Introducing the newest generation Automatic External Defibrillator (AED): The DefibTech Lifeline AED helps you dramatically improve the odds in time-sensitive cardiac emergencies, plus it is easy to use and extremely affordable.

The Lifeline AED is for adult and pediatric use and applies biphasic technology with disposable electrodes (pads). It automatically evaluates patients for proper pad placement and analyzes ECG rhythms for shock/non-shock. Depending upon the battery, the charge time ranges from 6 to 9 seconds, while the cycle time (between shocks) is less than 20 seconds. This AED also performs daily, weekly and monthly self-tests and weighs 4.2 to 4.4 lbs (dependent upon battery chosen).
