STORY LINES

- Saturday's matchup against South Alabama marks the first ever meeting between the two in-state programs and is the annual Homecoming game.
- Auburn has an 86-8-4 Homecoming record since the first game was played in 1924 on old Drake Field. The Tigers have won their last 33 Homecoming games, including a 45-19 win over New Mexico last year.
- The game marks the 17th consecutive sellout at Jordan-Hare Stadium, tying the program record previously set from 2013-16.
- South Alabama is the 143rd different opponent Auburn has played all-time, including the 92nd of the other 135 current FBS programs.
- The Jaguars are the 12th different in-state non-conference opponent Auburn has played in program history. The Tigers have compiled a 63-4-1 record against the group.
- Auburn is looking to open 3-0 for the 52nd time all-time and the second time in three seasons under head coach Hugh Freeze (2023).
- Auburn has scored in a school-record 156 consecutive games dating back to the first game of 2013.
- The Tigers lead the SEC in both rushing defense (30.5 YPG) and rushing offense (265.5 YPG), ranking second and 11th in FBS in the categories, respectively.
- The team allowed 68 yards of total offense against Ball State, marking the fewest total yards since holding Ole Miss to nine yards in 1985.
- The Tigers held the Cardinals to -3 yards rushing, which is the fewest since holding Akron to -3 in 2021.
- Auburn has allowed a total of 551 total yards (275.5 YPG) through two games, which is its fewest since allowing 364 yards (182 YPG) in 2021.
- The Tigers recorded 14.0 TFL in the win against Ball State, the most since recording 14.0 tackles for a loss against Ole Miss in 2014.
- Seventy-six players saw action in the win vs. Ball State, including 14 who made their Auburn debuts.
- Auburn appeared at No. 24 in the AP poll this week, marking the first time the Tigers have been ranked in the AP poll since being ranked No. 16 on Nov. 7, 2021.
- The Tigers are 335-126-6 all-time as a ranked team, including 138-35-1 as a ranked team against non-conference opponents and 194-36-2 as a ranked team at Jordan-Hare Stadium (157-20-1 vs. unranked opponents).
- Auburn leads the SEC in both tackles for loss (19.0) and sacks (10.0), tying for the national lead in the latter.

SERIES HISTORY

- Saturday's matchup marks the first in program history between Auburn and South Alabama.
- South Alabama is the 143rd different opponent Auburn has played all-time, including the 92nd of the other 135 current FBS programs.

UP NEXT

- Auburn starts SEC play with a trip to Norman, Oklahoma, to take on No. 13/16 Oklahoma Saturday, Sept. 20.
- The Tigers are 0-3 all-time against Oklahoma and have never played a game in Norman.

BEST ON BOTH SIDES

- Auburn leads the SEC in both rushing defense (30.5 YPG) and rushing offense (265.5 YPG), ranking second and 11th in FBS in the categories, respectively.
- The Tigers and BYU are the only two teams to rank in the top 11 in FBS in both categories.
- The 30.5 YPG allowed rushing is Auburn's best mark through two games since 2021 (21.5 YPG).
- Auburn's 470-yard rush differential through two games is the largest in program history.

DOMINANT ON DEFENSE

- Auburn allowed 68 yards of total offense against Ball State, marking the fewest total yards since holding Ole Miss to nine yards in 1985.
- The Tigers held the Cardinals to -3 yards rushing, which is the fewest since holding Akron to -3 yards rushing in 2021.
- Auburn has allowed a total of 551 total yards (275.5 YPG) through two games, which is its fewest since allowing 364 yards (182 YPG) in 2021.

SOLID VS. SUN BELT

- Auburn is 42-5 all-time against teams from the Sun Belt Conference with the last loss coming in 1991.

SOUTH ALABAMA CONNECTION

- Former Auburn linebacker Tre' Williams (2014-17) is in his third season at South Alabama, serving as the team's special teams coordinator and outside linebackers coach.
- Williams played in 47 career games at Auburn and made 188 tackles, including 11.0 TFL and 3.5 sacks.

AUBURN IN HOME OPENERS

- Auburn improved to 107-16-3 (.861) all-time in home openers with Saturday's 42-3 win vs. Ball State.
- The Tigers have won 18 of their last 20 home openers, the latest loss coming in 2016 to the eventual national champion Clemson Tigers by a 19-13 score.
- Auburn is 3-0 and has outscored its opponents 174-20 in home openers under head coach Hugh Freeze, averaging 58 points per game.

BACK IN THE AP POLL

- Auburn appeared at No. 24 in the AP poll this week, marking the first time the Tigers have been ranked in the AP poll since being ranked No. 16 on Nov. 7, 2021.
- The Tigers are 335-126-6 as a ranked team, including 138-35-1 as a ranked team against non-conference opponents and 194-36-2 as a ranked team at Jordan-Hare Stadium.
- Ranked Auburn teams are 93-6 vs unranked non-conference opponents at JHS all-time including 24 straight victories.

FIRSTS FOR FREEZE

- Auburn's first three games of the season - at Baylor, vs. Ball State, vs. South Alabama - will be the first meetings for teams coached by Hugh Freeze.

YEAR THREE UNDER FREEZE

- In his two previous stops in which he has reached his third season as a head coach, Freeze has turned in a combined record of 17-9.
 - 9-4 in 2014 (Ole Miss)
 - 8-5 in 2021 (Liberty)
- After also leading Ole Miss to a 39-24 overall record in five seasons in Oxford from 2012-16, Freeze enters his eighth season as a head coach in the SEC, ranking third among the league's active head coaches.
 - Mark Stoops, Kentucky: 13th season
 - Kirby Smart, Georgia: 10th season
 - Hugh Freeze, Auburn: 8th season

FAMILIAR FACES

- Auburn is one of 56 FBS programs (out of 136) to return its head coach, offensive coordinator (Derrick Nix), defensive coordinator (DJ Durkin) and strength and conditioning coach (Dom Studzinski).

SCORING STREAK

- Auburn has scored in a school-record 156 consecutive games dating back to the first game of the 2013 season.
- The Tigers are averaging 30.13 ppg (4,700 total points) during that stretch.
- The streak breaks the previous program record of 149 games set from 1980-92.

RUNNING WILD

- Auburn has rushed for 531 yards on 86 carries through two games this season, good for 6.17 YPC and the 17th best clip in FBS, including the third best in the SEC.
- The team's seven rushing touchdowns and six runs of 20+ yards through two games are tied for the most in the SEC

WINNING ON THE ROAD

- Auburn's 38 points in the season opener at Baylor were its most points in a road non-conference game since defeating Florida State, 42-41, in 1984.
- The win marked the program's first road win in a season opener since defeating Virginia 28-17 to begin the 1997 season.

SUSTAINED SCORING DRIVES

- Half of Auburn's 12 possessions that have resulted in points this season have been drives of seven or more plays and 65 or more yards.
 - 12 plays, 96 yards at Baylor (05:33)
 - 7 plays, 65 yards at Baylor (03:45)
 - 9 plays, 71 yards at Baylor (04:12)
 - 12 plays, 75 yards at Baylor (07:16)
 - 9 plays, 67 yards vs. Ball State (03:14)
 - 9 plays, 72 yards vs. Ball State (03:36)

REDZONE OFFENSE

- Auburn has converted on all five of its redzone possessions this season, resulting in four touchdowns and one field goal.

ACTION JACKSON

- Jackson Arnold was named the SEC Co-Player of the Week after rushing for a career-high 137 yards on 16 carries, good for 8.6 yards per carry, and matching a career high with two rushing TDs while going 11-for-17 with 108 yards passing in his Auburn debut at Baylor.
- He became the first Auburn QB since Cam Newton (2010) to rush and pass for 100+ yards in their Auburn debut and his 137 rushing yards were the most by an Auburn QB since Nick Marshall rushed for 214 yards at Tennessee in 2013.
- Arnold followed his performance by going 24-for-28 with 251 yards and three touchdowns in his Jordan-Hare Stadium debut vs. Ball State.
- He ranks second in the SEC and sixth in FBS in completion percentage (77.8).

DYNAMIC DUO

- Both Cam Coleman and Eric Singleton Jr. were named to the preseason Biletnikoff Award watch list, making Auburn one of eight programs with multiple wide receivers on the watch list.
 - Ohio State (3), Ole Miss (3), Alabama (2), Auburn (2), Clemson (2), Michigan State (2), Penn State (2), Texas Tech (2)
- The duo has accounted for 15 catches, 184 yards and two touchdowns in the first two game.

SUPER CAM

- Coleman finished his freshman season with 37 receptions for 598 yards and eight touchdowns.
- His 598 receiving yards were the third most by an Auburn freshman in program history and his eight touchdown receptions are tied for the most among returning SEC players this season.
- Over his last five games dating back to last season, Coleman has caught 30 passes for 406 yards and six touchdowns.
- During the span, Coleman has caught at least seven passes in a game four times.
- He ranked No. 1 in the country with six receiving touchdowns and No. 6 in the country with 306 receiving yards in the final three games of 2024.
 - Nov. 16 vs. ULM: 8 rec, 100 yards, 3 TD
 - Nov. 23 vs. Texas A&M: 7 rec, 128 yards, 2 TD

SINGLETON'S CATCH STREAK

- Singleton Jr. arrived at Auburn as ESPN's No. 1 wide receiver and No. 3 overall player in the last season's transfer portal.
- Singleton has a catch in every game of his collegiate career, extending his streak to 26 games with four catches for 64 yards and a pair of touchdowns vs. Ball State, marking the first multi-touchdown game of his career.
- His 26 straight games with a reception mark the 14th longest active streak in FBS.
- Singleton has multiple catches in 25 of 26 career games played, including 18 games with four or more receptions.

COBB'S CAREER START

- Jeremiah Cobb turned in his first career 100-yard game with 121 yards and two touchdowns on 11 carries vs. Ball State.
- His 121 rushing yards were the sixth most in the SEC this season, and the game marked Cobb's first career two-touchdown contest. He has already surpassed his career high with three rushing TDs on the season.
- Cobb scored on runs of 46 yards in the first quarter and 45 yards in the third quarter – the two longest runs of his career – and averaged 11.0 yards per carry against the Cardinals.
- He has recorded back-to-back games with 10+ carries for the first time in his career.
- Through two weeks of the season, Cobb ranks second in the SEC in rushing TDs (three) and fourth in rushing yards (195).

O-LINE EXPERIENCE

- Auburn's offensive line has combined for 257 career games played, the most in the SEC.
- The O-line has also combined for 149 career games started, the third most in the SEC.
- The Tigers returned four offensive linemen who started at least 11 games last season and combined to start 47 games as a group in 2024.
- Connor Lew, Izavion Miller, Dillon Wade and Jeremiah Wright have combined to start 97 games in their collegiate career, including 74 at Auburn.

CONSECUTIVE STARTS IN THE TRENCHES

- Auburn has six lineman on either side of the ball who have started in 14 or more straight games: Xavier Chaplain (27), Dillon Wade (24), Keldric Faulk (22), Connor Lew (20), Mason Murphy (14) and Jeremiah Wright (14).

YOUTH MOVEMENT

- Freshman center Kail Ellis entered the 2025 season as the youngest player in FBS and made his Auburn debut vs. Ball State.
- Ellis turned 17 years old on Apr. 29 and is one of two players who will play the entirety of the 2025 season at 17 years old.
- Along with Ellis, freshman running back Omar Mabson II reclassified to 2025 and didn't turn 18 until earlier this month (Aug. 9).

\ At the opening of training camps, Auburn had 52 former lettermen on NFL rosters, representing 27 different NFL teams.

\ Auburn has had 31 players taken in the first round of the NFL draft (most recently Derrick Brown and Noah Igbinoghene in 2020) and four No. 1 overall draft picks: Cam Newton (Carolina, '11), Aundray Bruce (Atlanta, '88), Bo Jackson (Tampa, '86) and Tucker Frederickson (NY Giants, '65).

\ At least one former Tiger has been selected to 19 of the last 25 Pro Bowls, and Auburn has had at least one former player in 16 of the last 19 Super Bowls, including Jack Driscoll and CJ Uzomah with the Philadelphia Eagles in Super Bowl LVIX.

GETTING IT DONE ON THIRD DOWN

- Auburn is second in the SEC and tied for 11th in FBS holding opponents to 20.69 percent on third downs this season.
- The Tigers held Ball State to 1-of-14 on third downs, which is the best mark by Auburn's defense since holding Georgia Southern to 0-of-15 on third down to open the 2017 season.
- On the other side of the ball, the Tigers are 11-for-21 on third down (52.38 percent) and have totaled 504 yards on 66 first-down plays (7.64 YPP).

BRINGING 'EM DOWN BEHIND THE LINE

- Auburn leads the SEC and ranks top 10 in FBS in TFL (19.0) and sacks (10.0), tying for the national lead in the latter.
- The team's 14.0 TFL vs. Ball State were the most since also recording 14.0 TFL vs. Ole Miss in 2014.
- Twelve players have recorded a TFL this season and eight have recorded a sack.

CAPTAIN KELDRIC

- Junior defensive end Keldric Faulk entered his third season at Auburn in 2025 with a plethora of preseason honors, including being named a Preseason All-American by Athlon and ESPN and Preseason All-SEC First Team by the coaches and the media.
- Faulk was rated by ESPN as the No. 18 player in college football entering 2025, including the No. 8 player from the SEC and No. 5 player on the defensive front.

KEYRON'S WREAKING HAVOC

- Making his first two starts in an Auburn uniform to start the season, Keyron Crawford is tied for the SEC lead with 3.0 sacks and leads Auburn with 11 tackles.
- Saturday vs. Ball State, Crawford matched a career high with 2.0 sacks, marking his most in an Auburn uniform, while forcing a fumble and applying another QB hurry.
- He recorded an Auburn-high seven tackles and added his first sack in an Auburn uniform in the season opener at Baylor.
- According to PFF, Crawford leads the SEC in pass rush percentage.

X GON' GIVE IT TO YA

- Xavier Atkins has started his first two games at Auburn and has recorded a career-high five tackles in each of the first two contests.
- All five of Atkins tackles vs. Ball State were solo stops, and he recorded career highs with 4.0 TFL and 2.0 sacks.
- His 4.0 TFL were the most in the SEC this season and the most by an Auburn player since Jalen McLeod also recorded 4.0 TFL at Arkansas in 2023.
- He is second in the SEC and 10th in FBS in TFL.

TAKE IT AWAY

- Auburn is 76-41 when it forces a turnover since the start of the 2013 season and 46-16 when it forces multiple turnovers during the span.
- Conversely, the Tigers are 15-21 when it fails to force a turnover.

MCPHERSON IS AUTOMATIC

- Alex McPherson is a perfect 63-for-63 on PAT in his career and is 21-for-23 (91.3%) on FG - the best mark in Auburn history and the best among active FBS kickers with a minimum of 20 FGM.
- His 63 extra points without a miss makes him one of only four Auburn kickers (min. 50 PAT attempts) to complete multiple seasons without a miss.

RUN IT BACK, RAY

- Junior cornerback Rayshawn Pleasant returned his first kickoff in an Auburn uniform 98 yards for a touchdown at the end of the third quarter at Baylor, extending Auburn's lead from one score to two in the eventual win.
- The kickoff return TD was the third of Pleasant's career, all coming in the last two seasons, and was the fourth TD of his career (one INT return).
 - 94-yard TD at Louisiana (9/21/2024)
 - 100-yard TD at UAB (10/5/24)
 - 98-yard TD at Baylor (8/29/25)
- He is the only FBS player with three kickoff return TDs in the last two seasons and is one of three active FBS players with three or more kickoff return TDs in their career, joined by Barion Brown (LSU) and Jaylin Lucas (FSU).
- Pleasant ranks third in the SEC with 147 kick return yards this season.

N.O.T GOING TO LOSE

- Auburn is 30-3 since the start of the 2013 season in games when scoring a non-offensive touchdown, the latest Pleasant's 98-yard kick return TD at the end of the third quarter at Baylor.

PACKING JORDAN-HARE

- Saturday will mark Auburn's 17th consecutive sellout at Jordan-Hare Stadium dating back to the beginning of the 2023 season, matching the current program record previously set from 2013-16.
- The first three home games of 2025 and four of seven home games overall are already sold out.

40-YEAR ANNIVERSARY

- The 2025 season marks the 40th anniversary of Bo Jackson's 1985 Heisman Trophy winning season, becoming the second of three Heisman Trophy winners in program history, and Auburn will honor Jackson at the Iron Bowl on Nov. 29.
- Jackson rushed for 1,786 yards, which was the second-best single-season performance in Southeastern Conference history, and 17 touchdowns en route to winning the highest honor in college football.
- The Bessemer, Alabama, native finished his four-year Auburn career with 4,303 rushing yards and 4,575 all-purpose yards and 43 rushing touchdowns. His No. 34 jersey was retired as part of Auburn's football centennial celebration in 1992.

RETIRING NO. 2

- Auburn Athletics will retire 2010 Heisman Trophy winner Cam Newton's No. 2 jersey with a ceremony during the Georgia game on Oct. 11, making him the fourth player in program history to have his jersey number retired.
- Newton's No. 2 jersey will join Pay Sullivan (No. 7), Bo Jackson (No. 34) and Terry Beasley (No. 88) as former football players to have their jersey number retired.
- One of the most decorated players in Auburn and SEC history, Newton was a consensus All-American in his lone season at Auburn and won the Walter Camp Award, Maxwell Award, Manning Award, Davey O'Brien Award and was Associated Press National Player of the Year while also leading the Tigers to the BCS National Championship.
- During Newton's historic 2010 season, he threw for 2,854 yards and 30 touchdowns while rushing for 1,473 yards and 20 touchdowns. He became the first player in SEC history to pass for more than 2,000 yards and rush for more than 1,000 yards in a single season.

HONORING ANOTHER HALL OF FAMER

- Former Auburn linebacker Gregg Carr (1981-84) will be inducted into the National Football Foundation Hall of Fame on Dec. 9 in Las Vegas, becoming the 13th member of the NFF Hall of Fame in program history.
- A consensus First Team All-American in 1984, Carr was Auburn's leading tackler as a sophomore (125), junior (136) and the second leading tackler as a senior (139). A two-time First Team All-SEC selection and 1984 SEC Lineman of the Year, Carr amassed 453 career tackles, currently ranking him second in school history. His career totals include 289 solo tackles, which also rank second in the school record books, and nine sacks. His 139 total tackles as a senior rank eighth in school annals for a single season.
- Along with the recognition for Jackson, Carr will also be honored during the Iron Bowl on Nov. 29.

AUBURN'S ALL-TIME RECORD

- Auburn has a 806-478-47 record in 133 seasons of football, the 14th most wins among FBS programs.
- The Tigers are 415-108-8 in Auburn, 207-207-20 in true road games and 184-163-19 in all other games outside of Auburn.

JORDAN-HARE STADIUM

- In the 86th season of football at Jordan-Hare Stadium, Auburn is 351-99-7 all-time in the stadium.
- This includes two wins by forfeit against Mississippi State (21-21, tie in 1975 and 27-13, MSU in 1977).
- The Tigers have had a winning home record 70 times in the history of JHS, including 21 of the last 25 seasons.

AUBURN IN SEC PLAY

- Auburn holds a 340-279-18 (.548) record in SEC play since 1933.
- The Tigers are 150-72-5 (.672) in Jordan-Hare Stadium, 127-142-8 (.473) in true road games and 63-65-5 (.492) at neutral sites against SEC opponents.

SCHEDULE NOTES

- Auburn will host a pair of teams ranked in the top 10 in the preseason AP Top 25 in No. 5 Georgia on Oct. 11 and No. 8 Alabama on Nov. 29.
- The game against the Bulldogs will mark the first time the two rivals have played under the lights at Jordan-Hare Stadium since 2012 and just the second time since 2000.
- Auburn has back-to-back road games against preseason top 25 teams when the Tigers travel to No. 18 Oklahoma on Sept. 20 and No. 19 Texas A&M on Sept. 27.
- All 16 SEC teams will face at least four opponents ranked in the preseason AP Top 25.
- The ACC minimum is zero, Big 12 minimum is one and Big Ten minimum is two.

17 CONSECUTIVE SELLOUTS

Pat Dye Field at Jordan-Hare Stadium, the nation's 11th-largest on-campus stadium with a capacity of 88,043, is in its 83rd year as home to the Auburn Tigers.

On football Saturdays in Auburn, Jordan-Hare Stadium becomes Alabama's sixth-largest city. A record number of 63,500 season tickets were sold before the 2023 and 2024 seasons.

The stadium is named for Ralph "Shug" Jordan, Auburn's all-time winningest football coach, and Clifford Leroy Hare, a member of Auburn's first football team, president of the old Southern Conference and longtime chairman of Auburn's Faculty Athletic Committee.

Legendary coach Pat Dye has also had his name forever attached to Jordan-Hare Stadium, as the turf officially became known as Pat Dye Field at Jordan-Hare Stadium prior to the 2005 Iron Bowl. Dye, who served as coach and athletics director at Auburn (1981-92) and was inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame (2005), led Auburn to a 99-39-4 record and four SEC titles in his 12 seasons on the Plains.

Auburn's current string of 17 consecutive sellout crowds at Jordan-Hare Stadium, including the South Alabama game, ties the program record streak of 17 consecutive sellout crowds, set between the 2013 Georgia game and the 2016 Clemson game.

What is now Jordan-Hare Stadium was dedicated November 30, 1939, at the Auburn-Florida game. Babe McGehee, who passed away in 2005, scored the first touchdown in what was then called "Auburn Stadium," by catching a pass from Dick McGowen. McGowen, who later coached at Auburn under Jordan, kicked the extra point and Auburn tied Florida, 7-7.

That first stadium held 7,500 seats and consisted of what is now the bottom part of the lower west stands. When the stadium was renamed "Cliff Hare Stadium" in 1949, 14,000 seats—the present lower east stands—had been added, raising capacity to 21,500.

Jordan became head coach in 1951 and the stadium underwent three major expansions in 15 years. More than 40,000 seats, virtually half of the stadium's present capacity, were added while Jordan was the coach.

Cliff Hare Stadium became Jordan-Hare Stadium in 1973. It was the first stadium in the country to be named for an active coach.

Overall, Auburn has played 456 games in Jordan-Hare Stadium, winning 351, losing 99 and tying seven for a winning percentage of .777 against some of the best teams in college football.

HUGH FREEZE » HEAD COACH



Hugh Freeze was named the 31st head football coach in Auburn's 129-year history on November 28, 2022. Freeze holds a 116-61 overall record as a head coach and is 49-33 in conference games.

With Auburn's selection to the Music City Bowl in 2023, Freeze has led four teams to a postseason bowl during his career. That ties him for the most schools among active coaches and fifth among coaches all-time. Freeze has guided Arkansas State, Ole Miss, Liberty and Auburn all to bowl games.

The head coach at Liberty from 2019-22, Freeze led the Flames to four bowl games and a 34-15 record. During his tenure at Liberty, he took former Auburn quarterback Malik Willis and developed him into one of the nation's top quarterbacks in 2021.

Freeze experienced similar success at each of his head coaching stops prior to Liberty, including Lambuth University (2008-09), Arkansas State (2011) and Ole Miss (2012-16). The Oxford, Mississippi, native led each school to double-digit win seasons, while helping Ole Miss to a top 10 national finish in 2015. He has led four different programs to double-digit win seasons.

Freeze guided Liberty to a 10-1 overall record in 2020 and the team's first-ever national ranking as it finished No. 17 in the country. That season Liberty had the best start in program history (8-0), tied the program record for wins (10) and defeated two Power 5 programs in Syracuse and Virginia Tech. For his efforts, Freeze was a finalist for the George Munger Collegiate Coach of the Year Award that season.

While the head coach at Ole Miss, Freeze led it back to championship form during his five seasons, guiding it to bowl games during three of his five years, including wins in the 2013 Music City bowl and the 2016 Sugar Bowl.

Freeze's time in Oxford was highlighted by a 10-3 campaign in 2015, the program's first 10-win season since 2003. The Rebels won their first four games of the 2015 season, including a 43-37 road victory over No. 2 Alabama, Ole Miss' first win in Tuscaloosa, since 1988.

In his Auburn debut, Jackson Arnold, the 2022 national high school player of the year returned to the Lone Star State and led the Tigers to a 38-24 victory over Baylor Friday at McLane Stadium.

Playing two hours south of his hometown in Denton, Texas, Arnold rushed for 137 yards and two touchdowns while adding 108 passing yards, securing Auburn's win with a 27-yard TD rush late in the fourth quarter on fourth down.

Arnold averaged 8.6 yards per carry on 16 rushes while completing 11 of 17 passes to pace Auburn's 307-yard rushing effort.

Leading 17-10 at the half, Auburn doubled its lead on a 70-yard drive with Arnold's 21-yard run crossing midfield and setting up Jeremiah Cobb's 2-yard touchdown to put the Tigers ahead 24-10 with 5:40 remaining in third quarter.

Baylor answered with a 75-yard drive, cutting Auburn's lead to 24-17 on Sawyer Robertson's touchdown pass to Caden Knighten on fourth-and-goal from the 4-yard line with 58 seconds left in the third quarter.

Rayshawn Pleasant immediately regained momentum for the visitors, fielding Baylor's kickoff at Auburn's 2-yard line in the middle of the field, cutting to his left and racing 98 yards down the sideline to give the Tigers a 31-17 lead with 35 friends and family members in attendance.

Baylor responded with a 79-yard touchdown drive, again trimming the Tigers' lead to seven points on Robertson's third touchdown pass, a 4-yarder to Michael Trigg at the 11:48 of the fourth quarter.

Auburn then consumed more than half of the fourth quarter, putting away the game with a 75-yard, 12-play touchdown drive, with Arnold converting three third downs before beating the Bears at their own game, going for it on fourth-and-1 and scoring on a 27-yard run up the middle for the game's final score with 4:32 remaining.

Baylor took a 3-0 lead on the game's opening possession on Connor Hawkins 36-yard field goal. On their second drive, the Bears had first-and-goal at Auburn's 8-yard line after a 57-yard pass completion, but the Tigers held Baylor to 5 yards on three rushes, then forced an incompletion on fourth down to take over on downs.

Auburn drove 96 yards on 12 plays to take a 7-3 lead with Arnold picking up a first down with a 9-yard run on third-and-7. Consecutive false start penalties gave Auburn first-and-20, but a 26-yard pass from Arnold to Malcolm Simmons picked up a first down at Baylor's 37-yard line. Two plays later, Arnold rushed up the middle behind a block from center Connor Lew and cut to his right for a 24-yard touchdown.

Auburn's defense recorded a three-and-out, then the Tigers claimed a 14-3 with a run-heavy, seven-play, 65-yard drive that Damari Alston capped with a 9-yard touchdown run at the 10:29 mark of the second quarter.

Arnold's 23-yard pass to Cam Coleman set up Alex McPherson's 21-yard field goal with 5:45 left in the first half, giving the Tigers 17 consecutive points. Baylor cut Auburn's lead to 17-10 at the half with 3:21 to play in the half on Robertson's 33-yard touchdown pass on fourth-and-8.

Holding Ball State to minus-3 rushing yards thanks to 14 tackles for loss, Auburn used three Jackson Arnold touchdown passes and two Jeremiah Cobb touchdown runs to defeat Ball State 42-3 Saturday in Kickoff on The Plains at Jordan-Hare Stadium.

After relying on the run in its season-opening win at Baylor, Auburn went to the air early and often in its home opener, with Arnold completing 24 of 28 passes for 251 yards.

With linemen Xavier Chaplin, Dillon Wade and Connor Lew creating a running lane to his left, Cobb broke a tackle at Ball State's 20-yard line and scored on a 46-yard touchdown run to give Auburn a 7-0 lead at the 4:15 mark of the first quarter.

Arnold put Auburn ahead 14-0 in the final minute of the first quarter with a 30-yard touchdown pass to Eric Singleton Jr., who motioned across the field and used his running start to clear the nearest defender by 15 yards for his first Tiger touchdown.

Auburn extended its lead to 21-0 when Arnold connected with an uncovered Horatio Fields for an 11-yard touchdown with 37 seconds left in the first half.

Midway through the third quarter, Cobb cruised 45 yards for his second score to give Auburn a 28-0 lead. Cobb rushed for a career-high 121 yards on 11 carries, averaging 11 yards per rush.

After Ball State recovered an Auburn fumble on the Tigers' 23-yard line, the Cardinals avoided a shutout by kicking a 22-yard field goal late in the third quarter.

Arnold ended his night on a high note, connecting with Singleton for a 13-yard touchdown to give Auburn a 35-3 lead with 12:22 left in the game.

Freshman quarterback Deuce Knight relieved Arnold, rushing for a first down on third-and-10 in his Auburn debut. Knight's first career completion went for 14 yards to Camden Etheredge.

Durrell Robinson capped the scoring with a 54-yard touchdown run with 5:13 to play.

Cam Coleman led Auburn with seven receptions for 77 yards. Sylvester Smith led Auburn with six tackles, all solos. Xavier Atkins delivered a memorable performance with five tackles, including four tackles for loss and a pair of sacks. Keyron Crawford added two sacks while Demarcus Riddick and Jared Smith each made one, helping Auburn hold Ball State to 68 total yards.

For the second straight week, Auburn negated its opponents rushing attack, holding Ball State to negative-3 yards on 33 attempts. In two games, Auburn has allowed only 61 yards rushing.

Keyron Crawford led Auburn with seven tackles and one of the Tigers' four sacks.
