To support teachers and professionals delivering **relationships and sex education** (RSE) to secondary school aged pupils, axess education team have produced a comprehensive educational package. This resource supports the school curriculum, providing practical support for educational staff to implement some of the sexual health elements of the statutory requirements for RSE.

The briefing session will include a Teams presentation or face to face (approx 45 minutes) which explains the axess RSE resource, how it could work in a 1:1 setting, small group work or in the classroom, top tips for teachers/professionals and an opportunity for questions and answers on sexual health topics. The areas covered include:

- Healthy relationships
- Sex and the law
- Sexually transmitted infections
- Contraception
