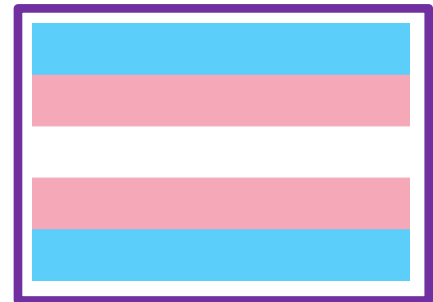
axess sexual health outreach team are offering a Trans awareness briefing session for professionals working with young people, who would like to raise their awareness of trans identity and gender
