Belyeu has been hit by 18 pitches in 107 at-bats this season, including three two-hit-by-pitch games.
- He is second on the team with a .462 on-base percentage, drawing 18 walks to go along with the 18 hit by pitches.
- In 72 career games played and 202 at-bats, the sophomore outfielder has been hit by 31 pitches, tied for the third most in program history.
- Belyeu started Tuesday's game vs. Samford with a two-run homer in the first inning, marking his first homer since Mar. 25.

GOOD TO GET GUEVARA GOING

- In five starts since the beginning of last week, Eric Guevara is hitting .353 (6-for-17) with a home run and four RBI and is reaching base at a .429 clip.
- Guevara played in 21 games at the end of 2024 after tearing his ACL in October and led the team with a .500 average in fall ball.

CARVE 'EM UP, CARSON

- Senior Carson Myers leads the team with 16 appearances and is second on the team with a 3.78 ERA, including a 2.56 ERA in 15 appearances as a reliever this season.
- He is third on the team in strikeouts (42) and innings (33.1) and has issued just six walks.
- Myers turned in a season-long 4.2 scoreless innings with 10 strikeouts in the series finale at Georgia on Mar. 29.
- His 10 strikeouts were a career high and the most by an Auburn reliever since Cole Lipscomb struck out 10 against Florida State in the 2017 Tallahassee Regional.
- Myers struck out seven straight batters to end his outing, and the last nine outs he recorded were via the strikeout.

ENTER THE CHATT

- In four midweek starts, freshman Christian Chatterton has allowed one earned run on four hits with four walks and 26 strikeouts in 19.0 innings pitched - good for a 0.47 ERA and .066 average against during the span.

- He is 3-1 with a 3.95 ERA overall and ranks second on the team in strikeouts (51) and innings pitched (43.1).

HUM NOW, HETZLER

- Sophomore right hander Ryan Hetzler leads the team and ranks tied for second in the SEC with five saves in league play and is tied for fourth with six saves overall.
- Hetzler earned back-to-back SEC saves in the series finale vs. Vanderbilt (Mar. 16) and series opener at Kentucky (Mar. 21), marking his first two saves in an Auburn uniform.
- He went on to earn back-to-back saves in series-clinching win vs. Alabama (Apr. 5) and LSU (Apr. 12) and earned his fifth save with 2.0 scoreless innings in the opener vs. Mississippi State (Apr. 25).

DYNAMIC DUO

- Preseason All-SEC honorees Ike Irish (first team) and Cooper McMurray (second team) combined to hit 28 homers with 115 RBI last year.
- Only two returning duos in the league can claim higher home run and RBI production - Jace LaViolette and Gavin Grahovac at Texas A&M (52 homers, 144 RBI); Slate Alford and Kolby Branch at Georgia (34 homers, 127 RBI).

CREAM OF THE CROP

- Auburn's 2024 signing class was ranked as high as No. 3 in the country, marking a new program record for highest ranked recruiting class - surpassing the 2017 class that was previously ranked No. 4.
- On top of the freshman class, the Tigers also brought in the No. 4 ranked transfer class.

SWEET HOME AUBURN

- Auburn's signing class features five of the top eight players in the state according to Perfect Game, including four players ranked No. 1 at their respective positions.

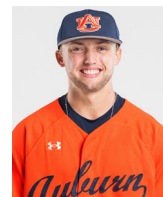
