- To learn about the law in relation to online protection including sexting and revenge pornography
- Explore the definition and different types of sexual harassment
- Gain an understanding of confidentiality when accessing sexual health services

- ✓ The legal definition of consent and understand the law surrounding it including how to give and withdraw consent.
- ✓ The Sexual Offences Act 2003
- ✓ The ways in which to evaluate and promote online safety.

- ✓ Identifying sexual harassment
- ✓ Knowledge of local services
