# Auburn Women's Basketball Quick Hitters

- This is the second meeting between Auburn and UTSA in women's basketball
- Auburn won the only previous meeting 73-50 in 2001 in San Diego, Calif.
- The Tigers are 6-0 for the first time since the 2008-09 season
- This is the second American Conference opponent Auburn has faced this year (def. Charlotte 71-58 in OT)
- Auburn set a non-conference attendance record with 5,769 vs. Mississippi Valley State on Nov. 13; more than 3,000 local schoolchildren were in attendance as part of Education Day
- Auburn scored 110 points vs. MVSU, their most vs. a Division I opponent since 2008
- The Tigers made 30 3-pointers in their first four games, their most in a four-game stretch since the 2022-23 season
- Auburn shot 69.3% from 3-point range vs. MVSU (9-of-13), their best in a game with at least 10 attempts since the 2007-08 season
- Auburn has won 26 of its last 28 home non-conference games
- Auburn is 95-14 in non-conference games at Neville Arena (opened in 2010-11)
- Auburn had six players in double-figures vs. MVSU, the first time that's happened since the 2018-19 season-opener vs. Grambling
- Khady Leye scored a career-high 20 points in the win over MVSU
- · Leye recorded her first Auburn double-double and the seventh of her career with 12 points and 10 rebounds vs. GSU
- Arek Angui recorded her first career double-double vs. MVSU with 11 points and 11 rebounds
- Mya Petticord had her second career game with 20+ points with a 21-point effort against Alabama State
- Kaitlyn Duhon had a career-high 5 steals vs. Alabama State; she leads the Tigers with 3.0 steals per game
- Ja'Mia Harris had 19 points and 8 rebounds in her Auburn debut, two points and one rebound shy of career-highs
- Harris also had 16 points vs. Alabama State, hitting 4-of-6 3-point attempts
- · Freshman Harissoum Coulibaly scored 19 points in her Auburn debut; it was the most points scored by an Auburn freshman in their first collegiate game since Janiah McKay scored 20 against UAB on Nov. 13, 2015
- Coulibaly matched that with 19 points to lead Auburn in the win over Georgia State
- Coulibaly also had 5 steals in the opener, the most by an Auburn freshman since Romi Levy had 6 vs. Georgia in 2021
- Auburn won its home opener for the 46th time in the last 47 years with an 82-41 win over Alabama State Nov. 8
- The attendance of 2,770 for the home opener vs. Alabama State was Auburn's best for a home opener since 2015 (3,110 vs. UAB in a doubleheader with the Auburn men)
- Eight players made their Auburn debuts at Charlotte with three playing in their first Division I game
- Auburn was the only SEC team to open their season with a true road game; Tennessee and Vanderbilt played at neutral sites
- Head Coach Larry Vickers spent the last 10 years as head coach at Norfolk State, leading the Spartans to three straight conference titles and three straight NCAA appearances the last three seasons
- Auburn returns two players from last year's team and welcomes 10 newcomers to the 2025-26 roster
- · Included in Auburn's 10 newcomers are seven Division I transfers, one junior college transfer and two true freshmen

- » Auburn is 6-0 on the year after a 51-46 win over Rutgers Thursday night.
- >> UTSA is 2-2; the Roadrunners defeated Incarnate Word 74-57 on the road Wednesday.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Improving to 6-0 for the first time in 17 years, Auburn shut out Rutgers for most of the third quarter and held the Scarlet Knights without a field goal for 16 minutes and 39 seconds to win 51-46 Thursday at Neville Arena.
- With Auburn leading by three points in the final minute, former Rutgers guard Mya Petticord secured the victory for her new team at the expense of her former one, driving for a layup that gave Auburn a five-point lead with 10 seconds to go.
- » Khady Leye led the Tigers with 14 points and shared the team lead with six rebounds. Harissoum Coulibaly added 12 points to help Auburn start the season 6-0 for the first time since 2008-09.

# **AUBURN-UTSA SERIES**

Auburn and UTSA have met just once before. The Tigers defeated UTSA 73-50 on Dec. 30, 2001, in San Diego, California.

# LAST MEETING: Dec. 30, 2001, in San Diego Auburn 73, UTSA 50

- Auburn used a big first half to pull away early for a 73-50 win over UTSA in the third-place game of the Surf 'n Slam Classic in San Diego, Calif.
- Three Tigers scored in double figures, led by LaKeisha Johnson with 14 points. Carol Smith scored 11 and Tia Miller added 10.
- Auburn led 37-16 at the half, thanks to forcing 15 turnovers and holding UTSA to 26.1% shooting in the first 20 minutes.

#### SCOUTING THE ROADRUNNERS

- » UTSA is 2-2 on the season. The Roadrunners have won their last two games, defeating Texas State at home and Incarnate Word on the road.
- Last season, UTSA was the American Conference regular-season champions, going 26-5 overall and 17-1 in league play. UTSA returns two starters and nine letterwinners from that team.
- >> UTSA averages 59.5 points per game and

holds opponents to 57.3.

>> Cheyenne Rowe leads UTSA with 12.3 points per game. Idara Udo adds 11.5 points and leads the Roadrunners with 9.5 rebounds per game.

## **SCOUTING AUBURN**

- Auburn is 6-0 for the first time since 2008-09 after wins over Charlotte, Alabama State, UNC Greensboro, Mississippi Valley State, Georgia State and Rutgers to open the season.
- » Mya Petticord, a senior transfer from Rutgers, hit the game-winning shot against her former team, hitting a driving layup with 10 seconds left to clinch the Tigers' win Nov. 20. She had her best game in two years with 21 points on 7-of-10 shooting (3-4 3FG) in the win over Alabama State. She followed that up with a team-leading 18 points (4-7 3FG) in the win over UNCG. Petticord is also one of 16 players nationally to not have missed a free throw, going 16-for-16 on the year.
- "True freshman Harissoum Coulibaly leads the Tigers with 12.5 points per game off the bench, and she also shoots a team-best 61.7% from the field. She led Auburn with 19 points, matching a season-best, in the win over Georgia State Nov. 17. She made a splash in her college debut Nov. 3 at Charlotte, scoring a team-leading 19 points with nine of those coming in the pivotal overtime period. She added 12 points, 5 rebounds and 4 assists vs. MVSU. She came to the U.S. from Paris, France, and she played high school basketball at S3 Academy in Virginia.
- » Redshirt junior Kaitlyn Duhon, one of two returners on the team, leads the Tigers with 3.0 steals per game. She scored a season-high 16 points vs. Mississippi Valley State, one shy of a career-high. She scored 14 points in the opener at Charlotte and matched a career-high with four assists. She then matched her scoring output with 14 against Alabama State, along with a career-high 5 steals. Against Georgia State, she matched a career-high with 8 rebounds.
- » Ja'Mia Harris scored in double figures in three of the first four games. She shared the team lead with 19 points and led the Tigers with 8 rebounds in the win at Charlotte Nov. 3, then scored 16 with four 3-pointers in the win over Alabama State. She followed that up with a pair of 3-pointers on an 11-point night along with 7 rebounds vs. UNCG.
- Sophomore Khady Leye scored a career-high 20 points in the win over MVSU, then she recorded her first Auburn double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds vs. Georgia State. She added a teamleading 14 points in the win over Rutgers Nov. 20. Earlier, she had her best game so far with 11 points and 5 rebounds vs. UNCG on Monday. She had three blocks and three steals in each of the first two games.
- 6-9 redshirt freshmen Arek Angui notched her first career double-double with career-highs 11 points and 11 rebounds vs. Mississippi Valley State. She came from Central Florida, where she appeared in two games as a true freshman last year. She made her first appearance for Auburn against Alabama State Nov. 8 and pulled down a teamleading 8 rebounds along with 3 points. Originally from South Sudan, she played one season of high school basketball at Greenforest Academy in Georgia.
- Sophomore Syriah Daniels, the Tigers' second returning player, scored 10 points with four rebounds and two steals vs. MVSU. She played in 28 games last year, starting six, and averaged 3.6

- Senior guard A'riel Jackson knocked down three first-half treys, scoring 9 points with a teambest 4 assists vs. UNCG. She made her first Auburn start at Charlotte, scoring five points with three rebounds and two steals. She then had 8 points, 6 rebounds, 4 steals and 2 assists against Alabama State
- Senior guard Angena Belloso transferred from FIU where she played in 57 games the last 2 years. She averaged 7.9 points, 3.6 rebounds, 2.6 assists as a junior. She scored her first Auburn bucket against Alabama State Nov. 8 and scored a seasonbest 5 points vs. MVSU.
- y Junior Clara Koulibaly came from the junior college ranks, where she started all 28 games last season at Gulf Coast State CC and averaged 12.0 points and 6.2 rebounds per game. She has played in all three games so far, averaging 2.3 rebounds.
- Junior forward Quanirah Montague appeared in all 34 games last year for Mississippi State, averaging 4.6 points and 3.7 rebounds in 11.7 minutes per game.
- Sophomore guard Eva Garabadian joined the Tigers as a walk-on in mid-November and dressed for the first time vs. Rutgers. She played in 16 games at Georgia College last year as a freshman.

## **MORE THAN JUST THE 67 THING**

- The Tigers put together one of their most complete offensive games in years in their 110-50 win over Mississippi Valley State on Nov. 13. Among the highlights:
- Six players scored in double-figures; that hadn't happened since the 2018-19 season-opener vs. Grambling.
- Auburn shot 59.4% from the field, their best since shooting 62.2% vs. Virginia-Lynchburg in 2024, and their best against a Division I opponent since shooting 60.4% vs. Oklahoma State on Dec. 5, 2021.
- >> From 3-point range, the Tigers were 9-of-13 for 69.2%. That's the best 3-point percentage with at least 10 attempts since the Tigers went 12-of-17 (.706) vs. Colgate on Dec. 5, 2007.
- With more than 3,000 students from Auburn City and Opelika City schools in attendance, the announced crowd of 5,769 was the fourth-largest in Neville Arena history and the largest-ever for an Auburn home non-conference game.
- Oh yeah, the 6-7 thing: when Khady Leye made a free throw in the third quarter to give Auburn its 67th point, the schoolchildren in attendance lost their collective minds. The reaction was captured by the War Eagle Productions crew and went viral, garnering more than 10 million views on ESPN's main Instagram page and hundreds of thousands more on Auburn's social media channels.

- Auburn topped the century mark in game four of the Vickers era with a 110-50 win over Mississippi Valley State on Nov. 13.
- >> The previous 100-point game by an Auburn team was a 128-36 win over non-NCAA Virginia-Lynchburg on Nov. 8, 2024, a stretch of 32 games and 370 days.
- Why is this notable? Before the VUL game last year, it had been 488 games (5,816 days) since the Tigers last topped 100 - Dec. 5, 2008 with a 119-54 win over Sam Houston. That had been the longest 100-point drought in the SEC and sixth-longest among major conference teams.

# **KEEPING IT (LESS THAN) 100**

- Auburn has the nation's second-longest active streak (by time) of not allowing 100 points in a game, having gone 1,275 games since March 3, 1984, when Georgia beat Auburn 102-72 in the 1984 SEC Tournament in Athens.

#### **TIGERS IN THE PROS**

- » DeWanna Bonner, a 2009 Auburn graduate, completed her 16th season in the WNBA in 2025, helping lead the Phoenix Mercury to the WNBA Finals. She is the active career leader in WNBA games played with 535, which ranks third all-time in league history. A six-time WNBA All-Star, Bonner helped lead the Sun to the WNBA semifinals, where they fell to the Minnesota Lynx. Bonner is nearing the top of the list in the all-time WNBA record books as she ranks third in career scoring (7,807 points) and eighth in career rebounds (3,204).
- Former Tiger Charlene Thomas-Swinson, who played at Auburn from 1984-87, is an assistant coach for the Las Vegas Aces, who won the 2022, 2023 and 2025 WNBA titles.
- "" Unique Thompson, a 2021 graduate, is playing for the Sydney Flames in the Australian WNBL for the 2025-26 season. Last year, she played for the Mackay Meteorettes in the NBL1, where she averaged 23.4 points and 14.9 rebounds and was named the league's MVP. She also played three seasons in Russia. Thompson was the No. 19 pick in the 2021 WNBA Draft by the Indiana Fever, and she signed a training camp contract with the Dallas Wings in 2022, but has not played in a WNBA regular-season game.
- Honesty Scott-Grayson, who completed her Auburn eligibility in 2024, is in her second professional season. This year, she is playing for Lyon Asvel Feminin in France after playing for Amyntas in Greece last season. She signed a free agent deal with the Washington Mystics in the summer of 2024 and played in two preseason games.
- DeYona Gaston, who rewrote the Auburn record book in her one season on the Plains in 2024-25, is playing for Royal Castors Braine in Belgium. She averaged 22.3 points for the Tigers last year and was a second-team All-SEC selection.
- » Mar'Shaun Bostic, a 2025 graduate, recently signed with Morroccan club Moghreb Tetua'n. She was second in the SEC in assists in conference games last year with 6.4/game, and she tied for the league lead in steals with 2.9/game in conference play.

# THE VICKERS ERA BEGINS

> Larry Vickers was named Auburn's eighth

- women's basketball coach on March 23, 2025.
- Vickers came to Auburn after spending the last 10 years as head coach at Norfolk State, his alma mater. He led the Spartans to a 177-99 record in those 10 seasons, including three straight NCAA Tournament appearances and four straight MEAC regular-season titles.
- » Known for his defense, his teams had a top-30 scoring defense in each of his last four seasons at Norfolk State. His 2022-23 team had the nation's No. 1 scoring defense, allowing just 50.7 points per game. That team was also No. 1 nationally in field goal percentage defense at 31.5%.
- Joining Vickers for his first season on the Plains are new assistant coaches Candice M. Jackson, Caroline McCombs, Rodney Hill, Taja Cole and DQ Gordon. Jackson comes from VCU, where she was an assistant coach, and she was previously head coach at College of Charleston. McCombs returns to Auburn for a second time; she was an assistant here from 2012-14 before taking the head coaching job at Stony Brook (and later George Washington). Hill comes from Texas A&M, where was on staff for two seasons. Cole, a former standout point guard at Georgia and Virginia Tech, enters the collegiate coaching world for the first time. And Gordon was elevated to assistant coach this season after serving as graduate assistant and video coordinator for the Tigers the last three years.

#### THIS, THAT AND THE OTHER

- " Junior Ja'Mia Harris is part of the SEC Women's Basketball Leadership Council.
- Sophomore Syriah Daniels is the daughter of former Auburn men's standout and NBA player Marquis Daniels and former Auburn women's player, the late Shana Askew Daniels. She's also the first graduate of Auburn High School to play for the Tigers since Trevesha Jackson in the mid-2000s.
- » Daniels is wearing a Kay Yow Servant Leader patch on her jersey this season.
- Head Coach Larry Vickers will be inducted into the Norfolk State Athletics Hall of Fame next spring.

# Larry VICKERS

Head Coach

First Season at Auburn • 11th Season as a head coach

Norfolk, Va. • Norfolk State, 2007

Larry Vickers, who has spent the past decade at Norfolk State leading the women's basketball program to unprecedented heights, including three consecutive conference championships and NCAA Tournament appearances, was named Auburn's head women's basketball coach on March 23, 2025. An 18-year coaching veteran, Vickers also spent eight years as a men's assistant and associate head coach for the Spartans.

Since he took over, NSU achieved its most successful run in its Division I era, posting a 177-99 record, including an 83-18 mark over the last three seasons. Prior to Vickers' arrival, NSU finished with a winning record overall just three times. During the last four years, his teams had a 49-7 conference record, winning four regular season MEAC titles, along with three conference tournament titles. Combined with his time on the men's staff, Vickers has been a part of nine conference championships at Norfolk State.

In 2024-25, Vickers led the team to a program-record 30 wins, a perfect conference record and the MEAC regular season and tournament titles. The Spartans won 19 consecutive games entering the NCAA Tournament with the winning streak starting in late December with a victory at Auburn. Vickers also led the Spartans to a win at Missouri in November.

Vickers led Norfolk State to a then-Division I program-best 27-6 record and its second consecutive MEAC Tournament Championship in the 2023-24 season. NSU advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the third time in school history and went 13-1 in MEAC play, winning the conference regular season title as well. Vickers earned his second MEAC Coach of the Year recognition while coaching the MEAC Player of the Year and HBCU Player of the Year Kierra Wheeler and MEAC Newcomer of the Year Diamond Johnson.

In 2022-23, Vickers led the program to its first MEAC Championship title since 2002 as the Spartans finished with a 26-7 overall mark and made a first-round appearance in the NCAA Championship tournament. The Spartans won the MEAC regular season title and Vickers was named the MEAC Coach of the Year and the HBCU National Coach of the Year.

Vickers led the 2021-22 team to a 17-12 overall record, going 11-3 in the conference, earning a share of the conference's regular season title for the first time in program history. NSU would make it all the way to the MEAC title game, falling to No. 1 seed Howard. The impressive campaign resulted in Norfolk State's first-ever berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT).

In 2019-20, Norfolk State achieved its best season since winning the MEAC title in 2002 as Vickers guided the Spartans to a second-place finish in the league at 12-4, their then-best MEAC record ever by percentage and tied for their highest finish in the league ever. Despite the season being cut short prior to the semifinals of the MEAC Tournament due to COVID-19, the Spartans still ended the campaign with 19 wins, tied for the second-most in their D-I history.

Raven Russell and La'Deja James led the way in 2018-19 when NSU placed fourth in the MEAC at 10-6. The Spartans found postseason success as well during the 17-15 overall season. They finished as runner-up at the 2019 MEAC Tournament, their fourth-ever MEAC Tournament title game appearance and the first since 2005. NSU's upward trajectory continued under Vickers in 2017-18 during his second full season in charge. The Spartans posted an 18-11 record, including an 11-5 mark in MEAC play for a fourth-place finish. It marked the first winning overall season since 2001-02.

NSU's trademark defense once again stifled opponents in 2017-18. The Spartans set numerous D-I program records while holding competition to 56.2 points per game on 32.8-percent shooting, including 26.8-percent from 3-point range. Norfolk State topped the MEAC and ranked 18th nationally in scoring defense, while its field-goal percentage defense was the third-best nationally.

In Vickers' first full season as head coach, he led the Spartans to a 10.5 game turnaround in 2016-17, which tied for the eighth-best improvement nationally that season. In addition, Norfolk State's 12-win improvement was the largest single-season increase in program history. Vickers served as interim head coach of the NSU women for the final 11 games of the 2015-16 season and led the team to its only three victories of the season, leading to him being named to the permanent head coaching post following the campaign.

Prior to taking over the women's program, Vickers spent eight seasons as an assistant coach with the Norfolk State men's basketball program. He served the last three as the associate head coach, including the final year in 2015-16 when he took over the women's program in mid-January. Vickers also held the title of recruiting coordinator for the program.

The 6-9 Vickers walked onto the NSU team during the 2004-05 season. He quickly earned playing time and was a noted defensive player during his career with the Spartans. A two-time member of the MEAC Commissioner's All-Academic Team, Vickers was named the Spartans' Most Improved Player as a sophomore in 2005-06 and was also a team captain.

Vickers earned his bachelor's degree in electronic technology in 2007. He has taken courses toward his master's in urban education at NSU. He graduated from Ocean Lakes High School in Virginia Beach, Virginia. Vickers and Charisse have three children; daughter Elle Christian and sons Lincoln and Lane.
