### OPENING TIP

► Oklahoma (13-14, 3-11 SEC) plays its penultimate regular season home game when it hosts Auburn (15-12, 6-8) on Tuesday at 8 p.m. CT at Lloyd Noble Center in Norman.

► Tuesday's game will be televised by ESPNU with **Roy Philpott** (play-by-play) and **Daymeon Fishback** (analyst) announcing. It will air on the Sooner Sports Radio Network (KRXX 107.7 FM in Oklahoma City; KTBZ 1430 AM in Tulsa; Varsity Radio App) with **Toby Rowland** and **Kevin Henry** on the call.

► OU is 9-5 at home this season, with five players averaging at least 9.5 points per game. The Sooners are outshooting opponents 48%-45% from the field and 38%-33% from 3-point range in the 14 contests. Auburn is 2-6 in true road games (beat Ole Miss and Florida; lost to Arizona, Georgia, Missouri, Tennessee, Arkansas and Mississippi State).

► After losing nine straight games, OU has won two of its last four (at No. 15 Vanderbilt and vs. Georgia). In those two contests, the Sooners led by double digits for a combined 40:32 of 80 minutes (27:23 at Vandy and 13:09 vs. Georgia). It shot a combined 56% from the field and 50% (23 for 46) from 3-point range.

► First-year Sooner **Nijel Pack**, who is in his sixth year overall, ranks third among active players with 2,170 career points. He has scored at least 17 points in six of the last eight games and is shooting 51% from 3-point range (29 for 57) over those eight contests. He needs one 3-pointer to become just the 31st Division I player ever to register 400 makes.

► Oklahoma's 82.3 scoring average is its highest through a season's first 27 games since 2017-18 and fourth highest in the last 32 years. Similarly, OU's 9.9 3-pointers per game are its second most through 27 contests in the 40-year 3-point era.

► OU has committed single-digit turnovers 14 times, already its most such outings for an entire season in at least 40 years. The Sooners average just 10.1 turnovers per contest.

**SATURDAY'S OU-TEXAS A&M RECAP**

► On a night in which Oklahoma honored its 2015-16 Final Four team and raised a No. 24 banner of **Buddy Hield** to the Lloyd Noble Center ceiling, the Sooners cut a nine-point deficit to one with less than a minute left but couldn't get over the hump in a 75-71 loss to Texas A&M on Saturday.

► The Sooners shot 32.8% from the field — their second-lowest figure of the season — and made just 25.0% of their shot attempts in the second half, while the Aggies shot 43.5% for the game and outscored OU 32-12 in the paint.

► For the first time this season, sophomore **Dayton Forsythe** led OU in scoring and assists. The guard came off the bench to register 14 points and a game-high six handouts — one shy of his career high — in his season-high 29 minutes.

► Super senior **Mohamed Wague** turned in one of his best games of the season with 12 points, a game-high 13 rebounds and two blocked shots. His fourth double-double as a Sooner resulted in his most points in 15 contests and his most rebounds in 13 outings. The center was 3 for 6 from the field and 6 for 8 from the line.

► Starters **Nijel Pack** and **Tae Davis** were scoreless in the first half and finished with six and four points, respectively, on a combined 3-for-17 shooting.

► With the Aggies taking a 70-61 lead with 6:16 to go, OU, which led for just 10 seconds in the game, made a final push with a 10-2 run behind six points from Forsythe to make it a 72-71 game with 26 seconds left. After a pair of A&M free throws a second later, Forsythe missed a potential game-tying 3-pointer with 11 seconds to go. The Aggies got the rebound and clinched the win with a free throw with 8.9 seconds on the clock.

**SCENE SETTERS**

► Oklahoma is 3-11 in SEC play but has held a halftime lead in six of the 14 games. In fact, it has held a double-digit advantage in five of the last 10 outings (two wins). Seven of its 14 overall losses this season have been by single digits.

► OU is the only SEC team and one of just five out of 361 nationally to start the same lineup every game this season (Houston is the only other Power Five squad). Its starters have been guards **Xzayvier Brown** and **Nijel Pack**, forwards **Tae Davis** and **Derrion Reid** and center **Mohamed Wague**. Auburn has started eight different lineups.

► Picked sixth in the preseason SEC media poll, Auburn is 15-12 on the year and sits in 11th place in the league at 6-8 after reaching the 2025 Final Four. The Tigers, who are 2-5 in SEC road games, hit a last-second shot to beat Kentucky 75-74 at home Saturday, snapping a five-game losing streak (they started 5-2 in conference play). Head coach **Steven Pearl**, the son of former Auburn head man **Bruce Pearl**, is in his first year as a collegiate head coach.

► Auburn has won three straight in the series and was ranked No. 1 in the AP poll in each of the last two meetings (last season and 2021-22).

► The resurgence of guard **Dayton Forsythe** has boosted the Sooners the last few weeks. After a 10-game stretch in which he averaged 1.3 points and went 2 for 31 from the field (he battled sprains of both ankles), the sophomore is averaging 9.7 points over the last six contests on 49% field goal and 41% (7 for 17) 3-point shooting. Over the last four games, he is averaging 11.5 points in 22.8 minutes.

**SERIES HISTORY**

► The Tigers own a 4-1 series lead against Oklahoma and have won the last three meetings (98-70 at No. 1 Auburn last season, 86-68 at No. 1 Auburn in a Big 12/SEC Challenge game in the 2021-22 season [**Porter Moser's** first as OU head coach] and 74-70 in Uncasville, Conn., during the 2016-17 campaign). **Bruce Pearl** was AU's coach in all three contests.

Auburn also posted a 78-70 win in the Big Sun Classic in St. Petersburg, Fla., in the 1978-79 season.

► OU's victory over the Tigers came under head coach **Billy Tubbs** in a 1988 NCAA Tournament second-round game in Atlanta, 107-87. Future first-round NBA Draft picks **Stacey King** and **Mookie Blaylock** scored 37 and 21 points, respectively, with King adding nine rebounds and Blaylock nine assists and four steals. King's 37 points and the Sooners' 107 marked then-postseason-program highs. Auburn was coached by **Sonny Smith**.

**LAST YEAR'S OU-AUBURN RECAP**

► Oklahoma trailed by just four points (38-34) with 3 minutes left in the first half at No. 1/1 Auburn on Feb. 4 last season, but was outscored by 24 the rest of the way in a 98-70 defeat. The Sooners committed 15 turnovers to the Tigers' 7 and were outscored 22-9 off turnovers. Auburn also posted a 46-20 advantage in paint points.

► For the first time of his career, freshman guard **Dayton Forsythe** led the Sooners in scoring. He finished with 13 points on the strength of 11-for-11 free throw shooting. He became just the sixth Sooner since the start of the 1996-97 season to shoot 100% from the free throw line with at least 11 attempts. **Jalon Moore** (11), **Jeremiah Fears** (10) and **Kobe Elvis** (10) also scored in double figures for the Sooners.

► OU's .931 free throw percentage (27 for 29) was its best in a true road game (min. 15 makes) since Jan. 26, 2022. But its .333 field goal figure marked a season low. Auburn shot .525 from the floor.

► **Chad Baker-Mazara** and **Johni Broome** led the Tigers with 15 points apiece. Broome also registered a game-high six assists.

**OU HONORS HIELD'S NO. 24 JERSEY**

► 2016 consensus national player of the year **Buddy Hield** became the sixth former OU men's basketball player to have his jersey raised to Lloyd Noble Center's ceiling on Saturday during a halftime

## OU'S RICH HOOPS HISTORY

Oklahoma's storied men's basketball history is the envy of most SEC programs. The Sooners' five Final Four appearances are exceeded in the SEC by only Kentucky (17), Arkansas (6) and Florida (6). OU, which played in the 1947 and 1988 national title games, has participated in 34 NCAA Tournaments and has played in the postseason in 36 of the last 43 years.

Oklahoma has also generated 18 first-team All-Americans, including Hollis Price, Blake Griffin, Buddy Hield and Trae Young since the turn of the century. Griffin and Hield were consensus national players of the year. OU has produced two of the six Wooden Award winners from current SEC schools (Kentucky/Texas two each).

ceremony in the game vs. Texas A&M. He joined **Wayman Tisdale** (No. 23 honored in 1997), **Alvan Adams** (No. 33 honored in 1998), **Mookie Blaylock** (No. 10 honored in 2001), **Stacey King** (No. 33 honored in 2008) and **Blake Griffin** (No. 23 honored in 2016).

► Winner of the 2016 Wooden Award, Naismith Trophy and Oscar Robertson Trophy, Hield was a two-time Big 12 Player of the Year. He finished his career ranked No. 1 in Big 12 and No. 2 in OU career scoring with 2,291 points.

► Hield was the 2016 NCAA West Regional Most Outstanding Player after he went 8 for 13 from behind the arc and scored 37 points in a Final-Four-clinching win over Oregon.

► The Bahamas native was the only player nationally in 2015-16 to average at least 25.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game. He scored at least 30 points 12 times that season and at least 25 on 19 occasions.

## PACK MENTALITY

► First-year Oklahoma guard **Nijel Pack** surpassed the 2,000-point mark Jan. 11 at Texas A&M and has 2,170 for his career to rank third nationally among active players.

► Pack ranks second among all active Division I players and 31st all-time with 399 career 3-point field goals. The only player to ever wear an OU uniform who has made more career treys is **Umoja Gibson** (428; was a Sooner during the 2020-21 and 2021-22 seasons).

► Pack leads the SEC with his .441 3-point field goal percentage on the season and ranks second with his 3.2 treys per game.

► Pack has scored 20-plus points in four of the last eight games (25 at Missouri, 22 vs. Arkansas, 23 vs. Texas and 20 at Tennessee). He scored 17 and 18 in two of the other four games during the stretch.

► Pack has made at least one 3-pointer in 25 of 27 games, at least three in 17 contests and at least four in 12 outings. He buried at least three treys in six consecutive games between Nov. 11 and Dec. 2, the first Sooner to accomplish the feat since consensus national player of the year **Buddy Hield** during OU's 2015-16 Final Four campaign.

► A sixth-year collegian, Pack spent his first two seasons at Kansas State (he was a first-team All-Big 12 pick as a sophomore when he averaged 17.4 points and made 95 3-pointers and shot a league-high .436 from behind the arc) and the last three at Miami, Fla. (he helped the Hurricanes to their first Final Four his junior season and was named the Midwest Region Most Outstanding Player). He has started 148 of his 149 career games.

## OU's 'X' FACTOR

► After scoring at least 13 points 14 times in a 15-game stretch (he averaged 18.7 points on 50% field goal, 40% [34-for-84] 3-point and 93% [54-for-58] free throw shooting in the 15 contests), junior guard **Xzayvier Brown** has been held to an average of 6.7 points over the last three games.

► Brown has a team-high six outings of at least 20 points in SEC play (23 in a win over Ole Miss, a season-high 24 against No. 19 Florida, 21 vs. No. 18 Alabama, 22 at South Carolina, 21 at Kentucky and 20 in a victory at No. 15 Vanderbilt).

► Brown ranks second in the SEC by shooting 91% from the free throw line (79 for 87), but only has eight attempts over the last seven games. He assembled a streak of 27 makes, which ended Jan. 13 vs. Florida.

► After scoring at least 20 points in 14 of 35 games last year at Saint Joseph's, Brown has a team-high 11 games of 20-plus in 27 outings this season (**Nijel Pack** ranks second with seven such efforts). Brown has 31 career games of at least 20.

## MORE OU NOTES AND NUGGETS

► Oklahoma has led for over 20 minutes in five of the last eight games. It led for 22:38 in an 88-87 loss at Missouri, for 23:36 in an 83-79 loss to Arkansas, for 30:21 in a 79-69 loss to Texas, for 39:45 in a 92-91 win at Vanderbilt and for 20:57 in a 94-78 win over Georgia.

► The Sooners have scored at least 85 points in 13 of their 27 games (48%), already their most 85-point efforts in a season since 2017-18 (15). For perspective, OU's last four teams scored 85-plus a combined 21 times in 133 games (16%).

► OU is averaging 27.0 bench points in its three SEC wins and 15.1 bench points in its 11 league losses.

► OU's top four scorers are all transfers in their first year in the program. **Nijel Pack** averages a team-high 15.7 points per game, while **Xzayvier Brown** (15.5), **Tae Davis** (12.6) and **Derrion Reid** (11.4) also average double figures. **Mohamed Wague** rounds out the starting five with his 6.4 per contest.

► Davis surpassed 1,000 career points and 500 rebounds this season and now has 1,223 and 589.

► Davis went 41 for 66 (62%) from the free throw line over OU's first 17 games but is 31 for 39 (79%) over the last 10.

► OU announced on Dec. 28 the signing of 23-year-old **Kirill Elatontsev** (kee-REEL EE-el-uh-tahn-suv), a 6-11, 240-pound center from Russia who is averaging 4.5 points and 2.5 rebounds in 15.7 minutes per contest over his 15 games. He is shooting 55% from the field, 41% (9 for 22) from 3-point range and 69% (11 for 16) from the foul line.

► Long Beach State transfer **Jadon Jones** is averaging 5.7 points in 18.5 minutes per game over his 23 outings. He has also drawn 13 fouls while attempting a 3-pointer. The 2021-22 Big West Conference Defensive Player of the Year has 12 steals and nine blocks over the past 10 games.

► Redshirt freshman forward **Kuol Atak** ranks third on the team with his 38 3-point makes (shooting 43%) despite playing in just 21 of 27 games and averaging only 12.2 minutes in those contests. He is 27 for 52 (52%) from long distance in home contests, including 18 for 32 (56%) over his last five outings at Lloyd Noble Center. He has played in just five of OU's last 10 games. In the Sooners' Feb. 14 home win against Georgia, he scored 18 points on 6-for-7 3-point shooting.

Praised for his ability to create culture and his never-tiring energy, University of Oklahoma head men's basketball coach Porter Moser is in his fifth season leading the Sooners in 2025-26. Moser was hired on April 3, 2021, becoming the 15th head coach in program history after a stellar 10-year run as head coach at Loyola Chicago that included NCAA Final Four and Sweet 16 appearances.

The 2024-25 season was Moser's most successful at OU, guiding his team to a 20-14 record and a No. 9 NCAA Tournament seed. The Sooners, who won their first 13 games and climbed to as high as No. 10 in the Coaches poll and No. 12 in the AP version, played one of the nation's toughest schedules, with 14 games against AP top-25 opponents and 22 of 34 contests against teams that made the NCAA Tournament. OU went 3-0 to win the Battle 4 Atlantis tournament in the Bahamas in November before navigating its first season in the rugged Southeastern Conference, a league that placed a record 14 teams in the NCAA Tournament. The Sooners also set a program record with their .795 free throw percentage, obliterating the previous mark of .767 by the 2001-02 Final Four team.

Point guard Jeremiah Fears was named to the 2024-25 SEC All-Freshman Team and was selected No. 7 overall in the 2025 NBA Draft by the New Orleans Pelicans to become Moser's highest draft pick. Fears was one of just three Power Four conference players (the only one in the SEC and the only freshman) to average at least 17.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.5 steals per contest.

In 2023-24, Moser guided OU to a 20-12 mark, ranking as high as seventh in the AP poll. The Sooners reached 20 regular season wins for the first time since 2015-16 and began the season 10-0, tying the 1991-92 and 2003-04 seasons for the seventh-best start in program history. OU bested Iowa and USC at the Rady Children's Invitational, claiming its second consecutive midseason tournament title, and Javian McCollum and Jalon Moore earned All-Big 12 honorable mention accolades.

Moser completed his second season in Norman in 2022-23, recording four AP Top-25 victories and winning the 2022 ESPN Events Invitational. Tanner Groves became only the second two-time College Sports Communicators (formerly CoSIDA) Academic All-American in program history, receiving third-team honors in 2023 and first-team accolades in 2022. In addition to the Sooners' success in the classroom, Milos Uzan was named to the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. Grant Sheffield and Jalen Hill received All-Big 12 Honorable Mention acclaim.

In 2021-22, Moser led the Sooners to a 19-16 mark and five victories over teams ranked in the top 25 at the time of competition. Oklahoma was selected as a No. 1 seed in the National Invitation Tournament, earning an opening-round victory over Missouri State at Lloyd Noble Center.

Umoja Gibson, Jordan Goldwire, Groves and Elijah Harkless earned All-Big 12 honorable mention honors, and C.J. Noland earned a spot on the Big 12 All-Freshman Team. In addition to the on-court success, Groves was tabbed a Senior CLASS Award Finalist and named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America First Team.

Moser received the keys to the Oklahoma men's basketball program as one of the most successful coaches of the prior half-decade. He has been entrenched in creating and developing team culture at all his stops.

Before his time in Norman, Moser led the Loyola Ramblers to remarkable success during his 10-year run as head coach, including a run to the Final Four in 2018 and Sweet Sixteen in 2021.

He amassed 188 wins (188-141, .571), including five seasons with 20-plus victories. He led Loyola to the postseason every year it was available from 2017-21, winning the 2017 CBI title and qualifying for the 2019 NIT. The 2020 postseason was canceled due to COVID-19.

In addition to his team success, he coached 12 all-conference selections, two Missouri Valley Player of the Year honorees, two Associated Press Honorable Mention All-Americans, two Academic All-Americans, a MVC Defensive Player of the Year, two MVC Sixth Man of the Year honorees and a pair of MVC Freshman of the Year selections.

Moser was one of three coaches in Loyola's history to record 150-plus wins. He guided the 2017-18 squad to a school record 32 victories and an appearance in the Final Four – Loyola's first appearance since winning the 1963 NCAA Championship.

After assembling a 25-5 regular season record (15-3 in MVC play), Moser guided Loyola to seven straight postseason wins, claiming the 2018 Missouri Valley tournament title and making a historic run to the pinnacle event of college basketball as a No. 11 seed.

The Ramblers were just the fourth No. 11 seed to advance to the Final Four, beating Miami, Tennessee, Nevada and Kansas State.

Loyola finished the 2017-18 season ranked No. 7 in the final USA Today Coaches Poll. Moser was named the Missouri Valley Conference (MVC) Coach of the Year and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) District 16 Coach of the Year.

The 2017-18 team ranked second nationally in personal fouls per game (just 13.9), third in field goal percentage (.507) and sixth in scoring defense (62.6 ppg).

During the 2017-18 season, Rambler guard Clayton Custer was named MVC Player of the Year and earned Associated Press (AP) Honorable Mention All-America honors, becoming the first player in Loyola history to receive both in the same season.

Cameron Krutwig earned MVC Freshman of the Year honors and Ben Richardson was named MVC Defensive Player of the Year. In addition to his on-court success, Custer was named CoSIDA Academic All-District. He is in his fourth year working with the Sooners and second as an assistant coach in 2024-25 after two seasons as the director of video operations and player development from 2021-23

Moser boasts six NCAA Tournament wins from 2018-21 – tied for the seventh most nationally in that time frame. Loyola, Gonzaga and Houston were the only teams outside major conferences to reach two Sweet 16s during the three-year run.

In his final season at Loyola (2020-21), Moser led the Ramblers to a 26-5 record and Missouri Valley Conference regular season and tournament titles. As an eighth seed in the NCAA Tournament, his squad upset No. 1-seed Illinois in the second round to advance to the Sweet 16 for the second time since 2018.

The 2020-21 Rambler squad ranked second in adjusted defensive efficiency (KenPom.com), allowing only 87.0 points per 100 possessions. Loyola's 16-2 record in MVC play set a program record for most wins in conference action.

After 19 wins during the 2014-15 season, the Ramblers earned a bid to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI), advancing to Loyola's first postseason appearance since the 1985 season. Loyola made the most of its chance at postseason play, winning the CBI Championship over Louisiana-Monroe with back-to-back victories in the best-of-three championship series.

After rebuilding during the 2013-14 season, Moser led the Ramblers to a 24-13 mark next season. The 24 victories were the most by a Moser led team and the most for Loyola since 1985.

In the early stages of building Loyola to a mid-major powerhouse, Moser led the Ramblers to an eight-game improvement in the win column from his first season at the helm to his second in 2012-13. The improvement was the most by a coach from his first year to his second in program history.

Owner of a 359-287 (.556) career record, Moser was hired for his first head coaching job in 2000 at Arkansas-Little Rock. In three seasons with the Trojans, Moser took over a program that went 4-24 during the season before his hiring and went 18-11 just one year later.

The Trojans ranked last in the conference in several defensive categories before his tenure. Moser turned the program around in one season, finishing with the Sun Belt's best field goal percentage defense and second-best scoring defense.

He steered the Trojans to a 54-34 overall record before heading to Illinois State in 2003.

After his 2003-04 squad notched a 10-19 record, Moser improved to 17-13 in 2004-05 despite being picked to finish last in the league in the preseason poll.

Following four years at Illinois State, Moser worked under legendary coach Rick Majerus at Saint Louis as an assistant coach from 2007 through 2011. He returned to a head coaching role by being named Loyola's head coach before the 2011-12 season.

A Chicago area native, Moser grew up in Naperville, Ill. He was a two-year starter at Creighton and helped lead the Jays to the 1989 Missouri Valley Conference title and a berth in the NCAA Tournament. He graduated in 1990 with a degree in business management.

Immediately following his collegiate playing career, Moser began his path in coaching at his alma mater as a graduate assistant. He left Creighton for an assistant coach role at Texas A&M for four seasons followed by a year at Wisconsin-Milwaukee. Moser returned to Texas A&M for two more seasons (1996-98) on the Aggies' bench, then served as an assistant coach at Little Rock for two years before his promotion to head coach.

Moser and his wife, Megan, have four children – Jordan, a former OU's women's basketball player, Jake, a former OU men's player, and Max and Ben.
