### **COACHING HISTORY**

Auburn (HC) 2015-Arizona State (HC) 2003-15 Tulsa - Head (HC) 2001-02 coach in 2025-26. She came to Auburn after spending the previous 13 years as the head coach at Arizona State, leading the program to an NCAA title in 2009, and then two years prior to that as the head coach at the University of Tulsa.

While at Auburn, Luellen guided the Tigers to three consecutive appearances in the NCAA Championship from 2019-2022, including a top-four finish in 2019 and 2022.

The Tigers picked up a tournament victory at the Cougar Classic and recorded five top-five finishes as a team throughout the 2024-25 season. Anna Davis earned WGCA second team All-American honors for the second consecutive season and was tabbed first team All-SEC. Davis won two individual titles during the campaign at the Illini Women's Invitational at Medinah and the Charles Schwab Women's Collegiate, where she broke a program record for

lowest 54-hole score with a 9-under 201. Luellen's squad recieved a bid to an NCAA Regional for the eighth consecutive season the championships have been held and finished the season ranked No. 17 nationally.

Auburn captured two tournament victories during the 2023-24 season at the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic and the NCAA Auburn Regional and finished within the top-5 in nine tournaments. The team recorded the best team scoring average in program history (287.35) and tied the second-lowest 18-hole score in program history at the Mason Rudolph Championship (274). The Tigers finished the stroke play portion of the SEC Championship and reached the quarterfinal round of match play. The team reached match play at the NCAA Championship for the fourth time since 2019 and finished the season as national quarterfinalists. Freshman Anna Davis was awarded second-team WGCA All-American and WGCA All-Freshman team honors while Davis, Megan Schofill and Casey Weidenfeld were tabbed second team All-SEC.

During the 2022-23 season, the Tigers finished in the top-5 in nine of 11 events played with two victories at the prestigious East Lake Cup in Atlanta and the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic in Athens, Georgia. The team captured a second place finish during the stroke play portion of the 2023 SEC Championship and earned the team's sixth consecutive NCAA Regional bid and the 28th in program history. The team set the second lowest

all-time overall scoring average (290.73), par-4 scoring average (4.16), par-5 scoring average (4.89) and the lowest all-time par-3 scoring average (3.14). The Tigers also set the record for lowest 54-hole team score (835) as well as the second lowest 18-hole team score (274) at the Illini Women's Invitational.

Senior Megan Schofill received the program's 12th first-team All-American honor following the 2022-23 season and was a first team All-SEC member as well. Schofill and junior Elina Sinz each earned individual victories at the Mason Rudolph Championship and the Liz Murphey Collegiate Classic, respectively. Junior Anna Foster received a second-team All-SEC nod and Casey Weidenfeld became the 10th Auburn golfer to be named to the SEC All-Freshman team.



In the 2021-22 season, the Tigers captured seven top five finishes and won the stroke play portion of the SEC Championship. They went on

to finish in a tie for third at the NCAA Stillwater Regional and finished as a semifinalist at the NCAA Championship in Scottsdale.

In 2019-20, the season was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In seven tournaments, Auburn finished top five in five of them and won the Lake Oconee Invitational. Kaleigh Telfer and Megan Schofill both earned individual medalist honors with Telfer winning the Northrop Grumman Regional Challenge and Schofill taking first at Lake Oconee.

The 2018-19 season proved to be a breakthrough season for Auburn under Luellen. Not only did the team finish as a national semifinalist, they also captured two tournament victories: the Battle at the Beach and the Shootout at Shoal Creek. The Tigers tied for third in the SEC Championship, making it to the semifinals of match play, and they placed fifth in the NCAA Auburn Regional to earn their spot in the NCAA Championship.

Individually, four different players won titles in 2018-19 with Anika Bolcikova (Magnolia Invitational), Kaleigh Telfer (Battle at the Beach), Brooke Sansom (Shootout at Shoal Creek) and Julie McCarthy (Clemson Invitational). It's the first time that's happened since the 2011-12 season.

Julie McCarthy, who finished with the sixth-lowest stroke average per round (72.90) in single-season history, earned First-Team All-SEC and Honorable Mention All-American honors while teammate Brooke Sansom was named to the All-SEC Freshman Team.

In 2017-18, Luellen's third season on The Plains, Auburn made its first trip back to the NCAA Championship since 2013 after finishing third in the NCAA Austin Regional. The Tigers placed fifth or better in five tournaments and also earned one individual title (Kayley Marschke, Lake Oconee Individual Championship). Senior Kelli Murphy was named to the All-SEC Second Team, and Kaleigh Telfer made the All-SEC Freshman Team.

During her very successful tenure at Arizona State, Luellen led the program to an NCAA team title, 10 NCAA Top 10 finishes, two conference championships and 25 team titles. She also coached one NCAA Individual Champion, three Pac-12 Golfers of the Year, three NGCA Freshmen of the Year, 14 All-Americans and 21 individual tournament medalists.

Luellen's coaching accomplishments have earned her several personal coaching honors. After the Sun Devils' NCAA Championship run in 2009, she was named SkyCaddie NGCA National Coach of the Year. Luellen was also named Pac-10 Coach of the Year three times (2006, 2007, 2009) and West Regional Coach of the Year

four times (2005, 2006, 2007, 2009). While at Tulsa, Luellen was named Central Regional Coach of the Year in 2002 and WAC Coach of the Year in 2001 and 2002.

Luellen's golfers have also achieved excellence in the classroom. NCAA Champion Azahara Munoz became the first two-time winner of the Edith Cummings Munson Award, which is given to the All-American with the highest grade point average. The following year, Sun Devil Juliana Murcia won the same honor.



In her two seasons as Tulsa's head coach, Luellen led her alma mater to seven tournament titles including back-to-back Western Athletic Conference and NCAA Central Regional championships in each year. The 2001-02 season saw her team win five tournaments, including the 2002 PING/ASU Championship at Karsten Golf Course, earn a No. 3 national ranking for most of the season, and finish 12th at the 2002 NCAA Championships. Luellen was named the Western Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in each of her two seasons and was the 2002 Central Regional Coach of the Year

A four-time All-American for the Golden Hurricane, Luellen succeeded her mother, Dale McNamara, who retired in 2000 following a 26-year career that included four national championships.

As a player at Tulsa, Luellen won medalist honors at four tournaments and recorded 22 top-10 finishes in 41 career events. She capped off a stellar collegiate career by capturing a two-stroke individual victory at the 1988 NCAA Championship while leading the Golden Hurricanes to the national team title.

After graduating with a bachelor's degree in Marketing from Tulsa in 1988, Luellen competed on the Futures and Ladies European Tours in 1988 and 1989 before qualifying for the LPGA Tour in October of 1989. She spent 11 years on the LPGA Tour, winning the 1991 Stratton Mountain LPGA Classic and teamed with Mike Springer to win the 1993 JC Penney Classic. She was also elected to the LPGA Executive Committee in her final two years on the tour.

Prior to college, she was a three-time Oklahoma state high school champion, a two-time Women's Oklahoma Golf Association Girls' Junior Champion (1981, 1982), the 1983 WOGA State Amateur, and the 1983 AJGA Player of the Year. Luellen was inducted into the Women's Golf Coaches Association Player Hall of Fame in 1998, the WGCA Coaches Hall of Fame in 2014 and the University of Tulsa Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000.

Luellen and her husband, Mark, have a son, Drake, and a daughter, Sydney.

Auburn 2020-Auburn (VC) 2018-2020 was promoted to associate head coach before the 2022-23 season.

Hall, a native of San Antonio, Texas, played five full seasons on the LPGA Tour from 2006-10, serving three seasons as Player Vice President on the LPGA Board of Directors. Her top finish as a professional was a third-place showing

at the 2008 Bell Micro LPGA Classic. She retired from full-time competition in

2010 after the birth of her first child.

Hall was a four-year letter winner at Stanford from 1999-2003. She was the

team MVP for two seasons, earning one victory along with 13 top-10 finishes. She was also a three-time selection to the All-Pac 10 Team. Hall graduated from Stanford in 2003 with a degree in American studies and a minor in political science.

As a junior golfer in San Antonio, she was the 1996 Texas state champion, the 1997 South Texas Player of the Year and a four-time junior All-American.

The former Kim Rowton is married to Casey Hall, and the couple resides in Auburn with their two children, Maggie and AJ.

CJ Easley joined the Auburn women's golf coaching staff as an assistant coach in July of 2024. Easley has experience playing collegiate golf at both Auburn and Ole Miss.

Easley arrived on the Plains as a freshman prior to the 2019-20 season and played three years for the Tigers before transferring to Ole Miss for his final two years of eligibility. Easley appeared in six tournaments for Auburn during the 2020-21 season and 10 events the following season.

The Oxford, Mississippi native was named an All-American Scholar, to the SEC Academic Honor Roll twice and to the SEC First-Year Academic Honor Roll in

As a junior player, Easley won three state championships at Oxford High School and was ranked as the No. 2 player in the state and the No. 38 player in his class according to Golfweek.



# Christopher B. Roberts University President

Christopher B. Roberts began his appointment as Auburn University's 21st president in May 2022.

President Roberts leads the university's four divisions, including Auburn's main campus with its more than 31,000 students and 5,500 faculty and staff, as well as Auburn University at Montgomery, the Alabama Cooperative Extension System and the Alabama Agricultural Experiment Station, a joint enterprise with Alabama A&M University. Roberts is an accomplished scholar who understands that research and teaching excellence, together with service and public engagement, are at the very heart of the state's R1 land-, sea- and space-grant institution. The R1 designation in the Carnegie Classification of Institutions of Higher Education recognizes Auburn as a top-level research institution. As the university's CEO, Roberts marshals the institution's \$1.54 billion annual budget and vast resources, while spearheading the university's strategic vision and advancing the Auburn's ever-growing research enterprise and economic development.

Prior to his presidency, Roberts served as the dean of Auburn's Samuel Ginn College of Engineering from 2012 to 2022. The college has more than 6,000 students and about 400 faculty and staff members. Roberts was a factor in the success of the university's Because This is Auburn — A Campaign for Auburn University, which raised \$1.2 billion. Under Roberts' leadership, more than \$357 million in donations to the college were made during and since the campaign.

He earned a bachelor's degree in chemical engineering from the University of Missouri and master's and doctoral degrees in chemical engineering from the University of Notre Dame. He began his career at Auburn in 1994 as an assistant professor in the Department of Chemical Engineering and became department chair in 2003. He also served as the George E. and Dorothy Stafford Uthlaut Professor of Chemical Engineering. He has a strong record of scholarly and academic achievement in nanotechnology and synthetic fuels. Roberts has published close to 150 peer-reviewed journal articles and book chapters in leading chemical engineering, chemistry, materials and related journals and has given over 300 conference presentations, invited seminars and lectures. He has received 45 research grants and contracts from government agencies and corporations, such as the National Science Foundation, U.S. Department of Energy, U.S. Department of Defense, the USDA-Agriculture and Food Research Initiative and Boeing.

He has been honored with numerous awards for his accomplishments and contributions to the field of engineering. Some of those recognitions include the University of Notre Dame's Graduate School Distinguished Alumnus Award in 2015; the University of Missouri's Chemical Engineering Academy of Distinguished Alumni in 2014; and the National Organization of Black Chemists and Chemical Engineers President's Award for Fostering Minority Engagement in 2012 and the SEC Academic Consortium Faculty Achievement Award in 2012.

He and his wife, Tracy, have two children and enjoy cheering on Auburn's national championship-winning Division 1 athletics programs.

In his almost 30 years on the Plains, Roberts has come to value and cherish everything that makes the Auburn experience truly remarkable and distinctive. Through the university's successes, Auburn has earned the right to dream the biggest dreams. He said the university will strive to be "nothing short of excellent in all areas of our land-grant mission."



## John Cohen Athletics Director

John Cohen, who has more than two decades of experience as a head coach and administrator in the Southeastern Conference, was named the 16th athletics director at Auburn University on Oct. 31, 2022.

During Cohen's first three years on the Plains, the Tigers have achieved tremendous success, highlighted by men's golf winning the 2024 NCAA championship, the 30th national championship in the history of Auburn Athletics. Auburn has also earned a pair of national runner-up finishes from men's track & field (2024) and equestrian (2023), and a Final Four appearance by men's basketball (2025). Auburn has claimed five SEC Championships during Cohen's tenure, and all 21 programs have advanced to their respective NCAA postseason tournaments.

Individually, Auburn student-athletes have also garnered incredible honors. Ja'Kobe Tharp won NCAA titles in 2025 in 60m hurdles (indoors) and 110m hurdles (outdoors). Auburn's 4x100m relay team won consecutive NCAA outdoor titles in 2024 and 2025. Jackson Koivun, in 2023-24, became the first collegiate golfer to sweep the Fred Haskins, Ben Hogan, Jack Nicklaus and Phil Mickelson national awards in the same season. In 2025, Koivun became the SEC's first repeat champion in 49 years. Consensus All-American Johni Broome was named 2025 SEC Player of the Year and Sporting News National Player of the Year. Equestrian's Avery Glynn was the 2025 SEC and NCEA Rider of the Year in fences.

Likewise, Auburn student-athletes have excelled academically, earning at least a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher each semester during Cohen's tenure. Fundraising and ticket sales have reached new heights under Cohen's stewardship, including the largest single capital donation in Auburn Athletics history from Robin and Reid Dove supporting the future Jordan-Hare Stadium North End Zone Multi-Use Facility. From 2022-25, donations supporting Auburn athletics nearly doubled from the preceding three-year average. Season ticket sales in football and baseball have also reached all-time highs. Cohen also reimagined spaces in Jordan-Hare Stadium and Neville Arena to diversify premium options. The Locker Room Club opened prior to the 2024 football season and the Sharon and Robert Maddox Club opened prior to the 2024-25 basketball season.

Auburn has invested heavily in capital projects under Cohen's leadership. After opening the innovative Woltosz Football Performance Center shortly after taking the helm, Cohen turned his attention to the \$30 million Plainsman Park expansion and renovation, which was completed before the 2025 season. A state-of-the-art medical and athletic training facility opened prior to the Fall 2025 semester, offering on-site physician, physical therapy, sport psychology and athletic training services to all Auburn student-athletes. Other projects include a new video board in the north end zone of Jordan-Hare Stadium an expansion of team and offices spaces for men's and women's basketball, more than doubling their previous footprint; and the addition of a volleyball training facility.

Cohen has also inked strategic partnerships that fortify Auburn's position as one of the premier brands in college athletics. In April 2024, Auburn reached a 10-year agreement to switch apparel providers to Nike. The Tigers also negotiated a new 10-year extension with Playfly Sports to continue Auburn's multimedia rights partnership. The new agreement doubled the partnership's anticipated average annual value and included innovative opportunities for Auburn student-athletes to earn name, image, and likeness opportunities as the revenue sharing era of college athletics takes hold.

### 2025-26 Media Guide

Cohen's career in college athletics began as a baseball player at Mississippi State before entering the coaching ranks for 25 years. A two-time SEC Coach of the Year, he was named MSU's athletics director on November 4,

2016, and led the Bulldog program to record-breaking success athletically, academically and in capital project campaigns.

Athletically, Cohen oversaw arguably the greatest era in Bulldog history, highlighted by a 2021 College World Series Championship - the school's first team national title in any sport. A total of five Bulldog programs turned in a program-best season with Cohen at the helm of the department, including softball (2022), baseball (2021), volleyball (2021), soccer (2018) and women's basketball (2017, 2018).

After beginning his stint as the head baseball coach at MSU in July 2008, Cohen's official role in administration



began in 2016 when he assumed the role of associate athletic director in addition to head baseball coach. As the head coach at MSU, Cohen led the Bulldogs to the 2013 College World Series finals, an SEC regular season championship and an SEC Tournament title.

In the classroom, 133 of his players were named to the SEC Academic Honor Roll, including three straight SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year winners from 2013-15. As a baseball player for the Bulldogs, Cohen was a key member of the 1989 SEC Champion and 1990 College World Series teams. He graduated from MSU with a degree in English and earned a master's degree in sports management from Missouri.

Prior to becoming the head coach at MSU, Cohen's coaching career included assistant coaching stops at Missouri (1992-97) and Florida (2002-03) and head coaching stops at Northwestern State (1998-2001) and Kentucky (2004-08).

Along with winning 284 games as a head coach at MSU, 138 of Cohen's players were selected in the Major League Baseball Draft, and numerous assistants, including Auburn's Butch Thompson, are now or have been SEC head coaches.

Cohen is one of just two individuals who have played, coached and later served as director of athletics for a program participating in the College World Series. He is the only coach in SEC history to win an SEC championship, SEC Tournament title, and advance to the College World Series both as a player and head coach.

### **Jack Key Golf Teaching Facility**



The Jack Key Golf Teaching Facility is named after Jack Key, a 1950 Auburn graduate and four-year letterman from Columbus, Georgia and features three indoor hitting bays, lounge and locker rooms, club repair and video analysis. Utilizing 29 acres, the practice facility features a range of nearly 400 yards with tees at both ends allowing players to train in a variety of wind conditions.







### **About Auburn University**



Auburn University has developed into one of the largest universities in the South, remaining in the educational forefront with its traditional blend of arts and applied science, and changing with the needs of today while living with a respect for the traditions and spirit that are Auburn.

Auburn was established in 1856 as the East Alabama Male College, 20 years after the city of Auburn's founding. In 1872, under the Morrill Act, the school became the first land-grant college in the South and was renamed the Agricultural and Mechanical College of Alabama. In 1899 the name again was changed, to the Alabama Polytechnic Institute. Finally, in 1960 the name of the school was changed to Auburn University, a title more in keeping with its location, and expressing the varied academic programs and larger curriculum of a major university.

Auburn University today is a comprehensive land, sea and space grant institution -- among the few that hold that distinction -- helping fulfill the dreams of more than 25,000 students.

Auburn's beautiful main campus -- graced by greenery and open spaces and highlighted by historic Samford Park -- is made up of 90 major academic buildings spread across 1,843 acres. Buildings in the main campus area are within walking distance of each other. Residence halls are only a short walk from classrooms, dining and athletics facilities. Auburn is located in the southeastern United States in east-central Alabama about 30 miles from the Georgia border.

From 1861 to 1866 the college was closed because of the Civil War. The college had begun an affiliation with the Methodist Church before the war. Due to dire financial straits, the church transferred legal control of the institution to the state in 1872, making it the first land-grant college in the South to be established separate from the state university. It thus became the Agricultural and Mechanical College of Alabama.

Women were admitted in 1892, making Auburn the oldest four-year, coeducational school in the state and the second-oldest in the Southeast.

In 1899, the name was again changed to the Alabama Polytechnic Institute. In 1960, the school officially acquired the name it has long been called and one more in keeping with its location, size, and mission -- Auburn University. The institution has experienced its greatest growth since World War II, and now has more than 250,000 graduates.

### The War Eagle Story



According to legend, football and the cry "War Eagle" came to Auburn on the same day. It was February 20, 1892, the day Auburn and Georgia met in the first game of what is now the longest continuous football rivalry in the deep South.

In 1864 at the Battle of the Wilderness in Virginia during the American Civil War, an Auburn student fighting in the battle was wounded and when the armies retreated to their respective lines, he was left on the battlefield for dead. When he regained consciousness, there were only two living things as far as he could see: himself and a baby eagle.

The soldier took the wouded bird with him and nursed it back to health. When he returned to attend school at Auburn, the eagle came with him. The student ultimately became a member of the Auburn facilty and he was there that day in Atlanta's Piedmont Park when Auburn and Georgia met in what was later referred to as "The Game of the Century". As usual, the eagle- called War Eagle because of the circumstances under which he was found- was there with him.

When Auburn scored the first touchdown, the old eagle broke free from its master and began to soar above the field. Auburn fans looked skyward, saw the familiar animal, and shouted "War Eagle". According to witnesses, Auburn then began a steady march toward the end zone.

At the end of the game that Auburn won 10-0, the old eagle collapsed and died, having given his all in pursuit of victory for Auburn. War Eagle may have passed that day, but his spirit lives forever in the hearts of Auburn men and women

Auburn's athletic teams are known as "The Auburn Tigers", but the battle cry of the Auburn faithful is "War Eagle". The battle cry is not a mascot or a nickname of the school.

Since the first War Eagle, there have been seven others throughout Auburn's history that have served as a symbol of the Auburn spirit and kept alive the legendary battle cry. Since 2000, an eagle has flown prior to all Auburn Football home games as tradition.




### 2024-25 Season In Review

The Tigers picked up a tournament victory at the Cougar Classic and recorded five top-five finishes as a team throughout the 2024-25 season. The squad also broke the program record for team season scoring average at 287.03. The team captured the third lowest 18-hole score in Auburn history during the second round of the Schooner Fall Classic with a 273 (-7). The Tigers also went low at the Illini Women's Invitational at Medinah, firing a 54-hole score of 839 (-25).

Anna Davis earned WGCA second team All-American honors for the second consecutive season and was tabbed first team All-SEC. Davis won two individual titles during the campaign at the Illini Women's Invitational at Medinah and the Charles Schwab Women's Collegiate, where she broke a program record for lowest 54-hole score with a 9-under 201.

Luellen's squad recieved a bid to an NCAA Regional for the eigth consecutive season the championships have been held and finished the season ranked No. 17 nationally.
