Agricola Dellavalle is a family-run winery located in the hills of Monferrato, operating since 2010.

Moving to Camino to grow grapes and turn them into wine was both a professional challenge and a lifestyle choice for us.

We produce both red and white wines, exclusively from grapes grown on our estate. The reds, in keeping with Piedmontese tradition, reflect the typical characteristics of the territory. The whites lead the rediscovery of little-known native grape varieties.

In 2025, our wine-making business will be complemented by hospitality, with the idea of offering slow tourism, far from the beaten track, to discover the unique characteristics of these territories.

THE CELLAR

The winery combines the millennial winemaking tradition of Monferrato Casalese with modern winemaking technologies.

The quality of the grapes is the detail that allows us to bottle the unique characteristics of the territory. Our winemaking processes are designed to enhance the results of the work in the vineyard. The character of each wine is due to the raw material: the meticulous monitoring of each process and the constant search for aromatic purity allow us to bottle the authenticity of our territory.



HOSPITALITY

In 2025, we decided to complement our winery with hospitality services, with the idea of offering slow tourism, far from the beaten track.

In our house, we have three rooms available for guests, to whom we offer breakfast service.

A visit to our winery and the opportunity to leisurely enjoy a glass of fine wine are part of our family hospitality offering.

Camino is an excellent first stop for exploring Monferrato: a peaceful and well-kept place to stay, surrounded by small villages, castles, museums, and nature.



THE TERRITORY



Camino is located on the last ridge of hills that forms the northern border of Monferrato Casalese. These hills were formed by the overlapping of two tectonic plates that once formed the seabed. The soil is therefore very fine and calcareous, predominantly clayey, which guarantees excellent ripening of the grapes. The alternation of cultivated areas and large wooded areas characterizes a varied landscape, rich in biodiversity and wildlife. The proximity to the Alps produces the Mistral wind in spring and during the harvest.

Wine production has always been linked to Piedmontese red grape varieties, Grignolino and Barbera in particular. As in many parts of Piedmont, the 1950s and 1960s brought severe depopulation, resulting in a reduction in the area under vine.

Since the 2000s, numerous wineries have been reborn, and today the area under cultivation is constantly increasing. Alongside the traditional reds, whites have arrived, both still and Metodo Classico.
